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PART II

The 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion (-) continued in General Support of the 1st Marine Division through 23 April. OPCON was returned to the Third Marine Division 27 April 1967.

Excess food stuffs (garbage) is given daily to the villagers of PHONG LE BAC, for livestock feed. 24 April 1967 Med Cap discontinued due to relocation of this battalion. 3d AmTrac Bn assumed civic action responsibility for this TAOR.
