

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. The amount of incoming artillery received this month was 75 rounds, the lowest amount for six previous months. The heaviest concentration was 20 rounds received on 26 August. Casualties within the battalion consisted of 1 KIA and 2 WIA. Material damage consisted of the loss of 2 POL bulk fuel bladders.
- 2. The 1st AmTrac Battalion and the Napoleon/Saline II AO were under the operational control of the 1st Marine Regiment until 181200H August. On 18 August, Special Landing Force Alpha conducted an Amphibious Operation and encompassed the Napoleon/Saline II AO, within the Amphibious Objective Area. They assumed operational control of the AO and this battalion from 181200H August until 212100H August. Operational control of this battalion and the Napoleon/Saline II AO returned to the 1st Marine Regiment until 261200H August. The 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), United States Army assumed operational control of the AO and the 1st AmTrac Battalion on 261200H August and continued throughout the remainder of the month.
- 3. Company "B", 1st AmTrac Battalion has continued to man Base Area G-1 and the platoon outpost at Oceanview (YD291751) throughout the month. During it's operations for the month the unit conducted a total of 66 fire missions and 1 fixed wing air strikes on bunker complexes and enemy personnel sighted. The unit had 53, visual and PPS-5 radar, enemy sightings, totaling 461 personnel. Sniper activity was encountered at Oceanview throughout the month. Bunker complexes and enemy observation towers were sighted on numerous occasions and were badly damaged or destroyed by artillery, naval gun fire and fixed wing air strikes. Numerous secondary explosions were reported as a result of these missions. Company "B" suffered the loss of 1 KIA and confirmed a total of 15 enemy killed during the month.
- Le During the month LVT and Tank support was provided for the 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment until 26 August. During their operations for the month the LVT's were used for resupply, artillery prime movers, medevac vehicles and to conduct mechanized patrols. Incidental LVT responsibilities consisted of support of units at Base Area C-h, support and assistance of the US Navy Dredge clearing the channel in the Cua Viet River and pulling several naval craft up on the beach for inspection and repair. LVTE-1, with line charge, was used to destroy a bunker complex and clear a tree line near Oceanview outpost and to clear portions of the beach route between the Cua Viet River and Base Area C-4. Additionally, LVT's were used in a diversionary tactic in support of the 2nd








ARVN Regiment, during Lam Son #250, when the ARVN swept into the DMZ with a mechanized force. LVTE-1, H-2h, which was submerged on 181825H September 1967, after being submerged for 11 months, was recovered on 161705H August 1968. Two line charges recovered from the vehicle exibited little deterioration when tried in a mine clearance role north of the Cua Viet River. The LVTE-1 will be shipped to ConUS for rebuilding.


- 5. Numerous combat patrols and operations were conducted during the month. H&S Company and Company "A" conducted a total of 50 day and night patrols and ambushes in the southern AO, Company "B" conducted as total of 62 day and night patrols and ambushes in the area north of Base Area C-4. Company "A" conducted a total of 5 night ambushes in the area of Camp Big John (YD 280666) after the withdrawal of 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment. The provisional company operating in the Resettlement Village with the Popular Forces has been successful in cutting down NVA/VC activity to insignificant amounts. This unit is presently operating with 42 Marines and approximately 60 Popular Forces troops. On 2 August the Battalion CAP Unit conducted a sweep of An Trung (YD 316708). On 9, 10 and 13 August Special Landing Force Alpha (2nd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment) conducted training operations in the southern AO. On 19 August demolitions were used to destroy building foundations, in Ha Loi Trung (YD 323716) in an attempt to uncover hidden bunkers and tunnels. On 28 August demolitions and class 3 105mm HE ammunition was used to destroy 15 bunkers, in My Loc (YD 308681), that could possibly be used as positions for firing on river traffic.
- 6. On l August, Col Dwyer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment visited Camp Kistler and was briefed on the utilization of Company "G", 2nd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment. On 11 August, Col Dywer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment and Col Lauffer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment (designated) with Col Glikes, CO, 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), U.S.A. visited Camp Kistler and were briefed on the current situation in the Napoleon/Saline II AO. On 28 August MajGen Davis, CG, 3rd Marine Division, LtGen Stillwell, CG, 2hth Corps and Vice Admiral Bringle, Commander 7th Fleet visited Cua Viet Port Facility and were briefed on the new POL bulk fuel area. On 29 August MajGen Olson, CG, Force Logistics Command visited Camp Kistler and surveyed the new POL bulk fuel tank farm area, south of the battalion perimeter.
- 7. Tracked vehicle mining incidents continue to be a problem. On 9 August an LVTE-1 was severely damaged be an anti-tank mine, near Oceanview, resulting in one WIA. On 12 August an M-76 Otter detonated an anti-tank mine, on the beach route between Base Area C-1 and the Cua Viet River, resulting in three KIA, two WIA and total loss of the Otter (M-76). Efforts are continuing to clear the beach route between C-1 and the Cua Viet River.







