PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- The Napoleon/Saline II AO was enlarged on 2 November and placed under the operational control of the 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), of the United States Army. The 1st AmTrac Battalion was delegated with responsibility for that portion of the Napoleon/Saline II AO designated AO Green (formerly Napoleon/Saline AO). Company C, 3d Tank Battalion, was under the operational control of the 1st AmTrac Battalion until 4 November and was deployed in the vicinity of My Loc (YD 308683). Elements of the company provided reinforcement for units at other positions in the AO and security for mechan ized patrols and convoys. On O41200H November, ist AmTrac Battalion, returned operational control of Company C, 3d Tank Battalion, to 3d Marine Division and on 041800H November, 1st AmTrac Battalion, assumed operational control of 1st Platoon, Company C, 3d Tank Battalion. On 20 November, Company A, 1st of the 61st Infantry (Mechanized), was placed under the operational control of 1st AmTrac Battalion and continued until 23 November, at which time operational control of the unit was returned to 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), United States Army. Various teams from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion were under the operational control of 1st AmTrac Battalion, throughout the month. The 2d Platoon, 1st Armored Amphibian Company, provided direct support artillery and harrassment and interdiction fires for units operating throughout the AO.
- 2. Camp KISTLER received fourteen rounds of incoming artillery this month, all of which were received on 1 November. The artillery attack resulted in minimal damage and two minor WIA, not requiring medical evacuation.
- 3. Tracked vehicle mining incidents occured three times this month. On 5 November, an LVTP-5 detonated an AT mine, at YD 304679, resulting in major damage to the vehicle and no casualties. On 6 November, an LVTP-5 detonated an AT mine, at YD 307682. Again the results were major damage and no casualties. On 22 November, an armored personnel carrier, belonging to Company A, 1st of the 61st Infantry (Mechanized), United States Army, detonated an AT mine, at YD 306684, resulting in total loss of the vehicle and three minor WIA.
- 4. Casualties within the Battalion were light, with only four Marines wounded. Two of those wounded received their wounds during the artillery attack of 1 November and two received their wounds during the enemy contact of the morning of 30 November. The two wounded on 30 November, were evacuated to 3d Medical Battalion, in Quang Tri.



- 8. Headquarters and Service Company, 1st AmTrac Battalion, conducted numerous day patrols/night ambuses in the southern portion of AO Green. The Company also supplied security elements for supply convoys, transporting building materials for the Gia Dang Resettlement Village project, from the Cua Viet Port Facility, at Camp KISTLER, to the project site (YD 460590). On 29 November, nine LVTP-5s from the Company were dispatched in support of an operation being conducted by 1st Battalion, 3d Marines, in the area west of Dong Ha bridge. Upon completion of their assigned mission, the Headquarters and Service Company LVTs were released and returned to Camp KISTLER (30 November). Reconnaissance teams, from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion were also employed throughout the AO south of Camp KISTLER.
- 9. The Combined Action Company, consisting of one platoon of Marines, from 1st AmTrac Battalion and three platoons of POP-ULAR FORCES Troops, continues consolidations of their two Command Posts (YD 314688 & YD 338703) and the Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 321700). During its operations for the month, the unit conducted a total of 56 day patrols and 74 night patrols/ambushes, resulting in 1 friendly WIA and 1 Viet Cong killed. The unit conducted numerous MedCAPs of the Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village area, treating a total of 804 persons. A 65 foot observation tower was completed, enabling the unit to maintain constant and accurate surveillance of the natural routes of approach to the village and is manned by personnel from the unit. A movie screen was constructed in the Kuan Khanh area for the use of the villagers. The Combined Action Company has continued to improve relations with the Vietnamese civilians in the village area.
- 10. LVTs were used extensively this month. A total of 1648.4 tons of cement, 73.5 tons of tin, 89 pallets of barbed wire and 91 bundles of engineering stakes were transported from Cua Viet Port Facility, at Camp KISTLER to the Gia Dang Resettlement Village project site (YD 460590). LVTs were also used, in support of the Gia Dang project, to relocate civilians, from the area around Gia Dang Village into the village. The major portion of supplies, necessary to support the assigned missions of units operating in the AO, were also transported by LVT. Additionally, LVTs were utilized on many occasions, to assist elements of Task Force Clearwater, in dry docking various river craft for repairs.
- 11. Reported sightings of unidentified flying objects were

