#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- The First Amtrac Battalion was under the operational control of Task Force Bravo until 17 January, when at which time it was placed under the operational control of First Infantry Brigade, Fifth Infantry Division (Mechanized), USA. In conjunction with the Opcon change that portion of the Kentucky AO which was maintained by the First Amtrac Battalion was designated a portion of the Marshall Mountain AO. Additionally, all of the AO south of the Cua Viet River, except for the area surrounding Camp KISTLER was given to Company "C", First Battalion, 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA until 19 January, at which time Company "C", First Infantry Battalion, 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA, departed and that southern portion of the AO was returned to First Amtrac Battalion. From 17 January until 22 January, Company "B", First Infantry Battalion, 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA, was under the operational control of First Amtrac Battalion and was utilized in the western portion of the AO. On 27 January, First Amtrac Battalion was returned to the operational control of Task Force Bravo and simultaineously that portion of Marshall Mountain AO, which is maintained by the First Amtrac Battalion, became a part of the Kentucky AO. From 27 January until 31 January First Amtrac Battalion had operational control of Company "K", 3d Battalion, 4th Marines who were deployed in the western portion of the AO. Second Platoon (-), Company "C", 3d Tank Battalion and various teams from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion were under the operational control of First Amtrac Battalion, throughout the month. The second Platoon, First Armored Amphibian Company, provided direct artillery support and harassment and interdiction fire for units operating throughout the AO.
- 2. Camp KISTLER received no incoming rounds of artillery this month.
- 3. There was one mining incident of tracked vehicles this month within the AO. While on a mechanized patrol, an APC of Company "B", First Infantry Battalion, 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA, detonated a mine at YD 271665, resulting in 7 WIAs being medevaced and total destruction of the vehicle. There were also two mining incidents on the Cua Viet River resulting in 1 Civilian KIA, 7 USN KIAs, 3 WIAs medevaced, and 1 MIA consisting of both Navy and Marine personnel.
- 4. Casualties within the Battalion reflected the increase of enemy activity with a total of ten WIAs, nine of which were medevaced.
- 5. Numerous combat patrols and operations were conducted this month. They consisted of 237 day patrols, 17 of which were mechanized and 326 night patrols, the majority of which culminated in ambushes. During the periods of 17 January to 22 January and 27 January to 31 January, the Battalion had operational control of Company "B", First Infantry Battalion, 61st Infantry (Mechanized), USA and Company "K", 3d Battalion, 4th Marines, respectively. Both units were deployed in the western AO, where they conducted extensive operations consisting of day/night patrol ambushes and search and destroy operations in response to the increased enemy activity in that area.







- 6. Company "A", First Amtrac Battalion (dismounted), continued operations in the area of My Loc and Mai Xa Thi (Jones Creek Outpost). The Company was reinforced by 60mm mortars, both at Jones Creek Outpost and My Loc. The Company continued to conduct mechanized patrols, infantry patrols, night ambushes and search and destroy missions concentrating their activities along the Cua Viet River. On 17 January, a reconnaissance team working in the area of Company "A", along with Navy PBRs made contact with an enemy force at YD 268 644. The contact resulted in 4 KIA NVA/VC (c), 1 NVA/VC POW and 2 WIA (friendly medevaced).
- 7. Company "B", First Amtrac Battalion, continued consolidation of base area C-h and Oceanview outpost (YD 291751), in support of Operation Duel Blade. The unit was reinforced by: platoon (-) of tanks, from Company "C", 3d Tank Battalion; one section of M-42 (40mm dusters), from the First of the 44th Artillery Group, USA; Naval Gunfire spotter teams from 12th Marines and 81mm mortars from H&S Company, First Amtrac Battalion. This month the Company requested/conducted two fire missions on enemy troops. On three different occasions the Company had aightings of fourteen enemy infiltrators. These sightings were accomplished both visually and with the aid of electronic night detection devices. The Company conducted numerous day and night patrols actively seeking out infiltration from the north.
- 8. Headquarters and Service Company, First Amtrac Battalion conducted numerous day and night patrols in the southern portion of the AO and along the Cua Viet River near the Company "A" outposts. From 26 January to 30 January, elements of H&S Company, LVT Platoon, moved to the Dai Do area (YD 260630), where they conducted operations.
- 9. The Combined Action Company consisting of one platoon of Marines from First Amtrac Battalion and three platoons of Popular Forces troops, continues consolidation of their two Command posts (YD 314688) and (YD 338703) and the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 321700). During its operations for the month, the unit conducted a total of 29 day patrols and 80 night patrols/ambushes. On 18 January, ARVN Lt Mao Toke took over command of the Popular Forces troops to assist in training and discipline in order to increase their combatt effectiveness. The unit was responsible for the discovery of 3 AT mines, 2 of which were found at YD 306714 on 1 January and 1 found in the same area on 2 January. On 5 January a patrol from the CAC unit while patroling the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village made contact with 3 VC. The action resulted in 2 dead VC females and one friendly NON-MEDEVAC casualty. The unit has continued its efforts to aid and assist, where possible, in all aspects of the "Civil Action Program", throughout the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village.
- 10. LVTs continue to be utilized for mechanized patrols and to transport supplies to outposts within the AO. They additionally have been used on a continuous basis for the transportation of the Battalion MedCAP team and the supplies and equipment necessary to support them. The R&R center, located on the north side of the Cua Viet River, has been continuously resupplied by LVTs. LVTs were used on several occasions to assist the Navy in removing boats beached by heavy seas and in dry dicking various river craft for repair. LVTs were additionally utilized to assist the two boats damaged by mines on 16 January.






