NARRATIVE SUMMARY

- 1. During the month of August 1968 the 1st Medical Battalion remained in support of Task Force X-Ray forces at Phu Bai, RVN. The 1st Platoon of Delta Company remained at Danang, RVN augmenting 1st Hospital Companu in support of 1st Marine Division Forces.
- 2. Plans were formulated for a phased movement of Alpha Company to 1st Hospital Company Danang, RVN to replace **él**ements of Bravo Company, 5th Medical Battalion as they displace.
- 3. Four SEA Huts were constructed and merged into "H" shaped building to provide **edequate** ward space and to release SEA Huts, previously used or military ward space, back for use as troop living spaces. Two SEA Huts were retained for use as Vietnamese wards and Vietnamese spill-over ward. Additional air conditioners were received for installation in the

Admission and Sorting, and Shock and Debridement Sections of the Hospital. An addition to the laboratory was completed providing the necessary space to adequately perform clinical laboratory analysis and blood bank functions. Continued improvements in the drainage system and minor construction was accomplished. Construction of concrete walkways around the Hospital proper was started