- 5. Numerous combat patrols and operations were conducted during the month. A total of 131 day patrols, 13 of which were mechanized and 251 night patrols, the majority of which culminated in ambushes, were conducted. On 20 November, Company A, 1st of the 61st Infantry (Mechanized), United States Army, arrived in the AO, and were deployed immediately in the western AO, where the unit conducted operations consisting of night ambushes, mechanized patrols and search and destroy operations, generally along the Cua Viet River.
- 6. Company A, 1st AmTrac Battalion (dismounted), commenced operations in the area of My Loc and Mai Xa Thi East (Jones Creek outpost), on 3 November. The Company was reinforced by 60mm mortars, both at Jones Creek outpost (YD 286670) and My Loc (YD 308683). The Company conducted mechanized patrols, infantry patrols, night ambushes and search and destroy missions, paying special attention to the area along the Cua Viet River and Mai Xa Thi (YD 270660). During operations the unit discovered and destroyed numerous bunkers of all types, some old and deteriorated and some recently constructed, which contained gear, giving evidence of enemy activity in the area. On 29 November, Company A, supplied one LVTP-5 and one LVTP-5 (Command) to join with H & S Company LVTs, in support of an operation conducted by 1st Battalion, 3d Marines. Both vehicles remained with 1st Battalion, 3d Marines, upon the release of the H & S Company elements. Additionally, reconnaissance teams from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion, were utilized in the Company A portion of the AO.
- 7. Company B, 1st AmTrac Battalion, continued consolidation of Base Area C-4 and Oceanview outpost (YD 291751), in support of Operation Duel Blade. The unit was reinforced by Tanks from Company C, 3d Tank Battalion; one section of M-42 (40mm dusters), from 1st of the 44th Artillery Group, United States Army; Target Aquisition Teams, from F Battery, 26th Artillery, United States Army; Naval Gunfire Spotter Teams, from 12th Merines and 81mm mortars, from H & S Company, 1st AmTrac Battalion. During its operations for the month, the unit requested/conducted 45 fire missions on enemy sighted, bunker/ trench line complexes and suspected enemy troop concentration/ staging areas. The Company had sightings of enemy infiltrators on 25 occasions totaling 180 personnel. These sightings were accomplished both visually and with PPS-5 and PPS-6 radar. On 28 November, one platoon of Company B, with demolitions personnel, conducted a sweep of the Ha Loi Trung area (YD 280760), where enemy activity and new construction of enemy bunkers had been reported. Several old bunkers and dud artillery rounds were discovered and destroyed during the course of this oper-Reconnaissance teams, from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion, were also utilized in the Company B portion of the AO, in areas



practically non-existant this month, with sightings being reported on only two occasions. The sightings continued to be reported in the area of the mouth of the Ben Hai River and generally toward the vicinity of Tiger Island.

12. The Battalion Civic Affairs Officer and the Battalion MedCAP Team (i.e., medical and dental personnel), conducted numerous MedCAPs this month, treating 931 persons and distributing 530 bars of soap. Emphasis has been placed mainly on the Gio Hai Resettlement Village (northern AO). The school project in Kuan Khanh continues, showing progress. The Gio Hai Village Self-help Cadreman, is soon to become foreman of the school project, with technical advise being provided by this battalion. Additionally, the 3d Marine Division Band performed a concert for the villagers early this month and other concerts are being scheduled for the future. The Trieu Van Village (southern AO) remains stable in its security and continues to maintain friendly relations with United States Forces. The villagers of Pho Hoi and Ha Tay Hamlets (adjoining hamlets), organized and put into effect, their own volenteer police force, dedicated to keeping the area free of NVA/VC personnel. The 1st AmTrac Battalion, in conjunction with Coastal Group 11 (NRVN), exploits this village for numerous and valuable intelligence reports. The Battalion continues to augment the existing school, of the village, with school kits, when ever educational supplies are needed.

13. On 1 November, Lt Gen WALT, Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps, Lt Gen KNICKERSON, Deputy Chief of Staff for Manpower and party visited Camp KISTLER and were briefed on current operations, projects and the situation in the Napoleon/ Saline II AO. On 2 November, Maj Gen DRAKE, Deputy Commander, XXIV Corps, visited Camp KISTLER, for a briefing on the situation in the AO. On 6 November, Maj Gen DAVIS, Commanding General, 3d Marine Division, visited Camp KISTLER and the Combined Action Company Command Post for a briefing on operations in the area. On 9 November, Maj Gen DAVIS attended Marine Corps Birthday festivities, at Camp KISTLER. On 10 November, the 3d Marine Division Band, visited Camp KISTLER, and conducted a concert. On 12 November, Major SHALIKASHNILI, of the United States Army, Senior Advisor for the Gia Dang Resettlement Village and Major CHEU, of the Army of the Republic of Viet Nam, Chief of the Gia Dang Resettlement Village, visited Camp KISTLER, to discuss the relocation of Vietnamese civilians in the Gia Dang area. Also on 12 November, Major SLAVEY, of the United States Army, Senior Advisor to the Gio Linh Subsector, visited the Battalion for a conference with the Battalion S-3. On 13 November, Maj Gen DAVIS, Maj Gen DRAKE, Col GIBSON, Commanding Officer, 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), United States Army and staff, visited Camp KISTLER, to





