12-1507-65	Official letter Official letter dated 1 December 1965, from Thich Giac Luong of V.417, to Thich Thanh Minh of Quang Nam Liberation Youth Association, telling him that their appointment will have to be postponed, and inquiring about the following: - Whether the Buddhists understand the NFLSVN religious policy. - How local cadre implement this policy. - What political tendencies the Buddhist leaders show. - What the urban Buddhists know about the VC and RVN, and what are their political tendencies. - What gaps should be filled and what measures should be enforced in the cities. - What are RVN's schemes toward the religions. - How they affect Buddhist ranks. - What activity the Quoc Dan Dang Party is carrying out. - What are the earnest aspirations of the Buddhists. - How the U. S. peace policy affects Buddhist ranks. - How Venerable Thich Tam Chau's appeal to Buddhists to move into war refugees' areas affects the Buddhists.	14 Dec 65, vic. Luong also inquires whether Minh has received a document titled "Buddhists carrying out the task of saving the country and the religion"; and how effectively it is disseminated. Minh is advised to discuss with some Buddhist monks the plans for motivating the Buddhists on the basis that Buddhism cannot service under the U. S. yoke but will service only in a free and independent Vietnam with its national sovereignty and territorial integrity secured. Also requested is information concerning the December election of the new leadership committee of the "Vien Hoa Dao" [Institute for the Execution of the Dharma].

