NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. April 1968 was characterized by a reduction in the number of incidents of incoming artillery/rockets, clear weather and increased employment as infantry in addition to continued AmTrac support of the 3d Marines.
2. One platoon (-) of Co "A" remained in direct support of 1st Bn, 3d Marines in the area Southwest of Cua Viet. An additional platoon of Co "A" supported 1st Bn, 3d Marines during a five day operation to the south of Cua Viet. Co "A" also supported 2d Bn, 4th Marines in the area north of the Cua Viet. During the month, one LVTP-5 was destroyed by recoilless rifle fire.
3. B/1/3 continued to man and defend Base Area C-4 until 19 April when D/1/3 was chopped OpCon to 1st AmTrac Bn (-) (Rein). On three occasions Co "B", 1st AmTrac Bn assumed responsibility for Base Area C-4 while 1/3 elements were chopped to 1st Bn, 3d Marines for operations. Co "B", 1st AmTrac Bn spent a total of 15 days at Base Area C-4.
4. Cua Viet Port Facility received incoming artillery five times. 1st AmTrac Bn patrols had contact three times and found surprise firing devices and fighting holes five times. Two men were killed by surprise firing devices.
5. On 9 April, B/1/3 conducted a sweep north of Base Area C-4 to Ha Loi Trung, finding assorted equipment but no enemy. D/1/3 on 20 April swept to Ha Loi Trung with negative contact.
6. Co "B", 1st AmTrac Bn conducted a sweep of the Resettlement Village on 14 April capturing two VC.
7. During 18-20 April 1st AmTrac Bn conducted embark/debark training with the USS Alamo and the USS Cleveland. During the training one LVTP-5 was mined on the beach and destroyed.

Elements of Co "B" 1st AmTrac Bn vic (YD 299748) found lower torso of one VN body and one M-98 Mauser rifle in shell hole. Body estimated to have been there approximately two months.

OP for Co "B" 1st AmTracs vic (YD 293752) rec'd 4 rds estimated 85MM arty from unk source.

OP from Co "B" 1st AmTracs vic (YD 293752) observed 4 rds arty impact 1,000 mtrs to his NW. ARVN at A-1 calling fire mission.

5 April 1968

H&S Co patrol (Y-40) departed CP with Armed Propaganda Team for Ha Tay Mo (YD 348677).

Patrol south (YD 365665) found four (4) punji pits rigged with explosive device. Blew in place.

6 April 1968

Co "B" patrol/ambush vic (YD 294754) rec'd one (1) rd arty. Later determined as friendly 155 MM from Dong Ha. Called 3d Marines FSOC for corrective action.

7 April 1968

Nothing Significant to report.

8 April 1968

B/1/3 arrived Camp KISTLER. Chopped from OpCon 3d Squadron, 5th Armd Cav, USA.

B/1/3 returned to Base Area C-4. Co "B" 1st AmTrac Bn remains as security unit.

9 April 1968

B/1/3 crossed LOD for search and destroy of HA LOI TRUNG (YD 283764).

S-5 and detachment from H&S Co conducted Med-Cap at Refugee Ville located at (YD 316682), DAM CHO CHUA.

H&S patrol with Armed Propaganda Team to HA LOC (YD 324708).

B/1/3 discovered miscellaneous enemy ordnance. Compilation on final entry.

B/1/3 returned from search and destroy of HA LOI TRUNG. Relieved Co "B", 1st AmTracs on station for security for Base Area C-4.

The following enemy ordnance and equipment picked up at HA LOI TRUNG: 1 box of 6 blasting caps, 3 concussion (ChiCom grenades), 18 60MM and 19 82MM mortar rds, 6 cans 82MM mortar increments with charges, 36 82MM mortar point detonating fuses, 6 82MM mortar VT fuses, 3 boxes approximately 3000 rds 7.62 ammo, 4 AT mines, 2 AP mines, 1 RPG (7) launcher (Unser), 4 Russian Type gas masks (Unser), 1 Russian Type helmet (Unser), 1 NVA pith helmet (Unser), 1 NVA canteen (Unser), 1 AK-47 magazine. Also recovered were 14 US, CS grenades.

10 April 1968

Nothing significant to report.

11 April 1968

Cua Viet Port Facility received 64 rds 100MM or larger artillery from suspected grids (YD-235840), (YD 253854). ARVN Advisors at Base Area A-1 reported as many as 15 active artillery pieces north of Ben Hai at grids (YD 240-855) and (YD 228851). Tower at Base Area C-4 and Cua Viet observed flashes. Minor damage to 2 fuel bladders, 2 LVT, damage to Maintenance, Butler Building and Messhall. One squad tent destroyed. No casualties.

