



PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. The First AmTrac Battalion and the Napeleon/Saline II AO, were under the operational control of the First Brigade, Fifth Division (Mechanized), of the United States Army, throughout the month. Company "C", Third Tank Battalion, was under the operational control of the First AmTrac Battalion, throughout the month, and was employed in the area of Camp Big John (YD 2866), until 17 September, and at My Loc (YD 308680), for the remainder of the month. Second Plateon, First Armered Amphibian Company, supplied direct artillery support for units operating in the AO, during the month.
- 2. The amount of incoming artillery was light this month, totalling 56 rounds. The heaviest concentration received was 26 rounds, of medium artillery, on 3 September. The Battalion suffered no casualties and minimal damage as a result of artillery attacks, during the month.
- 3. Casualties within the battalion consisted of 2 killed and 8 wounded. One man was killed in action, while in contact with the enemy, at Jones Creek platoon outpost (YD 286670). One man was killed, when he was run over by an LVT, after accidentally falling from the vehicle.
- 4. Company "B", First AmTrac Battalion, has continued to consolidate Base Area C-4 and Oceanview outpost (YD 291751). During its operations for the month, the unit conducted 69 artillery and naval gunfire missions, on enemy sighted. The unit also conducted 3 fixed wing air strikes, on bunkers and trench lines discovered, to the north of Oceanview (YD 291751). The unit had 44 sightings of enemy, totalling 277 personnel. Reconnaissance teams, from Third Force Reconnaissance Company, were utilized in the area to the north of Oceanview. These teams discovered numerous bunkers, tunnels and trench lines, indicating recent usage and constant enemy traffic in the area. Artillery, naval gunfire and air strike missions were initiated as a result of the information gathered by these teams.
- 5. LVT's were utilized in conjunction with Tanks and Ontos, in conducting numerous mechanized patrols in the AO. A major portion of supplies, necessary to support the assigned missions, of outlying units (i.e.: Company "C", Third Tank Battalion, Company "B" and platoons of Company "A") were








transported by LVT. A patrol boat was salvaged for the Navy, from the beach, at YD 342701, utilizing 2 LVT's, to lift the stern, by means of cable heist and an "I" beam laid across the LVT's. Assistance was provided to NSAD, Cua Viet, subsequent to the fire on 28 September. One LCM-8 was retracted from the water where it had sunk. Recovery of hull remanents, of two PBR's, was also accomplished, which assisted in the recovery of usable repair parts.

Numerous combat patrols and operations were conducted, encompassing the entire AO. Company "B", conducted a total of 60 day and night patrols and ambushes in the vicinity of Base Area C-4 and Oceanview (YD 291751). Additionally, utilization of reconnaissance teams, throughout the Company "B" portion of the AO, proved invaluable. H & S Company conducted 30 squad size day patrols and night ambushes in the southern AO. Elements of Company "C" (-) (Rein), Third Tank Battalion, located at My Loc (YD 308680) and one platoon, of Co"A", First AmTrac Battalion, located at the platoon outpost, at Jones Creek (YD 286670), conducted day and night patrols and ambushes, providing security for the Cua Viet River in the western portion of the AO. Fifteen bunkers were discovered and destroyed, by Company "A", in the vicinity of Mai Xa Thi (YD 2866). Enemy gear, amounting to 300 pounds of rice, 200 pounds of peanuts, etc, was also It was deduced that this gear had been cached prior to the occupation of Mai Xa Thi, by Marines, in March. underwater reconnaissance team, from Third Reconnaissance Battalion, was utilized in the area of Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), to search the river for possible mines and in the lake near Ha Loc (YD 321707), to search for any possible caches and entrances to tunnels or caves. Mechanized patrols, utilizing LVT's, Tanks and Ontos, were conducted in the southern and western AO. Popular Forces troops were employed as infantry elements on the mechanized patrols in the southern AO. The mechanized patrols were conducted to exploit reported enemy activity along the Cua Viet River and portions of the southern AO. The Battalion CAP Unit. (provisional rifle company), occuping Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village, conducted 120 day and night patrols and ambushes, providing security for that portion of the AO. Infiltration, of a detectable nature, has been decreased significantly because of the units presence and patrolling/ ambushing activities. Intelligence was provided by a Vietnamese informant on 82mm mortar ammunition, buried in a house foundation, which proved to be correct. Two 82mm mortar rounds were recovered. A project to cut enemy infiltration, into the resettlement village, by fencing off









the village and controlling exit and entrance by PF manned posts, was commenced. This concertina fence is being laid by the villagers and PF's, with technical advise from the provisional plateon. A search of the resettlement village, was conducted, by Regional Forces, from Gio Linh District, with a corden force provided by elements of this battalion.

- 7. On 9 September, BrigGen BENNET, Operations Officer, XXIV Corps. visited Cua Viet Port Facility and was briefed by the Commander of Task Force Clearwater and the Battalion Commander. On 15 September, Major BAHNMEYER, Ground Surveillance Officer, Third Marine Division, visited C-4 and Oceanview to survey the Duel Blade position (C-4) and to inventory Duel Blade assets (C-4 and Oceanview). On 15 and 19 September, the battalion was visited by Col GLIKES, Commanding Officer, First Brigade, Fifth Division (Mechanized). The Col was briefed on the current situation and activities in the AO. On 19 September, Mr BREWER, Senior Advisor, Quang Tri Province, for C.O.R.D.S. and LtCol MOONEY, Senior Advisor, Quang Tri Province, for C.O.R.D.S. (designated), visited Camp Kistler to discuss the refugee school project, in Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village. On 24 September, LtGen BUSE, Commanding General, Fleet Marine Force Pacific, LtGen CUSHMAN, Commanding General, III Marine Amphibious Force and MajGen DAVIS, Commanding General, Third Marine Division, visited Camp Kistler and were briefed on the current situation in the AO.. On 26 September, MajGen DRAKE, visited Camp Kistler and was briefed on operations and civic action in the AO. On 28 September, LtGen STILLWELL, Commanding General, XXIV Corps and Col GLIKES, visited Cua Viet Port Facility and surveyed the damage caused by the fire which occured earlier that day.
- 8. Mining incidents continue to be a problem. On 13 September, an LVT detonated an AT mine at YD 331699, resulting in minor repairable damage to the vehicle. On 16 September, a five ton truck, detonated an AT mine at YD 307683, resulting in two WIA's and total destruction of the truck. On 28 September, an LVT detonated an AT mine at YD 323703, resulting in three WIA's and total loss of the vehicle due to fire damage. On 30 September, a Tank detonated an AT mine near Oceanview (YD 291751), resulting in minor repairable damage. On four other occations mines were recovered in the northern AO. Eighteen punji pits and verious other booby traps, of an anti-personnel nature, were discovered and destroyed in the southern AO.
- 9. Numerous sightings of UFO's were reported during the month. Sightings were made from Base Area C-4 and Ocean-view (YD 291751). The majority sighted, were reported, in the vicinity of YD 2485 to YD 2887 and in most cases