- 11. There were no UFO sightings by the Battalion this month.
- 12. The Battalion Civil Affairs Officer has again directed Battalion support to the Gio Hai Village. They have continued to send MedCAP teams and Psyops teams into the Village about twice each week, taking care of medical problems whenever possible and sending more serious cases to the Battalion Aid Station for appropriate care. In regards to public works, two wells have been completed and the school project, with the help of 29th Civic Action Company, has continued, with completion anticipated near the end of March. A dispensary has been constructed in the Village with the aid of the Battalion, and the Battalion Aid Station has supplied medical supplies and information in order to improve medical aid. The Battalion has continued to give aid to the Trieu Van Village in the form of MedCAPs and Psyops operations. The southern Hamlets of the Village have been resettled in a more secure area and in the future elections will be held. This is a big step forward, since in the past, officials were appointed but now will be elected by the villagers.
- 13. On 3 January, Col CLARKE, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp KISTLER for an update briefing on the current situation in the AO. On 4 January, Brig Gen CARNEY, 3d Marine Division and Col GORDON 1st Infantry Brigade, 5th Infantry Division (Mechanized), USA, visited Camp KISTLER for an update briefing on the current situation in the AO. On 9 January, Col CLARKE, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp KISTLER to discuss present situation in the AO. On 17 January, Col GIBSON, 1st Infantry Brigade, 5th Division (Mechanized), USA, visited Camp KISTLER to discuss recent OpCon change. On 27 January, Col CLARKE, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp KISTLER for an update briefing. On 31 January, Maj Gen DAVIS, visited Camp KISTLER for an update briefing.
- 14. The cantonment maintenance projects have continued this month to keep Camp KISTIER operational and provide maximum security. The construction of the Enlisted Men's Club and The Post Exchange has been completed and both facilities were opened for the use of the personnel at Camp KISTIER. The improvement of the ammunition storage area has continued with the last of the ammunition being sorted and relocated to the new facility established for same. On 29 January a Helo-Fuel-Lift was initiated between C-4 and Cua Viet in order to insure a constant source of fuel being readily available to the units in that area. The project to rewire Camp KISTIER is still at a stand still because of the lack of personnel and supplies.
- 15. On 10 January, at a ceremony conducted at 3d Marine Division Headquarters, the Commanding Officer, LtCol W. W. DAMEWOOD Jr, accepted in behalf of the First Amtrac Battalion the MERITORIOUS UNIT COMMENDATION, awarded for the period 5 November, 1967 to 27 January, 1968 and presented by the Commandant of the Marine Corps.









### PART III LIST OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 January 1969

Sweep conducted of area reported previously in Spot Report No. 71 (312105H Dec, 68), by elements of CAC unit. Sweep resulted in negative findings.

Elements of CAC unit (provisional rifle co), while conducting sweep of area in vicinity of YD 30670h, discovered 2 AT mines approximately 75 meters apart. Mines disarmed and returned to Battalion S-2

From Oll400H to Ol2100H, Battalion MedCAP team/ Psyops team conducted MedCAP, in the Cua Viet Resettlement Village (YD 343678), treating 145 Vietnamese and distributing 75 bars of soap. Psyops team showed movies of the GVN in action.

