
PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. The First Amphibian Tractor Battalion was under the operational control of Task Force Bravo until 18 February. During this period, the Battalion had operational control of various units to bolster operations within the AO. From 5 February until 14 February, "M" Company, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines was under the operational control of the Battalion. They assisted in the cordon of the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village and conducted operations in the Nhi Ha extension area. On 14 February, 1st Platoon, "F" Company, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines was placed under the operational control of the Battalion. The 18th of February found the 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion being released from the operational control of Task Force Bravo and simultaneously being placed under the operational control of the 3d Marine Regiment. From 17 to 24 February, 2nd Platoon, "L" Company, 3d Battalion, 3d Marines was placed under the operational control of the Battalion and assigned operations in the Nhi Ha extension area. From the 24th to the 25th of February, "A" Troop, 4th Squadron, 12th Cavalry, USA, was placed under the operational control of the Battalion and utilized in the C-4/ Oceanview areas to bolster defensive posture in that section. On the 25th of February the Battalion was released from the operational control of 3d Marines/ Operation Kentucky and placed under the operational control of First Brigade, Fifth Infantry Division (Mechanized), USA/Operation Marshall Mountain. Second Platoon (-), Company "C", 3d Tank Battalion and various teams from 3d Reconnaissance Battalion were under the operational control of the Battalion throughout the month. The Second Platoon, First Armored Amphibian Company provided direct artillery support and harassment and interdiction fire for units operating throughout the AO.
- 2. Camp KISTLER received no incoming rounds this month.
- 3. There was one mining incident of tracked vehicles within the AO this month. A tank from "A" Troop, 4th Squadron, 12th Cavalary, USA detonated an AT mine at YD 297748 on the 25th of February, while they were conducting a sweep of the Oceanview area. There were no casualties and only minor track damage was reported. On 21 February an unknown number of enemy UDT personnel armed with magnetic mines succeeded in damaging 4 boats (LCM) and killing one USN personnel. A search of the area revealed one enemy KIA who was equipped with a rebreathing apparatus.
- 4. Casualties within the Battalion this month were considerably higher as reflected in the increase of sapper activity and the attack on Oceanview on 22 and 23 February. The Battalion suffered a total of 7 KIAs and 5 WIAs and the Navy reported one KIA in the mining incident of 10 February.
- 5. Numerous combat patrols and operations were conducted this month. These operations originated from both the Battalion CP and the patrol bases maintained throughout the AO. There was a total of 168 day patrols, 13 of which were mechanized, and 98 night patrols, the majority of which culminated in night ambushes. The reconnaissance teams that were working within the AO conducted 196 ambushes,









primarily along the Cua Viet River.