were moving both east and west in that general area.

- 10. On 5 September, the battalien experienced a tropical storm, causing minor flood damage to Camp Kistler, Camp Big John, Base Area C-4, Oceanview and Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village. Flooding effects were compounded by leaking bulk fuel, which floated throughout the Camp Kistler area, causing a considerable fire hazard.
- 11. Numerous cantonment maintenance projects have been completed during the month. The extension of the perimeter wire to encompass the new bulk fuel farm, the relocation of the dump and upgrading of the read network, has been accomplished. Continued emphasis on repairs within the cantonment area is expected during the month of October, to ensure maximum capabilities during the monsoon season.
- 12. Reconnaissance teams, from Third Force Reconnaissance Company, were utilized in other sections of the AO, to determine the nature and extent of enemy activity. Patrols were inserted both by PBR and LVT and extracted by the same means. Information gathered by these reconnaissance teams served as an invaluable guide for planning future patrols and operations in the AO.









PART III

LIST OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 September 1968



Reconnaissance team (Oaktree) found 2 round objects with wires at YD 373668. Appears to be a land mine cut into halves. Noted coordinates for later reference by EOD.


H&S Co patrol, while returning to CP, discovered a booby trap at YD 368663 and received permission to destroy it with a fragmentation grenade. The patrol was instructed to return any important items, from the booby trap, to the CP.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion elements, at Camp Big John (YD 280666) reported detaining one Vietnamese female with improper identification. The detainee was forwarded to Camp Kistler for interrogation by Battalion S-2 and later released as an innocent civilian.


Aerial Observer, working north of Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 2 bunkers and many foot prints at YD 278770. Airstrike was conducted with good target coverage; results unknown. Aerial Observer also observed bunkers and a camouflaged trench line at YD 290757, AO recommended airstrikes.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751) conducted a fire mission on a suspected sniper position at YD 283 760. Fired 48 rounds of 105mm with excellent coverage.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol detained one Vietnamese female believed to be a Viet Cong sympathizer. The detainee was forwarded to CP for interrogation and was later released as an innocent civilian.









Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a fire mission on bunkers and trench line at YD 284764. Fired 45 rounds of 155mm artillery with unknown results.

River patrol boat recieved a hit from an RPG rocket sinking the boat and killing LUSN at YD 307680. Returned fire with 50 cal machine gum. Reconnaissance team (Selby) was in the area and suffered one WIA simulatineously with the return fire from the boat.

2 September 1968

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, while returning from patrol, discovered 1 Chi-Com grenade at YD 3046% and returned it to their CP.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol discovered one fighting hole at YD 307681. Inside the hole were found 3 aiming stakes, 1 NVA cartridge belt, with first aid pouch, 1 M-26 hand grenade and 1 M-16 magazine. Returned equipment to the CP.

H&S Co patrol spotted 5 persons with packs at YD 36662. The patrol gave chase firing M-16 and M-79. The 5 persons disappeared into a hamlet at YD 368656. A search of the area revealed nothing; continued with original mission.

3 September 1968


Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion patrol had contact with unknown number of unidentified personnel, in the vicinity of Mai Xa Thi. Search of the area revealed nothing; no friendly casualties.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported that an aerial observer spotted an NVA observation post, consisting of 2 bunkers, a trench line and one building. Fixed wing airstrike was called in destroying 1 bunker and part of the trench line.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, while checking ID's in Ha Loc (YD 323709), found one man with two ID's. The PF's claimed that one of the ID's was a VC ID. The man was forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation and later released as an innocent civilian.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported receiving 2 rounds of sniper fire, which hit the tower, from YD 284761. Conducted 105mm artillery mission expending 111 rounds with excellent coverage.

H&S Co patrol reported finding 15 105mm dud rounds, 2 green smoke, 2 WP and 2 thermite grenades at YD 369671. The patrol also found 2 105mm dud rounds at YD 377665. All were destroyed in place.

Camp Kistler received 26 rounds of medium artillery from YD 22718594 and YD 251822, resulting in negative casualties or damage. Fired naval gun counterbattery with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 5 NVA/VC, walking on a sand dune, at YD 26837861. The area is believed to be a living quarters area. Fired 90mm from Tanks, 40mm duster (M-42) and called 105mm artillery mission resulting in the starting of a fire.

4 September 1968

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion, at Camp Big John (YD 280666), reported shrapnel, from H&I's, impacting in their CP area. Checked fire on all H&I's in that area.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion, at Camp Big John (YD 280666), reported that shrapnel, from H&I's continues to impact in their compound. Check fire has been in effect for 13 minutes.

Battalion set weather condition at A III. all units notified.







5 September 1968

River patrol boat extracted reconnaissance team with ill man.

