PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. Elements of the battalion located at Oceanview, YD 293754, sighted numerous unidentified flying objects, believed to be helicopters. The majority were sighted in the vicinity of the Ben Hai River and toward Tiger Island, YD 483987. To assist in positive identification, the battalion elements at Oceanview were provided with two Xenon Searchlights, after many attemps the searchlight crew illuminated one twin rotor helicopter on 19 June 1968.
- 2. The amount of incoming artillery fire received this month was 288 rounds. The heaviest concentration was 76 rounds received on 27 June 1968. Casualties with in the battalion were extremely light consisting, of 8 WIA's. Material damage consisted of minor shrapnel damage to one LVT, two tropical huts slightly damaged, and one starlight scope and one lubrication unit destroyed.
- 3. The battalion had operational control of the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO from 251000H to 301200H June 1968.
- 4. The following Army units were in support of the battalion for the dates indicated:

C/1/8 Cav U.S.A. 5-12 June 1968

A/3/5 Cav U.S.A. (Armd) 5-20 June 1968

The mobility of the mechanized Army units allowed numerous village sweeps to be conducted. The psychological effect on the villages of the multitude of tracked vehicles was immeasurable.

- 5. Company A, First AmTrac Battalion relieved Company B, First AmTrac Battalion on 161200H June at Base Area C-4. During their operations at C-4 the two units conducted a total of 31 fire missions and detected 312 NVA/VC infiltrators. One NVA was captured. A Free Fire Zone was established in the vicinity of C-4 with save-a-plane automatically in effect. This allowed units at C-4 to call fire missions with minimum lost time and allowed maximum utilization of COFRAM ammunition.
- 6. LVT support was provided to 1/3 and 3/3. The LVT platoon, H&S Co., First AmTrac Battalion supported 3/3 and 3/3 rear at Mai Ka Thi, YD 285670. The platoon carried a total of 51 tons of cargo and 183 personnel during this period. Additionally the 3d Marines ISA, YD 296653, was provided with LVT support. Incidental responsibilities included








support for a U.S. Navy dredge clearing the channel in the Cua Viet River. The LVT's were utilized to shift the piping and the dredge anchors. On 21 June LVTP-5A1, A-21, which had been hit by 75mm R.R. fire and burned during the battle of Dai Do on 2 May was recovered and returned to Cua Viet.

- 7. A cordon and search operation was conducted at Kuan Khanh village (YD 326697) on 14 June 1968. Sweeps were conducted on 16 hamlets in the southern portion of the AO.
- 8. On 27 June, Maj. Gen. R. G. Davis, CG 3d Marine Division, and Maj.Gen. Kerwin, U.S.A. visited Camp Kistler. They were briefed by the Battalion S-3 on current operations and by the CO, Task Force Clearwater, on Naval activities along the Cua Viet River.
- 9. The number of tracked vehicles mining incidents increased. Three LVT's were heavily damaged by T-11 Soviet mines and 10 1b locally produced mines. Two U.S. Army Tanks were also damaged by AT mines.

1 June 1968

1st AmTrac Bn assumed OpCon of all tracked vehicles in direct support of 3d Mar Regt.

Two, 4th Platoon, Cotat, LVT's were dispatched from 1/3 LSA to YD 296665, to assist Navy Dredge shift dredge anchor.

Co^{NBN}, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 10 to 12 NVA, vic YD 297713. NVA halted at this coordinate for 15 minutes then moved to the southwest. Co^{NBN} patrol checked area and found foot prints leading north.

Co'B", at C-4 position, using NOD, observed 10 to 15 persons moving northeast, at YD 293719. Co'B' fired 72 rds of 81mm mortar and observed possible secondary explosions.

2 June 1968

Bn Scouts, vic YD 297713, observed 20 to 30 NVA approaching their position from the south. The NVA approached to wintin 75 meters and were alerted to the Scouts position. At this time, the Scouts took the NVA under fire. The NVA split into two groups, one going northeast and one going southwest. Fired 81mm mortar from C-4 position at fleeing NVA; checked the area of contact and found drag marks indicating two bodies were drug to the southwest.

Camp Kistler received 10 rds of light artillery, from YD 225825, resulting in one WIA medevac and one Tropical Hut destroyed. Relayed tower's azimuth and grid to Regt FSCC.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using NOD and PPS-5 Radar, detected 15 NVA, at YD 299726. Fired 18 rds of 105mm Firecracker. Could not observe results because of excessive dust in the impact area. Good target coverage.

