

PART II

1. The Bn Commander continues to carry out assigned missions as the Installation Coordinator of the CUA VIET PORT FACILITY.

2. The greater part of 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion activities during August 1967 consisted of company search and destroy operations, platoon patrols and ambushes, day and night, and squad sized night ambushes throughout the assigned areas of responsibility in defense of the CUA VIET PORT FACILITY.

3. LVT operational support of the 3d Mar Div, FMF, in a general support role during Operation KINGFISHER was minor in comparison to the infantry type operations necessary in defending the CUA VIET PORT FACILITY within the assigned area of responsibility.

4. The CUA VIET PORT FACILITY came under eight artillery and rocket attacks during the month of August 1967. The Bn had 12 enemy contacts resulting in eight enemy KIA (Conf) and seven enemy KIA (Prob).

5. The Bn Civil Affairs and Medical Teams visited the villages of HA LOC vic (YD 323703), TUAN PHUONG vic (YD 334663), HA TAY vic (YD 343681), and THANH XUAN vic (YD 334665). A total of 543 persons were medically treated.

6. On 26 August 1967, an operation was conducted in the resettlement village vic (YD 328698). The purpose was to distribute foodstuffs provided by CORDS to the villagers, register the villagers and sweep the village. Military and civilian personnel, American and Vietnamese from QUANG TRI Province and GIO LINH District assisted in the operation.

a. The following quantities of foodstuffs were distributed:

b. Foodstuffs were distributed through the village chief. Medical assistance was given to 168 persons.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 August 1967

Co "A", 3d Plat patrol/ambush while moving to night position vic (YD 247666) received 20 to 30 rds SAF from vic (YD 245664). Returned fire with six 60 MM mortars, 10 M-79 rds and 100 SAF. Enemy broke contact. Results unknown.

2 August 1967

Co "A", 1st Plat patrol in D/S of 1st AmTrac Bn while in day position vic (YD 308733) found one spider hole four and one half feet long, one and one half feet wide and three feet deep in vic (YD 308735). Sealed hole with M-26 grenades, 20 rds of 5.56 MM and five rounds 7.62 MM, also found one Chi Com grenade, 100 rds 7.62 MM linked, one U. S. battle dressing, one Chi Com belt buckle and four leather ammo pouches.

Co "B", 4th Plat while in day position vic (YD 309733) received approximately 20 incoming mortar rounds from vic (YD 297745). Suspected to be 82 MM. Called in fire mission on suspected enemy position. 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co fired 36 rds of 105 MM zone fire. Enemy fire ceased. Jrnl #106.

3 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

4 August 1967

Co "A", 2d Plat while moving into temporary night position vic (YD 305735) encountered three NVA wearing green and khaki uniforms. Received 20 rds AWF. Returned fire with 350 rds 7.62 MM, 24 rds M-79 and 11 M-26 grenades. Called airstrikes and arty. Two NVA KIA (Conf), one NVA KIA (Prob). Two Friendly WIA, Med-Evac. Enemy equipment recovered consisted of one AK-47, one magazine, two Chi Com grenades and two green utility uniforms (NVA).

Co "A", 1st Plat vic (YD 273672) received one rd of artillery believed to be 155 MM. Also observed 10-12 more rds. Contact 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co for counter battery but was unable to clear mission.

5 August 1967

UNCLASSIFIED

NSA received two rds 600MM mortar fire vic (YD 344698). CUA VIET PORT FACILITY was on Red Alert at time rds were received. Negative casualties or damage.

6 August 1967

Co "A" 1st Plat while in night position vic (YD 279689) ambushed two enemy personnel. Fired 20 rds 7.62 MM. One knocked down and screamed. Received 20 to 30 rds AMF from enemy vic (YD 279689). Enemy retreated North. One enemy KIA (Prob). Jrnl #3.

7-10 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

11 August 1967

Co "A", 2d Plat with four LVT returning to CP after making relief of patrol in rocket belt had one LVT (A-45) hit mine in vic of (YD 296686). Mine was 35 to 40 lbs pressure detonated. Tractor sustained damage to No 4, 5, 7 and 8 roadwheels and destroyed No 6 roadwheel and 20 blocks of track. Negative casualties.

Co "A", 3d Plat vic (YD 262690) received approx 100 rds SAF while moving into night position from estimated three enemy vic (YD 262690). Plat proceeded to isolate enemy position and destroy with approximately 500 rds SAF, 15 M-26 grenades, 25 M-79's. One enemy KIA (Conf), one enemy KIA (Prob). Recovered one AK-47, and 12 Chi Com grenades. No friendly casualties.