Battalion S-3 received Typhoon warnings; all units notified.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported 4 81mm mortar rounds impacted near their position. Attempted to contact swift boats, in the area, with negative results.

Co"B" report H&I's were impacting at YD 292756, YD 293756, and YD 294756, within 520 meters from their position at Oceanview (YD 291751). Check fire was called.


Co"B" reports 4 rounds impacting in the vicinity of Oceanview (YD 291751).

Notified all companies of the possibility of winds reaching 50 to 60 knots, on 5 and 6 September and of the prediction of 4 inches of rain, on 5 September.

Battslion S-3 was notified, by Navy, at Cua Viet Fort Facility, that an LCU was crippled, at sea, and did not know his position. Fired ill-umination both north and south, in the hope the craft would observe. All units along the beach, to the south of Camp Kistler, were notified of the situation. The LCU moved out of radio range to the south.

The following tropical storm damage, to Camp Kistler, was reported:
(1) The triple concertena wire, on the sea side of the perimeter, was breaded in three places and high tides and surf totally destroyed 400 meters of it.

(2) Two berms of the new POL fuel farm perimeter were damaged, approximately 100 meters of the tank farm wire was carried away by the surf and

one bunker foundation was damaged by the high tide and surf.

The POL bulk fuel pump was damaged by water and moderate flooding, of tents and bunkers, was reported at Camp Big John (YD 280666).

(4) Minor repairable damage, to tropical huts, throughout the area and portions of the existing roads were washed out by tidal action.

(5) Road damage to C-4 and Oceanview

(YD 291751) was reported.

(6) Moderate flooding of the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, with the water past the first two rows of houses. ACTION: Wire will be replaced as soon as possible, bunkers and hooches throughout the area will be repaired on 6 September and PF's, assisted by Marines, from the Battalion CAP Unit, will help the villagers repair the flood damage.

6 September 1968

Co "B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported H&I's impacting at YD 289755, 449 meters from their position. Check fire was put into effect.

Diesel fuel and gas, floating on top of the flooding water, was ignited, causing minor damage to one tropical hut. Fire was quickly extinquished.

Fire in the Navy area was reported. Cause was gas being flushed up from the ground by the flooding water.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion, at Mai Xa Thi (YD 280666), reported a fuel bladder had drifted away from their position, in the flooding river. Location of the bladder unknown.

ColB platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), found an AT mine, that had been washed up by the surf, at YD 294753. The mine was approximately 12 inches in diameter, 5 inches high, was grey, with yellow markings (40A-5-63) and was cov-UNCLASSIFIED with plastic. Location marked.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), had a sighting of 3 NVA and bunkers at YD 271785. Fired 3 rounds of 90mm from Tanks and continued to observe the area.

H&S Co patrol reported that they had shot one of their men. The man was 75 meters outside of the patrol perimeter and had informed no one that he would be there. A flare was fired and the man hit the deck but was hit by the one round fired by a member of the patrol. The man then called for a corpsman, alerting the patrol of his identity. Emergency medevac was accomplished and a serious incident report was submitted.

7 September 1968

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed a bunker at YD 274778. Fired 28 rounds of naval gun fire, 4 of which were direct hits.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported sighting 5 NVA at YD 26887814, moving into bunker complex. Fired 25 rounds of 155mm artillery with unknown results.

Co"B", at C-4 position, conducted a naval gun fire mission on a suspected bunker complex at YD 299731; good coverage of the target area.

Swift boat sighted a bunker and a sand bagged sampan at YD 278773. Fired 81 mm mortar mission and called naval gun fire mission, with unknown results.


Combin platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 3 NVA fishing at YD 279773. Fired 2 rounds of 90mm from Tanks, on target, resulting in 1 NVA KIA.

Battalion CAP Unit, reported that for some reason the villagers of Ha Loc (YD 324707), were tearing down their houses and moving into Xuan Khanh.











Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion, at Camp Big John (YD 280666), reported rounds impacting within 400 meters of their night ambush position. Called check fire on all H&I's.

Concon, 3rd Tank Battalion, at Camp Big John (YD 280666), reported rounds continue to impact near their ambush. Check fire has been in effect for 10 minutes.

8 September 1968

Inquired of friendly units in the area, who reported no fire missions, in the area of Camp Big John (YD 280666). Check fire was cancelled.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using NOD, sighted 2-4 NVA at YD 270753. Fired 4 rounds of beehive from Tanks and observed no further movement.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported sighting 6 NVA, on the beach, at YD 262803. Called naval gun fire mission; NVA moved into a tree line; fire was adjusted, on the tree line; results unknown.

River patrol boats, reported automatic weapons fire, in the vicinity of YD 305657. Will inquire of friendly units in that area.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected a small group of NVA/VC, moving south, at YD 296705. Contact was lost at YD 295701.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, discovered 4 VC suspects, in a house, in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 328701). One man escaped, as others entered the house. One Fragmentation grenade, one roll of 12.7mm ammunition, 1 NVA cartridge belt, one canteen and 1 poncho were also found. Remaining 3 suspects were forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation.

9 September 1968

Five VC suspects were detained neat the house, in Xuan Khanh, of the earlier incident (082330H). One of the suspects attempted to escape but was shot and wounded in the leg.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 7 NVA/VC at YD 275740. Fired 10 rounds of 90mm beehive, from Tanks, with unknown results.

ARVN elements, at A-l position, reported an active rocket site at YD 251804. They requested artillery and emergency TPQ's.

A total of 12 VC suspects, were forwarded to Battalion S-2, for interrogation, along with one Russian fragmentation grenade, two NVA canteens, two pair of NVA utility trousers. one National Liberation Front flag and one propaganda banner.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, tracked a group of NVA/VC from YD 293712 to YD 301694 and had a visual sighting of 3 persons at YD 295704. No action taken at this time.

