






#### PART II

#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY



- 1. Numerous sightings of unidentified flying objects were reported during the month. The UFO's were sighted from Oceanview (YD 291751) and from the Cua Viet tower. The majority of the sightings were in the vicinity of the Ben Hai River and towards Tiger Island.
- 2. The amount of incoming artillery received this month was 127 rounds. The heaviest concentration was 44 rounds received on 1 July. Casualties within the battalion consisted of 4 WIA's. Material damage consisted of 1 LVTP-5, 2 tropical huts and 1 lubricating and servicing unit.
- 3. The battalion assumed operational control of the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO from O21200H July to O62300H July. The 1st Marine Regiment assumed operational control of the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO and 1st AmTrac Battalion on O62300H July and has continued through the month. Company "B", 1st Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment was OpCon to 1st AmTrac Battalion from 281400H June to O41105H July 1968.
- 4. Company "B", 1st AmTrac Battalion relieved Company "A", 1st AmTrac Battalion, at Base Area C-4, on 261155H July. During their operations for the month the two units conducted a total of 50 fire missions and detected 43 NVA/VC infiltrations totaling 375 persons. Activities included the Oceanview Area (YD 291751). A bunker complex was uncovered north of Oceanview and sniper activity was encountered in the area from 22 to 31 July. Efforts are underway to destroy; by demolition, the remainder of the houses in Ha Ioi Tay (YD 300740) and Ha Ioi Trung (YD 315723) area to eliminate possible utilization by the enemy. Numerous buildings have been destroyed.
- 5. LVT support was provided to 1/3, 2/3, 3/3 and 2/1. During Operation THOR, LVT support was provided to the Third Marine Regiment. During this operation, 16 tons of supplies and 360 personnel were transported. LVT's also provided medevac, prime mover and communication support. The H&S Company LVT Platoon and 4th Platoon of Company "B", provided LVT support for 2/1. They transported 50 tons of supplies and 740 personnel. LVT's were used extensively by 2/1 for mobile patrols. Incidental LVT responsibilities included support of units at Base Area C-4 and support and assistance of a US Navy Dredge, clearing the channel in the Cua Viet River. On 13 July, LVTP-5, 1-A-36, which was submerged 041530 December 1967, was recovered from the mouth of the Cua Viet River. During July an LVTE-1, bladed the beach from the Cua Viet River to Base Area C-4, on three occasions.
- 6. Numerous combat operations and patrols were conducted during July. Sweeps of An Trung were conducted on 9 and 17 July by Company "B" (-), reinforced with Popular Forces. A sweep of Ha Loc







and the adjacent lake (YD 323708) was conducted 15 July. Company "A" (-) conducted a sweep of Ha Tay Mot (Tuang Van Thoung) YD 362667, on 26 July, in response to Popular Forces contact. On 30 July, a sweep of the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village was conducted by Regional Forces. Cordon of the area was established by 2nd Battalion, 9th Marine Regiment. In addition to the above operations, 52 squad and platoon patrols were conducted in the southern AO and 98 patrols to the north. Additionally, 17 sweeps were conducted in the Oceanview area exploiting previous sightings of NVA.

- 7. On 1 July, Col A. H. HATHAWAY, U.S.A., PCV Artillery Representative, visited Camp Kistler for briefing on enemy artillery. On 6 July, Maj Gen DRAKE, USMC, Deputy Commander, PCV, visited Camp Kistler and was briefed on current activities in the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO. On 18 July, Col GILES and Staff Officer, 1st Brigade, 5th Mechanized Division, U.S.A., visited Camp Kistler and were briefed on current NAPOLEON/SALINE operations and terrain trafficability for mechanized operations.
- 8. Tracked vehicle mining incidents continue to be a problem. One LVTP-5, one M-48 Tank and one M-76 Otter were seriously damaged by anti-tank mines. Six T-41 Soviet mines and one locally produced mine were recovered, the majority of which were discovered in the area north of Oceanview (YD 291751).
- 9. On 15 July, a combined action company was formed in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 320695). Eighty Popular Forces personnel reside in the village. Marines from this command have been assigned, on a voluntary basis to work with Popular Forces, providing security for the village. From 15 to 31 July, the combined forces of PF's and Marines conducted 16 night ambushes, 32 security patrols and 2 sweeps of An Trung (YD 315706).

1 July 1968



LIST OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Camp Kistler received 44 rounds of light to medium artillery from azimuth of 5635 mils, from Camp Kistler tower. C-4 position reported active arty at 5690 mils. Attack resulted in loss of one POL bladder which burned. TPQ was run on artillery position and counter battery was fired resulting in 15 secondary explosions.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview, YD 293754, using starlight scope, observed active arty position (4 guns) on azimuth of 5880 mils, approximate grid YD 214817. Called NOF mission which resulted in 3 secondary explosions.

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, vic YD 289751, observed one blinking light (red), vic YD 293852, and another, at YD 298881, moving east to Tiger Island. Followed both lights with starlight scope until they vanished, vic YD 483887.