- 8. On 26 August the 1st AmTrac Battalion assumed operational control of Company "C", 3rd Tank Battalion. Company "C" occupies Camp Big John with the mission of conducting operations to maintain security of the Cua Viet River. On 31 August, Company "B", 1st of the 11th Infantry, U.S.A. was OpCon to 1st AmTrac Battalion for Operation Nhi Ha. On that date the Nhi Ha company outpost was completely leveled using supporting arms, bull dozers and demolitions. All wire was torn up and buried in bomb craters and covered with dirt by dozers.
- 9. Numerous sightings of UFO's were reported during the month. The majority of the sightings were in the vicinity of the mouth of the Ben Hai River and towards Tiger Island. The sightings were reported from Oceanview tower, C-4 tower and patrol craft at sea. On two occasions the sightings were confirmed by radar and in other instances by Gio Linh and A-1.





LIST OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 August 1968



Col Dwyer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment, visited 1st AmTracs for briefing on utilization of G/2/26.

1st Platoon, Co"B", moving from Oceanview (YD 291751) to YD 288756, came upon 10-15 NVA, at YD 288758. Took enemy under fire with SAF and 90mm gun (Tanks), killing 6 NVA. Tanks and 1st Platoon of Co"B", withdrew to Oceanview and called in NGF mission, with an AO adjusting. 1st Platoon, Co"B", suffered 1 KIA. Bunkers in this area were blown on 31 July 68 and were rebuilt overnight.

From Oll500H to Oll700H, 1st Platoon of Combm, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 15 to 25 NVA moving between bunkers at YD 287767. Fired two NGF and artillery missions on bunkers with negative results. Requested fixed wing on the bunkers. Tanks fired beehive resulting in 4 NVA KIA (C).

Post #30, observed 9 persons moving west to east, toward the shore line, south of the battalion perimeter. Post #131 reports 2 boats heading north to south offshore of the battalion perimeter. Alerted 1st Marines reaction platoon.

Post #130 observed 4 to 5 Junk type craft 1,000 meters east of this position. Investigation by Coastal Group 12 reveals that these craft belong to Coastal Group 11.

Post #30 observed 7 to 9 people moving south toward Ha Tay Mot. Notified patrols in that area. 1st Marines reactionary notified to stand down.

2 August 1968

Marine/PF Unit, sweeping An Trung Village (YD 316708), detained three VN males, who were later released as immocent civilians.

From 020745H to 020935H, 2nd Platoon of Co"B", ran fixed wing strikes and NGF mission on bunker complex (YD 287760 to YD 282769). AO reports 10-15 bunkers, 50 to 100 meters apart. Results, one bunker destroyed and four NVA KIA.









Received message from Coastal Group 11, warning of the possibility of Tidal Wave, resulting from an earth quake in the Philipine Islands.

2nd Platoon, Co^{NBN}, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 3 NVA (YD 288757), moving into bunkers. Fired 20 rounds HE (fuze delay) from Tanks, at bunkers.

Submitted serious incident report to 1st Marines, concerning a 13 year old girl, who was wounded by a short 60mm mortar round, in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, at 012000H Aug 68.

AO observed a bunker complex, with a trench running east to west, at YD 288757. AO fired NGF mission, destroying one bunker.

Elements of ComBn, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed eight NVA and three boats at YD 277779. Fired four rounds of 90mm HE with negative results.

ICPL ION E. FORREN, a member of H&S Co patrol, had an accidental discharge, resulting in wound of right hand. Dispatched reaction and two LVT's to return him to CP.


3 August 1968

Combon reports one round of artillery impacting within 100 meters of their lines. Investigation reveals that the round was fired by 3rd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Co. Called check fire in 2875 grid.

Returned OpCon of G/2/26 to 2/26.

2nd Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed a bunker complex at YD 284765. Fired NGF mission and destroyed 2 bunkers.

Elements of Co^{UBU}, on patrol, found a stack of bricks 12 inches long and 4 inches wide at YD 310730. Found 2 possible mortar position YD 296736, with aiming stakes aimed at Hill 23, Hill 31 and C-4 position. All were destroyed by explosives. Two used radio batteries (other than US) were found also.





Camp Kistler received four rounds of medium artillery from YD 2h4835. Negative casualties or damage.

Camp Kistler tower observed boats and personnel, along the beach, at YD 25258530. Called artillery mission with good target coverage.