Clearwater reported that river patrol boats were fired upon by B-40 rockets and small arms at YD 308680 (My Loc). One boat was hit but not seriously damaged. Boats returned fire and patrols in the area were alerted.


10 September 1968

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar and NOD, reported tracking 6 NVA/VC from YD 300690 to YD 294712. Fired 81mm mortar and 105mm artillery with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed a man carrying a body from the YD 2775 grid (area of contact at 100015H). Fired 50 cal machine gun and 60mm mortar. The man droped the body and fled to the northeast. As the man fled he was droped by fire from Oceanview, results one WAR Access

Camp Kistler tower reported a small boat at an azimuth of 5710 mils, approximate distance 15,000 meters. Notified swift boats who investigated with negative results.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion and the Battalion CAP Unit patrols and OP's report no civilian activity in the area north of the river (YD 2967 & YD 3068), where numerous civilians are normally seem. All units notified to be especially alert.

11 September 1968

A fixed wing aircraft (assumed to be an areal reconnaissance craft) made several passes over Camp Kistler, dropping what appeared to be photo reconnaissance flares.

12 September 1968

Called 105mm mission on bunker complex at YD 28637630; movement had been seen in the same area. Expending 111 rounds, with excellent coverage, resulted in one bunker destroyed. Part of the area not visable due to sand dunes. A0 required for complete damage assessment.

Aerial Observer observed two bunkers, with a trench line conecting them, at YD 239759 and YD 241796. Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), later observed an arc light strike, on the same area.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), received one round of sniper fire from an unknown location. The area was checked visually with negative results.

Reconnaissance team (Hayride), observed 2 NVA/VC and 2 bunkers at YD 337 656. Called 105mm artillery mission, resulting in direct hits on both bunkers.









13 September 1968

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using FPS-5 radar, detected 10 NVA/VC, moving from YD 300710 to YD 290707. Fired 81mm mortar and 105mm artillery, with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), fired on 4 NVA/VC at YD 273752. Fired 6 rounds of 90mm beehive, 70 rounds of 40mm duster (M-42) and 20 rounds of 105mm artillery. Tanks had two direct hits with 90mm beehive; 2 NVA KIA.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, encountered a National Policeman and a woman carrying a wounded man on a litter. The man was supposedly an NVA/VC. Man was forwarded to BAS for treatment.

LVT (A-21), hit a mine at YD 331699, while passing the resettlement village, damaging road wheels #2 & #3 and portions of the track. The vehicle was towed to the Battalion CAP Unit: CP.

Co"B" patrol found one Russian designed AT mine at YD 323722. The mine and firing device were water proofed. Engineers estimated that the mine had been buried for one week.

Battalion CAP Unit, while on patrol, received 5 rounds of automatic weapons fire from YD 312698. Returned fire and checked the area. Three sets of foot prints were found. The patrol continued on with the patrol planned.

Battalion CAP Unit, while on patrol, entered a house, with lights on. The inhabitants acted suspectiously and were ordered to leave, in order for a search to be conducted. One man refused to leave and grabbed a rifle (M=2 Carbine). A member of the patrol fired 20 rounds, killing the man and wounding a child.







The child was medevaced. The dead mans wife was detained and forward-edato Battalion S-2 for investigation. Results were 1 TVC KIA.

14 September 1968

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, at YD 323 711, observed 4 NVA/VC at YD 325701. Took the enemy under fire and received no return fire. Results unknown.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751), spotted 4 NVA/VC, moving south, at YD 273751. Fired 40mm duster (M-42). Group took cover at YD 267753. Called 105mm fire mission. The group was seen again in this area and were fired upon by 40mm duster and Tanks. Three people were seen again in the area of YD 258759. Fire was adjusted and no more movement was seen. It is believed that one NVA/VC was killed by artillery.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, while test firing weapons, wounded a Vietnamese woman and child with an M-79 round. The woman and child were taken to BAS for treatment and later medevaced to Quang Tri.

Battalion S-5 and medical personnel, conducted a medCAF, in Kuan Khanh, treating 40 persons.

The wife of the dead vc., detained at 132330H, was forwarded to CIT for further interrogation.

H&S Co patrol, found 3 105mm dud rounds, at YD 364674 and destroyed them in place.

Elements of Co"B", at C=4 position, reported numerous sightings of UFO's, by Oceanview (YD 291751) and the tower at C=4. The sightings were made both with starlight scope and with the naked eye. Sightings were from 0600 mils to 6000 mils, in groups of 8 or 9 and occured on 20 occations.

15 September 1968

Major Baundmeyer, Ground Survailence Officer, 3rd Marine Division, visited C-4 and Oceanview (YD 291751), to survey the Duel Blade position (C-4) and to inventory the Duel Blade assets (C-4 and Oceanview).

From 151410H to 151430H, Col Glikes, CO, 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), USA, visited Camp Kistler and was briefed on the current situation in the AO.

16 September 1968

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, at YD 320 700, observed a man at YD 326700, moving from the village to the northwest. Fired two rounds of M-16, results unknown.

A five ton truck, detonated an AT mine, at YD 307683, resulting in two WIA's and total destruction of the truck. One Vietnamese male, age 12, was detained and interrogated, by Battalion S-2 and released by S-2 as an innocent civilian.

Reconnaissance team, reported: at 15 2330H, they heard movement at YD 363640. The team fired an M-79 at the movement and upon returning the next day discovered drag marks and a position apparently used as an observation post.

Naval gunfire spot team, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 6 NVA, on the beach, at YD 263802. Fired 20 rounds of naval gunfire; good coverage; results unknown.

ComB", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 7 NVA/VC at YD 307701. Ambush in the area was notified; negative contact.

17 September 1968

An aerial observer spotted 2 OP's at YD 271761, 2, large bunkers at YD 281761 and numerous foot prints at YD 280772. Requested air strikes.







