PART II

1. Contact, consisting of either sighting the enemy or joining him in a ground action, occurred fourteen times during November. One sighting and one ground action involved VC in the southern part of the AO. The remaining twelve contacts were with NVA elements north of the Cua Viet.
2. The enemy shelled the Cua Viet Port Facility three times during the month, rocketed Base Area C-4 once and mortared security elements forward of C-4 on two occasions.
3. As a result of the above, the Battalion suffered one KIA and seven WIA.
4. Logistic support of the ARVN Bn at Strongpoint A-1 and of the USMC units building and defending Base Area C-4 continued during the month. Mine sweeping operations along the routes to A-1 and C-4 resulted in our finding a total of ten AT mines. A sweep by LVTE-1 produced some secondary explosions after line charges were detonated. Two LVTP-5 were damaged by AT mines that were not discovered.
5. The construction of Base Area C-4 involved building twenty-six bunkers, reduction of unfavorable terrain features and installation of defensive wire. Bunker construction on all twenty-six was completed during the month and sandbagging/wire laying continued. This Battalion assumed OpCon of F Co, 2d Bn, 4th Marines on 6 November and relinquished OpCon of A Co, 1st Bn, 1st Marines on 7 November. On 16 November, a detachment of Mortar Battery, 1st Bn, 12th Marines arrived at C-4 in direct support.
6. Operation NAPOLEON, assigning this Battalion a separate Area of Operation and mission, commenced on 5 November. Pursuant to this, Co "A" (-) Rein made three search and destroy operations, Co "B" (-) Rein made one and H&S Co (-) Rein made one. Some of these were inside the AO, some outside it.
7. Other events of interest included:
 - a. A U. S. Army Survey Team surveyed the position of the 50' observation tower adjacent to the Bn CP, as well as the observation tower used by the 2d Plat, 1st Armd Phib Co.
 - b. On 24 November, SLF Alpha (BLT 1/3) landed north of the Cua Viet on a search and destroy operation west and northwest of this Battalion's AO.
 - c. On 26 November, this Battalion distributed eleven CONEX boxfuls of foodstuffs to the Resettlement Village on the north bank Cua Viet.

LIST OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 November 1967 Nothing significant to report.

2 November 1967 The CUA VIET PORT FACILITY and 1st AmTrac Bn received approx 30 rds of 100 MM or larger arty inside CP. Called for counterbattery fire from 12th Marines. Azimuth of muzzle flashes 312 degrees and 320 degrees, distance between 14,000 and 20,000 meters. One Lieut (DC) USN KIA, five WIA. Two battle casualties Med-Evac. Two GP tents and one tropical hut destroyed. Some damage was caused to comm wire and cable.

3 November 1967 H&S Co patrol vic (YD 349672) picked up two Vietnamese females who had no ID cards. Suspects were interrogated by 7th ITT and released as innocent civilians.

4 November 1967 Co "A", 1st Bn, 1st Mar OpCon to 1st AmTrac Bn vic (YD 315725) received five rds of 140 MM rockets, two inside and three outside defensive perimeter. 1st AmTrac Bn called for counterbattery fire on the following grids: (YD 252-834), (YD 245835), (242839). Negative personnel casualties.

5 November 1967 Operation NAPOLEON commenced IAW 3d Mar Div OpOrder 60-67, CG msg 051139Z.

One Vietnamese boy approx 12 yrs of age turned in one U. S. M-26 fragmentation grenade to one of the Bn interpreters. The boy claimed to have found the grenade in Bn trash dump vic (YD 349693). The civil affairs officer rewarded the boy 100 piasters.

2d Plat Co "A", 1st AmTrac Bn while proceeding to base area C-4 to pick up mine sweep team found one T-41 AT mine vic (YD 342704). Mine was blown in place. Negative casualties or damage.

First Plat Co "A", 1st AmTrac Bn had
one LVT (A-15) hit pressure detonated
AT mine vic (YD 285715). Major dam-
age to vehicle. Two WIA Med-Evac.
Swept area with mine detector and found
three more T-41 AT mines. Mines blown
in place.