- 6. Company "A", 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion, continued operations in the area of My Loc and Mai Xa Thi (Jones Creek Outpost), until 25 February at which time the Mai Xa Thi outpost was deactivated. The company continued to conduct mechanized patrols, infantry patrols, night ambushes and search and destroy missions, concentrating their activities along the Cua Viet River. On 10 February a reconnaissance team working the area of Company "A" in conjunction with USN PBRs sighted 3 to 5 NVA/VC at YD 270645. The reconnaissance team initiated contact which resulted in 4 NVA/VC KTA and captured individual weapons and equipment. On 23 February reconnaissance team (Harbor Queen) sighted and opened fire on 20 NVA/VC at YD 269648, resulting in 1 friendly KTA and 1 enemy KIA equipped with an AK-50 and 40 pounds of explosives. On 27 February, a PBR crew observed 15 to 20 NVA/VC moving south in the vicinity of YD 266647. NVA/VC split into small groups with one walking into the ambush position of a reconnaissance team (Blend) who opened fire, killing 1 NVA/VC, and capturing 1 AK-50 assault rifle, 20 pounds of plastic explosives, blasting caps, 1 pair binoculars, 1 compass and one rope approximately 15 feet long.
- 7.. Company "B", 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion, continued consolidation of Base Area C-4 and Oceanview platoon outpost (YD 291751), in support of Operation Duel Blade. The unit conducted numerous day and night activities in their assigned portion of the AO, seeking infiltrators from the north. Company "B" was reinforced by a platoon (-) of tanks from "C" Company, 3d Tank Battalion, one light section of M-42 (40mm dusters) from the 1st of the 44th Artillery Group, USA, Naval Gunfire Spotter teams from the 12th Marines and an 81mm mortar section from the 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion. An attack by an aggressive force of NVA estimated to exceed 120 was initiated against Oceanview on the night of 22 February and continued until daylight on the 23rd. Although the enemy continuously made concentrated efforts to break the defenses his efforts were thwarted by the superbly adjusted and concentrated show of supporting arms in conjunction with the suppressing SAF from the unit within. A final count of friendly casualties reflected 2 KTAs and 2 WIAs and one enemy KTA (c). While "A" Troop was under the operational control of 1st Amphibian Tractor Battalion they conducted extensive sweeps in this area finding the equipment that the enemy had used in the attack.
- 8. Headquarters and Service Company conducted numerous day and night patrols/ambushes in the southern portion of the AO and supported the patrol base in the Dai Do (YD 265635) portion of the AO. The patrols in the southern portion of the AO have accounted for 1 NVA/VC KIA and on several occasions they have observed enemy movement. The patrols originating in the Dai Do portion of the AO have resulted in the discovery and destruction of enemy bunkers and equipment. On 10 February an 8 man ambush made contact with a force of 6 to 10 NVA/VC which lasted approximately 60 minutes and required the assistance of the reaction force. The action resulted in 4 friendly KIAs and 2 WIAs with 3 enemy KIAs and 1 POW.
- 9. The Combined Action Company consisting of one platoon of Marines from 1st







Amphibian Tractor Battalion and 3 platoons of Popular Forces troops, continues consolidation of their two command posts (YD 314688) and (YD 338703) and the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 321700). During its operations for the month the unit conducted a total of 28 day patrols and 58 night patrols/ambushes. In an attempt to curtail enemy traffic in and out of the Resettlement Village during the day, Popular Forces troops began sentinel duty on the 3 Village gates at YD 315691, YD 318696 and YD 320703 from 0630 to 1930 daily. Because of a report of a possible buildup of enemy troops, a cordon and search of the Resettlement Village was conducted on the 10th and 11th of February. The CAC unit provided personnel to assist in the search which resulted in recovery of minor equipment and the detention of 6 individuals. The tower at YD 327702 was equipped with a xenon light to aid in the detection of enemy traffic in the area. On 5 February while searching the home of a suspected VC, MSGT GROVER was wounded by a .45 pistol and medevaced. He was replaced as OIC by 1stLt J.B. ROSEN on 20 February. The unit continued to provide medical assistance in the form of daily sickcalls and weekly MedCAPs along with Psyops operations whenever possible.


10. LVTs continue to be utilized for mechanized patrols and to transport supplies to outposts within the AO. They have additionally been used on a continuous basis for the transportation of the Battalion MedCAP team and its supplies and equipment. The LVTs have also enabled the Battalion to move reaction forces to outposts within the AO with speed and effectiveness. LVTs were also used on several occasions to assist the Navy in drydocking various river craft for repair.

- 11. There were no UFO sightings within the Battalion this month.
- 12. The Battalion Civil Affairs Officer has again directed Battalion support to the Gio Hai Village. They have continued to send MedCAP teams and Psyops teams into the Resettlement Village on a once a week basis, taking care of the medical problems whenever possible and sending more serious cases to the Battalion Aid Station for appropriate care. The program to build a 3 room school in the Village has continued with good progress to a completion stage of about 40 percent. The Cua Viet Resettlement Village, which is to the south of Camp KISTLER, has recently been augmented by a Revolutionary Development Team and a Combined Action Group. These two units are expected to improve the relations between the populace and the Marines and provide security to the Villagers. It is felt that the assistance the Battalion has given the local populace has had a great effect and will continue to improve the feelings for Americans in this area.
- 13. On 5 February, Col CLARKE, CO Task Force Bravo, visited Camp KISTLER to discuss the existing situation in the Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village, and LtCol CULKIN, G-2 of the 3d Marine Division, visited Camp KISTLER to discuss the present situation in the AO. On 11 February, Col CLARKE, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited Camp KISTLER for a briefing on the Cua Viet River situation. On 18 February Col LaFOND, CO, 3d Marine Regiment visited Camp KISTLER for a situation briefing. On 23 February after the Oceanview incident LtGen STILLWELL, CG, XXIV Corps, BrigGen CARNEY, ADC, 3d Marine Division and Col OSTEEN, G-3 XXIV Corps visited