Co^uD^u, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 15 NVA moving south, at YD 301699. Notified 3d Marines and fired unobserved 105mm mission.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar and NOD, observed 7 NVA moving north, vic YD 294728. Fired 18 rds of 105mm Firecracker with good target coverage. Results unknown.

Co"B" completed search of area of Firecracker concentration the previous night, from YD 297723 to YD 283747; found numerous foot prints and one NVA canteen. Firecracker rds appeared to have landed 200 meters short.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 2 NVA moving northwest, vic YD 301709. Fired 23 rds 81mm mortar with unknown results. Notified A-1 position.

All BIT 3/1 assets, 1 tank, 4 ontos, 9 INTs, back loaded as per orders, aboard USS Thomaston. BLT 2/4 tracked vehicle assets remain OpCon to 1st AmTracs.

ComBm resupply LVTs, vic YD 299735, while on return trip from Oceanview were fired on by 4 or 5 NVA, vic YD 303734. Negative casualties.

Bn Scouts, vic YD 307726, were ambushed by 18 to 25 NVA, vic YD 309729. Bn Scouts returned fire with small arms and M-79 and withdrew to the south. Bn Scouts called 81mm mortar and 105mm mission. The Scouts suffered no casualties.

Vietnamese victims of war started relocating from Xuan Khanh, vic YD 315680, to resettlement village area, vic YD 327697.

1st Bn, 3rd Mar, departed southern AO. A/3/5 Cav, USA, will assume interim AO activity.

One Marine helicopter (CH-34) went down in Gulf of Tonkin, vic YD 350699. LVTP-5 (A-24) was dispatched by maintenance officer to helicopter which was 300 meters off shore. The LVTP-5 rescued four members of the crew/passengers, none was seriously injured. The crew of the rescue vehicle consisted of: 1st Lt Allum, SSgt Pollard, Cpl Maxwell, Cpl Scott and Cpl Lynch.

1st AmTrac Bn assumed OpCon of C/1/8 Cav, USA.

1st AmTrac Bn assumed OpCon of A/3/5 Cav, USA.

Downed helicopter retrieved to beach by maintenance officer. Navy ICM with a crane lifted helicopter and carried it close to shore, it was then dragged to shore by LVTR-1.











NGF Spotter Team, at YD 293753, fired 68 rds at an estimated 20 NVA, vic YD 290715, with unknown results.

ComBM, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 12 NVA moving north at YD 290715. Fired 18 rds of 105mm Firecracker with good target coverage. Reaction time for artillery was 05 minutes.

Elms 1/8 Cav and 3/5 Cav, USA commenced search and destroy operation of southern AO with two plateons of Co"C" 1/8 Cav and two plateons of "A" Trp 3/5 Cav sweeping from Bo Bang, YD 336630, west to Viet Yen, YD 311640, north to Yen Cu, YD 310652 and east to Houng Kim, YD 327650.

7 June 1968

Elms of 1/8 Cav and 3/5 Cav, USA, completed sweep of southern AO, from Bo Bang, vic YD 336630, to Yen Cu, vic YD 310652, with negative results.

M48-A3 Tank, leading column, from "A" Trp 3/5 Cav, USA, detonated AT, mine of unknown type and size, vic YD 354653, destroying one roadwheel and track on port side. Negative casualties.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, and elms of Co"B", at Oceanview, vic YD 298747, observed 7 to 10 NVA, vic YD 276775. Fired 90 rds 4.2 mortar HE with unknown results.

Co'B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar and NOD, detected 21 NVA, vic YD 299697, moving southeast. Fired 57 rds 81mm mortar and 30 rds 105mm artillery with unknown results.

8 June 1968

IVTP-5 (A-24) while supporting MedCAP to resettlement village, detonated AT mine, vic YD 337703, destroying two readwheels and 15 blocks of track. Crater and shrapnel indicates mine was T-41.

IVT (A-24) was preceded by engineer sweep team and one LVT. Negative casualties.

Co"C" 1/8 Cav and "A" Trp 3/5 Cav completed search and cordon of Vinh Hoa Phong, YD 373656 with negative results.