Co<sup>N</sup>A<sup>N</sup>, squad patrol, searched area of NVA sighting and fire mission, at 302243June68, with negative findings.

Tower, at Camp Kistler, reported 10 secondaries resulting from TPQ run north of the battalion AO.

First Platoon, Co"B", relieved Second Platoon, Co"B", at 1/3 LSA, YD 294654.

Camp Kistler received five rounds of light to medium artillery from unknown location. Results were: two tropical huts damaged, 1 M-16 rifle and one POL bladder destroyed. Negative casualties.


Col Hathaway, PCV artillery representitive, visited First AmTrac's CP for briefing on enemy artillery in and above the DMZ.

Lt Stoddard, USN Senior Advisor for Coastal Group 11,,advised S-3 Officer that their craft Would use blinking light recognition signals in order to elliminate previous recognition problems with this unit.









2 July

Co"A" LVT (A-40) which was mined 301420June was recovered and brought to battalion area.

.....

Tower, at Camp Kistler, reported six secondaries resulting from Arc Light run to north of the battalion AO.

Major Dannelly, Division G-3, informed the battalion that the ARVN Operation in southern AO was completed and that portion of our AO, which was under ARVN control, was returned to the battalion.

Notified 3rd Marine Division of the receipt of the Arc Light schedule for Operation THOR.

Elements Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, vic TD 324716, detained one VCS, 19 years of age, who had a bullet wound approximately 2 months old. Forwarded to 7th I.T.T. for interrogation.

lst AmTrac Battalion assumed responcibility for the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO from 3rd Marines and will retain AO until 1st Marines is established. Reference: 3rd Marines S-3 on instruction from 3rd Marine Division.


S-3 and S-3A attended planning conference at 3rd Marines CP. Three LVT platoons (-) will be provided as support for operation. One LVT platoon (-) to support each battalion.

Co<sup>8</sup>A<sup>8</sup>, L.P., vic YD 337692, observed movement 400 meters to their front and received SAF from the area of movement. Returned SAF and illuminated area with negative results. Coastal Group 11 reports that PF's were in the area of contact. Investigation reveals that Co<sup>8</sup>A<sup>8</sup> L.P. and PF elements fired on each other. Negative casualties on either side.

Tower, at AmTrac CP observed several secondary explosions on azimuth of 5600 mils resulting from NGF mission.

Operations Officer of USS Dubuque informed S-3 that LVT training planned for h July would have to be cancelled due to the rescheduling of the USS Dubuque.

3 July 1968









Elements of Co"A", vic YD 318711, observed 2 NVA/VC. Fired M-60 MG and M-79. One NVA/VC fell and the other ran. The patrol observed an other group of 5 NVA/VC and took them under fire with M-60 MG and M-79. NVA/VC returned fire and withdrew to the west. The patrol checked the area and found foot prints, will check the area again at first light.

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, vic YD 292743, observed two blinking lights on azimuth of 0480 mils, distance unknown. The lights on azimuth of 0480 mils were traveling from west to east, one behind the other, approximately 200 feet above the water.

4 July 1968

Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup> patrol checked area of contact at 032334H, vic YD 318711, and found foot prints leading to the west and seven spent cartriges from Ak-47.

CG, 3rd Marine Division and Col Gayler, USA, visited Camp Kistler and were briefed on the feasability of employing a mechanized unit in the NAPOLEON/SALINE AO.

B/1/3 returned to OpCon of 1/3. Departed sand ramp for My Loc via M-8 boat. 4th Platoon (-), Co<sup>n</sup>B<sup>n</sup>, reinforced with Light Tank Section, to maintain security for infantry position south of Camp Kistler perimeter.

3rd Marine Division Operations Chief requested a representative from the battalion to attend a DUEL BLADE meeting 060930 in Division Conference Room to discuss additional DUEL BLADE sights. Major J. C. Burger Jr. will attend the meeting.

H&S Co, LVT's, moved from Mai Xa Thi with 1/3 to YD 255711. Five LVTP-5's hauled 30,000 lbs of gear and 15 troops. Received SAF, mortars and RPG's with negative casualties.

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed blinking white light on azimuth of 6100 mils, distance unknown.


H&S Co, post #34, reported movement in dump area, vic YD 350686. Fired M-79 and illuminated with negative results.

5 July 1968



Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, vic YD 289751, observed one blinking light on azimuth of 6300 mils, moving west to east, at an unknown range.

H&S Co, LVT Platoon, in support of 1/3, vic YD 233716, reports unknown number of large caliber artillery incoming rounds.

Camp Kistler Tower, reported one secondary explosion, from TPQ, on azimuth of 5300 mils; also many people running from the scene.

Tower, at C-4 position, reports active artillery, vic YD 216858. Notified 3rd Marines.

3rd Marines reported finding one booby trapped AK-47 rifle and warned the battalion to consider all bodies, equipment, etc. as booby trapped.