Camp KISTLER and Oceanview for a briefing on the attack. On the 24th of February MajGen DAVIS, CG, 3d Marine Division visited Camp KISTLER for an update briefing and a report of the Oceanview attack. On 24 February, Col GIBSON, CO, First Brigade, Fifth Division (Mechanized) USA and Col LaFOND, CO, 3d Marines, arrived at Camp KISTLER for a situation briefing. On 25 February, Commander Rickels, CO, MCB7, visited the Battalion with LtCol HAYWARD, 3d Marine Division G-4 for an update briefing.

14. The cantonment maintenance projects have continued this month with an upswing in base renewal. The electrical system project has continued with the construction of two sheds for two 60 kW generators and the erection of utility poles. The completion of this project will enhance the operations of this unit immensely. Also, the construction of a new Butler building has commenced, which is intended to provide the Motor Transport section with the necessary accommodations to maintain the vehicles of the Battalion. The Helo-Lift fuel project has continued this month with the transportation of 8,000 gallons of POL to C-4, where it has been utilized by the Amtracs in that area.







PART II

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1 February 1969

H&S Company LVT Platoon departed CP to conduct operations in the Dai Do area (YD 263634).

From Oll445H to Oll630H, Battalion S-5 and Med-CAP team conducted routine MedCAP in the Pho Hoi Hamlet, Trieu Van Village (YD 335689), treating 100 VN for medical problems, 10 for dental and distributed 150 bars of soap.

Elements of the CAC unit sighted 2 VC, at YD 335701, attempting to gain entrance to their CP. Sentry opened fire, but received no return fire. Fresh footprints found while sweeping area but nothing further noted.

2 February 1969

Elements of 1st Amtrac Battalion, paid 4,000\$ VN, in conjunction with the "VIP" program, to 8 VN adults for 1-105 round, 2-60mm rounds, 1-61mm round, 1-Chi-Com grenade, 1 artillery round of unknown type and 1 TM-41 plastic mine. The TM-41 mine will be sent to G-2.

Elements of H&S Company patrol, while set in ambush at YD 340664, observed 5 NVA/VC moving southeast at YD 348660. Units to the south of their AO were notified of the sighting.

3 February 1969

Elements of H&S Company patrol, at YD 252653, discovered and destroyed 1-250 pound bomb, 1-155mm round, 1-120mm round, 1-time fuze, 1-M-79 round and several FC bomblets.

Elements of H&S Company patrol, at YD 257647, found and destroyed 6 bunkers and 2 tunnels.

USN PBRs observed, 4 to 8 NVA/VC in the vicinity of YD 279645. PBRs took sighting under fire with N-79 and moved in to check area. PBRs received AMF, returned same and suppressed fire. No casualties or damage.


4 February 1969

Elements of HES Company patrol, at YD 257647 found and destroyed 1-tunnel, 1-bunker and 1 well with tunnel inside.





5 February 1969



Elements of 1st Amtrac Battalion paid 2,000\$ VN in conjunction with the "VIP" program, to a VN woman and boy, who had turned in the AT mine reported in Spot Report No 113. They also showed the location of same to the Battalion S-2.

Elements of H&S Company patrol, at YD 252652, found and destroyed 1 tunnel in a creek at above grid.

Elements of H&S Company platoon patrol, paid 2,000\$ VN, in conjunction with the "VIP" program to 4 VN boys for turning in 2-105 rounds (duds), 4-M26 grenades and 2-M-79 rounds.

Col Clarke, CO, Task Force Bravo, visited the CP, to discuss existing situation in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village.

Elements of CAC Unit, at YD 334709, detained 1 VN male who's name appeared on the "Black List". Detainee being interrogated and house being searched.

While conducting search of detainee's house (ref Spot Report No 123), one .45 cal pistol, belonging to a member of the search team, discharged, while he was bent over searching a large container wounding another member of the search team. Only individual near him was VC suspect, who was to his rear, at least 2 to 3 feet. Marine was treated at BAS and medevaced. Vietnamese detained for interrogation.