Camp Kistler received eleven rounds of light to medium artillery from YD 243825. Fired counter-battery with unknown results.

2nd Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 3 secondary explosions from counter-battery on YD 243825.

CoMBM, at C-4 position, using NOD, observed 5 NVA at YD 300705. Fired 81mm mission with good target coverage, results unknown.

Co "A" reported a Marine was injured as a result of an accidental detonation of M-26 fuze.

The man was medevaced.

2nd Platoon, ComBm, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed two secondary explosions resulting from NGF at YD 282762.

Battalion CAP Unit, on patrol, at YD 321706, observed 3 NVA/VC moving toward the resettlement village.


M-26 grenade exploded in the battalion area from unknown cause.

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 5 NVA/VC at YD 305705. Fired 81mm mission with unknown results.

Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 3 NVA/VC moving north at YD 285720. Fired 6 rounds of 81mm HE and 2 rounds of WP.

1st Marines FSCC informed Battalion S-3 that an area from YD 3465, south along the 34 grid line and east along the 65 grid line to the sea, is temporarily included in the 1st AHVN AO.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports 8 LVT's operational

and that they carried 2 tons resupply to F/2/1.

BAS treated 2 VN children and returned them to their homes in the resettlement village.

6 August 1968

From 052205H to 052330H, posts on battalion perimeter reported 13 small explosions. Il were to the east of the perimeter and 2 were between posts #33 and #34. Inquired information from units in the area with negative results.

Camp Kistler received 3 rounds of medium artillery from unknown location.

Camp Kistler received 2 rounds of medium artillery from unknown location.

AO ran fixed wing strikes on bunker complex at YD 289759, destroying two bunkers.

Recovered 152mm dud artillery round. Will forward through channels for analysis.

VN woman medevaced from this position.

2nd Platoon, Co"A", 3rd Tanks, reports 2 Tanks operational and employed by 2/1.


1st Marines returned control of the AO, south of the 65 grid line, to this battalion.

Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) went into resettlement village to investigate the beating of an ARVN on leave. The PF, Platcon Leader, was detained with one PF and two weapons were also confiscated.

2nd Platoon, Co "B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed visually 50 NVA/VC in YD 2675 grid. Fired NGF, 90mm and machine gun with unknown results.

COMBN reports 50 NVA/VC currently pinned down by NGF/artillery at YD 278750.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 10 NVA/VC moving southeast at YD 308708.





PF/Marine patrol, at YD 328700, made contact with 6 NVA/VC. NVA/VC fled to the southwest, 2 were possibly wounded.

Co"B", squad ambush, at YD 310712, initiated ambush on approximately 13 NVA/VC. NVA/VC moved northwest and were taken under fire with 81mm mortar from C-4.

Co^{NBN}, squad patrol, using Starlight Scope, observed 10 NVA/VC, at YD 291715. Called Firecracked mission and 81mm mortar mission. Enemy broke into four groups, last seen at YD 297717.

From 062115H to 062250H, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 40 to 50 NVA/VC at YD 2675 (HILL 23, north), in staggered formation. Called fire on all movement. Fired 13 rounds of 90mm, 49 rounds of 105mm Firecracker and 24 rounds of NGF. Requested AO to check the area at first light. AO searched area of previous nights sighting and Firecracker mission. Found numerous foot prints and bunker complex from YD 263740 to YD 289758. Ran fixed wing on the bunkers, destroying one bunker and damaging one.

2nd Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 20 NVA/VC at YD 280750. Called 105 mm Firecracker mission.


7 August 1968

2nd Platoon of Co B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 3 NVA at YD 262750. Fired 90mm and 50 cal MG with unknown results.

Elements of Co"B", searched the area of contact the previous night (YD 310705). Found 1 NVA KIA and 1 AK-47.

4th Platoon of CoMBM relieved 2nd Platoon of CoMBM, at Oceanview.

4th Platoon of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 4 swimmers on the beach. Contacted Coastal Group 12, who reported the swimmers were a UDT/USN beach reconnaissance element. Group later identified as being from USS Point Defence.





8 August 1968



9 August 1968

Squad patrol from CoMBM, discovered a tunnel, at YD 318713. The tunnel was 6 feet in length, with shored sides and bamboo air vents. The tunnel was destroyed by demolitions.

Co"A" patrol detained one VN male, 16 years of age, moving around their position after dark.

4th Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 4 UFO's between 6380 mils and 0610 mils from their position.

PF/Marine patrol, at YD 316689, observed, with Starlight Scope, 4 NVA/VC at YD 302698. NVA/VC disappeared to the north.