Elements of CAC unit patrol assisted by the Engineer Sweep Team from Company "B" at C-4 (YD 310722) discovered 1 AT mine at YD 306714. Mine was disarmed and returned to Battalion S-2 for further disposition.

Elements of H&S Company patrol, while set in night ambush at YD 338656, observed 3 NVA/VC, approximately 50 meters to their southwest. Shortly thereafter (approximately 5 minutes), the patrol received SAF from 5 to 7 NVA/VC. Patrol returned fire, H&S Company reaction dispatched to assist.

From O21400H to O22230H, Battalion MedCAP team/ Psyops team conducted MedCAP of Cua Viet Resettlement Village (YD 348678), treating 150 VN for medical problems and rendering dental assistance to 31 people, additionally 100 bars of soap were distributed after giving showers with portable unit.

USN PBRs, observed 6 NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 294671 carrying tube like object. PBRs engaged with M-79, .30 cal. MG and .50 cal MG and then departed area. Upon their departure, elements of Company "A" reaction force swept area with negative results.


Elements of CAC unit (provisional rifle co), at (YD 315685), utilizing NOD observed 2 NVA/VC at

2 January 1969









YD 311695. Called illumination mission, expending 2 rounds 60mm and engaged target with .30 cal. MG. Sighting disappeared, results unknown.

From 030100H to 030825H, elements of H&S Company patrol and H&S Company reaction force, which had linked up as a result of contact reported in Spot Report No. 76 (022205H), conducted a sweep of the area in the vicinity of YD 338656. Sweep resulted in negative findings.

From 030730H to 030845H, elements of Company "A" swept area of activity (YD 288685) reported in Spot Report No. 79 (022300H). Sweep resulted in negative findings.

One Marine, L/Cpl N.A. King, Company "B", while burning refuse at C-4 (YD 310722), was burned by gasoline. The man was medevaced to hospital ship. Accident report submitted.

Col Clark, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp Kistler for an update briefing on current situation in the AO.

From O31400H to O31700H, Battalion MedCAP team conducted routine MedCAP in Cua Viet Resettlement Village (YD 348678), treating 150 medical cases and 25 dental problems. Additionally 200 bars of soap were distributed after giving showers to 100 children, with the portable shower.


From O31900H to O32230H, Battalion Psyops team showed Pro-GVN movies to approximately 300 Vietnamese in the Pho Hoi area (YD 337687). Additionally 2nd ARVN Regiment S-5 made Pro-GVN speaches.

Brig Gen Carney, ADC, 3d Marine Division and Col Gordon, 1st Infantry Brigade, 5th Infantry Division (Mech) USA visited Camp Kistler for an update briefing on the current situation in the AO.

Elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 251751), while on patrol, at vicinity YD 286715 found 1 Chi-Com grenade with carrying pouch and 1 AK-47 magazine. Equipment forwarded to Battalion S-2.

From O41300H to O41700H, Battalion MedCAP team conducted routine MedCAP in the vicinity of Phoi Hoi (YD 339689), treating 45 VN for medical problems and 10 VN for dental ailments.

5 January 1969

Blements of CAC unit (provisional rifle co), while checking area in the vicinity of YD 333701, received a burst of automatic weapons fire from a house near their location. Patrol returned fire as 1 VC male ran from the house, followed by 3 others. Fleeing group taken under fire with M-79

ing 2 dead VN females, spent AK-47 caseings and 2 AK-47 bullets in 55 gallon drum. Action resulted in 1 friendly non-medevac casualty and 2 dead

6 January 1969

7 January 1969

CAC unit (provisional rifle co), at YD 339703 reported an unexplained explosion taking place in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, in the vicinity of YD 329699. Two Vietnamese were killed and 1 wounded as a result of the explosion. Investigation will be conducted.

8 January 1969=

From 080830H to 080950H, an onsight imvestigation of the area reported in Spot Report No. 88 (072) 220H Jan, 69), was conducted. Crater analysis indicated rounds were fired from a direction of 4800 to 5000 mills. Fragments were gathered and are being forwarded to the S-2 of 12th Marines. Casualty total new stands at 2 Vietnamese killed and 4 wounded, 2 of which were medevaced.

