NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. During December 1969, the 1st Medical Battalion continued to execute its mission of providing medical support to the 1st Marine Division, and further, continued to extend its efforts in support of the Division civic action program by conducting MEDCAPS in designated Villages, Hamlets, Hospitals and Orphanages.

2. As of 31 December 1969 the construction of the new hospital complex was determined to be 100% complete which included the additional construction of a 30'x60' bunker, wired electrically throughout, and to be utilized as the hospital admission and sorting (A&S) bunker.