1st Platoon, Co"B", located at YD 270705, with F/2/3.

Co "A", at C-4 position, reports active artillery from azimuth of 4650 mils, impacting in A-1 position.

Senior Advisor, Coastal Group 11 (YD 340680), reported PF ambush took two VC underfire. Small arms from the incident impacted amoung the Companies L.P.'s and Bunker Posts.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, in support of 1/3, reported hauling 25 tons of equipment and acted as MedEvac vehicles this date.

6 July 1968

Elements of Co"A", vic ID 325714, detained one Vietnamese National with I.D. Card stating his age as 50 years. Suspect looks much younger. Forwarded suspect to C.I.T..

Received situation report from 1st Platoon, Co "B". Location, YD 270705, working with Co"G" and Co"H", 2/3. All vehicles operational at time.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports present location YD 254717, currently working as medevac vehicles.

MajGen Drake, Deputy Commander, PCV, visited Camp









Kistler and was briefed on current activities in NAPOIEON/SALINE AO.

3/3 landed at Assembly Area, YD 336705. Unit to spend night at this location, (AmTrac Liaison NCO attached as guide).

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed 25 to 30 persons moveing south vicYD 280740. Notified 2/3, who has a unit in the general area of the sighting.

1st Marines Regiment assumed OpCon of NAPOLEON/SALINE AO. Operation NAPOLEON/SALINE II commences at this time.

7 July 1968

2 LCM's, vic YD 33697, received small arms fire from the north bank of the river. Returned fire with M-79, notified H&S Co post at YD 337703 and 3rd Marine Regiment. US Navy Units on the river and Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) were also notified.

USN Patrol Boat, on the Cua Viet River, observed approximately 15 people moving on the river. Informed 3rd Marines.

Senior Advisor, Coastal Group 11 (NRVN), reported that at the same time the patrol boats were fire on, the PF Unit in the resettlement village (YD 325697) had contact with an estimated 40 NVA/VC resulting in two PF KIA and three PF WIA. NVA/VC withdrew in the direction of Nhi Ha (YD 283706).

1st Platoon, Co"B", operating with 2/3, reports all secure and all vehicles operational. They are acting as prime movers and medevac vehicles.

Upon request of the CO of 3/3, Co"A" will provide an LVT Section to support 3/3.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, operating with 1/3, hauled 12 tons of cargo this period. Received 85mm incoming, all vehicles operational.

CO, Co"B", reports that, 1st Platoon Co"B", operating with 2/3, has hauled 7½ tons of cargo to date.







8 July 1968



2nd Platoon, Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), reported that NGF was impacting dangerously close to their position. Notified 11th Marines who checked the fire.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD and Kenon Light, observed one blinking red light at 5720 mils, distance unknown.

Co"A", at C-4 position, reported that 3/3 had moved into Ha Loi Trung (YD 283763) with negative resistance. Found many small bunkers and destroyed them.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, detached from 1/3, reported that they were enroute to CP.

Galley stove exploded, at C-4 position, resulting in one emergency medevac with 2nd and 3rd degree burns and one bunker destroyed.

1st Platoon, CoNBW, at YD 261743, currently enroute to Nhi Ha (YD 266705) with one M-48 Tank in tow.

lst Platoon, Co"A", in support of 3/3, hauling rations, water, and ammunition resupply, two companies with 60mm mortars and two mules with 106mm recoiless rifles. Vehicle status: 5 LVT's operational and one deadlined.

9 July 1968

1st Platoon, Co"B", reports that one M-48 Tank was destroyed in place by order of CO, 2/3.

Coastal Group 11 reports that PF's have heavy contact with NVA/VC, vic YD 3166. PF Unit moving across strem (YD 330660) was ambushed by NVA/VC Unit of unknown size. River Patrol Craft were dispatched to area and the PF's were extracted. Enemy broke contact and moved south.

10 July 1968

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), reported artillery impacting dangerously close to their position. Notified 1st Marines who checked the fire.

Co"A", found 3 T-41 AT mines, vic YD 292756. Two of the mines will be forwarded to Battalion S-2 and one will be destroyed in place.









Elements of CoMA", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed flares over the mouth of the Ben Hai River.

4th Platoon, Co"B", located at YD 285671, hauled hot chow, water, and communications equipment, to elements of 2/1, in Whi Ha (YD 273705).

The Village Chief of Kuan Khanh Village and eight of his assistants will be allowed to stay within the confines of the compound on the north bank of the river, at night, to insure their safety.

12 July 1968

Elements of Co"A", found two T-41 AT mines (YD 291756) in loose sand and one T-41 AT mine (YD 290757) covered and marked by one upright and one slanted stick. Removed and disarmed mines and forwarded them to Battalion S-2 for disposition.

13 July 1968

LVTP-5 (A-36), which was submerged O41530Dec67, was recovered from the mouth of the Cua Viet River.