Tower, at 1st AmTrac CP, observed active arty at 5743 mils at a range of 16000 meters, approximately at grid YD 24818226. Requested counter battery from 3/12 and NOF. No fire mission granted

Camp Kistler received 15 rds of light to medium artillery from sound sensing azimuth of 5500 mils. Bn suffered no casualties and minor damage to LVTP-5 A-25.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports active arty, at 5634 mils, 15,000 meters. 3/3 and ARVN Forces taking incoming, at YD 255705 and north.

NGF Spot Team, at Oceanview, observed and adjusted NGF on active arty position, at YD 235840.

Co"B", at C-4 position, observed 4 to 6 NVA, vic YD 291717. Called 105mm mission, fired 19 rds with unknown results. NVA disappeared to the west.

C/1/8 and A/3/5 Cav, USA, reported sweep of upper Bo Bang had no major incidents. Only a few inhabitants remain in the village.

Co"A" patrol north, vic YD 330705, under fire. Co "B", at C-h position, detected 6 NVA south of the vic of contact. Negative results at this time.

BLT 2/4 AmTracs backloaded aboard ship and departing Cua Viet.

C.I.T. reports that 30 VC laid 15 AT mines in My Loc, vic YD 305683, at 092200H, and that 3 VC were wounded in a fire fight.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports NVA wheeled vehicles, vic YD 276774. Naval Guns fired 10 rds of 5 in.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reported that fire mission was called on active arty, at YD 22888541, resulting in one enemy gun destroyed.

C.I.T. interrogated PF who was brought in from Vinh Lai and Loung Kim. VC retreated to Lo Xuyen. He stated that VC entered area from the river.

3d Platoon, Co"A", reported that they participated in a sqd size patrol which swept village, YD 294644. Four families were moved from the village.

USA 3/5 elms reported 6 to 7 enemy at YD 375648. Personnel moved north out of range before action could be initiated. Time required for clearance of 4.2 mortar mission was excessive.

10 June 1968

Chopped OpCon C/1/8 Cav and assumed OpCon of A/1/8 Cav.



Elms "A" Trp 3/5 Cav, USA, in contact with 12 VC, at YD 335626, reports that, at 121035H, elms of "A" Trp at the village of An Trach, observed 3 enemy running west into tree line, then observed 9 more, all armed, running in the same direction. Exchanged fire with enemy and persued to southwest to YD 349615, where they found numerous spider holes and bunkers which were destroyed.

H&S Co patrol/ambush north, vic YD 324697, received 3 rds SAF from 2 to 3 VC, at YD 322694. Patrol did not return fire due to village in area and long range.

13 June 1968

Elms Co"B", at Oceanview, YD 29375h, observed 9 NVA heading north, vic YD 266756. NVA were carrying heavy loads and had no weapons. Attemped to call fire mission but could not get clearance from ARVN at A-1 position.

Elms Co"B", vic YD 293754, observed 10 NVA moving north, vic YD 272750. NVA were packing heavy loads. Took NVA under fire with 50 cal MG and NGF with unknown results.

Camp Kistler, received 61 rds mixed arty from grids YD 244824, YD 222822 and YD 217837. 12th Mar and NGF firing counter battery. Results of arty attack were: 3 friendly WIA non-medevac, 16 bladders of POL, and one Tropical Hut in Navy Compound was destroyed.

14 June 1968

Elms of ComB", vic YB 293752, observed 3 groups of NVA, totaling 7, vic YB 275755. Took NVA under fire with 50 cal and 30 cal MG and NGF.

Co"A", 1st AmTracs, I/3/3, A/1/8 Cav and "A" Trp 3/5 Cav commenced cordon and search of resettlement village, vic YD 326697.

Co"B" patrol checked area of contact, at 140220H (YD 285752), finding one wounded NVA and blood and drag marks indicating that at least two more NVA were seriously wounded. Patrol also found one AK-47, 5 ChiCom grenades, 3 clips for AK-47 with ammo, rain gear and assorted papers.

Search and cordon of resettlement village discovered an excess of rice and an excess of young males of draft age. Coastal Group 11 reports that 14 of these young males were detained.







Elms of Co"B", at Oceanview, observed 6 NVA in open, vic YD 270784. Fired 30 rds NGF with unobserved results.

From 150830H to 151200H Bn S-5 conducted MedCAP in villages Pho Hoi and Ha Tay.

UFO's in vic YD 2674, YD 2582 and YD 2583, reported by Blurry Critic "L". All towers alerted and makings. UFO's appear to be helicopters. Notified CO and put Bn on blackout status.

