PART II

1. The 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion (-), continued in general support of the 3d Marine Division, FMF for the month of June 1967.
2. The Battalion Commander continues to carry out assigned missions as the Installation Coordinator of CUA VIET PORT FACILITY.
3. The greater part of the battalion activities during the month of June 1967 consisted of platoon search and clear operations, day/night squad and fire team patrols and ambushes and listening posts throughout the area of responsibility.
4. During the month of June 1967 this battalion had 12 enemy contacts resulting in 18 enemy KIA (Conf).
5. The battalion's Medical and Civil Affairs team visited the villages of PHO HOI vic (YD 335638), MAI XA THI vic (YD 283668), HA TAY vic (YD 345679). A total of 533 persons were medically treated.
6. During the month of June 1967 the battalion suffered the following casualties.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 June 1967

Operation CIMARRON commences.

Co "B" with elements of H&S Co and Co "A" on Search and Clear mission in villages of DUY PHUEN and DOUNG XUAN picked up 20 detainees, 4 were listed as VCS, others possible draft dodgers. Found cache of medical supplies. Detainees sent to QUANG TRI. Medical supplies turned over to 15th CIT. Jrnl #108.

H&S Co patrol found AP Mine rigged as a booby trap. Mine destroyed in place by Grappling device. Also found 3 batteries, 4 Carbine casing, 1-30 Cal casing, 6 fighting holes and 1-2 man emplacement. Jrnl #109.

2 June 1967

Brigadier General METZGER was in Battalion area for about 30 minutes.

Co "B" 5th Plat Sqd vic of HA LOI TAY found 7.62 mm rds of unk make, 1 knife and 1 Chi Com Grenade. Jrnl #91.

Co "B" 5th Plat Sqd vic (YD 307733) spotted 10 NVA vic (YD 300743) dressed in full khaki uniforms w/packs. Sqd opened fire and called in artillery. Sqd received 2 rds from recoilless weapon. NVA broke contact, area searched finding 1 enemy KIA (Conf), 2 Chi Com Grenades, 1 canteen, 1 First Aid pack, Rice, 1 booby trap device (pressure type), 1 Flashlight, 3 magazines w/40 rds each, 1 map and 1 green scarf. Jrnl #141.

3 June 1967

Nothing Significant to report.

4 June 1967

H&S Co listening post vic (YD 348688) spotted 2 or 3 people in vic (YD 347686). Received 5 rds carbine fire, returned fire. Searched area with negative results.

5 June 1967

Nothing significant to report.

6 June 1967

Div G-3 and CO 9th Mar visited Bn Area.

7 June 1967

Co "A" 1st Plat patrol/ambush vic (YD 262689) received 2 incoming rds of unk type 200 meters from their position. Rounds did not explode.

8 June 1967

General WESTMORELAND, Lieutenant General CUSHMAN, Major General HOCHMUTH, Brigadier General CHAISSON visited Bn area.

3d Plat Co "B" ambush vic (YD 302722) detected movement approx 10 persons passing from North to South, more movement to the rear of ambush. Ambushed dropped back and arty was fired. Area searched with inconclusive results.

1st Plat Co "A" vic (YD 262689) received 1 HE rd. Believed to be friendly H&I, 50 meters from Plat's night position. Investigated at (080730H) crater analysis indicates round fired from 265 degrees. Caliber estimated 100 mm or larger. 1 WIA treated in field and returned to duty.

Brigadier General HERBOLD in area to visit Bulk Fuel.

9 June 1967

H&S Co patrol/ambush South, while returning to CP received 2 rds of sniper fire. Jrnl #57.

20 June 1967

3d Plat Co "B" vic (YD 323115) spotted 4 men running west of village toward East. The 4 men stopped, observed patrol and started to run again. Patrol fired two warning shots. Search of area could not locate the 4 men. Found 2 holes w/food and 1-45 rd. Believed to be where 4 men stayed last night. Jrnl #70.

10 June 1967

Co "A" w/elements of Co "B" returned from search and clear mission in village of MAI XA THI. Search resulted in 5 VC and 10 detainees, 1 small box of medical supplies, 1 letter and 1 USMC belt. All detainees forwarded to 15th CIT Hdqtrs. Jrnl #121.

Vietnamese unit attached to this Bn was ambushed by est 1 VC Bn vic (YD 348635). Called in arty fire and patrol extracted by LVTs. Two detainees held were sent out to lead unit into ambush. No damage assessment due to extraction. Will return and sweep area early 11 June 1967 with list of VC suspects supplied by detainees.