Co "A", 3d Plat while checking out bomb shelters and adjacent huts in vic (YD 262690) found one Vietnamese male inside bomb shelter. Man broke away and ran. Had to be tackled and forcibly held. Vietnamese had no ID card. Detainee will be brought to CP for transfer to 15th CIT.

12 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

13 August 1967

Co "A", 1st Plat while moving into night position found one AT mine at vic (YD 306733). Mine was pressure detonated, 35 lbs Russian type, pWiliube delivered to CP.

14 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

Two LVTE-1 while at 3/4 CP received 4 incoming rds of artillery. One WIA, Non Med-Evac.

16 August 1967

Bn Scout Team reported sighting 5 VC vic (YD 372666). H-6's fired 1 gun 2 rds. H&S Co patrol notified VC fled to south west.

Co "A", 1st Plat while in night position vic (YD 273676) received incoming arty rds from azimuth of 200 degrees. 4 or 5 rds landed approx 200 meters west of position. Next rd was a direct hit on position. Arty believed to be friendly. Checked fire in that area. S-3 cancelled all H and I cleared for batteries other than H-6's. 1 KIA. 2 WIA, Non Med-Evac.

17 August 1967

LVT Plat, H&S Co vic (YD 230720) in support of 2d ARVN Regt received 10 rds of 85 MM arty. Negative casualties.

Units of 2d Plat, Co "B" reported that CON THIEN received 5 rds of 85 MM arty. Negative casualties.

18 August 1967

Swift Boats on a shore patrol received AWF from vic (YD 2877) grid square. 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co and naval gunfire fired on above coordinates. Negative results.

Co "A", 1st Plat while moving to night position vic (YD 257669) apprehended two male suspects. The suspects are approximately 25 years of age. Had I. D. cards, maps and other documents in their possession. Suspects are being held subject to return to 1st AmTrac Bn CP for interrogation.

19 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

20 August 1967

LVT Plat, H&S Co while in support of 2d ARVN Regt had 1 LVTP-5 (H-04) detonate AT mine vic (YD 249731). Negative casualties.

21 August 1967

LVT Plat, H&S Co while in support of 2d ARVN Regt vic (YD 232722) received 12 to 15 rds of SAF resulting in one WIA Med-Evac.

Three LVTP-5 2d Plat, Co "B" in D/S of 3/4 had 1 LVTP-5 (B-29) hit mine. Vehicle is burning on top and inside. C-4 and ammunition exploding. Vehicle cannot be salvaged. One WIA from Co "B"

22 August 1967

Co "A", 3d Plat while in day position found one dud artillery round. Approximately 75 MM with oriental figures. Projected appeared to come from azimuth of 290 degrees. Round still intact. Awaiting EOD for identification.

23 August 1967

Nothing significant to report.

24 August 1967

LVT Plat H&S Co while supporting 2d ARVN Regt reported ARVN in heavy contact with enemy vic (YD 275705), 35 enemy KIA (Conf), Two enemy captured, ten weapons captured.

Co "A", 1st Plat while in day position vic (YD 304737) spotted two to three NVA moving through treeline 150 meters to the West. NVA were in uniforms. Received 30 SAF and five Chi Com grenades. Pursued NVA for approximately 500 meters, expended ten rd's M-79, ten rd's M-26 grenades, 120 rd's 5.56 MM, 19 rd's 45 Cal, 300 rds 7.62 MM. One USMC WIA (Med-Evac). One enemy KIA (Conf), one KIA (Prob). Captured one RPG with three rds, assorted 782 gear, one Medical kit, several propaganda leaflets and one bag of rice.

LVT Plat H&S Co vic (YD 230722) while in support of 2d ARVN received 24 rd's of 122 MM artillery. Negative casualties or damage.


25 August 1967

Co "A", 1st Plat patrol vic (YD 307735) spotted two persons vic (YD 304736) wearing blue shirts and dark colored shorts sneaking through treeline, personnel were out of sight before patrol could take under fire. Reconned area by fire with 20 rd's M-79. Results unknown. Called in A0.

Co "A" 1st Plat vic (YD 307735) spotted approximately three uniformed NVA approximately 400 meters North to North West of day ambush. Pursued enemy and made contact. Expended 200 rds M-14, 60 rds M-16, ten rds M-79. Received 175 rds SAF. One USMC KIA, one USMC WIA (Med-Evac). One enemy KIA (Conf), two KIA (Prob) due to heavy blood trails. Weapons and equipment captured one AK-47, three magazines, 5 Chi Com grenades and assorted 782 gear.

26 August 1967

Co "A", 3d Plat while moving into temporary night position vic (YD 279689) received 20 rds AWF from opposite side of river vic (YD 281691). Returned fire with approximately 200 rds 30 Cal. Two USMC WIA (Med-Evac).

