## PART II

1. The 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion continued in general support of the 3d Marine Division FMF for the month of May 1967.
2. In addition to the roll of general support to the division the Commanding Officer was assigned specific tasks in conjunction with the battalion's displacement from Danang to the Cua Viet Port Facility.
3. The Battalion Commander is designated as the Installation Coordinator, Cua Viet Facility. As such, he is responsible for administrative and control procedures for the purpose of regulating communal activities and establishing common rules for the use of shared facilities. Specifically, tasks include responsibilities for coordination in the following functions:
  - a. Internal security and base defense measures.
  - b. Travel and individual security precautions.
  - c. Preservation of order and discipline.
  - d. Morale.
  - e. Recreation and welfare.
  - f. Military police functions.
  - g. Motor vehicle and traffic regulations.
  - h. Safety.
  - i. Post Exchange facilities.
  - j. Liaison with RVNAF within or adjacent to the facility.
  - k. Messing.
  - l. Billeting, to include adequacy and appearance.
  - m. Medical support and sanitation measures.
  - n. Transportation.
  - o. Repairs, utilities and camp police.
  - p. Real estate and construction.
  - q. POL support.
  - r. Religious activities.
  - s. Special Services activities.

4. The following guidance and tasks were assigned in connection with base defense and activities with the operational area of responsibility.

a. Establishment and maintenance of a fortified perimeter and coordination of defensive measures with sectors of responsibility assigned tenant units.

b. Active, aggressive defense of the facility through day and night surveillance of the perimeter.

c. Saturation patrolling, listening posts, outposts and ambushes maintained beyond the perimeter.

d. Aggressive patrolling out to maximum mortar range and surveillance over avenues of approach for early detection of enemy movement and to deny vital ground from which attacks can be launched.

e. Request and coordinated offensive and defensive artillery fires through 9th Marines FSOC in order to ensure maximum effectiveness of fire support.

f. Conduct frequent clearing operations within the 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion Area of Responsibility to prevent an enemy buildup of supplies/equipment or personnel utilizing organic and tenant units.

g. Conduct operations outside assigned area of responsibility coordinating with Commanding Officer, 9th Marine Regiment and RVNAF.

h. Constitute and maintain a Provisional Company Facility Reaction Force to block and counterattack likely enemy penetrations into the Facility perimeter.

i. Coordinate active defense measures against underwater demolitions swimmers to prevent mining of Naval vessels utilizing the port facility.

5. The greater part of the battalion activities during May 1967 consisted of platoon search and clear operations, day and night squad and fire team patrols and ambushes throughout the area of responsibility.

a. 4 May 1967 4th Platoon Co "A" transferred OPCON to 3d AmTrac Bn DANANG.

b. On 19 May 1967 an additional mission was assigned this battalion, patrolling in the area where rocket attacks had been launched against DONG HA. Co "A" assigned one platoon to this mission on a continuous basis.

c. The 4th Platoon Co "B" (-) direct support of 1st Battalion 4th Marines Regiment until 25 May 1967 at which time 1st Battalion 9th Marines took control of CON THIEN and retained only 2 LVTP-5 and 1 LVT CMD in direct support. 1st Platoon Co "B" continues OPCON 3d Shore Party, PHU BAI area.

d. 30 May 1967 1st Platoon Co "A" returned OPCON to 1st AmTrac Bn.

6. During the month of May 1967 this battalion ran ten Platoon to Company size search and clear missions. Resulting in 17 VCS detained. For the same period 27 Platoon patrol/ambushes were conducted resulting in 8 VC KIA, 2 VC captured, 9 VCS detained. There was a total of 38 squad size patrols/ambushes conducted with 7 VCS detained and 1 VC WIA. There were 36 KIA (Prob). During this period 11 enemy contacts were made.

7. The battalion's Medical/Civil Affairs Team visited the village of PHO HOI vic (YD 335688). This was the first attempt for the battalions Civil Affairs Team in this location. A total of 134 persons were medically treated.

8. During the month of May 1967 the battalion suffered the following casualties:

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 May 1967

2d Plat Co "B" while D/S of Co "A", 1st Bn 9th Marines vic (YD 257749) received SAF and AWF from unknown number of enemy vic (YD 257749) returned fire. Infantry swept area. Negative results.

2d Plat Co "B" while D/S of Co "A", 1st Bn 9th Marines vic (YD 254756) received 300 rds SAF and AWF, 6 rds mortar fire from vic (YD 257749). Returned 500 rds 30 Cal, 800 rds 7.62, 500 rds 2.25, 25 rds M-79 and 11 Laws, called in artillery. Results unknown.

2-3 May 1967

Nothing significant to report.

4 May 1967

2d Plat Co "A" patrol/ambush vic (YD 382684) sighted 2 VC armed with carbine and rifle vic (YD 382685). Fired 1 rd VC ducked out of sight. Combine Alpha fired 3 rd 105 mm. Patrol/investigated at first light. Negative results.