11 June 1967

Co "A" with elements of Co "B" and H&S Co returned to CP with 5 detainees which were forwarded to 15th CIT. Found many fighting holes within treeline around village. Found cartridge case's of 30 Cal MG, 9 mm, 7.62 mm Foreign and U. S., 2 bottles of penicillin, 1 box of respiratory medicine, 2 viels of purified water, 1 canteen, 1 mosquito net.

12 June 1967

The CUA VIET PORT FACILITY and 1st AmTrac Bn received 225 rds of 140 mm rocket, 122 mm (VOF-463 Frag-HE) and mortars for approx 1 hour from enemy position vic (YD 270745). Received 10 rds of carbine fire from north side of river. Bulk Fuel received damage to 4 fuel pods, one pod on fire extinguished by Bulk Fuel personnel during attack. 2 LVTs damaged by 140 mm rockets. 1 LVT direct hit portside with hole $3\frac{1}{2}'$ by $3\frac{1}{2}'$. 1 LVT had damaged radiator. Other LVTs minor damage. 1 Conex box destroyed, 5 GP tents destroyed. 3d Plat 1st Armd LVT Co received directⁿ on Executives Pit, wounding Plat Leader, Liaison Officer, Plat Gysgt, and Plat Gun Sgt. Wounded Officers requested medical attention after end of fire mission. The units of CUA VIET PORT FACILITY received the following casualties. 1st AmTrac Bn: 1 KIA, 27 WIA, 7 which were Med-Evac. 3d Plat 1st Armd LVT Co: 5 WIA, 4 were Med-Evac. Bulk Fuel: 1 WIA Non Med-Evac. Schrapnel, Fuse's, Spin Stablizers of 140 mm and fuze and fragments of 122 mm arty rds forwarded to S-2 9th Mar.

H&S Co patrol returned to CP. 1 man KIA by rocket rd which over shot camp area.

Co "B" patrol north returned to CP. Neg contact but did observe rocket and artillery rds being fired at CUA VIET PORT FACILITY. Patrol gave azimuth and coordinates from which rds were being fired. Also kept Bn notified when incoming rd's were coming into area.

General CUSHMAN and General HOCHMUTH visited Bn area.

4th Plat Co "A" on search for rocket sites. Found 3 sites. Site 1 vic (YD 262677) found 27 firing positions, 18 command and fighting holes, 2 bamboo wicker carrying baskets and aiming stakes on azimuth of 195 degrees. At site 2 vic (YD 262675) found command holes, 5 firing positions, 3 pkgs of C-4 weighing 1 lb per package with detonating caps rigged to bamboo with string leading to command hole. Site 3 vic (YD 262673) found 8 firing positions, 8 command holes, 1 unarmed warhead for 140 mm rocket, 12 canvas carrying cases for rocket, 1 pair of Vietnamese tennis shoes. 4th Plat Co "A" set up security around the area. Jrnl #134.

13 June 1967

4th Plat Co "A" on searching area of (YD 247675) found 4 trenches 8' to 9' long by 2' wide. Possibility used to protect rockets. Found 8 fighting holes, 6 canvas rocket carrying cases. 8 canvas bags for warheads, $\frac{1}{2}$ lb C-4, and 1 document, possible firing instructions. Turned all equipment into S-2 9th Mar.

14 June 1967

Nothing significant to report.

15 June 1967

IVTE-1 (H-25) in D/S 11th Eng detonated unk type mine vic (YD 195733) extensive damage to starboard side and suspension system. 2 WIA Med-Evac. Jrnl #103.

2d Squad 3d Plat Co "A" while moving inland from dismount point found approx 300 projectiles, had fins were $1\frac{1}{4}$ " long and $\frac{1}{4}$ " in diameter. Found in diameter of 70 meters. Retrieved 6 for delivery to Senator-2. Jrnl #166.

16 June 1967

4th Plat Co "A" on patrol vic (YD 363677) found 1 - 81 or 82 mm mortar rd. Round still activated, did not appear to be rigged as explosive. Will be detonated by EOD 17 June 1967.

17 June 1967

4th Plat Co "A" on patrol vic (YD 341642) received 3 rds M-79, 10 rds carbine fire. Returned 2 rds M-79. Unable to return further fire due to some of the Plat's personnel being in village. Displaced patrol to new location. Negative casualties. Jrnl #75.

4th Plat Co "A" patrol vic (YD 347647) received 15 rds of 60 mm mortar fire from vic (YD 345635). Called fire mission from Combine Charlie (105 mm). Good coverage of target. Mortar fire ceased after fire for effect. Patrol sent to enemy position for damage assessment. Negative results.

18 June 1967

6 LVT dispatched on request of Sparing Jungle to extract Sparing Jungle 54 Tango and team members vic (YD 411619). Arty fired by Combine Charlie adjusted on enemy with 17 KIA (Conf). NVA broke contact. LVT extraction force retrieved Sparing Jungle 54 and team members at 180050H vic (YD 395620). Returned to CP at 180115H. Jrnl #14.