16 June 1968

4th Platoon, Ce A, at Oceanview, reported UFO's in their area firing air to ground missiles and that Swift Boat which they were observing by means of NOD had disappeared.

Through monitoring Swift Boats freq, confirmed that one Swift Boat is missing.

Co"B" reports observing 10 UFO's; 5 in Tiger Island vicinity, 2 in peninsula area, 2 north of hill 23 and one in Con Thien area.

Elms Co"B", at Oceanview, observed 5 UFO's; 2 in area of Tiger Island and 3 northwest of Oceanview.

Fire Raider NGF Spotter Team, at Oceanview, and tower, at AmTrac CP, report one UFO hit by Naval aircraft.

Platoon Leader, at Oceanview, believes Swift Boat was sunk by fixed wing aircraft. He says he saw rocket flashes and moments later Swift Boat disappeared.

Coastal Group 11 reports 14 detainees held from sweep of resettlement village 14 June. Six still being held for questioning, eight were released by PFs. Detainees were handed over to VN authorities for being eligible for the draft.

Co"A", Major R. B. Throm assumed command of C-4 position.

16 yr old VN male came to 3d Platoon, Co"A" requesting medical aid, vic YD 297655. ID reveals that he lives outside of AO. He said he found a blasting cap, in a rice paddy, and it went off in his hand. VN was medevaced to Dong Ha and is being classified as a VC suspect.









4th Platoon, Co"A", at Oceanview, reports finding wreckage of Swift Boat and one MIA, vic YD 315770.

3d Platoon, $\text{Co}^{\text{N}}\text{A}^{\text{U}}$, observed one individual swimming, vic YD 291650. Fired 18 rds M-16, 25 rds 30 cal MG and 4 rds M-79 with unknown results.

Co"A", perimeter guard, reports one person moving back and forth, vic YD 335693. Took the individual under fire with small arms and another appeared, both persons returned fire with rounds impacting on several post both in CO"A" and in Co"B" area. Individuals fled in the direction of Pho Hoi. PFs and Coastal Group 11 were notified.

Co"A" reports what appears to be UFO activity from the mouth of the Ben Hai River to Tiger Island.

17 June 1968

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, YD 293754, observed an undetermined number of NVA, at YD 28707573, moving southwest. Fired 105mm mission with unobserved results.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed UFO over peninsula to the north. While under observation the UFO appeared to explode in midair.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, fired arty and 50 cal MG at NVA, vic YD 280750, with unknown results. Requested AO to check area at first light.

Sweep Team, with Co"A" resupply run to Oceanview, found one T-41 AT mine, at YD 298749. They destroyed the mine in place.

Chopped OpCon of A/1/8 Cav, assumed OpCon of D/1/9 Cav, USA.

4th Platoon, Co^{ll}A", at Oceanview, discovered one 85mm, one 155mm and one 250 lb bomb duds. Duds were marked for later demolition.

Received report from CouA" that they observed 10 UFO's at the mouth of the Ben Hai River.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports muzzle flashes at 5668 mils, approximately 11,000 meters.

4th Plateon, Co"A", reports two UFO's flying west and one flying east, from Tiger Island to shore, at high rate of speed. Observed from Oceanview.









Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports that Gio Linh has sighting of two UFO's on azimuth of 6400-0200 mils at a distance of 8,000 to 10,000 meters.

Tower at AmTrac CP, reports 4 active AA positions around the mouth of the Ben Hai River.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed 3 UFO's landing north of the Ben Hai River. One touched down for 05 minutes, two on the ground for 10 minutes. Called arty mission, fired HE, VT and Firecracker with unobserved results. Excellent target coverage.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, observed active AA fire on azimuth of 5645 mils and 5654 mils, 15,000 meters. Also reports six more active AA positions in the general area.

Co"A", at C-4 position, reports active AA fire on azimuth of 5820 mils, 6000 mils and 5652 mils.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, reports active AA fire on azimuth of 5400 mils.

18 June 1968

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed 12 NVA, fully equipped and armed moving north, vic YD 285746. Called lo5mm arty mission with unknown results.

Two Kenon Lights depart CP enroute to Oceanview.

2nd Platton Co"B" completed the relief of 3d Platoon Co"B" at 1/3 LSA.

Flms "A" Trp, 3/5, Cav, USA, observed one VC guiding five NVA armed with AK-47s and MG. Took them under fire and wounded and captured one VC. Check of area revealed two blood trails.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports two UFO's at 2 Oclock, 8000 meters.

