

THEIR DUTY IS NO SMALL BURDEN, AND THEY PERSONALLY VIEW ITS GRIM RESULTS. A MILITARY OFFICER, NO LESS THAN ANY ONE ELSE. IS ANGUISHED BY DEATH AMONG HIS COMPANIONS. PARA THE COMMANDER'S GRUEL TASK IS SO OFTEN TO SEND ONE BOY TO DIE NOW A SO THAT OTHERS MAY AVOID DEATHLATER. SINCE HISTORY NEVER REVEALS IT ALTERNATIVES. WHILE CONDUCTING AN OPERATION. THE PATROL OBSERVED THE LOW ORDER DETONATION OF ONE B-40 ROCKET ABOUT 15 METERS TO THEIR FRONT. THE LEADING ELEMENT IMMEDIATELY EXPERIENCED NAUSEA AND VOMITING. THE ENTIRE GROUP EXPERIENCED LETHARGY AND TIREDNESS. A NUMBER ALSO EXPERIENCED PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS SUCH AS APATHY AND LACK OF INTEREST IN WHAT WAS HAPPENING. 
