





COMMITTEE CONTINUES TO PROBE ARMY REHAB METHODS. BELIEVE THEY ARE CONVINCED ARMY SHOULD NOT REHAB HERE-PERHAPS SPECIAL CONUS UNIT OR VA PEHAB UNIT.

COMMITTEE CONTINUES TO EMPHASIZE LACK OF MARIJUANA "HANGOVER", RATHER THAN THE MIND ALTERING EXPERIENCE OF MH.

COMMITTEE GAINING IMPRESSION THAT MILITARY COMES IN CONTACT WITH DRUG ABUSER ONLY IN CONJUNCTION WITH OTHER OFFENSES. RATHER THAN FROM A SINGLE DRUG ABUSE CASE OR OFFENSE.