attend the Change of Command Ceremony, when Lt Col G. F. MEYERS was relieved by Lt Col W. W. DAMEWOOD Jr.. On 14 November, Col GIBSON, again visited Camp KISTLER, for an updating briefing on the situation in the AO and on 20 November the Colonel visted the Battalion to discuss an operation plan. On 22 November, Maj Gen DRAKE, visited Camp KISTLER, to present the Bronze Star Medal, to 1st It RAMKIN, his aid, who received the award for action performed while a member of the 1st AmTrac Battalion. After the presentation, Maj Gen DRAKE was briefed on the current progress of the transportation of cement and other building supplies from Cua Viet Port Facility, at Camp KISTLER, to the Gia Dang Resettlement Village project site. The 26 Maj Gen DRAKE again visited the Battalion for a discussion of the Gia Dang suppy mission. Also on the 26th Colonel LETELLE, Engineer Officer, XXIV Corps, visited Camp KISTLER, for a briefing and discussion of the transportation of building supplies to the Gia Dang project. On 28 November, Brig Gen CARNEY, Assistant Division Commander, 3d Marine Division, visited Camp KISTLER for a briefing of the current situation in the AO and a tour of the area. Commanding Generals inspection was conducted 17 - 23 November. Overall Battalion rating: satisfactory with discrepancies.

14. Numerous cantonment maintenance projects were initiated during the month in conjunction with the continuation of projects started the previous month. The project to rewire Camp KISTLERS electrical system, to provide a more efficent and trouble free system, has been continued with approximately 60 percent of the camp now operating on the new system. recently constructed bridge across one of the most troublesome drainage areas of Camp KISTLER has been upgraded by the installation of a pole and chain guard fence along the edges of the bridge and the addition of a hard surface across the bridge, to minimize weather deterioration. Protection of the existing ammunition storage area has been improved by the forming of large berms of sand, encompassing the facility. On 24 November, construction of a new Edlisted Mens Club was initiated. The new structure will afford a more relaxed atmosphere, with larger seating areas, inside the club and will include a seperate section for Sergeants. On 28 November, a walkway, between the 1st AmTrac Battalion Headquarters area and the helicopter pad (LZ CACTUS) was installed to provide easier and more rapid movement to and from the pad and its location lends itself to ready access into and out of the Battalion Aid Station emergency entrance.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), in conjunction with reconnaissance team (Deer Fern), called a 105mm artillery mission on YD 276674, where it was believed there were 3 NVA in a bunker. Mission began at 010015H. First round resulted in small secondaries; fire mission was continued until 010340H, resulting in a total of 55 secondary explosions. AO requested at first light. Co"B" elements, with reconnaissance team (Deer Fern), will search the area.


Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), heard noises and observed movement, at YD 290749. Fired 30 cal machinegun and small arms. Will search the area at first light.


From 010758H to 010805H, Camp Kistler, received 6 rounds of medium artillery from the vicinity of YD 250834. Counterbattery called from A-2 position; results unknown. Minimal damage and no casualties resulted from the artillery attack.

Elements of Co"A", with 8 LVTs, departed Camp KISTLER, transporting 80,000 pounds of cement, to the Gia Dang project site (YD 460590).

From 010855 to 010905H, Camp KISTLER, received 4 rounds of medium artillery, from unknown location. No casualties and minimal damage resulted. NGF counterbattery was conducted on suspected artillery position, in the YD 2583 grid. Three secondary explosions were reported from the counterbattery.

From 011050H to 011105H, Camp KISTLER, received 4 rounds of medium artillery from YD 249837. Results were 2 minor WIA and minimal damage. NGF counterbattery was fired; results unknown.





Elements of Co"A", conducted a search of YD 276764 (area where fire mission resulting in numerous secondaries, from 010015H to 010340H). The unit discovered one 82mm mortar round, 30 rounds M-79 ammo and large amounts of debris in the area.

LtGen Walt, Assistant Commandant of the Marine Corps, Lt. Gen Knickerson, G-1, Headquarters Marine Corps and party, visited Camp KISTLER, for a briefing on current operations, events and the situation in the NAPOLEON/SALINE II AO.

Co"A" LVT convoy (six LVTs, w/security squad from H&S Co), departed CP, en route to Gia Dang project site (YD 460 590), transporting 62,500 pounds of cement.

2 November 1968

Elements of Co"A" (14 LVTs), departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site, transporting 140,000 pounds of cement.


Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, paid 300 piasters, to a VN child, for turning in one M-79 round and one M-26 grenade.

Battalion MedCAP Team, conducted a routine MedCAP of Pho Hoi Hamlet (YD 336689), treating 50 persons and issuing 40 bars of soap.

Co"A" CP, now located at My Loc (YD 308683), with reinforced platoon of Co"A", continuing to man the platoon outpost at Mai Xa Thi east (Jones Creek) (YD 286670).

As of this date, NAPOLEON/SALINE II in under the control of 1st Brig, 5th Div (Mech), USA. 1st AmTrac Battalion occupies the portion of the NAPOLEON/SALINE II AO named AO GREEN.

