1. PURPOSE THIS MSG IS TO UPDATE STATUS KUSHI-WAN PROJECT PRIOR SECNAV VISIT.
2. MEMO TO CHM JCS FROM SECDEF DTD 5 JUL 66 AS FOLLOWS: "LTCENR INDEFINITELY THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF AN ADDITIONAL JET-CAPABLE AIRFIELD ON OKINAWA. WHILE AN AIRFIELD AT KUSHI-WAN WOULD PROVIDE AN IMPROVED AIR OPERATIONAL CAPABILITY ON OKINAWA, THE ADDITIONAL BASE DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE JUSTIFIED IN VIEW OF THE EXTENSIVE SEA BASE CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM AND THE EXISTING COMPLEX OF AIRBASES IN JAPAN, KOREA, OKINAWA, TAIWAN AND THE PHILIPPINES."

1. DURING THE PERIOD 16 TO 21 JULY, PROFESSOR HENRY KISSINGER, AUTHOR AND STATE DEPARTMENT CONSULANT, WILL VISIT VIETNAM UNDER DEPARTMENT OF STATE SPONSORSHIP. US EMBASSY IS PREPARING AN ITINERARY WHICH WILL INCLUDE DISCUSSIONS AT THIS HEADQUARTERS AND MAY INCLUDE A VISIT AT YOUR HEADQUARTERS FOR DISCUSSIONS WITH YOU.

2. IN ADDITION TO OBSERVING ACTIVITIES YOU MAY SELECT, PROFESSOR KISSINGER NO DOUBT WILL SEEK YOUR VIEWS ON A RANGE OF SUBJECTS, TO INCLUDE SUCH TOPICS AS:

A. REVOLUTIONARY DEVELOPMENT AND ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES, PARTICULARLY CONCEPTS AND APPARATUS FOR COORDINATION AND INTEGRATION OF MILITARY, CIVIL, ECONOMIC, POLITICAL AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS AND THE IMPACT OF THESE ACTIVITIES ON POLITICAL EVOLUTION.

B. POLITICAL/MILITARY ENVIRONMENT IN RELATION TO NEGOTIATIONS, INCLUDING BASES FOR SUCH ACTION; MILITARY/PARAMILITARY POSTURE; DEVELOPMENTAL STAGES AND ALTERNATIVES OTHER THAN NEGOTIATIONS. THE SENSITIVITY OF DISCUSSION ON THIS SUBJECT WILL, OF COURSE, BE RECOGNIZED.

3. YOU WILL BE ADVISED FURTHER ON DETAILS KISSINGER VISIT.

INCREASED BASE LOADING AT CHU LAI (U)

1. FOLLOWING OUR DISCUSSIONS ON CHU LAI I HAVE HAD TWO TALKS HERE WITH CINCPAC. FROM THEM IT IS APPARENT TO ME THAT AS SOON AS THERE IS A USABLE RUNWAY, TAXIWAY AND PARKING APRON AT CHU LAI THERE IS GOING TO BE PRESSURE ON US TO MOVE, BECAUSE OF THE HIGH LEVEL DESIRE TO UNLOAD DANANG. WE ARE NOT GOING TO BE PERMITTED TO WAIT FOR ALL HANGARS, TEST STANDS, AND OTHER FACILITIES TO BE COMPLETED AS A PREREQUISITE FOR OUR OCCUPANCY OF CHU LAI MAIN.

2. CONSEQUENTLY WE SHOULD DEVELOP A PLAN NOW WHICH RECOGNIZES THE ABOVE, AND WHICH WILL BE MOST DESIRABLE AND ECONOMICAL FOR THE MOVE OF MAG-13 AND THE OCCUPANCY OF THE PERMANENT FIELD AT CHU LAI, FROM OUR OWN VIEW POINT.

3. I CAN INFLUENCE THE TIMING ON ORDERS TO MOVE MAG-13 AND AID THE OCCUPANCY OF CHU LAI TO SOME DEGREE, BUT IN ORDER TO DO SO, WE SHOULD HAVE AN AGREED UPON GENERAL PLAN. THIS PLAN SHOULD ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

- A. WHAT UNITS SHOULD GO TO CHU LAI DIRECT FROM IWAKUNI, AND WHEN?
- B. WHAT UNITS SHOULD GO TO DANANG? WHEN AND FOR HOW LONG?
- C. WHAT SHOULD BE DONE ABOUT GANTONMENT CONSTRUCTION AT CHU LAI? WHEN INITIATED, BY WHOM AND HOW?
- D. WHAT SHOULD BE DONE WITH MAG-13 GANTONMENT CONSTRUCTION AT DANANG?
- E. SHOULD THE MID-WEST PARKING APRON AT DANANG BE RE-PROGRAMED FOR CHU LAI?

4. GIVE ME YOUR DESIRES ON EACH SUBJECT BY 20 JULY IN ORDER THAT I CAN SUPPORT YOU IN ACHIEVING THE OPTIMUM ARRANGEMENT UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES. REGARDS.