LVTE-1 (H-23) at YD r291755, fired a line charge to blow bunker complex and clear tree line. While backing out, H-23, detomated a T-11 AT mine, damaging 7, 8, & 9 roadwheel assemblies and torsion arms, damaged track and skirt and broke hydraulic lines. One friendly WIA.

Engineer Team, at Oceanview (YD 291751), found and destroyed a T-11 AT mine.

Capt Bond, 1/44 artillery, USA, arrived at Oceanview with two M-42 (sp) 40mmAA guns.

Tower, at C-4 position, observed 2 rotor type aircraft, similar to C-53 (US), on azimuth of 5800 mils to 6400 mils, approximately 10,000 meters, altitude 2,000 feet.

BLT 2/26 scheduled practice landing in southern AO, day and night acts, in this area, are cancelled for 9 and 10 August 1968.

Coastal Group 12 reports running down and destroying one VC sampan, at YD 420627.

Co"B", squad ambush, at YD 310709, observed 4 NVA/VC at YD 305702. Fired 16 rounds of 105mm artillery with unknown results.

10 August 1968

Battalion S-5 departed CP for MedCAP of Pho Hoi Village.

ComBu, squad patrol, detained VC suspect (VN







male) YD 317708. The VCS was forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation.

4th Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), called 105mm mission on bunker complex at YD 28407618. Destroyed two bunkers and observed one secondary explosion.

H&S Co, LVT platoon, reports two LVT's with 35 troops made a mechanized patrol of Dai Do and two vehicles transported 15 troops and 1 ton of supplies to E/2/1, in Nhi Ha.

Sting Ray 38 (USN_RPB) fired small arms into a group of VN civilians at YD 319691, wounding two VN. One male medevaced to Quang Tri and one female treated and released. Investigation will be conducted by USN.

11 August 1968

4th Platoon, CouBu, at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD and Starlight Scope, observed 15 NVA/VC at YD 283760. Fired NGF, 40mm and 90mm with unknown results.


hth Platoon, Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751) fired 8 rounds of CS and 7 rounds of WP, in area of sighting at 1102h0H Aug 68, with negative results.

Col Dwyer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment and Col Lauffer, CO, 1st Marine Regiment (designated) with Col Glikes, CO, 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), USA, visited Camp Kistler and were briefed by Battalion S-3.

4th Platoon, CouBn, at Oceanview (YD 291751), fired NGF mission on bunker complex at YD 285762.

Coastal Group 12 observed abuilding, 25 X 15, with cultivated fields, at YD 273771. Fired 81mm and called 105mm mission. Building was damaged.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports two LVT's with 35 troops, ran a mechanized patrol in the Dai Do area. Moved demolitions team, 15 personnel and one ton of supplies to E/2/1 in Nhi Ha.

12 August 1968

Co "B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 10 to 15 NVA at YD 285717 and tracked them to YD 275725. Called fire mission.

4th Platoon of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 8 NVA at YD 269748 and YD 275735. Fired 50 cal MG, 40mm dusters and 90mm, with unknown results.

ComBu, at C-4 position, using FPS-5 radar, detected 5 NVA/VC moving from YD 324709 to YD 320714 and back.

Elements of Co^uB", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed one NVA at YD 281759. Fired 50 cal NG, 40mm and called 105mm artillery mission with unknown results.

CoⁿBⁿ, squad patrol, at ^{YD} 313716, detained VN male, who is the father of VC suspect, picked up 10 Aug 68, by elements of CoⁿBⁿ.

M-76 Otter, while enroute from C-4 to Camp Kistler, detonated AT mine at YD 332712. Vehicle was in the edge of water when it struck the mine. Results of the incident were 1 friendly KIA, 2 WIA and 2 MIA (presumed dead). The Otter was a total loss. Complete search of surf and ocean area adjacent to mining scene was conducted with the assistance of Coastal Group 12 (USCG), for MIA with negative results.

13 August 1968

S-3, 11th Engineer Battalion, informed the Battalion S-3 that troops and materials would be helo-lifted to C-4 on 15 August to commence construction of tower.

Sweep of Ha Ioc Hamle t was completed. Sweep netted one detainee, who was later questioned and released as an innocent civilian.

Co^{NBN} patrol found one MIA at YD 324719. One MIA remains missing from mining incident which occured 121545 Aug 68.

lst Marines Watch Officer, informed S-3 that BLT 2/26 would conduct training in the southern AO area bounded by YD 365675, YD 333655, YD 340640 and YD 385659.



PF/Marine elements detained one VN male at YD 325706. VN male was questioned by C.I.T. and released as an innocent civilian.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), received sniper fire from YD 284758. Called 105mm artillery mission and sniper fire ceased.

