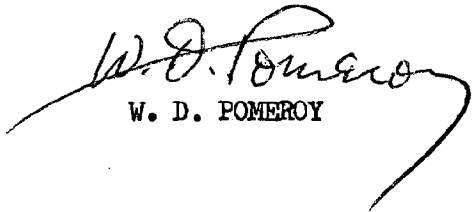

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SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 Jan 1966: The Battalion continues in general support of the 3d Marine Division. A perimeter patrol is sent out on a search and clear mission on our eastern perimeter each day. This patrol will not be mentioned unless a significant event occurs. The Battalion continues to provide daily excess foodstuffs (garbage) to the villagers of Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712). This excess feed is used to feed the village livestock, and amounts to approximately 110 lbs. per day.

2 Jan 1966: Thirty four LVTs are being utilized in Operation War Bonnet.

3 Jan 1966: Four LVTs departed the Battalion CP with Medical Personnel who gave medical aid to approximately 75 patients (12 dental). Candy and gum were also distributed to approximately 250 children at the Khue Trung Sampan hamlet at (BT 036755).

5 Jan 1966: A Battalion Medical Team consisting of 1 Doctor and 3 Corpsmen, gave medical assistance to 65 villagers of Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712).

6 Jan 1966: LVTE-1s in support of 3/3 destroyed 30 bunkers, 14 houses and 1½ miles of trench line in Cam Ne (4) while on a Civil Affairs area reclamation project. The Battalion Civil Affairs Officer, 1 Doctor, 1 Dentist, 1 Dental Assistant and 4 Corpsmen embarked on 4 LVTs for the Sampan community of Khue Trung (BT 036755) and rendered medical and dental assistance to a total of 103 patients (11 extractions).

7 Jan 1966: A Battalion Medical Team treated 52 patients from Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712).

8 Jan 1966: A Company "B" LVT, B-44, hit a land mine at (BT 054657). Vehicle operational, one crewman WIA.

9 Jan 1966: The Battalion area was measured. It comprises approximately 43 acres. Two LVTE-1s were dispatched to FLSG to blade the area in order to clear uncharted French mines. General Wallace M. GREEN, Commandant of the Marine Corps, Major General L. W. WALT and Sergeant Major SWEET arrived at the Battalion CP for a visit and briefing.

10 Jan 1966: Three LVTs departed this CP for the Khue Trung Sampan Village MEDCAP Program.

11 Jan 1966: Thirty Five LVTs including the LVTH-6s are presently involved in Operation Mallard.

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12 Jan 1966: Received 10 rebuilt LVTs from the R&E Program.

13 Jan 1966: Two LVTs were dispatched for the Sampan Village MEDCAP Program. In addition to the medical aid, four 100 lbs. sacks of corn, 37 lbs. of candy, 50 lbs. of clothing and 500 bars of soap were distributed to the villagers. Accompanying the LVTs were the Battalion Medical Officer, 1 Dentist, 1 Dental Technician, 3 Corpsmen, the Battalion Civil Affairs NCO and two Newsmen. LVTE-1s are clearing three suspected mine fields at the southern perimeter of the DaNang Airfield using the excavator blade.

14 Jan 1966: Two LVTE-1s continued clearing mined areas at the DaNang Airfield. A total of seven mines were detonated by the LVTE-1s and four were detonated by engineer personnel after being uncovered by the LVTE-1s. LVT, A-48, struck a land mine in the vicinity of Le My (AT 896824). Three VN civilians were killed and one Marine WIA. The vehicle was totally destroyed. This is significant as it is the first mine encountered by LVTs in this area of operations. 200 packages of candy and 500 bars of soap were given to the aid station at Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712). 500 bars of soap and 30 boxes of candy were also distributed to the villagers.

15 Jan 1966: Thirty one LVTs including LVTE-1s and LVTH-6s are in support of Operation Big Lodge. LVTE-1s fired four line charges and observed four confirmed secondary detonations in support of this operation.

16 Jan 1966: Two LVTE-1s are being utilized to excavate probable mined areas on the northeast perimeter of the DaNang Airfield. The Battalion's underground command center bunker is nearing completion. The Battalion Enlisted Club and Officers/Staff Club are nearing completion.

17 Jan 1966: Four MEDCAP LVTs departed the Battalion CP for the Khue Trung Sampan village on the Song Han River (BT 036755). The Medical Team, consisting of 1 Dentist, 1 Doctor, 1 Dental Technician and 3 Corpsmen, gave medical aid to 90 patients. In addition, the Civil Affairs Officer distributed 50 lbs. of candy and 500 bars of soap to approximately 300 villagers.

18 Jan 1966: Submitted LVT inventory to CMC (Code CSX-5). The LVTE-1s are being utilized on occasion to excavate in front of the Battalion Perimeter to insure against VC mine emplacement.

24 Jan 1966: The 1st (Prov) Armored Amphibian Platoon (Rein) embarked aboard ship at Tien Sha Ramp for Operation Double Eagle. Four LVTs with 1 Doctor and 2 Corpsmen, visited the Sampan village of Khue Trung (BT 036755) and gave medical treatment to 75 patients. Thirty lbs. of candy and 300 bars of soap was distributed to approximately 300 children and adults. A Medical Team from the Batt-

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alien also gave medical aid to 60 patients from Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712).

25 Jan 1966: By direction of G-3, the Battalion committed 6 LVTs to 2/9 to use as a river block/patrol.

27 Jan 1966: By direction of G-3, a "Clutch Platoon" (Infantry) was organized from Company "B" and were placed in direct support of 1/9.

