NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During November 1969, the 1st Medical Battalion continued to execute its mission of providing medical support to the 1st Marine Division, and further, continued to extend its efforts in support of the Division civil action program by conducting MEDCAPS in designated Villages, Hamlets, Hospitals and Orphanages.

2. The construction of the new Hospital complex continued. Originally scheduled for completion in mid-October, the nonavailability of essential equipment i.e., washers, sinks and electrical parts slowed progress, and extended the final completion date to mid-December.