MajGen Drake, Deputy Commander, XXIV Corps, visited Camp KISTLER, for an up-







date briefing by the Battalion Commander.

Elements of Co"A" departed Camp KISTLER, with 9 LVTs, transporting 90,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang Resettlement Village.

Elements of Co B, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), reported 5 60mm mortar rounds impacting at YD 279759. Elements of Co B observing for further information.

3 November 1968

Elements of Co^HB^H, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 3-5 suspected NVA, at YD 313731. Contact was lost before action could be initiated.

Co"B" patrol discovered a 3 bunker complex and a tunnel, at YD 282763. Found in the bunkers were 12 band-oleres of M-16 ammo, 1 AP mine, 2 4.2 mortar casings unfired, 1 long range C-ration (opened with contents still dry). In addition, spotted 3 NVA carrying packs; did not make contact. The bunkers were destroyed with demolitions and grenades. One secondary explosion was experienced.

LVT convoy, consisting of 4, Co"A" LVTs, 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles and a security squad from H&S Co, departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 90,000 pounds of cement.

LVT convoy, consisting of 6 LVTP-5s and 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles, departed CP, enroute to Gia Bang project site (YD 460590), transporting 60,000 pounds of cement.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 5 rounds of estimated 60mm mortar, impact, at YD 284757. Origin of the rounds unknown.

using PPS-5 rader, detected an unidentified target (possessing properties of mechanical rhythm), at YD 307
709. Fired 81mm mortars and called
105mm artillery mission. Target remained after mission. Bn CAC Unit
checked the area, with negative results.

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 10 to 15 NVA, who were also sighted from the C-4 tower, from YD 296708 to YD 295 701. Fired 81mm mortars and called 105mm artillery mission with good coverage. Area will be searched at first light.

4 November 1968

Elements of CAC Unit, while conducting a sweep, in the vicinity of YD 302690, discovered an NVA flag, with powder burns and dried blood stains, on a freshly cut, 10-12 foot bambo pole, 2 recently made mounds ½ foot high and ½ foot wide, one mound contained a mine, with a trip wire attached to a near by bush and five sets of foot prints. Removed flag from the pole and blew the suspected mine, which was later discovered to be a ceramic pot with explosives and an M-26 grenade attached to the trip wire.

LVT convoy, with 9 LVTs, 1 LVTH-6 security vehicle and security squad from H&S Co, departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 90,000 pounds of cement.

1st AmTrac Bn, returned OpCon of Co "C", 3rd Tank Bn to 3rd MarDiv.

Reconnaissance team (Big Shot), discovered 1 RPG rocket round, at ND 303675. The round was apparently a dud, as it had been fired. EOD team was dispatched and destroyed the round.

1st AmTrac Bn assumed OpCon of 1st Platoon, Co"C", 3rd Tank Bn.



Elements of Co[#]B[#], discovered and destroyed an 81mm dud at YD 325719.

CAC Unit patrol, while returning to their CP, heard a civilian type radio, observed a fire, with an unknown number of people near it and heard the sound of a small gasoline engine, at YD 316704. As the patrol moved closer, the people ran. The patrol fired 40 rounds of M-16, with negative results. A search of the area revealed nothing.

Co"A", squad ambush, at YD 272667, observed 3 persons approximately 300 meters southwest of their position. Called 60mm and 105mm missions. Swept area with negative results.

5 November 1968

Navy NOC, reported sighting 3 swimmers, at YD 328697, across from the LST ramp. Fired 2 rounds of M-79 and observed 3 persons running west, on the north bank of the river. Notified CAC Unit, who checked the area with negative results.

LVT convoy, consisting of 12 LVTP-5s, 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles and security squad from H&S Co, departed the CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 120,000 pounds of cement.

LVT convoy, while returning to CP from Gia Dang (YD 460590), picked up a Vietnamese male, suffering from a gunshot wound, received from an unidentified boat at sea. The man was medevaced to Quang Tri.

LVT convoy, consisting of 5 LVTP-5s and 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles, departed the CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 50,000 pounds of cement.

An LVT, while crossing the river near My Loc (YD 308683), detonated an explosive device of undetermined nature, causing minor damage to the vehicle and no casualties. Search of the area revealed no indication of a mino.

LVT convoy, consisting of 7 LVTP-5s and security squad from H&S Co, departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 70,000 pounds of cement.

From 060900H to 061100H, Battalion S-5 and medical personnel conducted a Med CAP of Xuan Khanh Resettlement Hamlet (YD 323700), treating 75 persons and distributing 50 bars of soap.

LVT convoy, consisting of 13 LVTP-5s and 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles, departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590), transporting 130,000 pounds of cement.

MajGen R. G. Davis, CG, 3d MarDiv, visited Camp KISTLER and the Battalion CAC Unit CP for a briefing on the current situation in the AO.