First Amtrac Battalion assumed OpCon of M Company (-) 3/4.

From 051430H to 051730H, Battalion S-5 and Med-CAP team conducted routine MedCAP in the Gio Hai Resettlement Village (YD 334699). Treating 85 WN for medical problems, 13 dental patients and distributed 50 bars of soap.

LtCol Culkin, G-2, 3d Mar Div, visited Camp Kistler, to discuss present situation in the AO.

Vietnamese detainee (ref spot report no 123), interrogated by Bn S-2 and CIT, cleared and re-





leased as an innocent civilian.

7 February 1969

Received verbal word from Task Force Bravo, on operation in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 320700)

A $2\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck was accidentally started by 2 VN. Resulting in a youth suffering a arm injury (ref spot report no. 126).

Third Platoon, M Company, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines, arrived at MY Loc (YD 308683). M 3/4 is now at full strength.

8 February 1969

Utilizing the PPS-5 radar, elements of Company "B" detected suspected movement of 5 to 10 NVA/VC, at YD 288758. Conducted fire mission using NGF and hOmm dusters with unknown results.

Elements of Has Company patrol, found and destroyed 1 bunker, at YD 251631.

Elements of H&S Company, with PPS-5 sighted 4 to 5 NVA/VC at YD 275647. Conducted 105mm fire mission, expending 36 rounds of HE with unknown results.

9 February 1969

M Company, 3/4 commenced cordon of Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 328700).

Elements of H&S Company, detected movement of 5 to 10 suspected NVA/VC with PPS-5 radar, illuminated area, negative results.


While conducting cordon and search operation in the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700). One Marine was run over and killed by an amtrac.

Elements of the National Police Field Force arrived at Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700). To conduct detailed search of the village within the cordon area.

Completed search of cordoned section of Xuam Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700) and moved cordon to the east.

Search of the cordoned portion of the Kuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700) resulted in the screening of 1550 VN and detained 4 VC suspects.





The following was found: 1 roll of comm wire, wire for one claymore mine (US type) and 1/8 pound of TNT. All the above equipment was found in one hooch.

Elements of H&S Company, observed and took under fire with SAF approximately 5 NVA/VC at YD 253650. Received sniper fire while checking area which resulted in negative results.

River patrol boat sighted 3 to 5 NVA/VC at YD 270645. Recon Team (Fancy Dan), moving to intercept. Made contact, utilizing SAF and supporting fire from PBRs, resulting in 4 NVA/VC KIA with individual weapons captured.

Commenced cordon and search in the east half of the Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village.

Elements of H&S Company, LVT Platoon, swept area at YD 254650 (092025H contact), locating one 4%4 spider hole and 1 flashlight and 2 pieces of plastic 6%7 feet.

Elements of H&S Company, LVT Platoon, while patrolling in vicinity of YD 256631, received 1 round of sniper fire resulting in one friendly WIA.

Cordon and search operation in Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700) completed at this time, with the screening of 3373 VN. Screening produced 6 detainees. The MedCAP team treated 225 medical and 70 dental cases.


Elements of IMS Company, LVT Platoon, while on patrol made contact with 6 to 10 NVA/VC in vicinity of YD 259657. LVT reaction while enroute to reinforce element received M-79 and SAF. Action resulted in, 4 KIA, 2 WIA friendly and 3 NVA KIA (c).

Elements of H&S Company and Company "A" reaction force commenced search and sweep in the area of LVT's contact of 101950H Feb 69 (YD 258657).

Elements of Kas Company and Company "A", while conducting sweep of the area where LVTs contact of 110845H Feb 69, occured, captured 1 NVA armed with 1 AK-47 and individual equipment (ref Spot Report No 140).

10 February 1969





Commanding Officer of Task Force Bravo, Col Clarke visited the CP for a brief on the Cua Viet River situation.

Received temporary boundary change from Task Force Bravo for the Nhi Ha area. Boundary to extend from YD 272671 northwest to YD 253698 northeast to YD 283712. Time will be from 120800H to 15 1800H Feb 69.