Second Plat Co "A" 1st AmTrac Bn, while
enroute to A-1 strongpoint had one LVT
(A-16) hit AT mine vic (YD 298705).
Mine estimated to be 35 lb pressure
detonated type. Major damage to vehicle.
Plat set up defensive perimeter and
stayed the night. Took tractors un-
der tow and mine swept back to CP.

6 November 1967

H&S Co, 1st AmTrac Bn with elements
of Co "A", 1st Bn, 1st Mar and 3d Shore
Party Bn departed CP to conduct a search
and clear operation in the village of
MY LOC vic (YD 305680) .

Received request from CIC, Coastal Div-
ision 114 for a helicopter to retrieve
crew from a capsized Swift Boat at mouth
of Gua Viet River. Did so.

While in support of Operation DYEMARKER,
2d Plat Co "A" with mine sweep team
swept area vic (YD 288705) finding three
Soviet T-41 AT mines and one 105 MM
dud round. All ordnancedestroyed by
engineers.

Commanding Officer assumed OpCon of Co
"F" (Rein), 2d Bn, 4th Mar.

H&S Co, 1st AmTrac Bn, deployed one
LVTE-1 (H-27) to clear mine field vic
(YD 297707). Detonated two line charges
and had four secondary explosions.
Three explosions were approx size T-41
Soviet AT mine, and one larger explosion
(Unknown size ordnance).

7 November 1967

Approx five rds 100 MM arty were received vic (YD 329706). Rounds landed approx 500 meters from 3d Shore Party position. Muzzle flashes were observed on azimuth of 310 degrees at approx (YD 2577), 12th Marines fired counter battery fire with unknown results.

1st AmTrac Bn CP vic (YD 347691) received three rounds of unk cal arty. Negative casualties or damage. 12th Marines fired counter battery fire on known/suspected enemy targets along azimuth 310 degrees magnetic.

Received CG 3d Mar Div msg 261003Z stating change of radio/telephone call signs effective 070800H Nov.

Chopped OpCon Co "A" (-) (Rein), 1st Bn, 1st Mar.

AO spotting for Bn thought he spotted six new mortar pits vic (YD 284744). Requested H&I fire on grid from 12th Marines. Mission denied. 1st ARVN Bn had swept area on 7 Nov and dug holes looking for more rockets.

8 November 1967

Received intelligence report from local informer there are two VC companies in and around 1st AmTrac Bn AO. The companies are believed to be part of the unit that 2d ARVN Bn had contact with on 3 Nov. There are two plat located at MAI XA THI. USMC rated C-3. Two plat at NHI HA (YD 273705), two plat at LONG HA (YD 317689), one plat at HOANG HA TRUNG (YD 300685). USMC rated F-6.

Received CG, 3d Mar Div message 081819H stating that ARVN has fixed location of an enemy Bn within 1st AmTrac Bn TAOR. ARVN requested to enter area bounded on the north by grid line 67, on the south by grid line 62, on the east by the coast and on the west by grid line 32; and to make contact. Authorization granted.

9 November 1967

Two Marines from Co "F", 2/4 were non-battle casualties, Med-Evac.

Brig Gen METZGER and party arrived CP to pick up Battalion Commander and visit Base Area C-4.

While in direct support of C-4 position (Operation DYEMARKER) 11th Engr's had one bulldozer hit unknown type mine vic (YD 313725). Broke right track, possible added damage. Negative casualties.

Co "F", 2/4 guard post reported suspected enemy movement vic (YD 313722). Fired 12 rds of 60 MM illum for a visual check, fired six rds HE. Will check area at first light.

10 November 1967

H&S Co listening post spotted three figures moving toward perimeter wire of 1st AmTrac Bn. Three figures were taken under fire. Enemy fled. Area searched at daylight. Negative results.

Co "F", 2/4 patrol apprehended one detainee vic (YD 321721). Suspect was interrogated by 7th ITT and released as an innocent civilian.

11 November 1967

U. S. Army Survey Party confirmed the location of 1st AmTrac Bn (50') observation tower as (YD 34906942), 1st Armd Phib tower as (YD 34456992). The grid azimuth from 1st AmTrac's tower to 1st Armd Phib Co is 5658 mils.

Co "F", 2/4 ambush vic (YD 314723) spotted two suspected NVA vic (YD 313712). Ambush spotted them with starlight scope. 105 illumination, 60 MM HE and small arms were fired. Search revealed negative results.