Co"A", at C-4 position, reports two UFO's due east of C-4 position.

Elms Co "A", at Oceanview, reports six UFO's, vic the mouth of the Ben Hai River.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reported UFO flying north over the peninsula.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports one UFO moving north from Tiger Island at high rate of speed.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports two UFO's on azimuth of 5370 mils at a distance of 10000 meters.

Co"A", at Oceanview, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 7 personnel moving southwest, vic YD 298716. Fired 81mm mortar mission with unknown results.

Co"A", at Oceanview, reports UFO being fired on in vic of C-2 position.

Elms Co"A" 1/9 Gav, USA, initiated ambush on 12 NVA/VC, vic YD 350673.

19 June 1968

Received spot report on 1/9 Cav contact, YD 350 675. Elms D/1/9 Cav, at YD 350675, initiated ambush on 15 to 20 people firing 4 Claymores, SAF and AWF. Enemy fled to west.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports AA fire on photo plane on azimuth of 5260 mils,10,000 meters.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports AA fire on photo plane on azimuth of 5500 mils, 14,000 meters.

Navy requested two LVTs to assist in putting LCM-8 back in water. ComBm took the committment.

Co"A" elms, at Oceanview, reported observing 10 roter type UFO's throughout the night on azimuth of 4500 mils to 6150 mils.

Elms CoⁿA", at Oceanview, spotted active arty, at YD 239828 on azimuth of 5775 mils. Fired 62 rds of NGF with good target coverage.

Elms of D/1/9 Cav, USA, checked area of ambush 190036H. Observed one VN male running from them into the village, YD 359644. Apprehended the male and searched the village finding one US steel helmet and one carrying case for a rifle. VN male was questioned by C.I.T. and released as an inocent civilian.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, reports active arty on azimuth of 5610 mils at a distance of 18000 meters.

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, observed 8 to 10 NVA, vic YD 250832, in the open; fired NGF mission with unknown results.

Co"A", at C-4 position, reports AA fire on azimuth of 5750 mils and 5410 mils.

Elms Co"A", vic YD 289751, observed UFO on azimuth of 5850 mils, at an altitude of 1500 ft. Using NOD and Xenon Light was able to observe spherical shape object with two rotors.

CoⁿAⁿ, at C-4 position, reports AA fire at photo plane on azimuth of 5400 to 5800 mils.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, using NOD and Menon Light, observed 10 to 15 NVA, vic YD 286756, moving north. Fired NGF mission (15 rds) and 15 rds 60mm mortar HE and WP.

Camp Kistler, received 57 rds of light to medium arty, from YD 2474583390 and YD 2466082480. Ammodump on north bank of river took several direct hits resulting in several large secondaries. NGF fired counter battery achieving 7 secondary explosions and TPQ was conducted getting one secondary explosion. Bn suffered one minor casualty and minor ammo losses as a result of the arty attack.

20 June 1968

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, using Xenon Light, observed h NVA moving north, vic YD 282751. Fired 105mm and 81mm with good target coverage. Results were unobserved.


Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 5 to 10 NVA moving northwest, vic YD 295706. Fired 81mm mission with unknown results.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, using NOD, observed 6 NVA moving north, vic YD 278746. Fired 105mm mission with unknown results.

Bn returned OpCon of "A" Trp3/5 Cav to 3/5 Cav USA and assumed OpCon of "C" Trp3/5 Cav, USA.

Co"A" patrol, vic YD 306735, discovered one AT mine weighing approximately 15 lbs.

Army units completed sweep and MedCAP of Van Ap and Xuan Phoung.

21 June 1968

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, reported that they saw one UFO on azimuth of 6000 mils, approximate distance of 6 miles.

Eims Co"A", at YD 289751, using NOD, observed a large complex of lights, on azimuth of 5450 mils, 10,000 meters. Rockets were fired from complex impacting in the area of hill 23.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, observed missile being fired on azimuth of 5635 mils.

Night ambush from D/1/9, vic YD 348683, observed one individual, vic YD 347683, signaling with what appeared to be lead pipes. They spotted two more people in the same area. They started to receive fire; they returned fire and withdrew to their CP.

Night ambush from D/1/9, vic YD 352682, observed one individual moving and other enemy movement, vic YD 350679. Ambush took enemy under fire and then withdrew to their CP, joining the other ambush patrol enroute.