From 080645H to 081500H, elements of 1st Amtrac Battalion, conducted a wweep of the area between grids YD 270710 to YD 282710, south to the Cua Viet River. Sweep resulted in negative results.

Maj Westfall, assistant S-3, 12th Marines, arrived at Camp Kistler, to conduct investigation of incident in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (Ref-

erence Spot Report No. 88, 072220H Jan, 1969).


Col Clark, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp Kistler to discuss present situation in the AO.


9 January 1969

At a ceremony conducted at 3d Marine Division Headquarters, the Battalion CO excepted the MER\* ITORIOUS UNIT COMMENDATION from the COMMANDANT of the Marine Corps, Gen Chapman, awarded to the First Amtrac Battalion for the period 5 Nov, 1967 to 27 Jan, 1968.

Elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed lights of what appeared to be a truck convoy, travelling north to south in the vicinity of YD 253823. No action taken due to location.

11 January 1969

Elements of CAC unit (provisional rifle co) patrol, while set in ambush, in the vicinity of YD 316702, observed, by starlight scope, 1 NVA/VC at YD 317703. Patrol moved into hasty ambush, called illumination mission and opened fire on tree line, where the NVA/VC was last sighted. The patrol received no return fire, checked area with negative results.

Elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 291 7551), observed 3 NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 288758. Fire mission called/conducted by NGF, expending 40 rounds HE additionally, dusters expended 162 rounds HE of 40mm and 60mm expended 2 rounds of illumination and 2 rounds of HE. Good coverage, movement no longer visible.

Naval Landing Craft (YFU-81), beached in the vicinity of YD 356685, due to storm. LVTs from H&S Company rendering assistance.

Elements of Company "A", security post, at YD 306681, observed 3 NVA/VC at YD 305685, took same under fire with SAF, 60mm HE, and illuminated area. Post received SAF from a weapon believed to be a carbine. Sighting disappeared. Sweep of area revealed footprints and drag marks. Will sweep area again at first light.

Elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751), observed 2 flashing lights in the vicinity of grids YD 253834 and YD 250828. At YD 236810 and YD 240820, two braversing skyward lights were observed and at YD 245825 a search light beam was observed. Negative action taken due to location.

Elements of Company "A" conducted a sweep of area reported in Spot Report No 95 (132030H). Unit found the wire cut in vicinity of YD 305 680, also found drag marks.

USN PBRs detonated 1 water type mine of unknown size with a concussion grenade at YD 307677.



LtCol Persac, CO, 3d Engineer Battalion and staff visited Camp Kistler to inspect the water point facilities.

USN PBRs, while making insert of recon teams, observed 5 NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 272651 and 5 NVA/VC at YD 265637. PBRs opened fire with .30 cal machinegun and M-79. Results unknown.

15 January 1969

LVTP-5 parked on the south side of the Cua Viet River, at YD 341691, caught fire. Fire fighting equipment was dispatched from POL and Navy. Attempts to extinguish fire were unsuccessful and LVT was submerged in river to extinguish fire. One fuel cell had exploded, while attempting to extinguish fire. Preperations are being made to recover vehicle at this time.

Battalion S-5 and MedCAP team conducted routine MedCAP in Gio Hai Village (YB 318692). 105 VN were treated for medical problems and 20 for dental ailments. Additionally, 200 bars of soap were distributed.

From 140800H to 151700H, Jan, 69, elements of First Amtrac Battalion completed destruction of treeline at YD 258625 to YD 265626. Destruction included old spider holes, trench lines and "A" frame bunkers. These bunkers contained bodies apparently killed in the battle of Dai Do, last May, 68. No weapons or equipment were discovered.

LVT reported at 151035 was recovered. Repair has commenced at this time.


Navy YFU-62, detonated mine at YD 307677, resulting in the following casualties: 5 KIA, 4 WIA-MEDEVACED and 2 MIA. Medical assistance rendered by Company "A" personnel.

Navy LCM-8, No 758, hit a mine at YD 300670 causing the following casualties: 1 Civilian KIA, 8 USN/USMC WIA and 9 MIA. Exact number of personnel onboard, at time of explosion is estimated based on available information. Assistance rendered by Company \*A" personnel.