LVT Platoon, H&S Co, reports 2 LVT's with 40 troops conducted a mechanized patrol of Dai Do, 2 LVT's with 40 troops conducted a mechanized patrol of Mai Xa Thi and 2 LVT's carried 15 troops and 1 ton of supplies to Nhi Ha, this date.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed, with NOD, 2 groups of 6 to 8 NVA at YD 269748. Fired 40mm and 90mm beehive with good target coverage, results unknown.

14 August 1968

Elements of Co^{NBN}, at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 4 NVA/VC, at YD 269748. Fired 90mm beehive and 40mm with good coverage.

Battalion CAP Unit found the remaining MIA, from the mining incident 121545H at YD 340700.

CO, CoWBW, reports unusually heavy traffic of people moving from Resettlement Village (YD 320695) to Hill 23 (YD 280719).


From 140800H to 141115H, Battalion S-5 and medical personnel conducted a Med CAP, in Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village, treating 65 persons and medevacing 2.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), called 105mm mission on suspected enemy storage area (rockets), at YD 283755.

Elements of ComB", at Oceanview (YD 291751), fired 105mm mission on suspected enemy storage area. Observed 1 secondary explosion and 1 bunker burning.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), fired 105mm mission on suspected enemy storarea (YD 282762). Observed 1 secondary.





CoMBM, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, observed 5 NVA/VC at YD 306711, moving south toward a CoMBM squad ambush. Notified the ambush of the presents of the enemy but no contact was made.

Elements of CottB", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 6 UFO's at YD 315755. The sighting was confirmed by Coastal Group 12 craft (Enfield Cobra "A").

Elements of CoⁿBⁿ, at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 13 UFO's moving from the Ben Hai River to Tiger Island.

Co^{MBM}, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 2 NVA/VC at YD 313729. Fired 81mm mission with unknown results.

Co^{WBW}, at C-4 position, using NOD, observed 3 NVA/VC at YD 306705, moving south. Enemy disappeared before action could be taken.

15 August 1968

ComBm, at C-4 position, observed 2 NVA/VC at YD 265755. Enemy disappeared to the north before action could be taken.

Elements of Co^NA^N, with 15 LVT's and 2 Tanks, proceeded from C-4 to YD v284750. Vehicles operating as a deversion for 2nd ARVN mechanized thrust into the DMZ. (Lam Som #250). Arrived at turning point at 150715H and returned to Co^NA^N LVT park at 150830H.

From 151300H to 151620H Engineer Sweep Team, conducted a sweep of the beach route between the Cua Viet River and the C-4 position, with negative results.

CoⁿAⁿ, at C-h position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 10-15 NVA/VC moving north at YD 294712. Called 105mm mission with unknown results.

16 August 1968

Elements of Co#B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), firing 40mm H&I's, observed two secondary explosions at YD 266753.

Co $^{\text{MA}}$ patrol south, observed two persons moving northwest at YD 367671. Notified $^{\text{VN}}$ Forces in the area.







Co"A" patrol south observed blinking light in the vicinity of YD 364674. NRVN Unit in that area will investigate.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), working with Coastal Group 12 Unit, at sea, coordinated fires on bunker complex at YD 281768.

Co"A" patrol south observed 4 persons at YD 368670, moving into tree line. Coastal Group 12 illuminated the area and starlight scope was also used with negative results.

Co^{NBN} patrol found two small buildings with one wall remaining on each. Destroyed the walls with demolition.

H&S Co elements used two line charges to clear 600 foot strip on the beach route between the Cua Viet River and C-4 position.

Coastal Group 12 reports a large group of people on the beach and one of them digging. Dispatched squad of PF/Marines who apprehended 20 VN's and checked ID's. Two were detained and forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation but were later released as innocent civilians.

LVTE-1 (H-2h), which was submerged in the mouth of the Cua Viet River on 181825H September 1967, was retrieved. Line charges aboard the vehicle showed no appreciable indication of deterioation and was later used in conjunction with a new line charge with no malfunction.

Elements of CoⁿBⁿ, at Oceanview (YD 291751), visually sighted 3 NVA/VC at YD 298747. Coastal Group 12 fired 8 rounds of illumination. CoⁿBⁿ fired 44 HE and 3 VP 60mm mortar rounds with unknown results.

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 8 NVA/VC at YD 285722. Fire mission was requested, received negative clearance.

17 August 1968

PF/Marine Unit detained one VN with suspicious ID. The individual was forwarded to Battalion









S-2 for questioning and was later released as an innocent civilian.

Mine clearance of beach route, vicinity of YD 334710, utilizing a line charge, resulted in 3 secondary explosions, possibly mines.