1st Platoon, Co "B", carried 1200 pounds of resupply to elements of 2/1 in Nhi Ha.

Elements of Coman, at Oceanview (YD 294754), received two 105mm incoming rounds from the southwest. Investigation reveals that these rounds were fired by 3rd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Company. Short rounds were the result of a 200 mil error. No serious incodent report was submitted by this command. No further investigation is anticipated by this command. Results were one friendly WIA non-medevac.

AO will change 140600H, Ref: Frag Order 106-68.

14 July 1968

hth Platoon, Co<sup>NBN</sup>, located at Mai Xa Thi, transported E/2/1 and H/2/1 to the south bank of the Cua Viet River, where both companies will conduct separate sweeps.

LVTP-5(B-10) damaged by fire in the LVT park. Investigation: reveals vehicle damage and no personnel were injured.









Radar (PPS-5), at C-4 position, detected 15 persons moving south (YD 289713). 1st Marines, Watch Officer, was notified. Fire mission was never cleared.



Elements of Co"A" observed small secondary explosion from NGF 1500-2000 meters north of Oceanview, vicinity of YD 278764.

15July 1968

Co<sup>\*</sup>B\*(-) returned to CP after search of Ha Loc. The lake west of the village was searched by US Navy UDT. One ARVN in UA status was apprehended.

"B"-4 LVT's and two M-76 (Otter), mired at YD 300655, were retrieved by LVTR-1. One submerged M-76 (Otter) retrieved and returned to Cua Viet by US Navy Craft (YLLC-2).


Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed four unarmed individuals moving south from YD 266753 to YD 272732. Fired sixty four rounds of 60mm mortar.

16July 1968

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed by starlight scope, four unarmed persons at YD 266755. Fired eight rounds of 60mm mortar.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 11 NVA, in the open, moving south to north. Fired 35 rounds of 60mm mortar and requested artillery mission. CO, Co"A", notified Conduct of Fire 10 minutes prior to the request. Tweleve minutes after request the mission was passed from 1/11 to W/1/11. 1/11 was advised that W/1/11 had no FDC capability. Request was cancelled as observation was lost. Fired ninety four rounds of NGF at YD 2775 and YD 2774, observed four persons fall and remainder move north rapidly. Swept area of NGF mission (160310H), found 11 sets of foot prints indicating group ran, one man fell and the remaining 10 foot prints were carrying a load as: the prints were deeper.

Co"A" patrol found one DH-10 AP mine, at YD 296749. Destroyed mine in place.









Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed red blinking light moving west to east from the vicinity of the Ben Hai River to Tiger Island.



Co"A" patrol observed 10 to 15 persons moving west to east. Fired fifty three rounds (mixed) 81mm mortar, 15 rounds 105mm artillery, with good target coverage.

Co "A" elements observed bright light moving east to west. UFO remained stationary above the peninsula for 5 minutes and then proceeded east.

17 July 1968

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed red blinking light moving east to west at unknown altitude at an azimuth of 6400 mils.

Friendly artillery, from the south, impacted vicinity: 1 round, YD 2338; 2 rounds, YD 2339 and 1 round, YD 2340. Ordered checkfire.

18 July 1968

Coastal Group 11 informed this battalion that one of their craft received SAF and AWF from YD 332656. Returned fire with .30 and .50 cal. MG.

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, at Oceanview (YD 293754), using starlight scope, observed 5 NVA/VC moving north, vic YD 268753. Fired 6 rounds NGF and lost contact.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using starlight scope, observed 4 NVA/VC, vicinity YD 269755. Fired NGF mission and 105mm mission, total of 50 rounds with unknown results.


ComAm patrol, near hill 23, received one round of reported artillery. Investigation reveals that there is a possibility that the ARVN Forces at A-1 position fired the round. Check fire was called.

Two M-48 Tanks from 1st Platoon, CoMCN, 3rd Tanks arrived at C-4 position for employment at Oceanview.

From 180605H Co<sup>\*</sup>A<sup>\*</sup> searched area of fire mission (180335H), YD 2675, YD 2875, YD 2775. Found four sets of foot prints and one T-41 AT mine.

Recon Team, 3rd Recon, in southern AO, observed 5 VC moving northwest from YD 352669.

ComA", at C-4 position, using NOD, observed UFO with small blinking light moving west to east at azimuth of 6000 mils.

Elements of Comam, at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed visually one UFO moving back and forth between 0150 mils and 0650 mils (magnetic azimuth). UFO made a total of six trips and then disappeared to the north.

Coastal Group 12 (Swift Boats) reports one UFO flying between the mouth of the Ben Hai River and Tiger Island. Observation was made with NOD and Radar.

ARVN, at A-1 position, report that there is one NVA company at YD 245752.