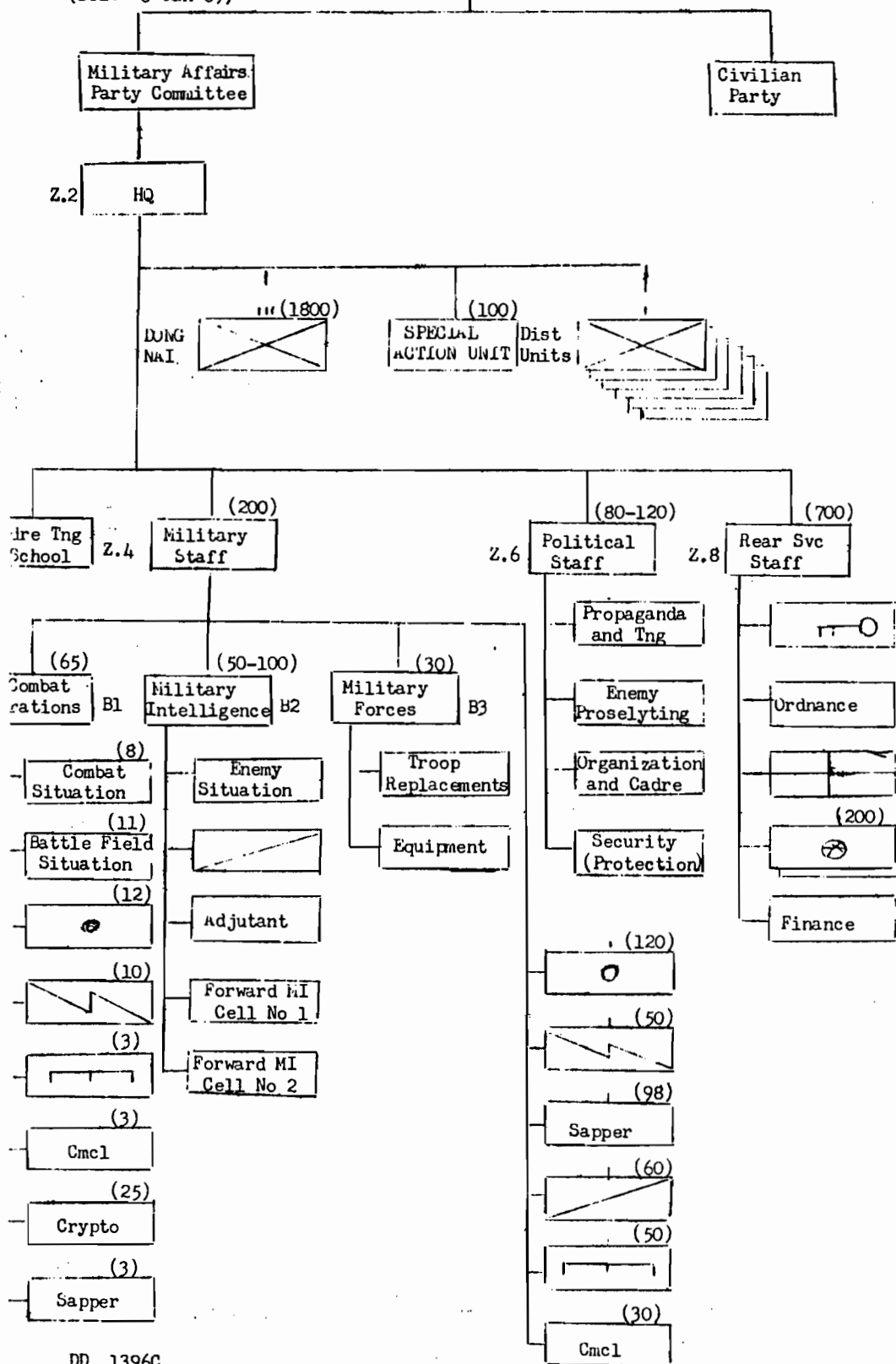

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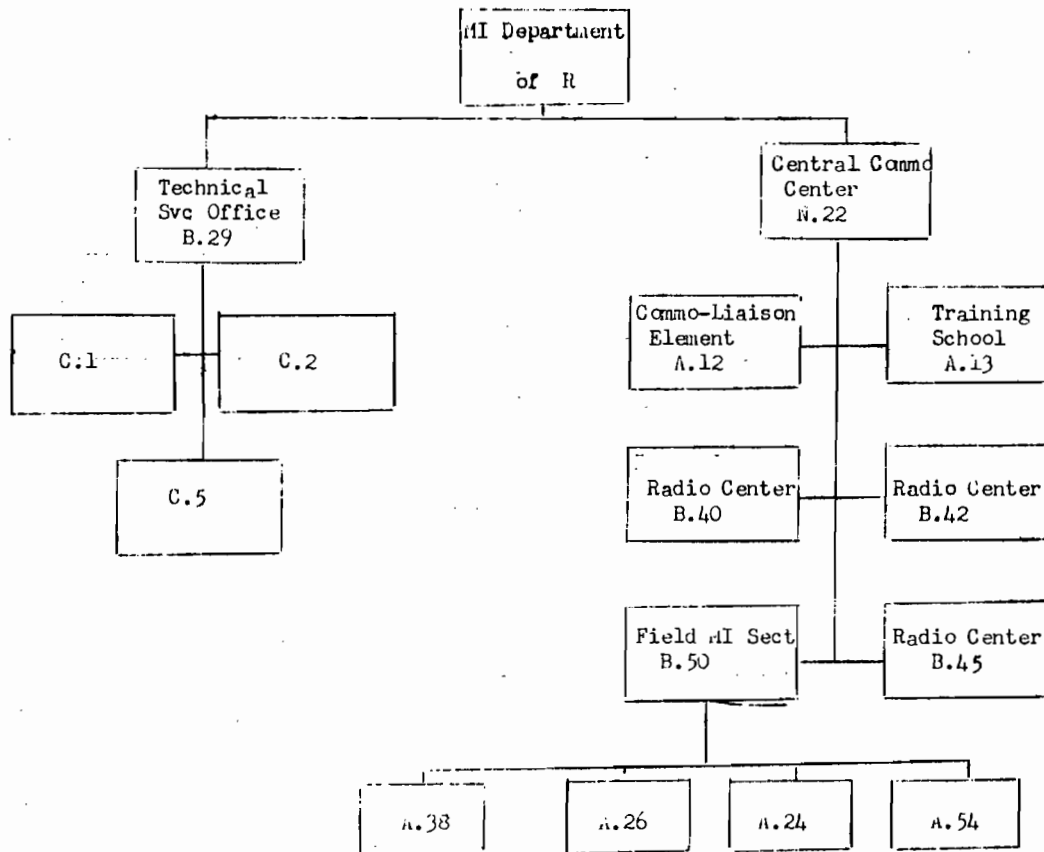