Co "A" LVT (A-35), detonated an AT mine, at YD 307682, causing suspension damage and a hole in the hull of the vehicle and no casualties.

LVT convoy, consisting of 9 LVTs, departed CP, enroute to Gia Dang project (YD 460590), transporting 90,000 pounds of cement.

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 3-5 per sons, at YD 29657095. Called 105mm artillery mission and dispatched recon team (Jacksonville) to check the area, who discovered foot prints of approximately 3 persons leading to the north.

7 November 1968

Fourteen LVTP-5s were utilized to transport 158,000 pounds of cement, from Camp KISTLER to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

8 November 1968

A convoy of 6 LVTP-5s transported 39,000 pounds of tin, to Gia Dang project (YD) 460590).

Received report of sighting of 15 Vietnamese persons, with weapons, heading north, at YD 362664. Passed report to H&S Co patrol, in that area, who accomplished no sighting.

CAC Unit patrol, while moving to night position, received 2 rounds of small arms fire from an old house, in the vicinity of YD 325708. Returned fire and observed 3-4 people flee to the north. The patrol investigated further with negative results.

CAC Unit patrol, set up in the area of earlier contact (YD 325708) and sent 1 man to scout the area. The man observed one NVA/VC, fired a hand illumination and threw a gragmentation grenade, with unknown results.

9 November 1968

Elements of ComBm, at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected 8 people at YD 321712 and had a weak unidentifiable target, with evidence of a radio beam, at YD 32257146. Fired 81mm mortars, at first target, and 105mm artillery, at second target; results unknown.

Three LVTP-5s escorted 2 self-propelled Armored Wehicle Landing Bridges, from Camp KISTLER to Gia Dang Resettlement Village (YD 460590).

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, tracked a group of 5-10 NVA/VC, from YD 299705 to YD 310 708. CAC Unit ambush in the area was dispatched in an attempt to intercept the group, making contact, at YD 310 705. A small amount of small arms fire was exchanged and the contact was broken. Co"A" reaction force joined with the CAC Unit patrol and conducted a search of the area with negative results.

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, detected 10-20 NVA, at YD 293708. Fired 48 rounds of 105mm firecracker, with unknown results.

10 November 1968

Reconnaissance team (Witty Ordeal), observed two lights, at YD 293687. Co "A", at My Loc (YD 308683), fired 60mm mortar mission. Lights disappeared, further results unknown.

River patrol boats reported receiving RPG rocket fire from YD 300675. Go"A", at My Loc (YD 308683) fired 60mm mortars, with unknown results. Elements of Co"A", conducting a sweep of the area.

Elements of Co"B", at C-4 position, using PPS-5 radar, detected a group of 10 persons, at YD 288723. Fired 81mm mortar mission and called 105mm mission, with unknown results.

Co"A" elements completed a sweep of the area of contact at 100235H, with negative findings. Will sweep the area again at first light.

The 3rd Marine Division Band, visited







Camp Kistler, to play a concert for the Marine Corps personnel, in celebration of the Marine Corps Birthday.

Elements of the Bn CAC Unit, while searching the area of contact, at 092037H, discovered 1 NVA KIA, with 1 ChiCom grenade, 1 AK-47 and 2 AK-47 magazines.

H&S Co patrol south, detained a VN male with suspicious identification, at YD 364663. S-2 conducted a field interrogation at the scene. It was believed that the individual possibly had information about VC in the area. The detainee was returned to Camp KISTLER for further investigation.

11 November 1968

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), using starlight scope, observed 10 NVA, at YD 289734, moving northwest to YD 277756. Tanks fired 7 rounds of 90mm beehive and 105mm artillery mission was called in. Target disappeared, results unknown.

Reconnaissance team (witty Ordeal), observed 1 persons sitting in the tree line, at YD 286687. Fired M-79 with negative results.



River patrol boats reported enemy movement, at YD 295666. Elements of CoⁿAⁿ swept area of the movement, with negative results.

Elements of Co"A", had sighting of 7 to 10 NVA/VC, moving north from YD 292675 to YD 292679. Co"A" fired 9 M-79 rounds, 36 60mm mortar HE and 5 illumination, results unknown.

Major Shalikashnili, Senior Advisor, Gia Dang Resettlement Village, (USA) and Major Cheu, District Chief, Gia Dang Resettlement Village area (ARVN), visited Camp KISTLER for a briefing and discussion of the moving of Vietnamese civilians, to Gia Dang Resettlement Village from the area in the vicinity of the Village.

A Vietnamese child turned in an M-79 round to the H&S Co patrol south. The child was rewarded with 100 piaster.

Major Slavey, Senior Advisor, Gio Linh District, Quang Tri Province, visited Camp KISTLER, for a conference with the Battalion S-3.

Received message stating: 2nd ARVN Regiment, will have all that portion,





of AO Green, west of Jones Creek, until 152400H Nov 68.

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, had sighting of lights, at YD 331711, moving north. Lights went out, then reappeared still moving north. The patrol then heard shots and returned fire. A sweep of the area revealed nothing.

