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## REFERENCE REPORT

Inquiry: Information on Missing Russian Servicemen in State Department Files.

State Department records dated through 1963 are in the National Archives at College Park. There may be records on the following incidents: 1) Air Force, November 18, 1952; 2) Air Force, September 4, 1950; 3) Air Force, July 22, 1953; and 4) Navy, December 15, 1952.

The central files of the Department of State for the period of interest are arranged according to a decimal system of subject classification. Some of the most relevant subject files are listed below:

- 611.61 Political Relations between the U.S. (11) and the Soviet Union (61)
- 761.00 Internal Political Affairs of the Soviet Union
- 761.5621 Submarine accidents in the Soviet Union
- 711.5461 Movements of, and attacks upon naval vessels and military and naval aircraft.
- 761.5622 Military and naval aircraft accidents in the Soviet Union
- 961.523 Commercial and private aircraft accidents in the Soviet Union (1950-1954)
- 961.723 Commercial and private aircraft accidents in the Soviet Union (1955-1963)