Elements of Co[#]B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 6-8 NVA, at YD 272 778. Fired 80 rounds of 40mm duster (M-42), resulting in possible secondary explosion. Negative clearance for artillery or naval gunfire.

Co B patrol discovered a T-41 AT mine, at YD 323722, with a wire running to an object, of undetermined nature, under it. The mine was destroyed in place.


Popular Forces, from Coastal Group 11, conducted a sweep of Vinh Hoa (YD 374 654), resulting in contact with North Vietnamese troops. The exchange of fire resulted in 2 NVA KIA's and 2 PF WIA's. During the action, the Popular Forces captured 9 NVA POW's (c) and 4 suspects. Additionally, a small cache, containing 1 AK-47, 1 AK-43, 1 ChiCom pistol, 1 ChiCom grenade, 1 M26 grenade, 1 web belt, 1 canteen cover, assorted clothing and small amounts of money, was found.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), sighted 4 UFO's, at an azimuth of 6200 mils, approximate distance 8000 to 10000 meters. Notified Dong Ha DASC.


Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), sighted 10 UFO's, from azimuth of 5900 mils to 6200 mils, approximate distance 8000 to 10000 meters. Note ified Dong Ha DASC.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS=5 radar, detected a group of 10 NVA/VC, rapidly moving south, from YD 300710 to YD 301705. Notified units in the area.

H&S Co patrol south, heard movement, near their position. The sounds were those of people moving in the water. Called 105mm artillery mission. A







sweep of the area revealed drag marks and foot prints. The patrol then move ed to a knew night position.

18 September 1968

Co"B", night ambush, had contact with 8 NVA/VC at YD 310709. Fired 81mm illumination and small arms; results unknown.

Elements of Co^{**}C^{**}, 3rd Tank Battalion, reported finding fresh diggings and a used tunnel at YD 300685. The tunnel was destroyed by demolitions and the area was investigated further; negative results.

Coastal Group 11 (NRVN/PF), reported they had lost contact at YD 366655, after capturing 1 AK-47 and 1 VC. They conducted a sweep toward YD 385647.

Co"B" patrol, searched the area of contact, at 180235H, finding a map, drawn in the sand, 5 sets of foot prints and drag marks. The patrol followed the foot prints, north, until they were lost in water. Four sets of foot prints were again found and followed until lost in grass.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 2 persons at YD 289 760. Fired 8 rounds of 90mm from Tanks; people dissapeared into a tree line.

Co"B" patrol, discovered 1 crew served weapon tri-pod, 2 NVA gas masks, 2 packs and a decomposed human arm, at YD 295711. The patrol also found numerous fresh tracks, in the vicinity of YD 299713 and YD 299712. The area from YD 290715 to YD 295701, also shows signs of heavy NVA traffic. Forwarded equipment to Battalion S-2 and overlay to Battalion S-3.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291







751), received 3 rounds of sniper fire from an unknown location. Fired 60mm mortar and 50 cal machine gun, at suspected sniper positions.

Camp Kistler received 8 rounds, of medium artillery, from YD 215845. Naval gunfire counterbattery was fired, with unknown results.

Camp Kistler received 12 rounds, of medium artillery from YD 220818. Negative casculties from the attacks. Fired naval gunfire counterbattery with unknown results.


Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 4 UFO's at 5800 mils, approximate distance 11000 meters; two were hovering over the area of an earlier air strike, one was heading north along the coast and one was heading the direction of Tiger Island. Sighting was passed on to ships at sea and Dong Ha DASC, via naval gunfire net.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed a light, believed to be a night observation device. When a naval gun fire began to the north, the light disappeared.

19 September 1968

Co"A" patrol, in the area of Jones Creek, observed 3-5 NVA/VC at YD 280665. Took the enemy under fire with small arms and they withdrew. The patrol fired illumination and observed approximately 30 NVA/VC trying to encircle them. The patrol withdrew to their compound and there engaged the enemy. Called 16 rounds of 105mm artillery, fired 60 rounds of 60mm mortar, 40 rounds of M-79 and 2300 rounds of M-16. One member of the platoon, died as a result of gun shot wounds, received while defending his position against the enemy force.







River patrol boat, at YD 267638, received RPG rocket fire and approximately 200 rounds of small arms fire, damaging the boat badly but causing no casualties. Reconnaissance team, in the area, conducted a 105mm artillery mission on the suspected enemy position.

Co"A" patrol, at the platoon outpost on Jones Creek (YD 286670), observed possible movement, in the area of earlier contact (190015H). Called 105mm artillery mission, with unknown results.


A search of the area of contact, at 19 0015H (YD 280665), was conducted. Thee patrol discovered drag marks and stains that could be blood. Two mounds of dirt, resembling graves were found but contained nothing. All bunkers that were near the area were destroyed. M-16 ammunition, 1 battery, 1 M-1 Carbine, with magazines and AK-47 ammunition were found also.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), sighted 8 persons at YD 249 844. Conducted naval gunfire mission, with good coverage; results unknown.


Guard post, at Camp Kistler trash dump, reported Vietnamese personnel observing Camp Kistler, with binoculars, from a tree line. Attempts were made to apprehend the individuals with negative results. The H&S Co patrol south attempted to stay concealed in the area throughout the afternoon, with the hope the individuals would return.

From 190900H to 191430H, Co"A" platoon conducted a sweep of the area from which the PBR had taken fire at 190135H, at YD 266640. Negative findings.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using starlight scope, observed 3-5 NVA/VC, moving southwest, from YD 290755 to YD 287751. Fired 40mm duster (M-42), 90mm from Tanks and small arms; one body was observed in the area.

Battalion CAP Unit, was notified, by an informant, of the whereabouts of 82mm mortar ammunition. The information proved to be true and 2 rounds of 82mm ammunition were recovered.