13 November 1968

MajGen R. D. Davis, CG, 3d MarDiv, MajGen Drake, DepCom, KXIV Corps, Col Gibson, CO, 1st Brig, 5th Div (Mech) and staff, visited Camp KISTLER to attendethe Change of Command Ceremony.

LtCol W. W. Damewood Jr. received the colors from LtCol G. F. Meyers.

From 130900H to 131100H, Battalion S-5 and medical personnel conducted a routine MedCAP of Long Ha Hamlet (YD 315 688), treating 50 persons and distributing 60 bars of soap.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751), requested a 105mm artillery mission, on a bunker complex/supply storage area, at YD 279759. Good target coverage.

From 130740H to 131805H, H&S Co patrols conducted searches of Vinh Hoa Hamlet (YD 342654) and Ha Tay Mot (YD 358674). The search of Vinh Hoa revealed nothing while the search of Ha Tay Mot produced 3 60mm mortar rounds and 7 detainees, one of which was believed to be a Viet Cong tax collector. The detainees were forwarded to Battalion S-2 for further investigation.

14 November 1968

Col Gibson, CO, 1st Brig, 5th Div (Mech), USA, visited Camp KISTLER and was briefed on the current situation in the AO.

H&S Co LVTs transported 28 pallets of barbed wire to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).



Recommaissance team (Witty Ordeal), discovered and destroyed an RPG rocket round at YD 301681.

Six of the 7 detaineds detained at 131800H, were released as innocent civilians. The seventh of the detaineds still being interrogated.

Coastal Group 11, reported having detained 7 Vietnamese, as Viet Cong Sus pects. One of the 7 is a confirmed VC.

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit and Task Force Clearwater, reported rounds impacting in the YD 3469 grid. NGF was conducting a fire mission at the same time and was put in check fire.

15 November 1968

Co"A" LVTs transported 71 bundles of engineering stakes and 40,000 pounds of cement, to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).



LVT convoy of 10 LVTs, transporting 100,000 pounds of cement, departed the CP, enroute to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

Reconnaissance team (Dock Leaf) discovered and destroyed 1 60mm morter round, at YD 305669.

Eight LVTs, transported 80,000 pounds of cement, to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported seeing lights, at an altitude of 500 to 1000 feet, moving north, in the vicinity of YD 269 748. Lights appeared to be those of a helicopter.

Tower, at C-4 position, had a sighting of 4 lights at YD 309725. Fired 81mm mortar mission and lights were no longer visible.

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, while checking the area, in the vicinity of YD 328700, found 1 NVA canteen and one Vietnamese male with a fake ID. The Vietnamese was detained and forwarded to Battalion S-2 for interrogation.

17 November 1968

Elements of Co"A", at My Loc (YD 308693), observed 3 NVA/VC, moving from east to west, in the vicinity of YD 305687. A sweep and search of the area revealed nothing.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 5-10 NVA/VC, at YD 294708 and YD 289725. Attempted to intercept







them with reconnaissance team ambush with negative results. Unable to fire 81mm mortar, at this time, due to rain.

River patrol boat reported receiving 2 rounds of RPG fire, from YD 275653, resulting in negative damage to the boat. Patrol boat returned fire with 50 cal and M-60 machineguns. Results unknown.

Elements of Co"A", at My Loc, using PPS-5 radar, detected a group of NVA/VC, moving in a northerly direction, in the vicinity of YD 305688 to YD 307690. Executed fire mission with 60mm mortar. Good target coverage, results unknown.

Commodore Swarztrauber, Task Force Clearwater, visited Camp KISTLER, and was briefed by the Battalion S-3.

Elements of 1st AmTrac Battalion, departed the CP, with 5 LVTP-5s, transporting 50,000 pounds of cement to the Gia Dang project (YD 460590).





Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported Observing 2 lights, which were believed to be lanterns, in the YD 2482 grid.

19 November 1968

Nine LVTP-5s, accompanied by 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles, transported 90,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590).

Seven LVTP-5s transported 70,000 pounds of cement from Camp KISTLER, to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

MajGen R. G. Davis, Commanding General, 3rd Marine Division, visited Camp KIST-LER, for an updating and an inspection of the area.

The Vietnamese detained at 131805H Nov 68, was released as an innocent civilian.

Forward Observer, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), called a 105mm artillery mission on bunkers, at YD 28217684. Two bunkers were destroyed.

A PF, informed the Battalion CAC Unit, of the location of a mine, which was discovered by the villagers. The mine was recovered for investigative action. The villagers were paid 500 dollars VN, for the information.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported observing a light, which appeared to be a headlight, moving southeast,

in the vicinity of YD 256889.

Elements of Co"A", observed 3 lights, from YD 310658 to YD 325659. River patrol boats checked the area, finding nothing.

