OCT 6 1965

1 Sept 1965: At 2230H movement noted 20 yards front of the Battalion Perimeter post #9. Orders were given to challenge, illuminate and if there was no proper response to open fire. After illumination, no further movement was noted. The posts were again cautioned to be attentive and to apply the rules of engagement in all cases.

3 Sept 1965: At 2330H Battalion perimeter post number 6 fired 4 flares and 7 rounds from an M-14 at a suspect near the double apron fence. Results were negative.

4 Sept 1965: At 1510H G-3, 3d MarDiv requested 3 additional LVTP-5s to support 9th Marines. The LVT Platoon H&S Company filled this commitment. At 2110H information was received from 9th Marines S-2 that 1 VC Squad from Hoa Lai Village set 4 AT Mines at (AT 968670) (AT 974670) (AT 970666) and (AT 976664). Units were notified. At 2325H Commander of the Guard reported that post #5 saw a male VCS located close to his post. Area illuminated and the suspect disappeared.

6 Sept 1965: Capt R. L. CHAPMAN assigned as Commanding Officer of Headquarters and Service Company vice 1stLt. R. G. SCHWARZ reassigned as Battalion S-2. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 35 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

7 Sept 1965: At 2200H PFC F. D. PHIPPS of Company "B" was wounded in rear of the head by mortar fragments. He was admitted to C Med at 2300 and released to duty at 1030H the following day. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 55 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

8 Sept 1965: At 1510H apprehended 2 VCS in Battalion CP area. One was armed with a .45 cal. pistol. Were delivered to the Division Collection point. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 20 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

9 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 126 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 99572).

10 Sept 1965: At 1500H this Battalion in conjunction with the 3d Tank Battalion and 3d Motor Transport Battalion celebrated a Vietnamese Holiday with the Phong Le Bac Villagers. Milk, Cookies, gum and clothing were distributed. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 25 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

11 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 82 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

12 Sept 1965: Cpl S. E. PRICE of Company "B" WIA by mortar fragments in his chest. Evacuated to C Med for further evacuation to Clark AFB Hospital.

13 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 35 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

14 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 65 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

15 Sept 1965: At 0730H and again at 1430H H&S Co's LVTR-1 was dispatched to recover Ontos' damaged by mines.

16 Sept 1965: At 0805H the LVTR-1 of H&S Company was sent to assist in the recovery of a Company "B" LVT at AT 996654. At 1515H LVTP5 B-26 struck a land mine. The vehicle was damaged beyond repair and the resulting fire and explosion caused 1 KIA PFC D. D. CASE, 4 WIAs, LCpl G. R. KINNEY, Jr., Cpl F. V. LABRADOR Jr., LCpl E. BOULLION and LCpl T. BRIGGS all from Company "B". The vehicle was moved to the Company "B" maintenance area in the vicinity of Marble Mountain where it was subsequently rigged to move on its own power back to this CP.

17 Sept 1965: At 2045H G-3, 3d MarDiv requested 2 additional LVTP5s for operations with 3d Marines. LVT Platoon H&S Company was assigned the Commitment. At 2100H the Battalion Rapid Reaction Force was activated to apprehend suspected VCS in front of post #5. After sweeping the area the RRF reported back at 2300H with no contact. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 156 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

18 Sept 1965: 2nd Lt. D. T. WARDEN Company "A", 1st AMTrac Bn was injured in a C-130 aircraft crash near Qui Nhon. He was evacuated to the 8th Field Hospital, Clark AFB on 22 Sept. Further evacuation to CONUS contemplated. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 110 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

19 Sept 1965: At 1538H received message from 3d Tank Bn stating that there had been an assassination in the Village of Phong Le Bac (1) adjacent to this CP. It was further reported that 12 VC were in the village. The Battalion Security Guard was placed on 100% alert and the RRF was placed on a standby status. At 1555H the 9th Marines sent a patrol through Phong Le Bac Village. Small arms fire was heard in the area. At 1835H a message from 3d Marines indicated that one of

this Battalion's refuelers was on its side in a ditch adjacent^{to} E Co. 2/3's position near Le My (AT 898811). The Battalion MTO and wrecker were dispatched to recover the refueler.

20 Sept 1965: At 0850H the refueler was returned to this CP. Only superficial damage noted. The vehicle was fully operational.