12 February 1969

PBRs reported sighting & swimmers in creek at YD 303679. PBR fired on sighting with M-79. Co "A" reaction checked area with negative results.

M Company, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines commenced operations in the Nhi Ha AO extention YD 278670.

Two Vietnamese children delivered two metal mines to elements of Co "A". Mines were buried in the sand near friendly location.

Elements of H&S Company LVTs, sighted 1 NVA/VC at YD 265635, checked area with negative results.

Received word from Division Eng that the 2nd ARVN Regiment had the mission of stringing wire between A-1 (Hill 31) and Oceanview (YD 291751)/


Elements of M Company, 3d Battalion, 4th Marines located tracks of possible enemy at YD 286702. Tracks indicate a force of approximately 150-200 people with half moving west and the rest heading south.

Tower at Cua Viet (YD 349694), observed a swimmer in difficulty. H&S Company dispatched 2 LVTs to aid swimmer.


LtCol Damewood, while on a helicopter VR of the battalion AO, used element of Company "A" as an airbotne unit to check and screen VN in the area of YD 280662.

Battalion S-2 detained one VN for having 21 dollars MPC in his posession and no ID card. (ref spot report no 146).

Received warning order from Task Force Bravo to be prepared to chop OpCon of M Company 3d Battalion, 4th Marines at 140900H Feb 1969.







14 February 1969

First Amtrac Battalion chopped OpCon of M Company, 3d Battalion 4th Marines to Task Force Bravo at the same time assumed OpCon 1st Platoon F Company, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines.

Elements of Force Recon completed search of Jones Creek vicinity YD 285685 to YD 284670.

Received a report from NSAD of flashing light, possibly a signalling device at YD 247618.

The Battalion S-3 with an element from Company "A" located and destroyed 2 bunkers at YD 289675 and YD 287674, one of which was reinforced with concrete.

Elements of H&S Company, sighted and took under fire 3 to 5 NVA/VC at YD 351664 with unknown results. (ref spot report no 151).

Received word from Task Force Bravo to be prepared to chop OpCon 1st Platoon, F Company, 2nd Battalion, 4th Marines and receive a company from 3d Battalion, 3d Marines on 15 February 69.


H&S Company patrol again sighted 3 to 5 NVA/VC at YD 352665. Took enemy under fire resulting in one enemy KIA, reaction was committed to reinforce the patrol and check area (ref spot report no 152).

Navy personnel on post 2 reported receiving SAF sniper fire, coming from approximately YD 331700. Elements of Provisional Rifle Company checked area with negative results.

H&S Company patrol completed sweep of contact area vicinity YD 352665. Finding 1 poncho and 1 rain hat (ref spot report no 154).


In reference to Spot Report No 152, 1 VC KIA has been identified by the local populace as Phon Dang a local VC. Phan Dang's sister has been detained by Battalion 5-2 as a VC sympathizer.


Elements of FRS Company, while searching a bunker found several documents, 2 bags of pills of unknown type, 2 pieces of plastic (light blue in color), 2 small bags of an unknown type of powder, 1 Russian flag and 1 MVA flag. Bunker locat-











ed at YD 261634.

Elements of Company "B", at YD 291751 reported receiving one sniper round. Fired 105mm artillery mission, had squad check area with negative results.

Elements of Provisional Rifle Company, spotted 3 NVA/VC at YD 32069h moving to the south at approximately 150 meters from the village perimeter wire. Tower crew opened fire with M-60 machinegun and then lost sighting. Reaction force checked area finding only 3 sets of footprints.

PBRs spotted 4 NVA/VC at YD 270644. Took under fire with M-79 and SAF. Elements of H&S Company, LVT Platoon swept area at first light with negative results.

Provisional Rifle Company fired 4 to 6 rounds of small arms at 2 NVA/VC moving west away from Xuan Khanh Resettlement Village (YD 339700). Individuals moved back into village and sighting was lost.

Assumed Operational Control of "A" Troop, 4/12 Cav, USA.

Elements of Company "B", at Oceanview (YD 291 751) sighted approximately 30 NVA with PPS-5 radar at YD 281762 moving northwest. Sighting disappeared vicinity YD 278764. Conducted NGF mission with unknown results.