CouB" reports a bunker complex at YD 27727642. A/1/11 fired 8 rounds of WP and 24 rounds of HE with unknown results.

Co^{UBU}, using LVTH-6, on known NVA infiltration route, expended 2 rounds of WP and 18 rounds of Firecracker with unknown results.

18 August 1968

Squad patrol from Cotte found 2 T-41 AT mines at YD 301744 and YD 301743. The mines were destroyed in place by engineers and Cotte for the found 2 T-41 AT mines at YD 301744.

This command is OpCon to SIF BLT 2/26 until approximately 200600H. Sent liaison NCO.

19 August 1968

Battalion Commander and Battalion S-3 departed the CP, via 2 IVT's from Co"A", for Ha Loi Trung (YD 323716), to destroy, by demolitions, building foundations in an attempt to uncover any bunkers and tunnels in the area. Negative findings.

PF/Marine Unit, with the assistance of the village chief of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, detained four persons with questionable identification. The four individuals were later cleared by the village chief as students but two others were turned o over to NRVN Unit as draft dodgers.

NGF Spot Team, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 3 NVA on the beach. NGF mission called, NVA disappeared into tree line, results unknown.

The Battalion Commander departed the CP, via skimmer boat, enroute to Oceanview. The Battalion Commander observed, from the new Oceanview tower, new NVA observation towers to the north.





Camp Kistler received six rounds of medium artillery. All rounds landed in the Gulf of Tonkin. Counterbattery fired by NGF.

UNCLASSIFIED

H&S Co patrol reported movement at YD 334667. Fired three rounds of M-79; movement ceased, results unknown.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reports 10-20 NVA to the northwest. Coastal Group 12 fired illumination, fired 81mm, fired 114 rounds of 90mm beehive from Tanks, LVTH-6 fired 2 rounds WP and 12 rounds of Firecracker, also used 40mm duster and 50 cal MG. After the initial volley, all but 2 NVA disappeared; fire adjusted on the remaining two with good target coverage.

20 August 1968

BLT 2/26 notified the battalion that Thrust Points have been compromized. New Thrust Points in effect upon receipt.

NGF Spot Team, at Oceanview (YD 291751), called a mission on bunker complex at YD 279769, resulting in 3 bunkers destroyed and 2 damaged.

Camp Kistler tower reports 3 secondary explosions from NGF counterbattery, to the north of Oceanview (YD 291751).


Radio Frequency for Area Defense changed to 74.80.

ComB" reports Coastal Group 12 has sighting of UFO's near Cap Le, along the 90 grid line. No friendly aircraft in the area. UFO's being tracked by radar, moving from the mainland to Tiger Island.

21 August 1968

SLF BLT 2/26 commenced tactical withdrawal from NAPOLEON/SALINEII AO; to be relieved by 2/1.

Received message from CG, 3rd Mar Div (G-3) stating that 1st Marines would assume OpCon of NAPOLEON/SALINE II AO and 1st AmTrac Battalion at 212100H August 1968.





Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using PPS-5 radar, sighted 10 NVA/VC at YD 282742; informed ARVN Unit at A-1 position. Co"B", at C-4 position observed same group at YD 278728 and tracked them to YD 280720. NGF Spot Team called mission. Group was observed moving to YD 296703 and YD 300701, later mighted at YD 301693. Results of fire mission unknown.

CoMBM, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar and NOD, observed 1 group of 5 NVA/VC at YD 307710. Fired 81mm mortar and NGF mission; good target coverage, results unknown.

CoMBM, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 3 NVA/VC at YD 309731. Notified ambush in the area but no sighting was made.

Elements of Co B, at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD, observed 2 UFO's, moving south-south-west from YD 2590 vicinity and one moving west from Tiger Island vicinity. Reported sightings to 1st Marines, NGF. Naval ships at sea confirmed sightings with radar.

Fired NGF mission on area of previous sighting of NVA/VC at YD 314714. Results were 1 large secondary explosion, will check the area at first light.

22 August 1968

Co^NBⁿ platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 10 persons at YD 26875l; contact was lost in 5 minutes. Fired 10 rounds of NGF in the area of the sighting.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751) sighted 10 persons swimming at YD 253815. Fired 37 rounds of NGF. When mission had ended 2 persons were sighted swimming at YD 254834, fired 22 rounds of NGF. Results of both missions unknown.

ComBm patrol found a booby trap marker at YD 303713, a new grave, covered by a parachute, at YD 301712 (investigation reveals that the grave contained nothing) and observed a man, with a pack, running into Ha Loc (YD 323709).





ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar and NOD, observed 2 group of 2-3 persons using flash lights to rendezvous. Fired illumination and observed 2 persons. Fired 81mm mission with good target coverage, will check the area at first light.