Co"A", monitoring ARVN radio net, reported that ARVN had a sighting of a tracked vehicle at YD 253752. ARVN currently running artillery mission.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 29375h), spotted approximately 15 NVA at the wire in front of their position and took them under fire with M-60 MG and M-16 fire. NVA returned fire and withdrew to the north. Fired 35 rounds 60mm, 10 rounds of 90mm beehive and one round of 90mm HE. Called 105mm mission reinforcing fires. Movement ceased, will check at first light. From 190552 to 190810H Co"A" searched the area of contact 182350H. Found two 250 lb bomb duds, three serarate sets of foot prints and one group of 8 to 10 sets of prints leading up to the wire at Oceanview.







19 July 1968



Co<sup>N</sup>A<sup>N</sup> reported tracked vehicle is still being reported, by ARVN at A-1 position, at YD 24337523. ARVN also reported 10 to 15 man groups of NVA, totaling 200 men at YD 2374, YD 2375 and YD 2376.

Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup>, at C-h position, observed one UFO visually and with NOD on azimuth of 6100 mils, moving west to east and east to west, at the mouth of the Ben Hai River.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, departed CP enroute to Mai Xa Thi, to support 1st Marine Regiment.

Camp Kistler received nine rounds of 100mm or larger artillery from azimuth of 5810 mils, from Oceanview, approximate range 10,000 meters, approximate grid YD 217859. Negative casualties or damage. Called NGF mission on YD 217859 and notified 1/11 FDC.

M-48 Tank, detonated AT mine, while on patrol, at YD 264699. Results were five infantry WIA and considerable damage to suspension system.

From 190945H to 191316H, elements of Co"A" swept YD 3172, YD 3073, YD 2974 and YD 3072. Found one round from 3.5 and destroyed one concrete house at YD 306730.

An Otter (M-76), enroute from C-4 to Camp Kistler, had a power failure while crossing river. Otter was swept down river but was retrieved by US Navy craft.

Received coordinates of new Navy Observation Tower, YD 33706959, call sign - tower 102.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed UFO/blinking light moving west to east between 0250 mils and 0550 mils. Also, observed another UFO make four trips between 0150 mils and 0650 mils.

20 July 1968

Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 29375h), using NOD, observed four NVA/VC moving north, vic YD 275755. Fired NGF and artillery mission with unknown results.

PF patrol, with Marine advisors, at YD 336702,









observed a number of individual moving, at YD 335702. Set ambush but did not trigger it Marine Advisors and PF's detained seven VN males and forwarded them to Battalion S-2. 3rd I.I.T. interrogated detainees and released them as innocent civilians.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, with two LVT's from Co"A" attached, departed CP enroute to Mai Xa Thi.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed two red blinking lights (UFO's) on azimuth of 0300 mils, one going west and one going east at a distance of 12,000 meters.

21 July 1968

Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 5 to 8 NVA/VC, vicinity of YD 298720. Contact was lost before action could be initated.

Co"A" patrol, at YD 311713, reported people moving out of An Trung Village (YD 317707). Interrogation of VN female revealed that there were VC in the village.

Co "B", reaction platoon, completed the sweep of An Trung Village (YD 317707) with negative results. Seven persons were detained.

Damaged Tank, from BLT 2/4, departed for Dong Ha.

Otter (M-76), on resupply run to C-4 position, detonated, what is believed to have been, two T-41 AT mines, stacked one on top of the other, at YD 325720. Results were 4 friendly WIA's and total loss of the Otter (M-76).

Co<sup>BB</sup> patrol, YD 338708, received small arms fire from three persons at YD 329712.

Squad from Co<sup>M</sup>A", with two LVT's, on recovery operation (YD 325720), observed two personnel moving away from the position were the Otter was mined earlier. Attemped to apprehend the two persons by firing M-16 over their heads. The two persons went into tree line and disappeared.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports hauling 135 troops and 7 tons of cargo in the past three days.









Target Acquisition personnel, at Camp Kistler, observed 5 UFO's at 0405 mils, approximate range 25,000 meters and 1 UFO at 0288 mils, range 20,000 meters.

Tower, at Camp Kistler, observed 1 UFO at 0065 mils, approximate distance 21,000 meters.

Elements of Co A, at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed three UFO's at 0500 mils, moving east to west, approximate range 9,000 meters.

Tower, at Camp Kistler, observed 5 UFO's at 0235 mils, approximate range 18,000 meters, moving back and forth between the mouth of the Ben Hai River and Tiger Island. Sighting was made with BC scope.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed 2 UFO's moving east to west at 0200 mils and 1 UFO at 6400 mils moving east.

22 July 1968

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed UFO's marked by white light, moving east to west at 5940 mils, north of the Ben Hai River.

Co"A" NGF Spot Team, at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed lights on one UFO at YD 227771. Fired NGF at UFO, which at that time lifted off and flew in a northwest direction. Upon ceasing fire, two UFO's returned to impact area, unable to observe because of lights being turned off. Impact area was NGF replot but unable to fire because cease fire in effect.