12 November 1967

H&S Co listening post spotted three figures moving toward 1st AmTrac Bn perimeter wire. Figures moved into treeline vic (YD 349684). LP called in 81 MM on the treeline (one illumination and six HE rds were fired). Results unknown, will check at first light.

13 November 1967

UNCLASSIFIED

One Plat, Co "A", 1st AmTrac Bn, one Plat Co "F", 2/4 and elements of H&S Co, 1st AmTrac Bn departed CP for search and destroy mission in 1st AmTrac Bn's southern AO. The area covered is bounded by (YD 335652), north to (YD 340687), east to (YD 364673), south to (YD 350-660). Negative contact. One detainee.

Received intelligence report passed by Vietnamese agent. Approximately 80 VC at MAI XA THI vic (YD 265670) armed with AK-47, mines, sniper rifles. Passed information to 1st ARVN Airborne Task Force. 1st ARVN Airborne Task Force had swept this area on 12 Nov with negative results.

One U. S. Marine of the sweeping force on search and destroy operation in Southern AO, was charged by angry water buffalo. He was forced to kill the animal when warning shots failed to stop the animal. Solatium payment was made to the owner by Civil Affairs Officer.

Mine detector team of Co "C", 11th Engr Bn in D/S of 1st AmTrac Bn was clearing path for four LVTP-5 of Co "A" enroute to resupply ARVN strongpoint A-1. Found three T-41 (Soviet) AT mines vic (YD 290717). There were no UDT/EOD personnel available. Mines were blown in place and elements continued to A-1 strongpoint.

Elements of Co "A" and H&S Co 1st AmTrac Bn and elements of Co "F", 2/4 returned to CP. On the return route to the CP one detainee was apprehended vic (YD 329662). Detainee was on CIT blacklist. Interrogated by 7th ITT representative and forwarded to 15th CIT headquarters at Dong Ha.

1st AmTrac Bn apprehended one Vietnamese female who attempted to sell what appeared to be Marijuana to Marines working on perimeter wire. Subject had no ID card and will be forwarded to Dong Ha for further questioning.

14 November 1967

Elements of Co "F", 2/4 vic (YD 305736) spotted two NVA vic (YD 302741) wearing pith helmets, cartridge belts and possibly carrying rifles. Called in artillery with excellent coverage on target, swept area with negative results.

Two unidentified aircraft dropped two bombs vic (YD 312720), snakeye fins from one 250 lb bomb was found in fresh crater. Markings on fin assembly were quote IS-0867, cont 67-C-0099, warning 1. Place 3-- clips only on tail release. 2. Pass release wire through aft bomb by, release band-- through fin release wire qu-- end quote. The crater left by the bomb had no water in it although heavy rains had fallen prior to bombing. At 2015H called DASC, Dong Ha who checked and reported a friendly aircraft had jettisoned ordnance there when evading SAM's. Pilot thought he was farther north.

15 November 1967

Elements of Co "F", 2/4 while on patrol found fresh footprints one to five hours old. Also found fortification of NVA type in vic (YD 292752). Fortification consisted of two covered holes and three uncovered holes. Ambush planned for 160400H.

16 November 1967

Elements of F/2/4 in vic (YD 299745) spotted two to three NVA in vic (YD 296745), called in arty. Moved forward by fresh footprints (NVA jungle type). Set in hasty ambush. Sent reinforcements, attempted to register artillery. Scout sniper team with patrol could not get sighting. Enemy ran back into defilade after mutual sighting.

Sniper and FO Team with elements of Co "F", 2/4 in daylight ambush at 0730H observed six enemy. Took them under fire at eight meters killing two NVA (Conf) one NVA KIA (Prob), wounded another. Took large volume of enemy AWF from nearby treeline. Returned fire with SAF. Called artillery, sent reinforcements. Reaction of reinforcements 12 minutes, reaction time on ar-

tillery 15 minutes. Moved reaction force forward behind amtracs for cover, enveloped enemy. Enemy broke contact, retreated north. Picked up weapons and one NVA prisoner. Coordinated other daylight activities to exploit success in area. Prisoner Med-Evaced. Recovered two AK-47, eight AK magazines, four Chi Com hand grenades, one pair binoculars, one hero medal, one dog tag, four pounds cooked rice, three cartridge belts. No friendly casualties.