3d Plat Co "A" completed search and clear of village vic (YD 343653) took 4 detainees with faulty ID cards. On leaving village one bottle of Kerosene found hidden in well. One female detainee taken.

3 VC were observed moving toward H&S sector wire. One rifle grenade fired. Patrol searched area. Negative results.

19 June 1967

3 LVT H&S Co on resupply to MA-3 had one LVT (H-17) detonated mine vic (YD 285685). Damaged 2 road wheel assemblies, radiator and oil lines. 1 WIA Non Med-Evac. Jrnl #49.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349694) went on modified Red Alert. Patrol and ambushes normal.

20 June 1967

Bn secured from modified Red Alert.

21 June 1967

20 LVT, 1 R-1, 1 CMD, and 2 LVTH-6 departed CP on Operation LAM SON 70.

2 Sqds 2d Plat Co "A" escorted EOD team to vic (YD 335699) where Vietnamese pointed out AT mine. EOD removed mine of Soviet make Approx 12 lb pressure type. Vietnamese was rewarded.

22 June 1967

Nothing significant to report.

23 June 1967

NSA observed three explosions in vic (YD 330700) NSA investigated, found 3 Vietnamese fishermen with slight wounds. Vietnamese agent said 2 VC threw grenades at fisherman. Wounded Vietnamese treated at BAS and released. Jrnl #84.

Operation LAM SON 70 terminated. All Co "B" IVTs returned to CP.

1st Plat Co "A" while moving into night defensive position vic (YD 317724) obs 3 NVA moving from north to south vic (YD 315727). Plat took up pursuit of NVA. NVA retreated north. Plat ended pursuit after 600 meters with negative results.. NVA were wearing Olive drab uniforms, helmets, rifles and cartridge belts. Jrnl #136.

24 June 1967

Co "A" patrol found masonry building vic (YD 325705) with Red Cross markings on it, Also found medical supplies with markings indicating it came from British Isles and Ireland. Check with QUANG TRI District, GIO LINH District and S-2 9th Mar and 9th Mar Civil Affairs. None have any knowledge of Medical Facility in that area. 1 Vietnamese and medical supplies turned over to ITT Team.

Co "A" 3d Plat Patrol/ambush sighted 10 Flashes from vic (YD 270733) that appeared to be rockets being launched. Jrnl #150.

25 June 1967

2d Plat Co "B" ambush vic (YD 329663) sighted 2 boats at coord (YD 325661). Ambush opened fire on boats. 15 minutes later ambush sighted another boat moving north. Opened fire on this boat. All boats sunk. Searched area at first light. Found 1 basket floating in water. Received 1-60 mm mortar rd while checking area. 8 VC KIA (Prob).

3d Plat Co "A" received approx 4 rds arty while sitting in day position. Rounds were determined to be enemy. Plat moved to new position. Jrnl #194.

4th Plat Co "B" received 3 rds arty around night ambush position. Notified Click FSCS. AO requested on station. Jrnl #4.

26 June 1967

AO checked area for suspected enemy arty position. Negative observation on possible arty position. Jrnl #10.

Intelligence report received from Sparing Jungle that 1 NVA unit located vic (YD 325649), 1 NVA unit vic (YD 383648), and 1 NVA unit vic (YD 334633), armed with 2-82 mm mortars, 4 AA Guns, 4-60 mm mortars and 1-75 mm RR. NVA dressed in black and green uniforms with sandals and jungle hats. Mission to attack QUANG TRI and TRIEU PHONG. F-3 rating. Information passed on to 9th Mar, 12th Mar FSCC and 3d Plat 1st Armd AmTracs.

27-28 June 1967

Nothing significant to report.

29 June 1967

LST 603 (Coconino County) hit by water mine on portside vic (YD 337698) at LST Ramp, CUA VIET PORT FACILITY. Both Engine rooms flooded. No danger of sinking. At 0400 2d mine exploded 20 ft aft of ship. No damage on second explosion. Tug requested from DANANG. Patrol Boats sweeping river. 1 Navy WIA Med-Evac. Jrnl #18.

4th Plat Co "A" vic (YD 281712) observed fire in vic (YD 275688) between unk forces. Heard about 75 rds of SAF and ANF. Ten minutes later heard 10 rds of 60 mm mortar fire.

30 June 1967

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY went into a modified Red Alert due to suspected enemy movement in TAOR.

Co "B" roving patrol and listening post observed movement. Area illuminated. Listening post fired 40-50 rds of SAF. Four enemy broke contact and moved southeast. Area searched, negative results.