5 May 1967

1 LVT Co "A" vic (YD 318719) detonated unk type anti-personnel device. No damage to LVT. No casualties.

4th Plat Co "B" D/S on convoy to GIO-LINH received 500 to 600 rds SAF, 3-57 recoilless rifle rds, 2 RPG's, 2-60 mm and 81 mm mortars. Returned 8000 rds 30 Caliber. Results unk.

4th Plat Co "B" vic GIO-LINH received 3 to 4 rds 82 mm mortar fire. Supported units returned counter-battery fire of 81 mm mortars. Results unk.

6 May 1967

4th Plat Co "B" vic GIO-LINH received 25 rds 82 mm mortar fire. Supported units countered with 81 mm mortars and arty fire. Results unk.

7 May 1967

Co "A" 1st Plat patrol received 40 rd's SAF and AWF vic (YD 345639) from unk number of enemy vic (YD 345637) returned 20 rds SAF. Results unk.

8 May 1967

2 LVT (B-41 and B-44), 4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 destroyed by sachel charges and RPG's while in moving counterattack force into position against NVA forces which had penetrated D/1/4 positions. 2 KIA, 7 WIA all Med-Evac.

Co "A" patrol vic (YD 265738) received 200 rds AWF from vic (YD 265738), 13 rds of 60 mm mortar fire from vic (YD 275738). Returned 15 rds M-79, 150 rds 7.62 mm, 100 rds 30 Caliber, 15 rds 105 mm fired by combine Alpha on mortar position. Results not determined. 4 WIA, 3 Med-Evac, 1 Non-Evac.

9 May 1967

At 090455H Civilian Dredge hit water mine vic (YD 344699) in Cua Viet River. Hit second mine 1½ hours later. Minor damage to dredge, 2 civilian employees wounded, treated at BAS and Med-Evac.

4th Plat Co "B" at CON THIEN D/S 1/4 received 35 rds of 82 mm mortars, 3 rds of unidentified rockets. Counterbattery fire returned by 1/4. Unk results.

10 May 1967

Co "A" patrol vic (YD 418619) received 4 rds SAF. While moving south vic (YD 421621) fired 4 rds 7.62 mm with negative results.

Co "A" patrol vic (YD 418619) located punji pit. Destroyed with M-26 grenade.

4th Plat Co "B" at CON THIEN D/S 1/4 received 15 rds 82 mm mortar fire.

1 LVT B-29 detonated shape charge AF mine vic (YD 322693) damage to LVT 2' X 3' hole starboard aft oil resevoir. and outboard sprocket. 1 WIA Non-Evac.

11 May 1967

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 received 35 rds of 82 mm mortar fire at CON THIEN.

Coastal Group 11 relayed an agent report of one VC Bn vic (YD 210717) possibly 303 Bn, also one VC Bn vic (YD 249753) possibly 308th Bn. 1 VC Co vic (YD 256730). Coastal Group rating B-2. Information passed to 9th Mar.

Co "A" ambush estimated VC Plat 500 meters from ambush site vic (YD 305723). Called in artillery fire from 1st Armd LVT. 35 VC KIA (Prob). Six secondary explosions seen.

12 May 1967

1st and 2d Plat Co "A" made sweep of area vic (YD 305723) for possible evidence of VC KIA, several persons observed running from area. Search of area produced inconclusive results.

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 45 rds 82 mm mortar fire and 100 rds 105 mm fire. Counter mortar fire and airstrikes delivered. Results unknown. 3 WIA Non Med-evac.

Agent intelligence report relayed by Coastal Group 11 indicated that several water buffalo were seen moving in vic (YD 2771) with bodies draped over backs. Rating F-5.

Co "B" and LVTH-6 received sniper fire from vic (YD 332701) possibly fired at dredge. No return fire due to NSA patrol boat in line of fire.

13 May 1967

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 150 rds of 82 mm fire through out the day. 82 mm fire and 10 rd's rocket of unk type through out the day.

14 May 1967

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 3 rds artillery fire, 10 rds 82 mm mortar fire and 16 rds rocket of unk type through out the day.

15 May 1967

Coastal Group 11 vic (YD 340690) was ambushed at southern perimeter of their compound. Received automatic weapons fire from est 12 VC vic (YD 340688). 5 (ARVAN) WIA. Treated at BAS and Med-evac.

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 36 rds 82 mm mortar fire and 45 rds 100 mm fire. 3 WIA throughout the day. 1 Med-Evac, 2 Non-evac.