27 August 1967

Co "B", 2d Plat patrol vic (YD 307731) spotted 20 NVA moving South in treeline vic (YD 304737) called in artillery mission to 3d Plat 1st Armored AmTrac Co. AO (Oak Gate 51) on station to observe.

Co "B", 2d Plat patrol vic (YD 310731) observed five NVA on beach in woodline. Called in artillery from 3d Plat 1st Armored AmTrac Co. Results unknown.

Co "A", 3d Plat while moving into day position vic (YD 268657) found two Chi Com grenades. Will return grenades to CP.

LVT Plat H&S Co while in support of 2d ARVN Regt received 36 incoming 85 MM artillery rounds. Negative damage or casualties.

Swift Boats on patrol North of CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349694) reported observing 3d Plat 1st Armored AmTrac Co H&I's vic (YD 300744) after impact of H&I six secondary explosions seen. Estimated six 140 MM rockets destroyed.

28 August 1967


The CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 394696) received 15 rds of 100 MM artillery or larger. Called fire mission on suspected enemy artillery position. Results unknown. Negative damage to area.

Co "A" 1st Plat vic (YD 258674) found two rockets sites and equipment with 560 rockets still intact. Found command and fighting holes on azimuth to attack DONG HA. Set up security to await Bn CO and EOD.

Co "A", 1st Plat vic (YD 253674) while setting in security around rocket site spotted one female approaching from village of KY LAM vic (YD 245670) heading to North East. Stopped her to check her out. She had no ID card. Detained and sent back to CP for interrogation by 15th ITT Sub Team.

 CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349693) received approximately four rd's of 100 MM artillery from suspected artillery position from following coordinates (YD 250800, YD 251812, YD 245835 and YD 252798). One round hit and destroyed oxygen and acetylene storage. Bn went on red alert. Counter Battery fire by Naval gunfire on above coordinates. Two WIA (one Med-Evac). Med-Evac had 2d and 3d degree burns on both arms.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349693) received approximately 30 rounds 100 MM artillery. Swift boats on patrol observed firing from coordinates (YD 250826) two batteries and (YD 245824) four batteries. Called in above position to 12th Marines FDC. Negative damage to CP, observed destroyer on station taking 15 rd's on port and starboard. Unknown damage. Countered by Naval gunfire. Results unknown.

Co "B", 4th Plat Co "B" vic (YD 283703) while in blocking position received approximately 22 rd's SAF from enemy vic (YD 275704). People came running out of village. The people were stopped and checked for ID cards and weapons. One male approximately 40 years of age was detained. Detainee had brief case full of documents and 1900 P's. One boy approximately 8 years of age was stopped. Was believed to be son of detainee. Boy had 6000 P's in his possession. Boy was released. Man detainee was brought to CP for interrogation. Two USMC WIA (Non Med-Evac).

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349693) received 100 MM or larger enemy artillery. As of 1920 CP had received 10 rds. One rd hit mess tent. At 1920 Co "B" received sniper fire from vic (YD 335700). Co "A" countered by 60 MM mortar fire. At 1920 Swift boats at CUA VIET received three artillery rds on ramp. Negative damage. Enemy artillery countered by Naval gunfire and 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co fired two observed missions.

Co "A", 1st Plat vic (YD 263674) while moving into temporary night position found one small green box approximately 9 inches wide, 11 inches long and 2½ inches deep. Has latch and handle. Box was not opened for fear of booby trap. Will send in to CP.

29 August 1967

Co "A", 1st Plat while moving into temporary night position found approximately ten enemy fighting holes vic (YD 264673). Holes set up in 360 degrees with one main ammo bunker. Was probably used to guard rocket sites. Also found numerous bamboo stakes around holes. Sites destroyed.

Co "B", 4th Plat while returning to CP from S/C operation had one LVT (B-59) detonate pressure type AT mine vic (YD 333 639). LVT burning. Will be completely destroyed. Four WIA (two Med-Evac).

Co "A" 1st Plat vic (YD 276674) while in night position received approximately six rounds of artillery at 0125H and four rounds at 0215H. Estimated to be 105 MM rounds. No friendly units firing at those times.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349693) received ten rounds of 100 MM artillery or larger. Negative damage. Called for smoke and Naval gunfire in GS (YD 2675 and 2874).

Co "A" 1st Plat vic (YD 276674) received 12 rounds of estimated 105 MM from 0430H to 0505H. Negative damage or casualties.