23 August 1968

Received message from 1st Marines (forward) stating that there would be no replacement troops for 2/1 at Mai Xa Thi (YD 2766).

Received report from 2/26 stating there is a possible enemy mine field at YD 303688. The area will be checked by engineers.

Received message from 2/1 stating that many VN civilians had entered the Nhi Ha combat base(YD 267704), upon the withdrawal of the 2/1 element.

PF/Marine patrol, while moving near village at YD 328697, picked up a man who was reportedly from north of the DMZ. The patrol was instructed to move to the river, where a detail, sent from the CP, would pick up the detainee. While enroute to the rendezvous point, the patrol detained another man who attempted to run. Both detainees were forwarded to Battalion for interrogation.

River Patrol Boat reports an explosion on the river at YD309678. It is assumed that one of their craft (RPB) hit a mine. Boats also report people in the water. Two Otters and a squad of Marines were dispatched to the area to check the river bank. All personnel recovered; patrol boat with EOD personnel investigating the area.


PF/Marine Unit sent 2 Otters to their western CP (YD 314688) to pick up an injured Marine with a possible broken foot. Further details not known at this time.

24 August 1968

Navy reports all personnel, involved in the mining incident at 232400 Aug, are safe and aboard Otters enroute to the CP. Navy requests







Battalion S-2 forwarded the detainee picked up at 232120H Aug, to Dong Ha for futher interrogation. The other detainee was released as an innocent civilian.

ComBN platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), received 2 rounds of sniper fire from the vicinity of YD 281759. Fired homm and called 105mm artillery mission. Spotted 3 NVA/VC at YD 271773 and shifted fire to that area; good target coverage; results unknown.

Received an intellegence report from Coastal Group 11 stating: an NVA Regiment with 650 personnel and one platoon of rocket launchers with 35 personnel and 2 launchers for 122mm rockets, moved from YD 210765 to YD 245785 and YD 250765; mission unknown.

Combin platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed a man carrying field glasses at YD 290756. Fired 2 rounds of 90mm beehive; after second round, no further movement was observed.

Co"B", at C-4 position, observed a large explosion on Hill 23 (north) (YD 267756), cause unknown.

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 6 NVA/VC at YD 314707. Notified PF/Marine patrol in the area.

25 August 1968

Notified 1/11 that 3rd Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Tractor Company, was chopped to OpCon of 5th Battalion, 4th Artillery Group, U.S.A. as of 241500H August.

ComAm patrol detained a man that ran from their patrol. The man had no identification. Forwarded the detainee to 15th C.I.T. for interrogation.

Company "G", 2nd Battalion, 26th Marine Regiment, arrived in the AO, in the vicinity of





YD 295650. 1st AmTrac Battalion has tactical control of the unit.

2nd ARVN Regiment, at A-1 position, agreed to fire on YD 267704, to destroy built up area left by 2/1.

CoⁿBⁿ patrol found 1 RPG round with extra fuzes, one NVA helmet and aiming stakes, at YD 305679. Filled the fighting hole and returned to the CP with the remainder of the gear.

Co¹¹B¹¹, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected a group of 2-3 NVA/VC at YD 310714.

Ambush in the area could hear the group talking.
C-4 received small arms fire from the south.

Fired 81mm illumination and HE and 1 round of 90mm from Tanks.

26 August 1968

UNCLASSIFIE

C/6/33 had a premature detonation over Camp Kistler. No casualties or damage.

C/6/33, FDC, at Camp Kistler, reported a 3000 meter error caused by miscopy of an H&I grid. No casualties from the round.

Coastal Group 12, river patrol boats, report a skimmer boat has capsized at YD 305678. All personnel rescued; gear presently being recovered.

1st AmTrac Battalion became OpCon to 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), of the United States Army at 261200H August.

From 261735H to 261825H, Camp Kistler received 20 rounds of medium artillery from unknown location. Results were 1 KIA and 2 WIA. Unable to obtain sighting of the guns because of a heavy haze in the DMZ.

27 August 1968

Received message that a river patrol craft (ICPL) received 30-40 rounds of AVF from north bank of the river at YD 308688. PF/Marine Unit in the area notified.

Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) report a VN woman was wounded by a 60mm mortar fired from Camp Kistler. Night defensive fires were being fired, at consentration points, along the perimeter, at the time.



Vietnamese interpreter received a gun shot wound, from his own personal weapon, while removing his cartgidge belt. Wound was in the knee. Man was medevaced to Quang Tri; prognosis good.