28 Jan 1966: Major General L. W. WALT arrived at the Battalion CP for a review and presentation of decorations. The Division Band was also present. The Commanding General decorated 5 men. One Navy Commendation Medal and four Purple Hearts (see S-1 Journal). General WALT also addressed all hands in a brief but effective talk. At 282145H The Battalion held a defense drill.

29 Jan 1966: H&S Company distributed TET gifts to approximately 200 villagers of Phong Le Bac (1) (AT 995712). The children were also given boxes of candy and soap.

31 Jan 1966: Three LVTs departed this Battalion for MEDCAP at Khue Trung Sampan village on the Song Han River. Engineers are repairing the LVT river access points on Highway 1(B) at the Railroad Bridge.

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COMMAND CHRONOLOGY

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1-31 January 1966

Section XII - Company "A" 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion

1. Operations. Company A, 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion was attached to the 1st Marines effective 20 January 1966.

a. During the period covered by this report, the principal tactical operations conducted by elements of this unit were by Headquarters Section, First and Second Platoons in support of Task Force Delta and elements of the First, Second and Third Platoons in support of 1st Battalion, 4th Marines.

(1) On 15 January AMTracs participated in a combined amphibious and helicopter borne assault of Battalion size on Hoa Xuan Island. After landing troops, the AMTracs retracted and set up a river block during the sweep.

(2) On 24 January, elements of Headquarters Section, First and Second Platoons with one LVTP-5(Ord), thirteen LVTP-5's, and one LVTR-1 embarked on three landing ships for Operation Double Eagle. On 28 January these elements landed troops and artillery across the beach and continued operating in support of "Double Eagle".

b. On 22 January, the LVTP-5A1, in support of MAG-12 as an AMCrash vehicle, was released by MAG-12 and returned to company control.

c. On 29 January, Five LVTP-5's from the Second Platoon began operations with the Splash Point element and five LVTP-5's of the Third Platoon returned from the Splash Point to the Company area.

2. Training. During the period of this report the following training was conducted.

a. All individual weapons and machineguns in the company area were fired.

b. This company sent forty personnel through the Mine Warfare School conducted by Company "B" 3rd Engineer Battalion.

c. Twice - weekly classes on Weapons, First Aid, UCMJ, and Code of Conduct were conducted during the first three weeks of January. The classes were terminated to be resumed after the personnel in support of "Double Eagle" return to the company area.

3. Problems encountered and Lessons Learned.

a. The biggest single problem encountered during this period was the continued inadequacy of supply support for the tracked vehicles. Track, connecting pins, tools, ect. are in critical shortage.

b. The deadline, as a result of swamping, of the two outboard motors with the aluminum boats at the Splash Point has caused a great increase in operational hours on AMTracs. The motor boats are needed at the Splash Point to prevent the necessity of using tracked vehicles on small administrative runs.

1. In accordance with standing directives, this battalion designates a platoon to be called into action under emergency conditions. This platoon is organized and armed as follows:

a. The platoon is an Operational Amphibian Tractor Platoon of Company "B". It is composed of a platoon leader, platoon sergeant and three squads of ten men each.

b. The personnel will be armed with 4 pistols, Cal.45, 28 M-14 rifles, 2 M-72 LAAM and 2 30 Cal. Machine Guns. Each individual carries 2 M-26 Fragmentation grenades.

c. The platoon may be employed as an infantry platoon, combined LVT-Infantry or LVT platoon. Communication will be limited or nil if utilized in a strictly infantry role. Consideration should be given to employment of the platoon as an LVT-Infantry team of 2-3 LVTs with mounted infantry for the following reasons:

(1) Mobility - Rapid transportation to the area of commitment. Pursuit of the enemy.

(2) Communications - Inherent communications capability within each LVT.

(3) Fire Power - Each LVT is equipped with a turret mounted 30 Cal. Machine Gun.

2. In addition to the one platoon, the battalion could furnish the following personnel and armament for emergency combat employment under conditions of maximum threat.

a. Company "B" can provide two additional platoons of the same composition as in paragraph 1. above. A consideration in this case is that LVT support would be limited to the present commitment of one platoon in direct support of the 3d Marine Regiment and one platoon in direct support of the 9th Marine Regiment.

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b. Headquarters and Service Company can provide a provisional Company command group, 3 platoons, each consisting of a platoon leader, platoon sergeant and three squads of 12 men.

c. Each platoon will be armed with 2 45 Cal. pistols, 36 M-14 rifles and 2 M-26 hand grenades per man. Each platoon will also be armed with 2 M-72 LAAW and 2 30 Cal. Machine Guns.

d. Employment may be as infantry or as 2 infantry type platoons mounted in one platoon of LVTs.

3. Employment of the emergency combat platoons as infantry will require communications equipment support. Total assets of the radios available for use in the infantry roll are 6 AN/PRC-6 and 3 AN/PRC-10.

4. Giving due consideration to communications, fire power and mobility, it is recommended that this emergency combat force be employed in an LVT-Infantry role.

5. Utilization of the personnel assets of this battalion as set forth in paragraph 2 above would be at the expense of the battalion being unable to sustain the existing LVT commitments of the battalion, and its own security. Accordingly, a determination that additional LVT support would not be required during an existing emergency, should be a pre-condition to commitment of more than the one platoon organized as in paragraph 1 above.

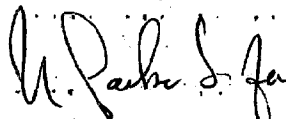

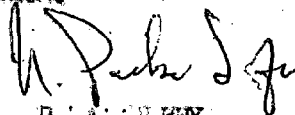