21 Sept 1965: At 1630H Maj Gen. L. W. WALT, Division Commanding General arrived at this CP. He toured the area and talked with Marines of the various units and sections of this organization. He was shown LVT #B-26 that had been destroyed by a mine and commented favorably on the ability of the Company "B" Maintenance personnel to bring the damaged vehicle back under its own power. Maj Gen WALT departed the CP at 1655H. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 55 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

22 Sept 1965: Received fuel ferrying assemblies.

23 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 122 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

24 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 35 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

25 Sept 1965: H&S Company conducted a field firing exercise at Hoa Cam Training Center. Zeroed individual weapons and fired crew served weapons organic to the unit. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 50 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

26 Sept 1965: At 1112H 2 LVTP5s from H&S Company departed on a riparian patrol on the Song Cau Do River with elements of 3d AT Bn. At 1315H the LVTs returned from patrol. No contact.

27 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 63 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

28 Sept 1965: The first increment of material for the cantonment program received. At 1100H 2 LVTP5s from H&S Company departed on a Riparian Patrol on the Song Cau Do River with elements of 3d AT Bn. At 1330H one of the LVTP5s on the patrol broke an idler arm assembly (AT 977699) near Cam Hoa Village. A field fix was installed and the vehicle was brought back to the RR bridge (AT 998705) where it experienced another break down. Security was established for the vehicle and it remained there over night and was repaired the next morning and returned to this CP. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 67 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

29 Sept 1965: Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 80 Vietnamese civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

30 Sept 1965: LVTP5 #B-23 hit an AT Mine at BT 091682. The vehicle was damaged but not destroyed. 2 LVTP5s were dispatched from Company "B" to assist in the recovery. There were no personnel casualties. Battalion medical personnel gave medical treatment to 50 Vietnamese Civilians from the Village of Phong Le Bac (AT 995712).