CO, mortar battery 1/12 arrived for duty at C-4 at 1130H with three 4.2".

Co "A", 1st AmTrac Bn while on S/D mission vic (YD 379649) found 13 punji traps made of wood and tin, 10" X 10" with 6" to 8" steel spikes. Spikes had wooden base. 12 punji pits destroyed by hand. One destroyed with M-26 grenade.

17 November 1967

M&S Co recon patrol vic (YD 339674) spotted three VC via binoculars at (YD 329671). VC uniforms were black PJ's. One had canvas pack on his back and one had carbine under his rain jacket. VC began to run. Patrol fired three M-14 rds at range of 500 meters. VC dispersed into treeline. Unable to search area due to river in between VC and patrol.

18 November 1967

Squad of F/2/4 spotted approx 50 NVA bearing small arms. Called arty. NVA dispersed. Called F/2/4 reaction force. Took several small parties under fire at 300 meters. 300 rds of 7.62 fired. Enemy returned fire with approx 100 rds SA and AMF. Found 50 to 60 fresh holes 4m X 2m X 3m deep on line between (YD 297749) and (YD 295748). Reaction force mustered. Reaction time nine minutes. Reaction force set out on foot while AmTracs called. Called for AmTrac reaction force of 2½ platoons. Moved up on line and enveloped to right with Bn reaction force dominating high ground. called in artillery from 105 battery at CUA VIET. Airstrikes controlled

by AO (Fingerprint 46) plus other rein arty. Enemy left rear taken. Negative contact. Sweep of area disclosed one dead NVA with weapon and equipment. Withdrew to C-4 position during darkness. Posted one squad/ambush at (YD 297745). Keeping one plat AmTrac Marines plus four LVT as added reaction force at C-4. One NVA KIA (Conf), two NVA KIA (Prob). Weapons captured: one AK-47; equipment captured: two AK-47 magazines, one Chi Com grenade, two lbs cooked rice, one NVA emblem, one new cartridge belt, one undershirt, one pair NVA green undershorts, one pair NVA trousers cut off for shorts, one black shirt.

19 November 1967

Nothing significant to report.

20 November 1967

F/2/4 patrol vic (YD 298746) spotted three NVA vic (YD 296749) in black uniforms. Called in 4.2 fire mission from C-4. Negative surveillance. Negative movement. AO (Smitty Oscar / Charlie) examined area. Negative findings.

F/2/4 squad/ambush vic (YD 294754) received 20 rds of incoming 60 MM mortars from vic (YD 289759). Returned arty fire from LVTH-6 Plat at Cua Viet and Composite Artillery Bn at Gio Linh plus NGF. Had good coverage on target. Ambush position moved to (YD 298746). Four friendly WIA non Med-Evac.

21 November 1967

4th Mar returned OpCon of three LVTP-5 and one LVTP-5 ORD to 1st AmTrac Bn. LVT's departed Camp Evans for Colco Island enroute to Cua Viet.

Squad ambush of F/2/4 vic (YD 300742) received 10 rds of incoming. Believed to be 60 MM mortars. Rounds landed 200 meters short of ambush. Called 4.2 mortars and LVTH-6 counter battery fire. Enemy fire ceased.

22 November 1967

Nothing significant to report.

23 November 1967

Bn Scout Team in vic (YD 329669) received small arms, automatic weapons and 60 MM mortar fire from approx 20-35 enemy vic (YD 329670). Returned fire with M-79, M-26 grenades and automatic weapons. Reaction Plat, dispatched at (232015H) arrived at contact site at (232115H). Artillery (LVTH-6) called in at 232000H. Area swept resulting in two VCS, returned to Bn Headquarters for interrogation by ITT. Negative friendly casualties. Relocated Bn Scout Team and secured reaction force.

24 November 1967

SLF A (BLT 1/3) landed for opn in northern AO and area west of it.

25 November 1967

F/2/4 ambush vic (YD 292754) spotted three NVA in treeline vic (YD 280755) at 600 meters range. Called in arty from 2d Plat, 1st Armd Phib Co to flush enemy closer to ambush. Arty reaction time nine minutes. Alerted reaction force. Negative further movement.