Training exercise for LVTE-1 crewmen was conducted at C-4 position. Two line charges were fired. Impact area selected was the tree line north of the position thus the training thinned the trees providing improved visibility.

Elms C/3/5 Cav, USA, completed sweep of An Trach, vic YD 355623, with negative results.

D/1/9 Cav completed sweep of Vinh Lai, YD 327637, and Van Ap, YD 335666, with negative results.

Elms of Co"B" recovered LVT (A-21), from Dai Do. Vehicle has been declared code X. It is to be used as a bunker/chapel at Camp Kistler.

Elms D/1/9 Cav, USA, vic YD 335648, observed enemy movement while moving into their night position. Took enemy under fire killing one NVA/VC who was armed with a 9mm Browning FN Canadian make automatic pistol.

Co"A", at C-4 position, observed lights in the tree line, vic YD 31217310. Fired 7 rds of 60mm. Then observed 4 NVA/VC, fired 81mm mission, lights went out and the NVA/VC disappeared.











22: June 1968

Camp Kistler received 11 rds, light to medium arty, from azimuth of 5200 mils. H-6's ammo bunker took a direct hit igniting several WP rds. Bn suffered 3 minor WIAs.

Co"A", at C-4 position, received two rds of unknown size arty, from YD 235835. Negative casualties or damage.

Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected two small groups of NVA/VC, at YD 317732. NVA were moving northwest. Fired 9 rds of 90mm beehive, 51 rds 81mm and 50 cal and 30 cal NG with unknown results.

Elms 3/5 Cav and 1/9 Cav began sweep of Bo Bang, YD 327627 and Vinh Lai YD 326627.

Bn Aid Station treated 3 VN from resettlement village, who were supposedly wounded by an arty rd, which impacted in the resettlement village at the same time that Camp Kistler was receiving incoming arty. The 3 VN children were medevaced to "D" med in Dong Ha. Bn S-5 was notified to investigate cause of the injuries.

Bn MedCAP departed for resettlement village.

Tank (M48-A3) from C/3/5 Cav, USA, detonated AT mine, at YD 335634 and suffered damage to one road-wheel, one torsion arm and the track. Tank was retrieved to C/3/5 Cav CP

Bn S-5 Officer, Lt Parsons, inspected area of resettlement village where NVA arty round was supposed to have impacted, killing 5 and wounding 5 VN. Due to the lack of fragmentation in the area of the blast it is considered highly doubtful that the damage is a result of an arty round. The VN National Police will investigate. There is a possibilty that the blast was caused by villagers handling of explosives.


CoWB", to provide two LVTP-5s, to assist C/3/5 Cav, in retrieving Tank which hit mine, at YD 335634.

Co^{NBN} ambush, vic YD 324704, took 5 to 8 NVA/VC, vic YD 325704 under fire with M-79 and MG fire with negative results. Attempted to fire Claymore but it misfired.









24 June 1968

Co"A", at C-4 position, received 3 rds of incoming SAF, from YD 310728. Negative casualties.

C/3/5 Cav, USA, apprehended 7 VC/NVA suspects while conducting sweep, vic YD 383648. Suspects had 2 NVA uniforms, canteen, mess gear, small piece of explosive and 20 NVA piasters. Detainees forwarded with possessions to 3d Mar S-2.

Co"A" elms destroyed 2 buildings, possibly used for shelter or way station. Buildings located at YD 261755.

Received call from project officer of MCB-5, stating that 12 men would arrive on 25 June with one TD-15. On 26 June the tower for C-4 will be delivered. Inquiries were made in regard to Maj Burger accompaning personnel to C-4, since he was at C-4 when tower position was selected. Informed party of possibility, Maj Burger will be unable to accompany, will give details to Maj Threm in order to effect emplacement.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed 10 NVA/VC swimming, at YD 253813. Fired 40 rds NGF with good target coverage. Results unknown.

Oceanview reports active arty, at 5260 mils. Tower, at Camp Kistler, reports 5260 mils while C-4 indicated 5300 mils. Artillery fire possibly AA fire. Secondary explosion observed at 5340 mils.

Elms Co"A", at YD 292750, observed white light proceeding seaward and white light moving toward land. Lights observed between Tiger Island and mouth of Ben Hai River. Distance 4,000 meters, azimuth 1200 mils.

Oceanview observed light moving at 120 knots on azimuth of 3000 mils. Light was observed traveling toward Tiger Island.