Co "A" patrol vic (YD 289690) observed 1 VC with weapons in vic (YD 288690) fired 20 rds 7.62 mm resulting in 1 VC KIA (Conf), 1 enemy suspect detained. Recovered 1 Thompson Sub-Machine Gun Cal 45, 4 magazines, 1 pouch with note book, papers and book, 1 M-26 grenade, 2 ChiCom Grenades. Patrol continued on mission, found 1 U. S. cartridge belt with 2 magazines vic (YD 289688) captured VC turned over to CIT. Equipment turned in to S-2 9th Marines.

Co "A" patrol vic (YD 259677) found 2 rocket battery positions with 4 pits per battery, 17 fighting holes. Found several plastic fuse caps, 1 ChiCom Grenade, 1 Bamboo Rocket carrying basket, 4 bamboo aiming stakes. Portion of 140 mm rocket fiber glass bases. 1 Non-battle casualty from heat.

1st Plat Co "A" fire team tripped rigged ChiCom Grenade vic (YD 344656). 4 WIA 2 Med-evac by air 1 Med-evac to BAS, 1 returned to duty.

Received agent intelligence report from Coastal Group 11 that 2 NVA Bns armed with 4 rocket launchers, 3 recoilless rifles, 4 AA Guns, 8 82 mm mortars and 60 mm mortars vic (YD 159701, 170695, 166684). Mission to attack all forces that are in this operational area. Information passed on to S-2 9th Mar Sector. Rating B-2.

16 May 1967

Co "A" patrol/ambush vic (YD 338651) received 1 incoming grenade from vic (YD 338648) swept area at first light. Negative results.

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 42 rd's 100 mm fire through out the day. 1 WIA Non-Evac.

17 May 1967

4th Plat Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 17 rd's 100 mm fire through out the day.

Coastal Group 11 found 350 pound command detonating water type mine anchored vic (YD 300660). NSA EOD removed and disarmed mine for return to CUA VIET PORT Facility for study by Naval Intelligence. Location of mine reported by VN Fisherman.

18 May 1967

COC observed rockets being fired from vic (YD 255685) all units went on red alert.

Received msg from 3d Mar Div forward to investigate rocket site vic (YD 255685).

10 LVT's Co "B" D/S Operation BEAU CHARGER.

Operation HICKORY commenced.

H&S Co and 1st Plat Co "A" searched rocket site vic (YD 233664) found 21 fighting holes, 30 launching sites, 16 control sites. Enemy equipment captured; 1 rocket launch board, rocket fuze plug, electrical firing contacts, Bamboo carrying basket, Bamboo aiming stakes, medical viels, 30 Cal and carbine casings, 1 AT Mine (Soviet TM-41). Two VCS detained. VCS forwarded to 3d Mar Div Forward.

2d Plat Co "A" ambush vic (YD 277687) received 8 rds SAF from unk number of VC vic (YD 276688) returned 15 rds 7.62 mm, 3 rds M-79. Results unk.

19 May 1967

2d Plat Co "A" searched area of fire fight of 182250H vic (YD 276688), Found 1 VC KIA (Conf), 1 automatic U. S. Carbine, 2 magazine, 2 ChiCom Grenades, 1 M-26 grenade, 1 First Aid pouch, 1 Plastic Bag, 1 cartridge belt, 1 wristwatch and 1 wallet. All equipment turned over to 3d Mar Div Forward.

3d Plat Co "B" D/S operation received 35 rds of 120 mm mortar fire or Heavy Artillery. Counter-battery airstrikes and Naval Gun fire returned.

2d Plat Co "A" vic (YD 273668) received SAF and AWF from unk number of enemy. Returned fire, search area. Negative results.

2d Plat Co "A" ambush spotted 2 VC with weapons, fired 10 rds 7.62 mm 1 VC hit. Noise indicated body being dragged away. 1 VC KIA (Prob).

20 May 1967

H&S Co ambush vic (YD 359669) observed 2 VC suspects approach ambush site fired 18 rds 7.62 mm. Observed 1 VCS fall. Searched area at first light. Found 1 VCS wounded. 1 VCS Med-evac.

3d Plt Co "B" D/S BEAU CHARGER received 20 rds 85 mm Howitzer.

4th Plt Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN received 13 rds 100 mm fire. Counter-battery 105mm artillery.

2d Plt Co "A" while interrogating villages. Found 1 adult male with ID card, Blacklisted as confirmed VC by Curtiswood 17. VC turned over to Div MP. Informed by 15th CIT that VC killed in ambush on 19 May 67 was Plt leader of 22 man plt from MAI-XA-THI.

H&S Co blocking force vic (YD 393614) found eight 2.75 rockets. Motors had not been fired. Indications they had been jetisoned. Rockets turned over to NSA EOD and destroyed.

21 May 1967

4th Plt Co "B" D/S 1/4 at CON THIEN from 0630 to 1200 received 100 rds of 100 mm fire. From 1300 to 1830 received 35 rds 100 mm fire.

