#### PART II

1. During the month of August 1970, the 1st Medical Battalion continued to execute it's mission of providing medical support to the 1st Marine Division, and further, continued to extend it's efforts in support of the Division's Civic Action program by conducting MEDCAPS in designated Villages, Hamlets, Hospitals, and Orphanages,

2. Notification was recieved in July 1970 that "C" Company 1st Medical Battalion would redeploy during Increment IV of the reduction in forces in RVN. An embarkation committee was established and the embarkation requirements of functional areas were reviewed and assignments made. During August 1970 emphasis was placed on preparing Organic and Medical MO and MOA blocks for shipment. This included inventoring all supplies and equipment, ordering shortages, constructing boxes and pallets, and packaging. Also accomplished during August was the cleaning of "C" Company vehicles for embarkation. Significant problems encountered during this period were (1) lack of cleaning equipment for vehicles, and (2)difficulty in obtaining lumber for construction that would meet agricultural requirements.