Co<sup>n</sup>A<sup>n</sup> patrol conducting sweep of YD 3172, YD 3073, YD 2974 and YD 3072, found unidentified US ordinance simular to AP mine. Patrol also destroyed concrete structure at YD 307728.

Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), reported ARVN, at A-1 position, had contact with estimated NVA Battalion. Ten NVA KIA's and eight weapons captured at present.

lst Marines reports that H/2/1 is in contact at YD 360624. H&S Co patrol notified.









1st Marines has directed that no units operate below the 65 grid line, until activity in contract that area stabilizes.

Co"A", at C-4 position, visually sighted two UFO's proceeding west to east at an elevation of 2500 feet.

Co"A", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected five NVA/VC at YD 314703. Co"B" patrol, at YD 322703, observed five NVA/VC at the same position. Fired 81mm mortar mission with unknown results. Co"B" will check area as soon as practical.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed one UFO moving east to west.

Co "A", at C-4 position, observed one UFO, flying west to east, decend at 5880 mils, distance 12,000 meters.

23 July 1968

Squad patrol from ComBm searched area of NVA sighting and 81mm mortar mission. Found foot prints moving northwest.

LVTE-1 (H-23) and two LVTP-5's from H&S CO, crossed Cua Viet River and commenced mine clearing operation of the route to C-4.

Camp Kistler received 15 rounds of light to medium artillery from 5643 mils, distance 17,000 meters.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 3 NVA on the beach at YD 275784. Called NGF mission. NVA fled into bunker. The bunker was destroyed, (3 confirmed credited to USS St Paul)

Battle Survey of Oceanview, C-4, C-4 tower and Camp Kistler tower completed. Coordinates of Oceanview is YD 2911375093, elevation 5 meters.

Vietnamese female, approximately 30 years of age, was apprehended in the battalion dump area with MPC and Marijuana Cigarettes in her posession. She was forwarded to Dong Ha as a civil defendant.







LVTE-1 and two LVTP-5's completed the sweep of the beach between Camp Kistler and C-1.
No mines were uncovered.





Camp Kistler received one round of light artillery from unknown location.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, transported F/2/1 to Nhi Ha and H/2/1 to Camp Big John.

Camp Kistler tower reports two secondary explosions from TPQ at YD 231845.

Flements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed one UFO at 5890 mils, approximately 13,000 meters.

Coastal Group 11 reports PF Unit is in contact with NVA/VC at YD 328657.

Elements of Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed three UFO's at 6300 mils, unknown range, moving west to east between the mouth of the Ben Hai River and Tiger Island.

Coastal Group 11 reports contact between PF and VC at Pho Hoi Village. Estimated size of VC Unit, one squad to one platoon.

Elements of Co A, at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed visually and with NOD, flashing red light on azimuth of 1600 mils, moving north to south, also heard engine noise of prop driven craft.

24 July 1968

BLT 2/4 Amtracs landed at this position with 7 LVTP-5 and 1 LVTP-5 (CMD).

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports hauling 10 troops and 2 tons of supplies to Nhi Ha to F/2/1.

Coastal Group 11 reports contact between PF and unknown size VC force at YD 328651. Exchanged SAF and VC withdrew to the west.

Elements of Co"A", at C-L, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 6 NVA/VC, at YD 303707. Fired 12 rounds of 81mm mortar to force them toward a friendly patrol. NVA/VC disappeared and the patrol had no contact.







25 July 1968

Elements of Co"A", at YD 335710, discovered one T-41 mine in surf. Disarmed and forwarded the Commine to Battalion S-2.



From 250800H to 251110H, Battalion S-5 and medical personnel conducted MedCAP of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village and treated 50 VN patients.

Camp Kistler received 20 rounds of medium artillery from approximate grids YD 242812 and YD 232812. Fired 63 rounds NGF conterbattery with 6 secondary explosions resulting.

Co"A", at Oceanview (YD 293754), reports multiple UFO sightings. UFO's moving east to west between 6300 mils and 0200 mils.

Coastal Group 11, NRVN, reports PF's at YD 336689, took approximately 24 VC, at YD 328651, under fire with SAF. VC broke contact and withdrew.

26 July 1968

Camp Kistler Tower, reports artillery impacting on north bank of the river. Battalion CAP on north bank reports rounds landing 500 meters north of their perimeter (YD 337703).

USS Dubuque to arrive in area for embark-debark training between 4 & 10 August. Liaison visit will be made 311200HJu168.

Coastal Group 11, NRVN, completed sweep from YD 333656 to YD 340650. Detained 3 VN males 30 years of age.

Co"A" (-) relieved Co"A" (-) at base area C-4.
Co"A" (-) returned to Camp Kistler.

Co<sup>u</sup>B<sup>u</sup> fired routine 4.2 mission on YD 272759, resulting in one secondary explosion.

Received agent report from Coastal Group 11, MRVN, stating that a VC Platoon moved into Le Kugren(YD 338645), mission unknown.


Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed 10 NVA/VC, at YD 295710. Fired 28 rounds 4.2 mortar with unknown results.







Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), using NOD, observed 35 UFO's, moving east and west, between 4800 mils and 6400 mils, north of the Ben Hai River.

PF land patrol, at YD 315657, fired on what they believed to be enemy movement and seriously wounded 2 friendly PF's. The injured were medevaced from this position.

Co"A" patrol/ambush, at YD 316690, triggered ambush on 7 to 12 NVA/VC, by firing Claymore, M-79 and SAF. Negative results at this time, will search area at first light.

27 July 1968

PF patrol, with Marine advisors, in Xuan Khanh (YD 325698), picked up 5 people who had apparently been to VC propaganda meeting. Personnel were forwarded to 15th C.I.T., at Camp Kistler, for interrogation.

Emergency medevac of two PF (reported 262200H) was completed.

Co "A" patrol, enroute from might position, searched house at YD 318690. Results were, one NVA uniform, mess gear and equipment. The occupant of the house was detained and turned over to 15th C.I.T., at Camp Kistler, for interrogation.


Co"A" patrol, swept area of earlier contact (262200H), at YD 316693, found foot prints, blood and one fragmentation type grenade.

Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) reported that PF's, while on sweep of Ha Tay Mot (Tuang Van Thuong) at YD 362667, came into contact with estimated platoon of VC. PF's indicated one VC KIA, unconfirmed. AO dispatched.

Alerted Co"A" reaction platoon to respond to PF action.

Seven VN, wounded from VC action at 270955H, arrived at Camp Kistler for treatment.

Alerted 1st Marines reaction plateon to respond to PF action.









Co"A" reaction platoon's departed Camp Kistler via LVT's, for Ha Tay Mot (Tuang Van Thoung), YD 362667. One platoon moved south of hamlet to block for PF sweep of village. Second platoon remained north of the village to resweep and check bunkers. AO on station reports no VC movement out of the village and two houses burning. Two interpretors from 11th Coastal Group, with five men and two advisors accompanied PF Units.

Six of the Seven VN brought to Camp Kistler BAS (270955H) were medevaced, including the Hamlet Chief of Ha Tay Mot and his young son. A second son died as a result of gun shot wounds.

Co"A" reaction platoon completed search of Ha Tay Mot (Tuang Van Thuong) YD 362667, with negative findings. Placed 24 CS grenades in suspected VC hiding places, with negative results. Reaction units returned to CP.

Two of six civilians detained at 270005H and 270730H, were released as innocent civilians, after questioning by 15th C.I.T.. Four were forwarded to Dong Ha, 3 as VC suspects and 1 as NVA suspect.

One VN female medevaced for wounds resulting from VC action at YD 362667, 270955H.

Marine advisors with PF's at North Side Security Point reported receiving an intelligence report from the PF's. Report will be forwarded to Camp Kistler ASAP.

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, observed 10 to 15 NVA at YD 294720. Expended 14 rounds of 81mm mortar, with good target coverage. Tanks at C-4, observed 1 NVA, disappeared as a result of 81mm mission.

First Marines (rear) informed AmTrac watch officer that 1st Marines (forward) notified them of change in AO, effective 280600H to 281800H. Change moved bottem boundry from YD 3464 to 3664.

28 July 1968

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 29375h), observed 9 NVA on the beach (YD 281769). Tanks

fired 5 rounds direct fire, NVA moved into tree line. Artillery and NGF mission called, resulting in two secondary explosions.

LATIVISCE

Elements of ComBm, at C-li position, using PPS-5 Radar, sighted 10 NVA at YD 302711, moving south. Fire mission not called as observation was lost. Informed ComAm ambush at YD 314702.

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, had visual sighting of one NVA, at YD 314727, moving south. Fire mission: 13 60mm illumination, 5 60mm WP and SAF. Results unknown.

Co"A" patrol, at YD 314702, observed two NVA to their west.

Elements of Co<sup>n</sup>B<sup>n</sup>, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, sighted one NVA at YD 298728. Radio wave emission also detected from same location. Fired 10 rounds of 90mm beehive with excellent target coverage. Will check at first light.

29 July 1968

LVTE-1 (H-23) and two LVTP-5's from Co"A", commenced mine clearing operation from Cua Viet River to C-4 position.

PF patrol, at YD 336651, discovered 3 VC in a bunker. Killed 2 VC, 1 VC escaped. Captured 2 AK-47 assult rifles.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 2 NVA on the beach at YD 273772. Fired 105mm artillery mission with good coverage, results unknown.

Co"B", 1st AmTracs is OpCon to 2/9.

H&S Co patrol, at YD 337657, sent 5 men to recon their night position (YD 340657). Recon element flushed 5 NVA/VC with AK-47's and 1 RPG. Took enemy under fire. NVA/VC fled south.


Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed flashes and heared mortar tube at







YD 266749. Called artillery and NGF mission with unknown results.