3d Plt Co "A" enroute to ambush site found three 120 mm rocket carrying packs made of canvas, 4 rocket hand carrying pouches, and comm wire stretched from north to south. Found words written in sand in Vietnamese.

22 May 1967

3d Plt Co "A" on way to ambush site in village vic (YD 240675) found two 120 mm canvas rocket pouches near L shape foxhole. Fire team checked village vic (YD 265660), found 10 ft of comm wire, 1 spool of copper wire, 2 empty M-79 casings, 2 communist military Jackets, 1 Pair U. S. jungle trousers, 1 Chi Com canteen. All equipment turned over to 3d Mar Div forward.

Coastal Group 11 reported heavy caliber fire vic (YD 240675) requested 1st Plat. 1st Armd LVT Co to check coordinates on their fires and cancel fires. Coastal Group 11 reported 2 civilian killed and 1 male and 2 females wounded by white phosphorus. 1st Plat, 1st Armd LVT Co checked computations of data indicates only WP fired at 222215H at Coordinates (YD 34106740). HE rd fired coordinates (YD 33746750)

secondary explosions noted by Bn COC watch at 222213H. Information on Picto-Map available at 1st Plat, 1st Armd Co indicates no house's at (YD 34106740). Complete serious incident report. Wounded civilians med-evac by Helo.

23 May 1967

Cease fire truce went into effect for 24 hrs.

Div AO reported 6 new rocket site's vic (YD 258678). 3d Plat Co "A" checked area marked by AO. Found sites to be old sites. Report sent to Div G-3.

24 May 1967

H&S Co and elements of Co "A" as blocking force on search and clear mission vic (YD 413618) detained 9 VCS, 5 male and 4 female. Also found cave used for weapons storage. VCS pointed out position of mines. Area probed without results. Provisional Reconnaissance Unit (PRU) teams searched village for arms and medicine caches and interrogated suspects on Black-list. Entire village populace without I.D. cards. VCS forwarded to 15th CIT.

25 May 1967

Nothing significant to report.

26 May 1967

Operation BEAU CHARGER terminated.

3d Plat Co "B" 5th AmTrac Bn landed at CUA VIET PORT Facility. Will be OPCON to Co "B" for approximately 14 days.

27 May 1967

Joined 10 LVT and 1 CMD 2d Plat, 5th AmTrac Bn from BLT 3/4. Opcon to 1st AmTrac Bn this date.

28 May 1967

H&S Co patrol/ambush vic (YD 359669) detained 3 VCS. Interrogated by PRU's and turned over to Coastal Group 11.

Received 1 rd 82 mm mortar in Co "B" sector vic (YD 346696). Crater analysis indicates shell came from 170 degrees. Bn went to condition red.

29 May 1967

H&S Co with PRU's on search and clear mission vic (YD 340680) picked up 9 detainees. Detainees interrogated by PRU's. 7 were released, 2 detained as VCS and turned over to Coastal Group 11. Also found 1 Khaki trousers, 1 Khaki shirt, 1 Khaki shorts, 9 bottles penicillin, 8 viels sterile water, 1 bottle cholera vaccine, 1 tube penicillin salve. All equipment turned over to S-2 9th Mar.

3d Plat Co "B" patrol/ambush spotted 10 VC vic (YD 312724) fired 100 rds SAF. Later fired 1000 rds SAF in vic (YD 301729). Called in artillery. Found 1 M-14 magazine pouch, 1 Kodak 32 ounce bottle, type (GP-5) contents black powder and chemical with odor like paint thinner. Container turned over to EOD NSA, CUA VIET Facility

30 May 1967

3d Plat Co "B" in blocking position vic (YD 321709) on search and clear mission received 10 rds carbine fire. Southern blocking force received 6 rds carbine fire. No fire returned because of safety to inhabitants. Movement in brush along lake from where fire received. One Frag grenade thrown resulting in 1 VCS wounded. VCS Med-evac, 1 VCS female detainee turned over to Coastal Group 11.

1st Plat Co "A" arrived at CUA VIET Facility. Debarked, joined OPCON to 1st AmTrac Bn from OPCON 3d AmTrac Bn.

Bulk Fuel vic (YD 348692) received 10 rds sniper fire from vic (YD 335700) placed fire team as additional security along river bank at LST ramp for security of Bulk Fuel Farm and NSA unloading LST.

31 May 1967

H&S Co LVT Plat with 3 LVT's retracted PRU's from southern ambush site. Returned with 3 VCS. VCS turned over to Coastal Group 11. All 3 confirmed as VC.

1st Plat Co "A" with elements 1st Plat Co "B" on search and clear mission vic (YD 395635) found 20 holes which were destroyed with demolitions. Also found suspected VC hiding places which were destroyed by elements of 1st Plat Co "A". 11 VCS were detained and turned over to Coastal Group 11.

Operation PRAIRIE terminated.