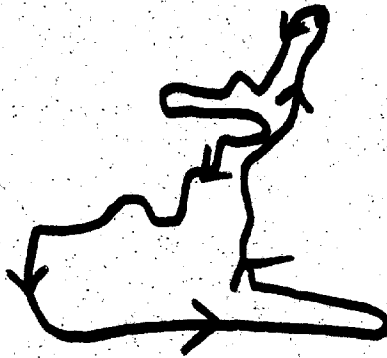

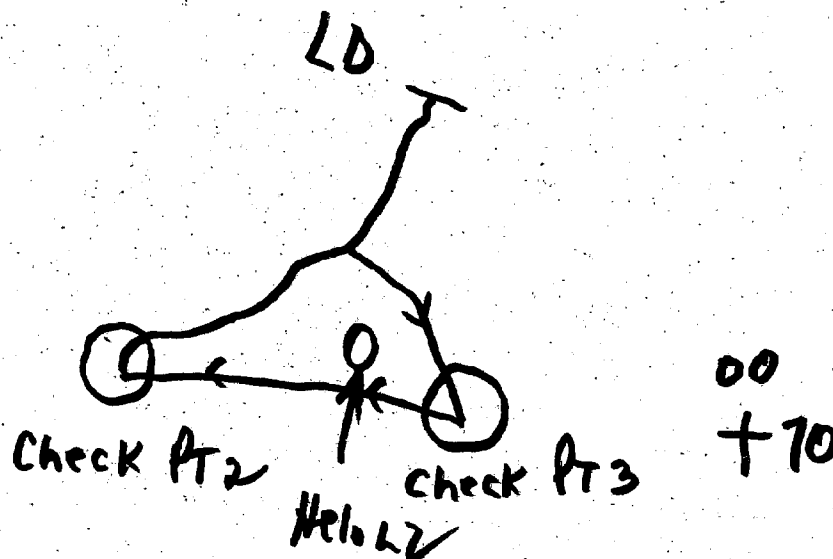

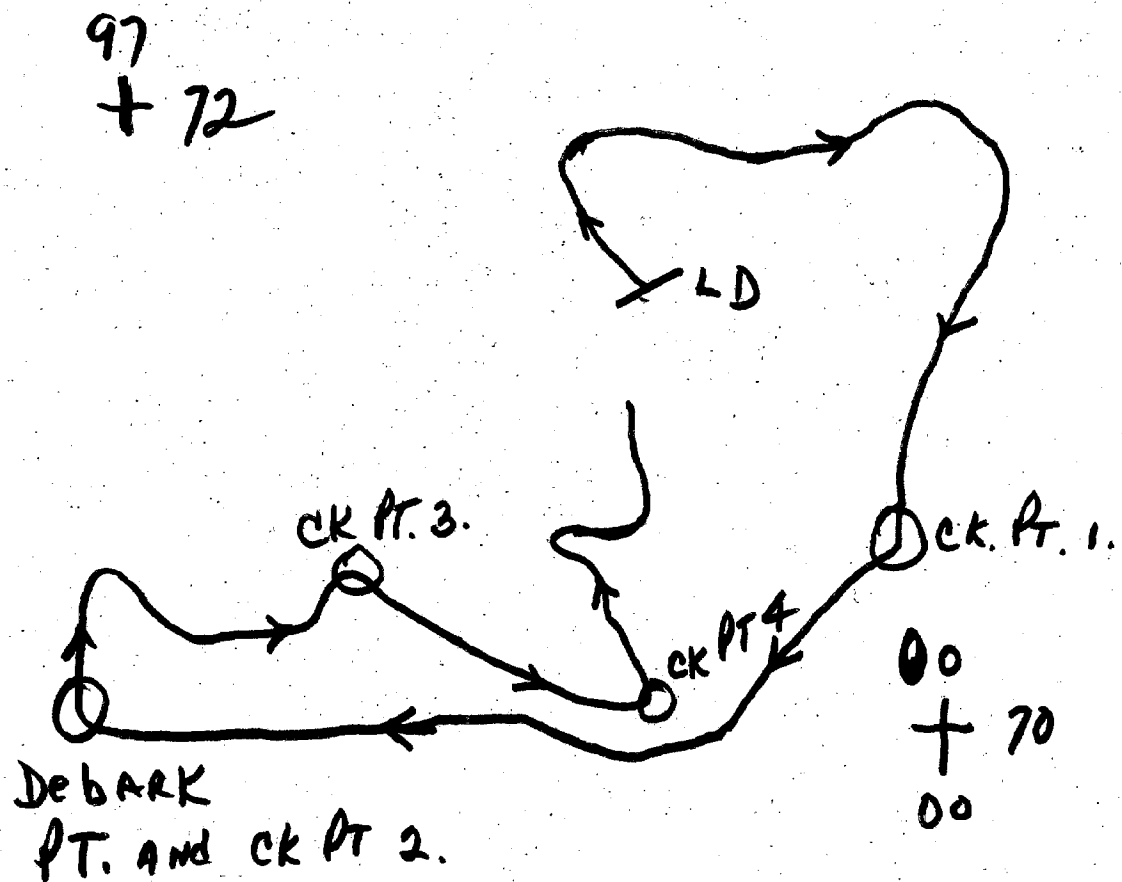

As the patrol was deployed along the trail at these coordinates noise and movement were detected approximately 150 meters down the trail, towards the southwest. The patrol leader felt that a small VC patrol was heading Northeast up the trail when they detected the USMC patrol.

251100H

(AT 880620)

When the patrol occupied an OP position at these coordinates, they detected a possible enemy OP position or sniper emplacement. Human dung approximately four days old was noted. The area was well policed.

261200H

(AT 877610)

At these coordinates at the bend in the stream and near several rock formations human dung was detected about four days old.

261930H

(AT 888602)

When the patrol occupied this area several old shell casings were found. Two overhead shelters were approximately 6 feet high, 6 feet long, 6 feet wide. On the topographical crest a 4 strand, 34 foot, barbed wire complex encircled the topographical crest. The shelters were located in the center of the complex. The wire complex was 100 meters long and 50 meters wide. These shelters and the wire obstacle were probably constructed several months ago.

Significant Remarks:

- (1) The trails used by the patrol were free of booby traps and no trail markings were noted. The trails appear frequently used. The width of the trails are generally 11 inches - 18 inches wide.

Subj: Command Chronology

1. Company A, 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion continues in General support of the 4th Marines.
2. One (1) LVTP5 from Headquarters Platoon, eight LVTP5's from the 2nd Platoon and one (1) LVTP5 from the 4th Platoon are in direct support of First Battalion, 4th Marines. Two (2) LVTP5's from the 4th Platoon in direct support of Second Battalion, 4th Marines. One (1) LVT(CMD) from Headquarters Platoon, three (3) LVTP5's from 3rd Platoon and two (2) LVTP5's from 4th Platoon are in direct support of Third Battalion, 4th Marines.
3. The most significant event of the month was the firing of two line charges by two LVTELAL's on operation Piranaha 6-9 September 1965. This marks the first time in history that a line charge has been fired in combat by EL's.
4. The problem area is the lack of support from supply as previously reported in the periodic logistics reports and the combat deadline essential equipment reports.