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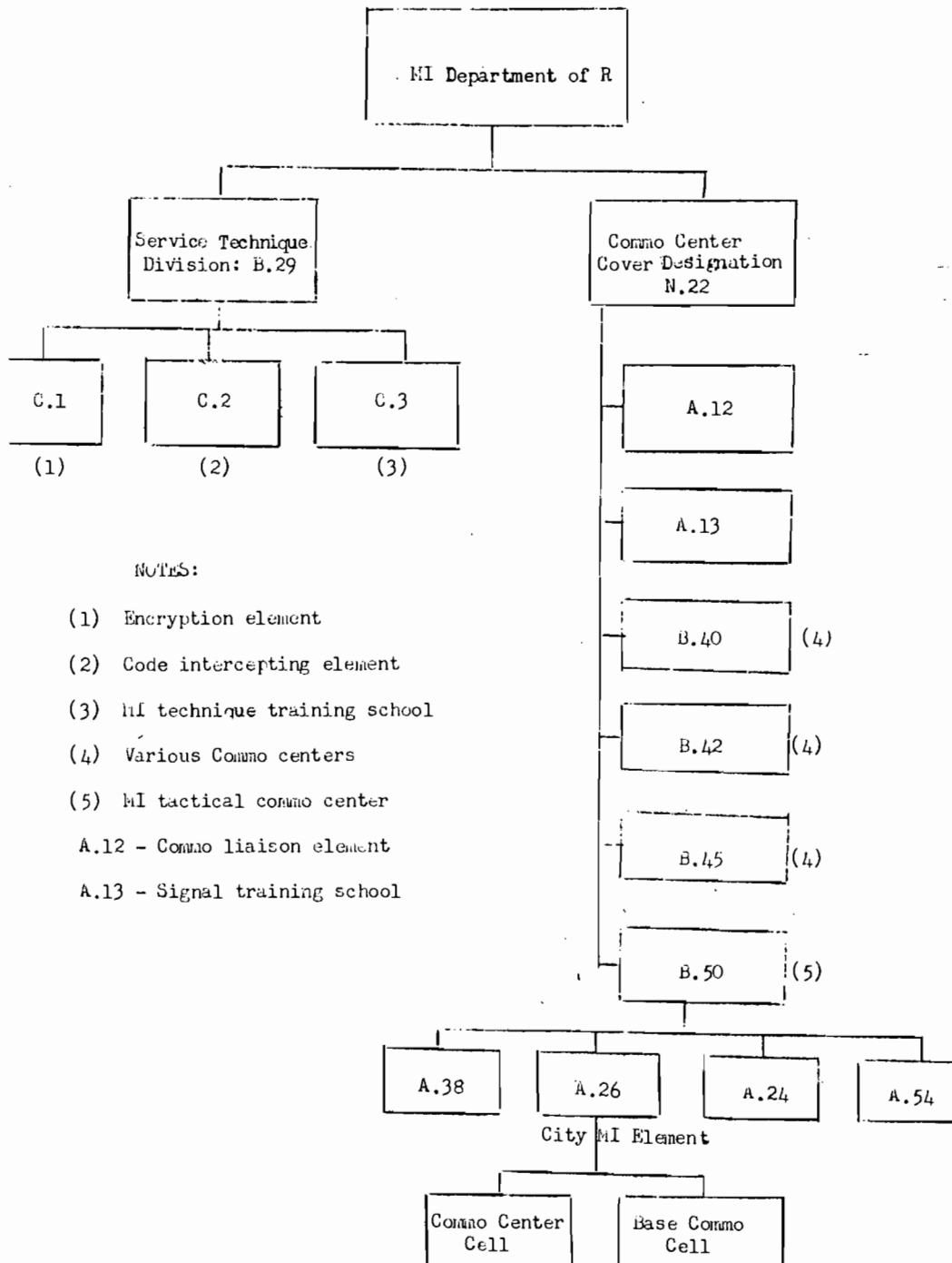

Chart of organization of MI Department of R



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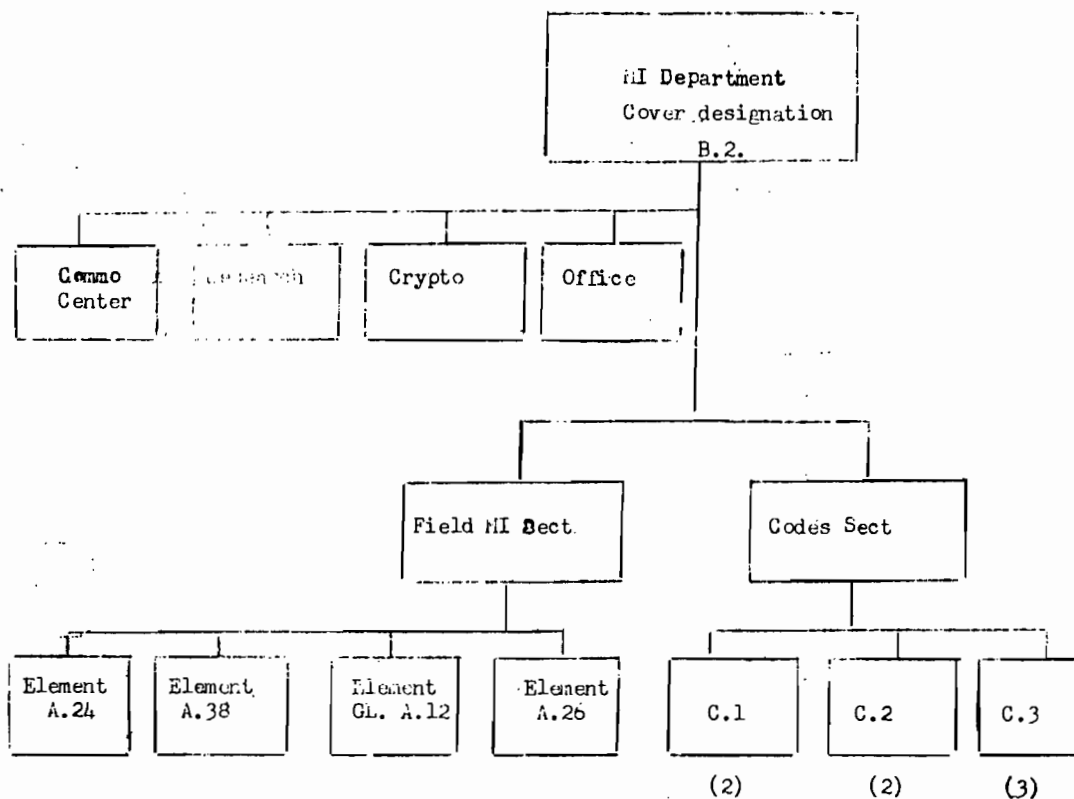