The team set in for observation of the area and received small arms fire from an unknown location, some of which impacted in the teams radio, rendering it inoperable. Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), requested a 105mm artillery mission, on bunkers at YD 288762, results unknown.

Co"A", 1st of the 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA, conducted a sweep from YD 299685 to YD 300687, discovering and destroying 1 "A" frame bunker and 1 "L" shaped bunker. One NVA shirt with blood stains and drag marks were also found.

Elements of CoⁿAⁿ, 1st of the 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA, discovered and destroyed 5 concrete bunkers and 7 ⁿAⁿ frame bunkers, in the vicinity of YD 288692.

Three Vietnamese children, turned in an RPG-7 sight, in excellent condition, to Co"A" elements, at YD 300675. Payment was made to the children for the sight

which was retained by Battalion S-2 for intelligence value.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 2 search lights, in the vicinity of the YD 2588 grid and YD 2585 grid.

22 November 1968

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, had a sighting of 4 NVA/VC, at YD 315695, heading north. Fire mission was called (105mm), with negative results.

Fourteen LVTP-5s transported 140,000 pounds of cement, from Camp KISTLER, to Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

From 220900H to 221200H, Battalion S-5 and medical personnel, conducted a MedCAP, in the vicinity of YD 280630, treating 50 persons and distributing 20 bars of soap.


Reconnaissance team (Alexander), discovered and destroyed a 105mm dud, a 155mm dud and 1 "L" shaped bunker, at YD 283753.

Sometime during the hours of 222000H and 230800H, the 2 Vietnamese detaines, reported on spot rep 221510H, Nov 68, were mistreated by their sentries. Investigation initiated by Detachment "B", 15th C.I.T., in conjunction with the investigation being conducted by 1st AmTrac Battalion S-2.

From 230900H to 231100H, Battalion S-5 and the Battalion MedCAP Team, conducted a routine MedCAP in Pho Hoi Hamlet (YD 335688), treating 60 persons and distributing 80 bars of soap.

At 231200H Nov 68, 1st AmTrac Battalion returned OpCon of Co"A", 1stof the 61st Infantry (Mechanized) to 1st Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), USA.

Battalion CAC Unit, conducted a routine MedCAP in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Ham-let (YD 331700), treating 111 persons.

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), using PPS-5 radar, detected 3 NVA/VC, at YD 286725 and later at YD 286704. An attempt to intercept the group with reconnaissance team (August Night) was made, with negative results.

24 November 1968

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, using PPS-5 radar, detected 3 NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 319698, traveling from north to south, towards the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Hamlet (YD 331700). Dispatched patrol to check the area and set an ambush with negative results.

PBRs reported a mine detonating at YD 305675. No casualties resulted. It is believed that the mine was possibly command detonated. A search of the north bank of the river was conducted immediately, by elements of Co"A", with negative results.

25 November 1968

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), reported lights, which appeared to be





headlights, moving east to west, at YD 256889. Observation was made by 1st Lt M. I. Peterson, 0104422.

Reconnaissance team (Penguin), discovered a new bunker complex being constructed, at YD 289755.

Co"B", at C-4 position, reported approximately 250 civilians, in their trash dump area, within their outer wire. Attempts to tell the people to leave failed. Co"B" fired 81mm WP, in the vicinity of the trash dump causing the people to leave.


Aerial Observer, working north of Oceanview (YD 291751), fired 10 smoke rockets, at a bunker complex, at YD 289755. The complex had been discovered by reconnaissance team (Penguin) earlier. The reconnaissance team was dispatched, upon the departure of the AO, to check out the area, discovering and destroying 1 bunker, 3 expended RPG rounds and 1 5 inch round.

Battalion S-2 dispatched a Marine to the Battalion trash dump area to purchase Marijuana cigarettes. The Marpurchased 60 cigarettes, for 20 dollars (MPC), from a 12 year old girl. After the transaction, the girl was taken into custody and forwarded to Coastal Group 11 (NRVN) for further disposition.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), observed 1 NVA, at YD 289755. NGF spot team, called in a NGF mission, with unknown results.

Reconnaissance team (Penguin), observed 4 men carrying what appeared to be a body, at YD 289755. The reconnaissance team followed the men and were taken under fire by an ambush of unknown size. The team returned fire, broke contact and returned to Oceanview (YD 291751). Once at Oceanview, the team called 105mm artillery, 90mm from tanks, 40mm M-42 and 60mm mortar missions. The missions resulted in one secondary; further results unknown.





26 November 1968

Eight LVTs from H&S Co and 2 LVTH-6 security vehicles, departed CP, en-route to Gia Dang project (YD 460590), transporting 80,000 pounds of cement.

Fourteen LVTB-5s transported 140,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang project.

Reconnaissance team (Penguin), conducted a search of the area of contact at 252005H, in the vicinity of YD 289758, with the following results: discovered one syringe, one 5 inch dud and the foot prints of approximately 4 persons heading north.