20 September 1968

Reconnaissance team (Grasshopper), reported noises that could be the sounds of bunker building at YD 277 772. No action taken at this time.

Elements of Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalon, reported receiving 3 rounds of RPG or rifle grenade fire, into their position, from an unknown location.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion patrol, discovered boot prints and many small foot prints, indicating heavy traffic and 2 bunkers at YD 287671. Destroyed 1 bunker.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported receiving one round of sniper fire from YD 290758. Fired 15 rounds of 60mm mortar, results unknown.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported receiving one round of sniper fire from an unknown location. Fired 30 rounds of 60mm mortar at previous sniper position; results unknown.

Co"A" platoon, at the Jones Creek outpost YD 286670), detained 3 Vietnamese, who had no identification in their possesion. Forwarded the detainees to the Battalion S-2 and were released as innocent civilians.





Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a 105mm mission on a suspected bunker and sniper position, at YD 284775; excellent coverage, results unknown.

Co"A" patrol, at YD 282670, spotted 10 indiginous personnel (2 carrying packs). When the personnel saw the patrol, they used evasive action and ram into a thickly vegitated area. The patrol followed until they came upon a freshly swept trail. The patrol found a punji pit and signs of other booby traps. The patrol withdrew and called a 60mm mortar mission on the trail, resulting in one secondary. The patrol returned and found a fresh blood trail.

Col GLIKES, Commanding Officer, 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), USA, visited Camp Kistler and was briefed on the current situation in the AO.

Elements of the battalion, using 2 LVT's, assisted the villagers of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, in cutting and transporting wood for repairs of their houses and fuel. The wood cutting also cleared fields of fire for the C-4 position. The reaction of the people was favorable.

Elements of CoNB", at C-4, using PPS-5 radar, detected 2-3 persons at YD 321 712 and tracked them to YD 300712. Notified friendly units in the area.

Battalion CAP Unit (YD 338703), reported movement in their wire. Fired small arms and received no return fire. Will search the area at first light.

21 September 1968

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion, reported receiving 4 rounds of imcoming, estimated as 60mm mortar, from an unknown location.

Co"A" platoon, at the Jones Creek out-

post (YD 286670), reported a sentry sighted a man with a rifle 30 feet from his position. The sentry fired small arms and threw an M-26 grenade. The sentry was wounded by shrapnel from the M-26 grenade. Small boot prints were found in the area of the sighting.

Co"A" patrol, while sweeping Mai Xa
Thi (YD 283668), discovered 300 pounds
of rice, 200 pounds of peanuts, I NVA
canteen, 30 AK-47 rounds and I set of
blood stained pajamas. The patrol
destroyed 250 pounds of rice and 125
pounds of peanuts; returned to the
CP with the remainder of the gear.

Co"A" patrol, in the area of Mai Xa Thi (YD 279671), found a pack filled with M-79 rounds, Claymore mine and various Vietnamese books. The items were forwarded to Battalion S-2.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 3 persons at YD 279759. Fired 40mm duster (M-42) and 50 cal machine gun with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using PPS-5 radar and starlight scope, observed 3-5 persons moving southwest from YD 290754. Took the enemy under fire with 50 cal machine gun and notified friendly units in the area.


Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using starlight scope, observed 1 NVA/VC at YD 278754, moving south. No action at this time.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using PPS-5 radar, detected a target of unidentified nature. Fired two rounds of 90mm beehive from tank.

Reconnaissance team (Grasshopper), working north of Oceanview (YD 291 751), discovered a trench 3-4 feet deep and 4 feet across. Submitted

22 September 1968



CottA" platoon, at Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), reported that one of their men was accidentally wounded by a fragmentation grenade. The man was reentering the CP, from patrol, and was mistaken, by a sentry, as an enemy. The sentry threw a grenade at the unidentified movement resulting in the minor wounding of the man.

Co^NB" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 5-10 persons, moving south, at YD 272752. Fired 40mm duster (M-42) and 90mm from Tanks. The group stopped momentarily; when the group started moving again, they were again taken under fire with M-42 and Tanks.

One man was accidentally killed, as a result of being run over, by an LVT, after he fell from the vehicle.

Elements of the battalion, conducted a mechanized patrol, in the southern AO, using Popular Forces, from Coastal Group 11, as infantry elements. The unit detained a total of 5 persons, who were forwarded to Camp Kistler, for interrogation and were later released as innocent civilians.

Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 2-3 persons, moving south, at YD 295702. No action taken at this time.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), received 1 round of sniper fire from an unknown location.

2nd ARVN, at A-l position, reported that a squad patrol had been ambushed at YD 267722. When a reaction force arrived at the scene, it became apparent that they were in contact with a large enemy force, estimated as a Co (-). The enemy was pushed south to YD 270718.







23 September 1968

At the time of the report, the ARVN totals were: 1 friendly KIA, 17 friendly WIA, 50 NVA KIA, 3 NVA POW, 14 individual weapons captured and 1 crew served weapons captured. All units in the vicinity notified of the action.

The battalion was notified that high winds and the rapid current of the river had caused a river patrol boat to run aground on the north bank of the river, near the CAP Units CP. All hands are secure and uninjured.

The battalion was notified that the extreme current of the river had caused a river patrol boat to run aground on the south bank of the river, at Camp Kistler. An LVT was dispatched to the scene to provide a tie down for the boat.

Reconnaissance team (Selby) extracted, due to flooding in their RZ.

Reconnaissance team (Ringlet), requested extraction. River patrol boats were unable to reach the teams because of the condition of the river. Will arrange other means.


Reconnaissance team (Air Police) reported extreme difficulty in moving, due to flooding in their area. Extraction was accomplished by LVT.

Co"C", 3rd Tanks, reported that their squad patrol received 4 rounds of sniper fire from YD 276675. The unit returned fire and checked the area; negative findings.

Clearwater informed the battalion that the river is closed due to the current.

