NARRATIVE

ON 28 FEBRUARY 1970, SERGEANT FIRST CLASS WILLIAM BOYLE WAS LOADING SIX WOUNDED INDIGENOUS PERSONNEL INTO A CH-34 HELICOPTER. THE HELICOPTER, SERIAL NUMBER 554324, WAS HIT BY B-40 ROCKETS AND MACHINE GUN FIRE AND EXPLODED INTO FLAMES IN THE VICINITY OF GRID COORDINATES YB586188, APPROXIMATELY 65 KILOMETERS EAST SOUTHEAST OF MUANG MAI AND ONE KILOMETER NORTHWEST OF BAN PAKHA, ATTOPEU PROVINCE. SEARCH AND RESCUE FORCES LOCATED THE DOOR GUNNER, AND TWO INDIGENOUS PERSONNEL BUT COULD FIND NO SIGN OF SERGEANT FIRST CLASS BOYLE. THE PILOT AND CO-PILOT SURVIVED THE INCIDENT.

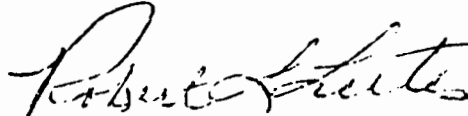

MISSING IN ACTION
BOARD
PROCEEDINGS

On 2 March 1970, at 1130 hours, pursuant to the authority of AR 15-6, AR 600-10 and USARV Regulation 600-1, a Board of Officers convened at Special Operations Augmentation, Command and Control Central, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces, located at Kontum, Republic of Vietnam, APO San Francisco 96499, to determine the status of Sergeant First Class William Boyle, , a member of this organization, who was declared Missing in Action on 28 February 1970, as a result of hostile action.

The board was detailed by Unit Orders 16, Special Operations Augmentation, Command and Control Central, 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne), 1st Special Forces, APO San Francisco 96499, dated 2 March 1970

The following members of the board were present:

The board called as a witness 1LT Leonard Kinnaird, 464-74-6701, SCA (CCC) 5th SFGA 1st SF, APO SF 96499, who was sworn and testified in substance as follows:

I am Lieutenant Kinnaird. I knew the deceased, SFC William Boyle. On 28 February 1970, at approximately 1000 hours, I saw SFC William Boyle kicking off resupplies from a CH-34 helicopter that had come to our operational area to pick up wounded personnel. SFC Brinkmeier was approximately 25 meters away from the helicopter. I personally assisted one of the wounded onto the aircraft. SFC Boyle was inside the ship and was receiving the dead and wounded personnel and placing them in the cargo compartment of the helicopter. We loaded a total of five wounded and one dead paramilitary personnel onto the helicopter. After the last man was loaded into the helicopter, I ran to about 25 meters away in the general area of SFC Brinkmeier. I heard what I assumed to be machinegun fire, then something exploded inside the helicopter and the whole cargo compartment was engulfed in flames. The explosion was so tremendous that it ripped the cockpit from that cabin of the ship and left an escape for the pilot and co-pilot, who climbed to safety. After the wreckage had cooled thorough check was made of the entire area. We found the door gunner, who undoubtedly was blown out of the ship at the time of the explosion and two other paramilitary personnel. We searched the area again and again and no trace of anyone else was presence. The entire ship was burned to ashes. It was only a small piece of fused metal left. I am positive that SFC Boyle burned in the ship. There being no further questions the witness was excused and withdrew from the hearing.

The board called as a witness Sergeant First Class Robert C Brinkmeier, 571-56-2966, SOA (CCC) 5th SFG (Abn) 1st SF, APO SF 96499, who was sworn and testified in substance as follows:

I am SFC Brinkmeier. I have known the deceased, SFC Boyle, for many years. I recognized the American that was in the helicopter that crashed as being Sergeant Boyle. On 28 February 1970, a CH-34 helicopter came into our operational area to bring resupplies and to pick up one dead and five wounded paramilitary personnel. When the helicopter came into the landing zone I saw Sergeant Boyle throwing out resupply bundles. I was standing about 25 meters away. Lieutenant Kinnaird, went to the helicopter and assisted one of the wounded on to the helicopter. He immediately returned to the perimeter. The aircraft was then hit with B-40 rockets and machine gun fire. The ship burst into flames and burned rapidly. One dead and five wounded SCU were loaded on the chopper. The last two SCU that were loaded on the chopper was blown out by the blast. The door gunner was blown from the door of the helicopter by the explosion. The pilot and co-pilot left the aircraft through the upper part of the front cabin. One of the SCU that was blown out of the aircraft was still burning when we found him. SP4 Lambert, 1LT Kinnaird and myself search the entire area around the wreckage and found only the bodies of the two SCU. Everything else was totally destroyed by the fire. In fact, the only thing left was a hunk of molded together metal. I am sure SFC Boyle was burned in the fire.

There being no further questions the witness was excused and withdrew from the hearing

The board called as a witness 1LT Richard D. Vander Zwalm, SOA (CCC) 5th SFG (Abn) 1st SF, APO San Francisco 96499, who was unavailable to testify at the hearing due to operational commitments.

The sworn statement made on 1 March 1970, by Lieutenant Vander Zwalm was read into evidence by the recorder. (See Inclosure E)

There being no further witnesses or evidence to submit the board discussed the evidence at hand at 1440 hours, 2 March 1970.

VERBATUM FINDINGS

1. At 1600 hours, 2 March 1970, the below findings were concluded.

a. That the CH-34 helicopter that departed Dakto Air Field, tail number 324, was the aircraft that crashed and completely burned on 28 February 1970 at about 1000 hours.

a. That the aircraft contained one American six paramilitary personnel, two Vietnamese pilots and one Vietnamese door gunner.

c. That SFC William Boyle was the American on that the aircraft.

d. That all personnel aboard the aircraft, with the exception of the pilot co-pilot and door gunner, died prior to or as a result of the crash.

e. That proper identification was made of SFC William Boyle, and that he died in the aircraft either as a result of hostile fire or by cremation.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS:

Based on the facts and evidence given by the three Americans that were within 30 meters of the crash, the launch officer that dispatched the aircraft to the operational area, and the fact that a thorough search of the area was conducted by Americans shortly after the crash, it is recommended that the "missing in action" of Sergeant First Class William Boyle, , be listed as "Killed in Action", on or about 1000 hours, 28 February 1970, and that all documents reflecting the missing in action status of the deceased be amended to Killed in Action.

3. The President of the board adjourned the proceeding at 1625 hours 2 March 1970.