Camp Kistler received 16 rounds of medium artillery from YD 222832 and YD 219820. All rounds impacted outside the battalion perimeter, to the southwest. Counterbattery was fired resulting in 2 secondary explosions.

F/2/26 patrol detained one Vietnamese male; age mid 20's, wearing khaki appearal and was intoxicated. Was forwarded to F/2/26 CP for futher disposition.

Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) reported that 4 civilians were killed and 5 were wounded during the artillery attack at 271830H.

CoMBM, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected a group of 10 NVA/VC, moving very rapidly, from YD 296708 to YD 299703. Contact was lost before action could be initiated.

From 272015H to 272300H, Co"B" platoon at Oceanview (YD 291751), had numerous sightings, with PPS-5 radar, of groups of NVA in the YD 275753 area. Fired 20 rounds of naval gun fire, 400 rounds from 40mm (M-42) dusters, 11 rounds of 90mm HE from Tanks and 200 rounds from 50 cal machine gun. Excellent coverage; no movement at this time; will check area at first light.

28 August 1968

Coastal Group 12 reports 2 sampans at YD 304678 and requested any information from the battalion. Notified Battalion CAP Unit patrol, in that area, who will investigate. Negative results.

ComCn, 3rd Tank Battalion (provisional rifle company), at Mai Xa Thi (YD 288666), report a contact with h NVA/VC at 272320H, resulting in one enemy KIA; the body is at YD 288670; will attempt to recover the body at first light. No friendly casualties were reported.





F/2/26 reports one detainee; will forward to Camp Kistler for interrogation by Battalion S-2.

Battalion Commander and the Battalion S-3 departed CP, via 2 H&S Co LVT's, enroute to for Myl Loc (YD 308681), where bunkers, that could possibly be used as positions of fire on the river, were destroyed by utilization of demolition and class three 105mm HE ammunition.

PF/Marine Unit, following the advise of the Village Chief of Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village, detained one Vietnamese civilian at YD 316708. The detainee was forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation and later released as an innocent civilian.

Coastal Group 12 reports 3-7 NVA/VC on the beach at YD 27607719. CoⁿBⁿ called artillery mission and observed one secondary explosion and the dispersal of the enemy personnel.

Co"D" platoon at Oceanview (YD 291751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 5-10 NVA/VC at YD 273752 and later at YD 279739. Fired 105mm, 40mm (M-42) and 90mm from Tanks at both grids with unknown results. Co"D" at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected the same group 20 minutes after the first sighting, additional fire was called.

ComBu at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, had multiple sightings of NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 299702. Contacted C/6/33, FDC, for fire mission. No fire mission granted at this time; will continue to track enemy.

Co"B" platoon at Oceanview (YD 291751), using NOD and PPS-5 radar, tracked 5-10 NVA/VC from YD 273754 to YD 277745. Fired 40mm (M-42) dusted and 90mm from Tanks.

29 August 1968

Oceanview tower (YD 291751), observed 3 NVA in the tree line at YD 278778. Called artillery mission with good target coverage; results unknown.



Reconnaissance Teams inserted by LVT's and FBR's (river patrol boats).

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected movement at YD 301709. No action was taken as contact was only momentary.

30 August 1968

ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected groups of NVA/VC totaling 5-7 persons at YD 318713, YD 319715 and YD 320712. The groups disapeared to the southeast. Alerted friendly elements in that area.

PF/Marine Unit detained one Vietnamese male with a discrepancy in his identification. His ID shows his age as 16 years and he is supposidly 26 years of age. Later released as an innocent civilian.

Co^NE^N platoon at Oceanview (YD 291751), sighted visually 7 NVA, on the beach, approximately 4000 meters north of *Oceanview. Fired 2 rounds of 90mm HE from Tanks; Coastal Group 12 craft fired 34 rounds of 60mm VT and 2000 rounds from 50 cal machine gun. Results unknown.

Co"B" reported sighting of 5 NVA/VC from Oceanview, 8 NVA at YD 276757 and 10 NVA/VC at YD 273752 from C-4 position. Fired artillery mission, illumination, 90mm from Tanks, 40mm (M-42) duster and 60mm mortar. Results unknown.

PF/Marine Unit, guided by information from the Village Chief of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, detained one Vietnamese male, who was supposidly going to join the North Vietnamese Army in three days. This person was in the company of one detained earlier at 301330H. Forwarded to Battalion S-2 for further investigation.


31 August 1968

Called fire mission on possible bunker complex and sniper position at YD 281767. Result unknown.







He had requested military equipment to fortify a position along the Cau Viet hiver (TD 271627). He was informed that we could not secure this type of gear for him, but that we were willing to aid in other ways if possible. Plan on visiting this area again for further talks with the village chief.