Reconnaissance team (Ringlet), was extracted by helicopter and returned to the CP.





Co"B" patrol discovered 2 Vietnamese, with what appeared to be napalm burns, at YD 323711 and YD 310711. The Bnc-CAP Unit detained one of these individuals.

Co"B" patrol, while interrogating a Vietnamese civilian, received 1 round of sniper fire from the vicinity of YD 3071. A search of the area revealed nothing.

24.September 1968

Naval gunfire spotter team, at Oceanview (YD 291751), conducted a fire mission, on a suspected bunker complex/staging area, at YD 236814.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 3 NVA at YD 280771. Fired 90mm from Tanks and NVA moved into a tree line. Called 105mm artillery mission, with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), conducted a 105mm artillery mission on bunkers at YD 270780; results unknown.

LtGen BUSE, LtGen CUSHMAN and MajGen DAVIS, visited Camp Kistler and were briefed on the current situation in the AO.

Co"B" (rear), at Camp Kistler, requested permission to man their guard posts with one man less on each post, due to a shortage of personnel in the area. Permission granted.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 4-6 persons at YD 276748. Notified reconnaissance team in the area, who accomplished no sighting.

Reconnaissance team (Grasshopper) reported finding a tunnel at YD 287760. The tunnel had plywood walls and a reinforced cealing. There was a 60mm mortar round, hanging from the cealing, assumed to be booby trapped. Plan to excavate the tunnel at a later date.

25 September 1968



Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 2-3 NVA/VC at YD 307716. Notified reconnaissance team in the area.

Co"A" platoon, at the Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), reported H&I's impacting 200 meters from their position. Checked fire on all H&I's in their area.

Underwater reconnaids ance team (League Leader Uniform), departed CP to conduct an operation with Co"B". A search of the lake near Ha Loc(YD 323 709) was conducted with negative results.

Co*B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 3 NVA, on the beach, moving into a tree line, at YD 280773. Called 105mm artillery mission with unknown results.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a 105mm artillery mission, on a bunker complex, at YD 277 765. LVTH-6's, at Camp Kistler, expended 87 rounds, with excellent coverage, resulting in two bunkers destroyed and one damaged.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a naval gunfire mission, on a construction site, at YD 251834. Fired 31 rounds damaging two buildings.

Reconnaissance team (Grasshopper), discovered an "A" frame bunker at YD 289 759. Upon approaching to within 10 meters of the bunker, the team observed one man in the doorway. The team withdrew, to Ocean view (YD 291751) and called a 105mm fire mission on the bunker. Results unknown.

Co"A" platoon, at Jones Creek outpost, (YD 286670), observed possible movement, outside their wire. Called H&I's, adjusted from "on call" concentrations.

River patrol boats, reported artillery rounds impacting in the river at YD 272642. Checked fire on H&I's in that area.

26 September 1968



River patrol boat, at YD 272643, received 3 rounds of RPG fire from YD 274642. Did not return fire due to friendlies being in the area.

Co"C", 3rd Tank Battalion patrol, at YD 293685, observed 3 NVA/VC, moving northeast from YD 300685. The NVA/VC were too far away for small arms. The patrol withdrew to their CP and called a 105mm artillery mission on the movement; results unknown.

An H&S Co LVT detonated an AP mine at YD 28076702, causing no damage to the vehicle.


Co"A" patrol, in the vicinity of Mai Xa Thi (YD 2867), recovered the body of a Vietnamese child, at the request of the elders of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village. The body was returned to Xuan Khanh via skimmer boat.

Elements of the battalion, with 3 LVT's, assisted NSADCV in removing a fuel barge, from a sand bar, at YD 269633.

Elements of the battal ion, in conjunction with Regional Forces, from Gio Linh District, conducted a cordon and search of Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village, at YD 325696. Five persons were detained as VC suspects and 18 males of draft age were recruited.

Received an agent report from Coastal Group 11 stating: 11 NVA/VC, with 40 kilo mines, in the vicinity of YD 295684, were planning to mine the Cua Viet River. Sent a patrol to check the area.

H&S Co patrol south detained one man, with suspicious ID and apparently of







draft age, at YD 360666. The detainee was forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation and was released, the next morning, as an innocent civilian.

Co"A" patrol reported a member of their patrol shot himself, while loading his 45 cal pistol. The man was medevaced; serious incident report was submitted.

Reconnaissance team (Ringlet) observed a man, coming onto the beach out of the surf. The reconnaissance team apprehended the man and forwarded him to Battalion S-2. Released as innocent.

27 September 1968

One platoon, of LVT's from Co"A", reinforced with two tanks, conducted a mechanized patrol in the southern AO.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a 105mm mission, on fighting holes at YD 2831765. Good target coverage; results unknown.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a 105mm artillery mission, on bunkers, at YD 27967656. Good target coverage resulting in 1 bunker destroyed.

Co"A" platoon, while conducting a mechanized patrol of Thanh Hoi (YD 388648) and Thanh Hoi Phong (YD 393643), had the following results: 2 persons detained by the PF and 1 82mm mortar tube captured; one PF was killed(by a booby trap); other booby traps were also found and destroyed; detained four persons claiming to be returnees (were released later as innocent civilians.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported an Aerial Observer observed four houses at YD 281769 and YD 278761.

A0 requested air strikes.

Reconnaissance team (Air Police), working north of Oceanview (YD 291 751), discovered an "A" frame bunker at YD 285762. The bunker contained, 2 gas masks, 2 chi-com grenades (rigged as a booby trap on top a helmet), 1 pound of TNT, utilities, poncho, 2 belts and a buckle. While setting a demolitions charge, the team observed 2 NVA approaching. Set a 3 minute charge and withdrew.

Co"A" platoon, at Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), reported one of their line posts heard sounds like those of someone swimming in the river. Fired small arms in the direction of the sounds; will check at first light

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using super starlight scope, confirmed an earlier reported sighting of a small craft at YD 338908. Confirmation was passed on to the swift boat that made the original sighting.