30 July 1968

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 25 NVA (YD 293707) moving east. Called artillery mission with unknown results. Informed 2/9 who are in the area to the south of the sighting.

CoNB", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, detected 4 groups of 7 NVA, at YD 291697 and YD 295691. Fired 19 rounds 105mm Firecracker with unknown results. Units to west observed NVA and continued fire mission.

Camp Kistler took salvo of unknown number and size rockets. Called counterbattery on Ha Loi Trung (YD 283763). C-4 took 20 rounds, negative casualties or damage.

Battalion Liaison NCO reports F/2/9 killed 2 NVA and captured 2 AK-47 rifles on west side of Gio Hai Village (YD 319692).


Elements of Co'B', received one round of sniper fire from pagoda (YD 279751). Fired NGF and artillery on pagoda with unknown results.

From 300750H to 300920H Camp Kistler received 33 rounds light to medium artillery from approximate grid YD 245825. Called counterbattery from 12th Marines and NGF. Artillery attack resulted in 4 friendly WIA and damage to 1 LVTP-5 and one tropical but destroyed.

Elements of Co<sup>u</sup>B<sup>u</sup>, at Oceanview (YD 293754), received one round of sniper fire from unknown location. Fired 60mm mortar mission at previous sniper position (YD 279759).

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 2 NVA with packs and rifles at YD 289752. Fired 60mm mission and NGF with good target coverage.

H&S Co patrol, YD 364662, observed with starlight scope 3 NVA/VC at YD 363662. Took NVA/VC under fire with M-16, M-79 and MG fire, called illumination and checked area and found drag marks.



31 July 1968

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 3 NVA at YD 284761. NGF mission called, NVA seemed to move into bunkers. 23 rounds expended. 10 minutes later, elements of 1st Platoon, Co"B" sighted 1 NVA approximately 1000 meters northwest of Oceanview. Took NVA under fire with 60mm mortar (10 rounds) and sniper (10 rounds).

H&S Co patrol, sweeping area of earlier contact found drag marks and blood at YD 363662, the trail ending at YD 362666.

1st AmTrac Battalion, resumed OpCon of Co"B" (-) from 2/9, who departed AO.

LVT (A-31), operating with H&S Co LVT's in support of 2/1 was damaged by a mine at YD 257694. Damage was limited, consisting of one road wheel and track. LVT (A-31) presently being repaired.

Co B patrol, while investigating probable enemy locations to northwest, located rocket sites not visible from Oceanview. The site: (YD 289756), built to accomidate 41 to 43 rockets, was oriented toward Camp Kistler. Mound of sand and bamboo, used to aim rockets. Also located two new and recently occupied bunkers at YD 290756. Bunkers were constructed to be out of sight of Oceanview. Bunkers were destroyed. Also found one fighting position/OP at YD 287754, hole freshly dug and resently occupied. IN ADDITION - Sighted numerous bunkers to the north, too far from Oceanview to recon with small patrol. Entire area littered with duds. In future Co"B" plans to move one platoon to Oceanview to work to the northwest during the day leaving one platoon to man Oceanview. Also plot of artillery H&I's in the area will be changed.

1st AmTrac Battalion assumed OpCon of Co"G", 2nd Battalion, 26 Marine Regiment, inserting unit to the north of Gio Hai Resettlement Village.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), observed 9 NVA at YD 266794. Fired mission with Tanks, expended 25 rounds. Coastal

Group 12 came on station and fired 50 cal MG and 15 rounds of 81mm mortar. Results unknown.

Co"A" patrol, at YD 362668, observed 2 VN males running from their position. Individuals would not stop, took VN under fire with small arms. The 2 VN ran into village causing the patrol to cease fire.

LVT (A-31), which was damaged by a mine, as reported 311010H, was towed to Mai Xa Thi (2/1 CP). Damage repaired, vehicle operational.

Co"A" patrol south detained 1 VN male with no I.D. card, at YD 289656, (Vinh Hoa Phong). H&S Co reaction platoon, LVT mounted, was dispatched to bring detained to Camp Kistler.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 293754), sighted 2 NVA at YD 289757. Tanks executed fire mission, expending 2 rounds of 90mm beehive. Coastal Group 12 boats surveyed target area with negative sightings. Area will be searched at first light.

H&S Co, reaction platoon, returned to Camp Kistler, with detainee. Third I.T.T. interrogated the individual clearing him as an innocent civilian. Lack of identification is accredited to the man being insane. The VN government does not issue I.D. cards in these cases. The man will be detained overnight at Camp Kistler and sent to Dong Ha, by 15th C.I.T., in order to possibly obtain I.D. or disposition on the man.

Elements of Co<sup>N</sup>B<sup>N</sup>, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 Radar, sighted 2 company sized units assembling at YD 28187216. Artillery and NGF missions were called; A/1/11 expended 20 rounds in an unobserved mission; NGF presently firing in order to saturate the area. Efforts were made to inform the ARVN Unit on Hill 31 (A-1).