A Vietnamese woman was injured in the Camp KISTLER trash dump area. The woman was treated at BAS and medevaced to Quang Tri. SIR submitted.

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, conducted a routine MedCAP, in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Hamlet, treating 127 Vietnamese civilians

Col Letelle, the Engineer Officer, XXIV Corps, visited Camp KISTLER, to discuss the movement of cement to the Gia Dang project (YD 460590).

MajGen Drake, USMC, Deputy Commander, XXIV Corps, visited Camp KISTLER, for a briefing and discussion on the cement supply project (YD 460590).

Elements of Co"B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 2 lights at YD 252835.

Seven LVTP-5s and security element, transported 70,000 pounds of cement.

27 November 1968

River patrol boats, reported sighting 2 red light, at YD 314675. Lights were no longer sighted after the mission.







Elements of 1st AmTrac Battalion, patrolling the area of YD 274689, discovered and destroyed 4 bunkers with communication wire running into them.

Ten LVTP-5s, transported 10,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang project (YD 460 590).

Six LVTP-5s, transported 60,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang project (YD 460 590).

Elements of 1st AmTrac Battalion, sighted 3 NVA/VC, wearing packs and uniforms, moving north-northwest, from YD 251707. Passed sighting to 2nd ARVN Regiment, at A-1 position, who are in control of that area.

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, conducted a routine MedCAP, in Xuan Khanh, treating 50 Vietnamese civilians.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 4 NVA/VC, on the beach, at YD 270786.

Six USA M-548s arrived at Camp KISTLER, to assist the Battalion in transporting cement to Gia Dang project.



Four M-548s (Army), departed the CP, enroute to Gia Dang (YD 460590), transporting 40,000 pounds of cement.

Brig Gen Carney, ADC, 3d MarDiv, visited Camp KISTLER, for a briefing and a tour of the area.

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291751), sighted 5 NVA, on the beach, at YD 260 804.

29 November 1968

Elements of the Battalion CAC Unit, sighted 2 NVA/VC, moving south from YD 322698. One was carrying a rifle. Fired M-60 machinegun at target and lost sighting. A search of the area revealed nothing.

Four M-548s (Army), transported 40,000 pounds of cement to the Gia Dang project site (YD 460590).

Eleven LVTP-5s, transported 110,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang project site (YD 460590).

Nine LVTP-5s, from H&S Co with 1 LVTP-5 and 1 LVTP-5 (CMD), from Co"A", departed the CP, to link up with 1st Bn, 3d Mar Regt. Vehicles to be utilized in support of operation to be conducted west of the Dong Ha bridge, for approximately 2 days.

Lt Col Mooney, Senior Advisor, Gia Dang Resettlement Village (YD 460590), arrived at Camp KISTLER.





Three M-548s (Army), transported15,000 pounds of cement to Gia Dang (YD 460 590).

Co"B" platoon, at Oceanview (YD 291 751), sighted 15 NVA, at YD 268751, moving south. Conducted 81mm mortar fire mission, results unknown.

Elements of Co"A", had a visual sighting of 5-6 NVA/VC, in the vicinity of YD 295672. Committed the reaction force from Co"A" to sweep area, with recon team (Parasol) set in as blocking force to the north.

30 November 1968


Co"A" patrol made contact, at YD 301673, receiving 2 ChiCom grenades, resulting in 2 WIA. Co"A" and H&S Co reaction forces were dispatched. Co"A" fired 60mm mortars in support of their patrol, results unknown.

Six LVTP-5s transported 52,500 pounds of cement to Gia Dang (YD 460590).

From 300650H to 300930H, elements of Co"A" and H&S Co, conducted a sweep of the area of contact, at 300001H (YD 301673), discovering 4 NVA packs, 3 entrenching tools, 1 inner tube, 2 life jackets, 1 snorkle, 1 basket 24 inches in diameter and 1 foot deep, containing 40 pounds of plastic explosive. Additionally, 1 Vietnamese male was detained, because of what appeared to be blood stains on his shirt. All gear and the detainee were forwarded to Battalion S-2 for investigation.

Nine LVTs from H&S Co, dispatched on 291110H Nov 68, in support of 1st Bn, 3d Mar Regt, returned to CP. The 2 Co"A" LVTs remain with 1st Bn, 3d Mar Regt.

From 300900H to 301100H, Bn S-5 and medical personnel, conducted a routine Med-CAP of Xuan Khanh, treating approximately 50 persons.


Bn CAC Unit conducted a routine Med-CAP of Long Ha Hamlet, treating 150 persons.

Battalion CAC Unit tower, sighted one man moving toward village, at YD 307 694. Fired illumination and swept area with negative findings.

Reconnaissance team (Constitution), sighted 3 persons at YD 277652. Called 105mm artillery mission, with unknown results. While sweeping the area the team discovered 1 AT mine and 1 pack near a hole deep enough to contain the mine. Forewarded gear to Battalion S-2 for investigation.