Co "A" 1st AmTrac Bn vic (YD 349693) received three sniper rounds from unknown vicinity. Countered with ten rounds 60 MM mortar fire. Sniper fire ceased. Negative casualties.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349694) received 13 rounds 100 MM artillery or larger. Third Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co had water buffalo and emersion burner destroyed. Naval gunfire called on vic (YD 251818), 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co fired zone fires. AO on station. Negative results.

Co "A", 1st Plat while in day position vic (YD 276074) observed two men with possible radio and antenna near top HILL 23 vic (YD 280720) serving as possibly as enemy FO. No movement was spotted. Contacted AO. AO had negative results.

AO (Preseverance Charlie conducted air strikes on vic (YD 302738), reported one secondary explosion and 80 % of ordnance covered 70 % of the target.

Co "B", 4th Plat while in

30 August 1967

Co "A", 4th Plat while in night position vic (YD 271651) spotted ten people moving from North East to South West along river. Fired 12 rounds, 7.62 MM, three M-26 grenades. Called in illumination. Results unknown.

Co "A", 4th Plat vic (YD 271651) searched area vic (YD 271650) where 4th Plat Co "A" pulled ambush on ten persons on 292340H. Found large puddles of blood and one Chi Com grenade. One enemy KIA (Prob).

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY received seven rounds 100 MM artillery. Naval gunfire, 175 MM and eight inch howitzers fired on grid (YD 2382) which is suspected artillery position. Negative damage or casualties to CP.

Co "B", 2d Plat and Co "A", 2d Plat received seven rounds of 100 MM artillery while moving onto beach. Naval gunfire called. Smoke screen fired by 3d Plat, 1st Armored AmTrac Co and swift boats. AO (Oak Gate 51 & 52 could not locate flashes of artillery. Co "A", 2d Plat observed flash vic (YD 254808) large column of black smoke observed at above coordinates. Negative damage or casualties.

Co "A", 4th Plat while sitting in day position vic (YD 257669) spotted a large group of people moving across desert. One squad from 4th Plat Co "A" intercepted 9 people. Adjacent and approximately five meters of the trail they were using found one enemy rocket, 140 MM, armed but without propellant charge. AO on station.

Co "A". 4th Plat while in day position vic (YD 257669) informed by AO (Cat Killer 45) of numerous rockets at (YD 266673), one squad 4th Plat Co "A" moved into area and checked out location, found ten 140 MM rocketes. At least four were wired, also found two rocket sites. Three command holes, two packs and assorted aiming devices. Prevented from extensive search by suspected presence of booby traps.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY vic (YD 349693) received seven rounds of 100 MM artillery. Also received 12 rounds of sniper fire from outside perimeter wire. Naval gunfire mission was called in on coordinates (YD 270783) with AO (Oak Gate 71) observing.

Unobserved Naval gunfire on grid (YD 2482).
Co "A" fired on sniper position with 60
MM mortar fire and SAF. Dispatched Bn
Scout Team to check area for sniper. Scout
Team reported Negative results.

Co "B", 2d Plat vic (YD 300738) saw two
NVA vic (YD 303739) while moving into
ambush position. Four more NVA were seen
to West of Plat, all six taken under fire.
NVA returned fire. Plat set into position
and came under heavy ANF from North and
West from approximately 50 NVA at 25 meters.
3d Plat 1st Armored AmTrac Co boxed Plat
in with artillery, fire adjusted by AO
(Preseverence Yankee and Cat Killer 44).
Reaction Plat sent to reinforce Plat and
to establish Med-Evac zone. Results of
artillery could not be determined due to
darkness. 11 USMC WIA (two Med-Evac), one
USN WIA (Med-Evac), eight returned to duty.
Three enemy KIA (Conf).

Of 11 rockets recovered by 1st AmTrac Bn
seven had to be destroyed due to damage
from artillery and airstrikes on 28 Aug.
All were live and could not be disarmed.
Four rockets and six fuses plus wiring and
contacts returned to CP. Airstrikes and
105 MM within five feet to 20 meter from
site. Seven rockets damaged as a result.

31 August 1967

Foxtrot Co, 2d Bn, 3d Marines arrived at
this position to exploit current contacts
and to search in area North of Cua Viet
River.

CUA VIET PORT FACILITY went on Red Alert
due to message that DONG HA was receiving
rockets.

On 26 August, an operation was conducted in the resettlement village at YD328698. The purpose was to distribute foodstuffs provided by CORDS to the villagers, register the villagers and sweep the village. Military and civilian personnel, American and Vietnamese from Quang Tri Province and Gio Linh district assisted in the operation.

The following quantities of foodstuffs were distributed:

Foodstuffs were distributed through the village chief. Medical assistance was given to 166 persons.
