Beyond Nam Dong is Roger H. C. Donlon's personal story, from his boyhood days in up-state New York, to his account of the siege of Nam Dong, Vietnam, and his own path to reconciliation. With Foreword by General William C. Westmoreland, U. S. Army (Retired.)

The author is the first recipient of the Medal of Honor awarded for valor in Vietnam. In his own words he describes the battle that he and his brave twelve-man Special Forces Team, A-726, fought at Nam Dong. It was the first time that regular North Vietnamese Army Forces joined the Viet Cong in an attempt to overrun an American outpost. Team A-726 successfully defended Camp Nam Dong from this pre-dawn attack by a reinforced battalion of some 800 to 900 men.
