DIVISION, AND HQS, XXIV CORPS.
3. THE SUB-COMMITTEE RECEIVED COMBINED BRIEFINGS FOLLOWED BY
INDIVIDUAL AND GROUP CLOSED SESSION INTERVIEWS WITH 170014, THE
VISIT TO LZ BOYER INCLUDED LUNCH WITH 170014 WHO HAD JUST RETURNED
TO THE FIRE SUPPORT BASE FROM THE FIELD. ADDITIONAL INTERVIEWS
INCLUDED PARTICIPANTS IN THE AMNESTY PROGRAM, TROOP AWAITING
ADMINISTRATIVE DISCHARGE, OTHER ENLISTED PERSONNEL OF THE LOW
GRADE GRADES AND SEVERAL NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICERS. QUESTIONS MOST
FREQUENTLY ASKED DURING THE EXERCISES WERE: THE EXTENT OF

AND THE FACT THAT THEY WERE PRIMARILY INTERESTED IN DISCUSSIONS WITH THE TROOPS. IT WAS INDICATED THAT AFTER FOUR DAYS OF CONCENTRATED BRIEFINGS, INTERVIEWS AND DISCUSSIONS THE INFORMATION NOW RECEIVED WAS BECOMING REPETITIOUS. FOLLOWING THE VISIT TO THE 1ST INF BDE ON 12 JAN 1978 THE SUB-COMMITTEE PLANNED TO RETURN TO SAIGON. THEY WERE OF THE BELIEF THAT THE MILITARY WAS ACUTELY AWARE OF THE DRUG PROBLEM AND WAS AGGRESSIVELY SEEKING TO CONTROL IT NOT ONLY THROUGH EDUCATION, ENFORCEMENT AND AMNESTY PROGRAMS BUT ALSO THROUGH IDENTIFICATION AND APPREHENSION OF VIETNAMESE DRUG PUSHERS BY USE OF COMBINED INVESTIGATION TEAMS. THEY ALSO IMPLIED THAT IN THEIR OPINION THE PRESS HAD FAILED TO FOCUS SUFFICIENT ATTENTION TOWARD THESE POSITIVE PROGRAMS RATHER THAN THE NEGATIVE ASPECTS OF THE SITUATION. I BELIEVE THE SUB-COMMITTEE HAD BECOME WELL VERSED REGARDING THE DRUG SITUATION AND RECOGNIZES THE DIVERGENT PHILOSOPHICAL VIEWS OF THE AMNESTY PROGRAM AS BRIEFED BY US ARMY AND MARINE CORPS UNITS.