Elements of Recon Team (Hindrance), observed 2 to 4 NVA/VC in the water at YD 268644. Team made contact with SAF and M-26 grenades and received SAF in return. As team boarded PBR, they



noted 2 NVA/VC which appeared to be stunned from grenades. Recon team disembarked from PBR. They received SAF and returned same. Contact broken, team swept area in conjunction with Co "A" reaction, found 3 NVA/VC KIA and took 2 NVA/VC POW.

USN PBRs returned Recon Team (Hindrance), along with 2 NVA/VC POW to Camp Kistler. One of the PGWs died, as a result of wounds.

First Amtrac Battalion chopped OpCon from Task Force Bravo and simultaneously OpConed to 1st Infantry Brigade, 5th Infantry Division (Mech) USA. That portion of Kentucky AO which is maintained by 1st Amtrac Battalion is now a portion of Marshall Mountain AO, with all of the AO south of the Gua Viet River, except for the area surrounding Camp Kistler being given to "C" Co, 1/61 Infantry (Mech) USA, to conduct operations in.

First Amtrac Battalion assumed OpCon of Co "B", 1/61, Infantry (Mech) USA.

From 170710H to 170840H, elements of Co "A" conducted sweep of area reported in Spot Report No. 101 (170115H). Final breakdown reflects 4 KIA NVA/VC (c), 1 NVA/VC POW and 2 WIA (friendly medevaced). The following equipment and weapons captured; 1-AK-47 rifle, 1 Grease Gun, 1 letter, 2 packs, 3 cartridge belts, 4 Chi-Com grenades and 11 Pineapple grenades.

LtCol Weeler, CO, 1/61 Infantry (Mech) USA, visited Camp Kistler to discuss present operations in the AO.

Col Gibson, CO, 1st Infantry Brigade, 5th Div (Mech), USA, visited Camp Kistler to discuss recent OpCon change.

One APC of Co "B" 1/61, while on mechanized patrol detonated a mine at YD 274665. Resulting in 7 WIAs being medevaced and total destruction of the vehicle.

Elements of Co "A", while on patrol in vicinity of YD 263668 found what appeared to be 1, 122mm rocket, with a diameter of 5 inches, length 424 inches and length of war head 17 3/4 inches.







Rocket is being returned to Battalion S-2 for further identification.

Elements of CAC unit (provisional rifle co), observed 5 to 6 NVA/VC entering wire to the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village, at YD 332700. Reaction wnit from CAC dispatched to sweep that portion of Resettlement Village. Sweep resulted in negative findings.

18 January 1969

Rocket reported in Spot Report No 1 (171735H, Jan. 69), identified as 140mm rocket. Rocket being forwarded to S-2, 1/5 Mechanized, USA.

Elements of B/1/61, while on patrol discovered 1, 1,000 pound bomb at YD 255645. Bomb was blown in place.

From 181400H to 181700H, Bn S-5 and MedCAP team, conducted a routine MedCAP in the Cua Viet Resettlement Village (YD 345680). Treating 100 VN for medical problems and 14 for dental ailments. Team distributed 300 bars of soap and miscellaneous Psyops material.

Vietnamese children turned in to elements of Co "A", at YD 305680, a water mine, consisting of a pineapple grenade tied to styrofoam container. Children claimed to have found mine at YD 295680. Mine being forwarded to Battalion S-2.

Elements of Has Co patrol, while set in ambush at YD 332660, observed 4 NVA/VC moving east to west in the vicinity of YD 335665. Approximately 5 minutes later, sighted 2 more people in the same area. 



Sweep of area reported in Spot Report No 108, conducted with negative results. Vietnamese woman, who was wounded, found to be an innocent bystander and released after minor medical aid.

Elements of H&S Company, LVT Platoon, returned to CP from Dai Do area.

From 302050H to 310025H elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 291751), utilizing PPS-5 radar, observed 2 groups of 6 NVA/VC each at YD 288760, moving to the north. Approximately ten minutes later, group was observed setting in at YD 284 764. Fire mission called and executed by H-6s, expending 20 rounds FC, 110 rounds of HE and 8 rounds of WP. Additionally fire missions were executed by "tanks" expending 16 rounds of BH, "dusters" expending 330 rounds of 40mm and Coast Guard swift boat expending 4 rounds of WP and 7 rounds of HE. Good coverage of area. Element dispatched to sweep area which resulted in negative findings. Area will be swept at first light.

Sweep of area reported in Spot Report NO 110 completed with footprints of 4 to 5 personnel noted but no casualties found.