PF land patrol/ambush made contact vic (YD-340677) with estimated VC squad. 11th Coastal Div NRVN provided mortar support. VC broke contact.

12 April 1968

Co "A" plt security patrol departed CP to sweep upper portion of southern AO.

13 April 1968

MedCap accompanied by Armed Propaganda Team departed CP for resettlement village vic (YD-316683).

14 April 1968

Co "B" departed CP to sweep Resettlement Villa vic (YD 320695).

Co "B" returned to CP from sweep. Sweep apprehended 2 VC confirmed, 19 VN males of military age who were turned over to 2d ARVN Regt and 1 VC suspect who was later released as an innocent civilian.

Personnel working apprehended VN boy who had previously been observed several times in vic of booby traps. Forwarded to 15th CIT for interrogation.

15 April 1968

FO B/1/3 ambush observed 5 males vic (YD 287-746), fired 2 rds 105 WP. Fled SW, neg results. Notified ARVN Bn on A-1.

16 April 1968

Co "B" patrol detect M-26 grenade rigged w/trip wire vic (YD 369670), destroyed in place.

Co "B" patrol detonated trip wire grenade. 3 WIA (2 emergency MedEvac, 1 NonMedEvac). One dead on arrival Co "D", Med Bn, one died of wounds, one returned to duty. Detonated second grenade while moving WIA's to LZ, no casualties.

Med/Dent Cap Pho Hoi and Ha Tay departed CP.

Co "B" patrol destroyed two additional trip wired grenades in place (YD 369670).

17 April 1968

Nothing significant to report.

18 April 1968

Sec H&S LVT w/Co "B", 3d Eng Mine Sweep Team departed CP. Mission: sweep beach area (YD-375665) in preparation LVT Embark/DebarK Trng w/LSD 33 USS ALAMO.

Med/Dent Cap Pho Hoi-Ha Tay.

Plt Co "B" departed CP for Embark/DebarK Trng. Maj J.C. BURGER Jr OIC.

Co "A" Plt commenced Embark/DebarK Trng USS ALAMO.

D/1/3 plt ambush found one body (decomposed) and one M-26 (unservicable) ser #639810) vic (YD 296744). No US MIA reported. ARVN have

not operated in the area for many months. Clothing of VN origin. Marked grave. Recovered weapon.

19 April 1968

UNCLASSIFIED

Plt of Co "B" departed for above coord for LVT Embark/Debark Trng w/LPD 7, USS CLEVELAND.

Co "A" commenced Embark/Debark Trng.

Two (2) LVTH-6, 1st Plt, 1st Armd Phib Co, displaced from Cua Viet to Base Area C-4. To provide deeper indirect fire support for D/1/3 search and destroy of Ha Loi Trung.

20 April 1968

PF's on Island vic (YD 319669) in contact with small group VC in sampan at (YD 321672). Firefight ensued. Coastal Group 11 NRVN, provided illumination, VC broke contact. PF's reported fire from (YD 329665). At 200035 Coastal Group 11 patrol Junk, while checking area of PF action received fire from (YD 324673). Estimated to be 4 or 5 VC on river bank. Results of contact unknown.

D/1/3 departed Base Area C-4 moving to LD at Ocean View (YD 292753).

LVT section with mine sweep team, Co "B" 3d Eng Bn departed CP to sweep and mark beach for LVT, LPD Embark/Debark Trng.

LVT B-45 hit mine vic (YD 373667), vehicle burning. Three (3) WIA/MedEvac.

Med/Dent Cap, Refugee Island vic (YD 317682).

H&S LVT with Bulk Fuel Fire Fighting Detail (Sgt Weeks) departed for (YD 373667).

Results of PF/Junk action listed in Ser #200: One (1) burned out sampan; two (2) AK-47 magazines; one (1) block C-4. Senior Advisor feels that there may have been more equipment which was retained by PF's.

Co "B" patrol south detained four (4) indigenous persons at (YD 367673) in area of mined LVT B-45. Forwarded to Regt'l S-2. Four detainees.

interrogation by ITT/CIT. Two (2) detainees
were released as innocent civilians, two (2)
are to be forwarded to Dong Ha Combat Base for
further interrogation.

Two LVTH-6 returned from Base Area C-4.

21 April 1968

Two (2) VN males detained by Co "B" patrol.
Routine ID check revealed each to be carrying
M-26 grenade, forwarded both to Dong Ha Combat
Base as VC POW.

22 April 1968

VN female who claimed to be sister of VN detainee
(apprehended by patrol yesterday, armed w/M-26)
picked up, by S-5, outside wire for questioning.

Co "B" patrol apprehended VN female at (YD 362-
668). US technical manuals and two hundred
sand bags in her possession. Ret'd to CP for
questioning.