28 September 1968

River patrol boat reported sighting 2 persons at YD 321693. Notified Battalion CAP Unit patrol that was in the area.

Battalion CAP Unit reported movement at YD 316688. Fired small arms and used illumination with negative results.

H&S Co patrol, discovered a small box (5"X 4"X 1"), with a wire attached to it, at YD 339671. The box was destroyed in place.

Battalion CAP Unit reported that the errection of their observation tower had been completed.

Co"A" patrol, discovered 7 bunkers,

at YD 267667 and 6 bunkers at YD 264648. The bunkers were somewhat complex and one contained 20 pounds of rice. The bunkers were destroyed and the rice was poured out on the ground.

From 280900H to 281130H, the Battalion S-5 and medical personnel, conducted a medCAP in Pho Hoi Village, treating 20 Vietnamese.

Received the following intelligence report: On 27 September, one NVA Battalion (designation unknown), moved to Thuy Khi (YD 243785) and Cam Pho (YD 246765), mission unknown, weapons unknown. Emergency air strikes were requested, fired artillery and naval gunfire saturation fires and requested TPQ's.

A fire started, at Cua Viet Port Facility dock, resulting in six medevaced for burns, 2 killed and 2 missing (presumed dead). Material damage consisted of 3 PBR's totally destroyed, heavy damage to the PBR pier and damage to several "pusher" boats and LCM's. LST 1076 (Page County), played a significanthrohedin extinguishing the fire, when it approached to within a few feet of the flaming pier and used it's foam type fire fighting equipment. LtGen STILLWELL, USA, was in the area and surveyed the damage, moments after the incident occured. Col Glikes, USA, was also in the area.

LVT (A-22), while on a routine mission, detonated an AT mine at YD 332704. A fire started aboard the vehicle and it was towed to the surf to extinguish the blaze. Results were 3 WIA's and total loss of the LVT.

Camp Kistler received 10 rounds of medium artillery from YD 247854. All rounds impacted approximately 1000









meters at sea, near the mouth of the Cua Viet River. Naval gunfire counterbattery was fired.

Reconnaissance team (Air Police), working north of Oceanview (YD 291 751), discovered a trench at YD 287 757. Trench will be destroyed at a later date.

Reconnaissance team (Air Police), working north of Oceanview (YD 291 751), discovered a bunker in Ha Loi Trung (YD 282761). The bunker will be destroyed at a later date.

River patrol boat (LCPL) recieved 2 rounds of RPG rocket fire, from YD 288658, resulting in no damage or casualties. Returned fire with 50 cal machinegun, results unknown.

Reconnaissance team (Oaktree), using starlight scope, observed 5-6 persons at YD 271649. Called 105mm artillery mission with unknown results..

From 282200H to 282400H, CoMB" patrol, had multiple sightings of camp fires in the vicinity of YD 313713. The patrol had radio trouble and did not investigate. A patrol will be sent to the area again of 29 September.

29 September 1968


Reconnaissance team, working north of Oceanview (YD 291751), discovered a trench line/bunker complex, at YD 285785. One bunker destroyed and found to contain nothing.

Co"A" patroly working in the western AO, discovered a trench line at YD 279 660. The patrol also found bunkers in the same area. The bunkers and trench line destroyed by demolitions.

One of the MIA's, from the fire at 281400H, was found dead and sent to Quang Tri.

Cd'B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), recieved one round of sniper fire from the vicinity of YD 285759. Fired 40mm duster (M-42), into that area.

Co"A" platoon, at Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), observed two persons and a building at YD 288676. Fired 106mm recoiless rifle and 50 cal machinegum with unknown results.

River patrol boat reported movement at YD 300674. Illumination was fired with negative results.

30 September 1968

River patrol boat, received 2 rounds of RPG rocket fire from YD 300674. Called 105mm artillery mission, with unknown results; the area will be swept at first light.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), received four rounds of sniper fire from YD 285755. Returned fire with 90mm from Tanks, 40mm duster (M-42) and 50 cal machinegum.

From 300510H to 300530H, CoⁿAⁿ LP, at Camp Kistler, heard sounds like those of someone crawling. At 0530 one persons was seen and engaged by the LP. Results unknown, area will be searched at first light.

With the assistance of a Kit Carson Scout, the R&S Co patrol south, in-vestigated a possible booby trapped area near Vinh Hea Phong (YD 375650). The patrol discovered 16 punji pits and destroyed them in place.

Searched the area of the LP's contact, at 300530H, with negative results.

H&S Co patrol, while returning to the CP, found a pair of boots simular to NVA boots and forwarded them to Battalion S-2.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (Y





751), received one round of saniper fire from YD 285759. Returned fire with 40mm duster (M-42).

Co¹¹B¹¹ platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), conducted a 105mm mission on a suspected bunker position/sniper position, at YD 285756. Results unknown.

Two Vietnamese children turned in an 82mm mortar round and were rewarded with 300 piasters, by Battalion S-2.

A Tank, while clearing fields of fire for Oceanview (YD 291751), detonated an AT mine, resulting in minor repairable damage to the Tank.

River patrol boat observed movement at YD 295675. Fired M-79, results unknown.

Battalion CAP Unit, using PPS-6, detected 2-3 people at YD 332711. Co "B", at C-4, firee 12 rounds of 81mm mortars with excellent coverage, results unknown.

Co"A" platoon, at Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670), using SID, detected movement at YD 283674. Fired 60mm mortar, results unknown.

Battalion CAP Unit patrol, discovered 8 persons, in a house, in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 336702). The Village Chief believes they are VC sympathizers. Detained the 8 for interrogation by Battalion S-2.

River patrol boat, received 2 rounds of RPG fire from YD 278647. Returned fire with 50 cal machinegum and 60mm mortar; results unknown.