Camp Kistler received the rds of light and medium artillery. Experienced a good percentage of either duds or delays. POL dump took one hit, resulting in two ruptured fuel tanks. Total damage undetermined at this time:

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, using starlight scope and PPS-5 Radar, observed 10 to 15 NVA vic YD 29137197. Fired 22 rds of 105mm HE; with good coverage.

Co"A", at C-4 position, observed 10 NVA, vic YD 286709, by use of starlight scope and PPS-5 Radar. Personnel were moving in a westerly direction.

Informed 3d Mar Regt that C-4 had reported observing 10 to 15 NVA moving into their AO, vic YD 300710. Fired 22 rds of 81mm mortar with unknown results.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, had visual contact with 2 UFO's moving from Ben Hai to Tiger Island.

Tower, at AmTrac CP, observed one secondary from TPQ in area 5605 mils to 5635 mils at a distance of 16,000 meters.

C/3/5 Cav, USA, reported sweep of Tuong Van, YD 333677, was conducted with negative results.

Co"A", IVTR-5, on resupply run south from C-4 position, detonated estimated 40 lb mine, vic YD 339705. Three persons wounded and evacuated to In Aid Station. Vehicle sustained damage to the hull and suspension system. Fuel system fire extinguished. Initial indication is that mine was homemade.

Post 34 spetted boat traveling north along perimeter. Reaction force alerted. Boat changed course 180 degrees. Elms C/3/5 Cav, USA, alerted and tracked boat along coast for distance of 2000 meters, using Kenon Light and 22 rds of 4.2 mortar illumination. Naval operational unit dispatched vessel to intercept at 242215H. Boat being chased and two more in its vicinity identified as Coastal Group 11 patrol craft (Junk Fleet). C/3/5 Cav and 1st AmTrac Bn reaction force returned to CP. Adjacent units had not been informed of Junk Fleet night activity along southern portion of coastal AO.

Elms of Co"A", at YD 292754, visually observed 2 UFO's, one moving east, the other moving north. Both had blinking red and white lights. Sightings were made on an azimuth of 1000 mils from their position, distance unknown. A total of 10 UFO's were sighted, but unable to assertain any set pattern. Last observation being on azimuth of 0200 mils, distance unknown.

UFO sightings, from Oceanview, total 15. General location, mouth of the Ben Hai River. All UFO's display blinking red and white lights.

Films Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPs-5 Radar, spotted 5 to 6 NVA, at YD 299726. Fired 8 rds of 81mm mortar and then lost contact. Unable to assertain results.

25 June 1968



Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed firing at YD 2775. Checkfire requested through 3d Mar Regt watch officer.

MCB-5 personnel embarked on LCM for movement to C-4 where they will install new tower.

lst AmTrac Bn assumed responsibility for NAPOLEON/SALINE AO in compliance with CG 3d Mar Div message 250900Z.

Assumed OpCon of A/1/3 in compliance with CG 3d Mar Div message 260950Z.

Two companies from 4th Bn, 2nd ARVN Regt set in, vic YD 271703.

Camp Kistler received 12 rds light to medium arty. One starlight scope damaged due to fragmentation, damage from fragmentation was minor in Co areas. Active arty sighted at an azimuth of 5640 mils and 5450 mils, distance 12,000 meters.

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, had visual sighting of 4 UFO's, all having red and white blinking lights. UFO's were moving from area of Ben Hai River to Tiger Island.

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, spotted light moving between, #D 294751 and YD 285756. Fired 60mm illumination and sighted 6 personnel. Opened fire with MG and SAF, Sniper Platoon commenced firing at the same time. Results unknown at this time.

Tower, at Camp Kistler, reports search light being used at azimuth of 5635 mils, distance 12,000 meters. Contacted elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, and were informed that they were using search light.

15th C.I.T. relayed message to S-2 to that NVA had constructed a log and concrete bunker, at YD 215818, housing artillery piece or pieces whose mission is to shell Cua Viet Port Facility.

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, reported Swift Boat, at the mouth of the Ben Hai River, on azimuth of 5788 from Oceanview, taking MG fire from shoreline. MGF mission being prepared.

CoMB" LVT (B-15) hit AT mine, at YD 332697, resulting in four wounded personnel, one of which scheduled for medevac. Vehicle sustained damage to suspension system resulting in loss of 3 roadwheels and several blocks of track. Mine was probably homemade consisting of black powder. Crater is approximately 6 feet in diameter and 6 feet in depth. There was no fragmentation from blast.