Co "B" patrol south returned to CP with female
detainee. (Ref Ser #233 DTG 220930).

VN female detainees (Ref Ser #232 DTG 220930
and Ser #233 DTG 220930) released as innocent
civilians.

Radar at C-4 detected approximately fifty per-
sons (50) at (YD 297707). Passed to 2/4 for
action.

Camp KISTLER (Cua Viet Port Facility) received 30-50 rds of artillery. D/1/3 reported muzzle flashes at (YD 235855) and (YD 245855). Passed to 3d Mar FSCC.

Oil Barge alongside (US Navy Tanker AOG-8) received hit, barge afire. AOG sustained some minor damage. (Two Navy WIA, not added to our totals).

23 April 1968

Three (3) WIA (NonMedEvac) results of arty attack (Ref Ser #241 DTG 222320).

Two (2) VC POW (Ref Ser #227 DTG 211435) released as innocent civilians.

24 April 1968

Co HQ and 4 plt occupied Base Area C-4.

D/1/3 chopped to 1/3. Departed C-4 on A-4 LVT for southern AO.

Co "B" patrol north terminated patrol/ambush by rejoining their company at Base Area C-4.

ARVN advisor at A-1 reported 16 secondary explosions at (YD 270778) as a result of NGF (w/ delay).

Cua Viet Port Facility received approximately 80 rds of 85 or 100MM arty.

25 April 1968

Marine MedEvac helicopter crashed on LST landing. Two crewmen KIA.

MedDent Cap Pho Hoi - Ha Tay.

Advisors with ARVN at A-1 controlled NGF at 27-0778, 113 rds fired. One secondary.

H&S Sqd patrol observed 8 Vietnamese carrying rice baskets vic (YD 330661). Fire Team dispatched to investigate. Vietnamese ran, crossed river at (YD 329667), out of AO.

26 April 1968

H&S patrol encountered four (4) Viet males 20-25 yrs old vic (YD 373654) when challenged by Kit Carson Scout, VN ran. Patrol fired warning shots without effect. Lost contact at (YD 369659).

Co "A" patrol reported he contacted B/1/3 units vic (YD 335617). Advised patrol to remain with B/1/3 for the night.

1st Plt Co "B" chopped D/S to 2/4 (Lt RANKIN).

H&S patrol (B3B) discovered and destroyed 15 covered spider holes. Resulting in one secondary explosion.

D/1/3 (Capt FOX) chopped OpCon to 1st AmTrac Bn from 1/3. 4th plt Co "A" 1st AmTrac Bn (Lt SCHNIEDER) D/S, D/1/3, chopped back to 1st AmTrac Bn.

D/1/3 picked up male Vietnamese without ID Card, vic (YD 344645). Kit Carson Scout claims he detained same man three (3) months ago. Forwarded detainee to 3d Mar S-2.

1st Plt D/1/3 proceeded to C-4. Remainder of Company remained at Cua Viet.

28 April 1968

Radar at C-4 detected two groups NVA at (YD 295-716) and (YD 302719). Fired 60MM with unk results.

D/1/3 departed Camp KISTLER for C-4.

D/1/3 assumed control of C-4.

CO Co "B" elements departed C-4.

Cpl E. E. HARTLINE, 2d Plt Co "A" D/S with 1/3 accidentally shot himself in right leg. Non battle casualty evacuated to "D" Med. Serious incident report submitted to 3d Marines.

1st Plt Co "A" returned from D/S of 2/4 vic (YD-281215).

29 April 1968

Radar at C-4 detected NVA sqd vic (YD 288732) moving north. Fired LVTH-6, 30 rds VT/HE on target. Results unk.

30 April 1968

Three (3) crewmen, 2d Plt Co "A" in D/S B/1/3 OpCon to 2/4: One KIA, Two WIA MedEvac; by small arms during assault of north bank SONG HIEU GLANG (YD 257625).

LVT A-21 D/S B/1/3 OpCon 2/4 hit 3 mines, portside. No casualties. Vehicle burning.

2d Plt, Co "A", 1st AmTrac Bn D/S B/1/3 OpCon 2/4 encountered SA, AW and Recoilless Guns crossing to north bank SONG HIEU GLANG (YD - 257625). LVT A-21 previously reported (Ser#-321) as hitting three mines, correct to read hit by three (3) rds Recoilless Gun. Vehicle destroyed by fire caused by gun fire. Add one (1) additional WIA (MedEvac).

Provisional Rifle Company; commanded by Maj J. BURGER Jr. (plt from each company H&S, Co "A" & "B") moved into cordon position around resettlement village, north bank Cua Viet river.

D/1/3 reported three (3) Marines from W/1/12 were burned when primer set off charges which had just been cut, all three emergency MedEvac) nonbattle casualties.