26 November 1967

F/2/4 patrol vic (YD 301739) found one 140 MM rocket. Rocket appears to still have fuse in but rocket motor appears burned out. Marked position for future detail to remove fuse and evacuate to G-2 channels.

Bn Civil Affairs Officer distributed, via village chief, 11 Conex boxes of food stuffs to resettlement village vic (YD 320695).

One Vietnamese civilian brought to Bn Aid Station with traumatic amputation of right and left legs. Serious powder burns and blast damage to right arm. Wife of injured man stated he had stepped on something near a well in vic of village of Ha Tay, exact location unk. Man Med-Evaced for surgery. Later died of wounds. Junk Fleet notified of incident for relay of word to widow.

27 November 1967

One injured Vietnamese girl with her parents approached perimeter of 3d Shore Party Bn detachment at (YD 323693) seeking medical aid for gun shot wound in right leg. Father claimed "SMC

patrol shot her while family was asleep. No USMC in the area. Believed this incident was the result of VC reprisal against another family of Chieu Hoi who lives in same village. Checked BLT 1/3 and they had no troops in area. Girl treated in Bn BAS and Med-Evaced with father to Quang Tri. Solatium payment of 1,000 piasters made even though this unit not responsible for incident.

F/2/4 patrol vic (YD 292754) observed five NVA move into a stationary position vic (YD 291756). Set up ambush and continued observation of enemy unit for approx two hrs. Called arty (LVTH-6) 30 rds mixed, 4.2 mortars 18 rds HE. Negative surveillance, excellent coverage of area.

28 November 1967

Co "A" (-) made sweep of Trieu Phuoc Island. Sweep resulted in nine detainees. Six were released after questioning. Three retained will be sent to Dong Ha for further interrogation by 7th ITT.

29 November 1967

Co "B" (-) made sweep of southern AO. Found six punji pits, two booby traps. Punji pits destroyed; booby traps disarmed. Negative enemy contact.

F/2/4 ambush vic (YD 294753) observed two NVA loitering in vic (YD 289757). Fired 16 rounds of 4.2 mortars by mortar battery 1/12 at C-4. Negative surveillance.

30 November 1967

F/2/4 ambush observed approx 10 NVA vic (YD 297746) and heard movement around position. Fired 20 rds SAF and relocated ambush to (YD 303738). Called arty from LVTH-6's, fired 9 rds VT, 21 rds HE. Neg surveillance, will search at first light.

F/2/4 checked out area vic (YD 296746) where enemy contact was made at (300150H). Found 13 one man fighting holes, foot prints, blood stains. (1 NVA hit with burst of ANF at distance of 2 meters) claimed as 1 KIA (Prob) and 1 NVA KIA claimed as (Prob)(results of M-26 grenade). Patrol debriefed at (301130H).

F/2/4 ambush/patrol vic (YD 292754) while in support of 1st AmTrac Bn observed 4 enemy troops in khaki clothing vic (YD 288756). Fired 20 rds SAF and called in arty mission (30 rds) excellent coverage on target. Neg surveillance.

Bn Scouts while on patrol in southern portion of AO vic (YD 366662) apprehended 2 suspects. Both males w/o ID cards. Patrol also found anti-American propaganda leaflets in vicinity. Detainees returned to CP for interrogation by 7th ITT.

LP on perimeter of Bn CP detected movement in front of wire, sentry in bunker observed 4 figures moving toward perimeter wire. Sentry took figures under fire with small arms. 

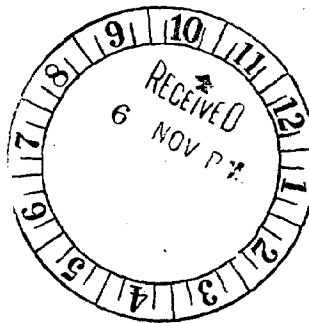

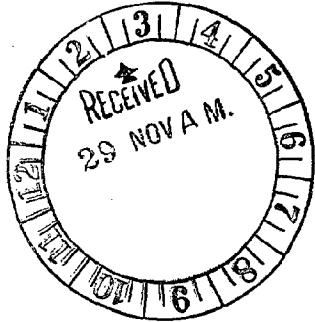