Medevac of GySgt Antley, CoMBM, 1st AmTrac Bn, completed. Individual has possible fractured clavicle resulting from mining incident.

Div G-3 informed Bn S-3 that OpCon of C/3/5 Cav, USA, and D/1/9 Cav, USA, will terminate at 271200H. Co "C"/1/9 will arrive by helicopter to take up Army position. Co"B" will provide 5 LVTP-5's and one LVTP-5 (CMD) in support along with two tanks from Co "C", 3d Tank Bn.

Elms C/3/5 Cav, USA, and D/1/9 Cav, USA, observed one individual in treeline, at YD 354674, opened fire and person ran, shortly after, three more were sighted and brought under fire with 50 cal NG, 90mm cannister rds and illumination was fired by 4.2 mortar. Four individuals observed to fall but later sweep relealed no casualities. Contact area will be swept again at first light.

27 June 1968

C/3/5 Cav, USA, and D/1/9 Cav, USA, returned to operational control of their parent organizations.

Co"B" CO returned from III MAF "Quarterly Tactical Seminar".

CO, 1st Mar Regt, with staff, visited Camp Kistler for NAPOLEON/SALINE briefing, prior to entry of 1st Marines into AO.

CG, 3d Mar Div and MajGen Kerwin, visited Camp Kistler for briefing on current NAPOLEON/SALINE operations.

First increment of C/1/9 arrived at Camp Kistler Landing Zene.

28 June 1968

Camp Kistler received 76 rds of light and medium artillery; Bn sustained minimal damage. Camp Kistler tower recorded sightings from 5595 mils and C-4 tower indicated 5800 mils. Emergency TPQ's were called on active arty, at YD 239826 and YD 222825, with unknown results.

4th Platoon, Co"A", vic YD 288752, using starlight, scope, observed 25 to 30 NVA moving north, vic YD 271754. Called NGF mission but target disappeared before fire mission could be effected.

Ce "A", at C-4 position, observed 10 to 15 VC/NVA moving northwest, vic YD 317721. NVA/VC disappeared, vic YD 294715, before fire mission could be effected.

Elms A/1/3, vic YD 274670, observed 10 VC dressed in black pajamas moving into treeline, YD 278673. Fired 3 rds 81mm WP with unknown results.

Sqd patrel, Co"A", destroyed one cement building with explosivies, at YD 300730.

1st AmTrac Bn returned OpCon of C/1/9 to CG, 3d Mar Div, ref CG, 3d Mar Div message 290600 June 1968.

lst AmTrac Bn assumed OpCon of 1/3 with Co's "B" and "C" untel return of 3d Mar CP to Cua Viet area, ref, CG, 3d Mar Div Msg 290522Z June 1968.

Elms A/1/3, vic YD 274670 observed 30 VC in open, vic YD 267662. Fired 5 rds 81mm WP with unknown results.

Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 10 NVA/VC, vic YD 303729. Fired 30 cal and 50 cal MG, 54 rds of 81mm mortar and 4 rds of 90mm bee-hive and movement ceased.

29 June 1968

C/1/3 moved to Nhi Ha, vic YD 270703.

Elms Completed sweep of Gia Do, vic YD 275633, with negative results.

Elms Co"A", at Oceanview, observed 2 UFO's with red and white lights on an azimuth of 6400 mils, at a distance of 15000 meters.









CoMA" LVT enroute to Camp Kistler, from 6-4, detonated AT mine, at YD 323720, resulting in minor injuries to 3 personnel. Explosion ignited LVT, subsequently causing LVT to be towed into Gulf of Tonkin, vic YD 323724, in order to extinquish fire. LVT was carrying grade 3 ammo.

Elms Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, observed 20 NVA, at YD 302703. Fire mission cleared for YD 302703.

Elms of Co"A", while setting booby trap, at YD 289751, had an accidental discharge resulting in 2 personnel WIA. Emergency medevac for two Marines executed from Oceanview.

Elms of Co"A", at Oceanview, observed one stationary light in position, at 5700 mils, vic YD 242803, and one blinking light moving west. Both lights vicinity of the Ben Hai River. Fired NGF.

Elms Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, observed 20 NVA travelling in easterly direction, vic YD 302703 to YD 309702. Fired 4.2 mortar with good target coverage. Target was obscured by impact. Area will be searched at first light.
