#### PART II

#### NARRATIVE SUMMARY

#### S 2 INTELLIGENCE

1. During the month of September, three (3) confirmed VC were captured and turned over to Danang Special Sector for intensive interrogation. In addition, one hundred twenty five (125) individuals were apprehended by battalion operations and patrols. Of these, five (5) were classified as confirmed VC and one hundred four (104) reclassified as civil defendents or innocent civilians. Civil defendents fell into the categories of draft dodgers, illegal residents or were in possession of illegal or invalid I.D. cards. The remaining sixteen (16) have yet to be classified. All persons apprehended were turned over to Danang Special Sector or Hoa Vang Sub-Sector for interrogation and appropriate civil action. The following arms/equipment were discovered by combined search/sweep/probing operations within the Battalion TAOR.

- 2. The following areas were mentioned as enemy objectives within the Denang Vital Area during this reporting period.
- a. Danang Air Base still remains high on the enomy objective list due to the availability of bactical air support and vulnarability to rocket attack.
- b. Marble Mountain Kir Base continues to be a high priority target for the enemy due to its capability to helolift troops and supplies, as well as being vulnerable to mortan attack.
- c. I Corps Bridge has been mentioned in numerous reports due to the logistical importance to the ICTZ.
- d. Other targets listed were the Cam Le Bridge, Hoa Vang Sub-Section and I Corps Headquarters.

#### S.3 OPERATIONS/TRAINING

- 1. During the reporting period this command participated in numerous small unit operations, but sustained no major contact. Noteworthy in this months operations were the combined company sized operations which were conducted in East Danang in cooperation with Danang Special Sector and Third District Headquarters.
- 2. The battalion conducted 140 day and night fire team size patrols; 28 day and night squad size patrols; 296 fire team size night ambushes; 505 squad size night ambushes and 30 platoon size operations for a total of 999 small unit activities during this reporting period.
- 3. In addition to the small unit activities, the battalion also conducted 15 company or multi-company size operations.
- A. Battalion Officers and SNCO's attended classes in the following subjects: Battalion Supply Procedures: Concept of Operations in East Danang; Information lecture on ARVN, RF, and PF Forces. Several hours of discussion have been devoted to the progress and future plans of the 1st MP Bettalion.

- 5. Battalion GMS training was conducted in accordance with Charmen's directives to include Technical Training by MOS and NOO Lealership training. Some training was cancelled due to operational conditionates.
- 6. A troop orientation class for 100 newly joined personer hand conducted on 16 September 1968.
- 7. Eight (8) enemy rocket attacks were conducted against feating during this reporting period.

### S. A LOGISTICS

### 1. Significant Events

- a. Company 40% compliabed the move dute their new contemparity area. on 10 September 1968.
- b. Heavy rains this month resulted in considerable damage to thirty-two (32) bunkers and broken power lines.
- c. The electric power was off in the battalion contonement area from 140930 September 1968 until a 60 KW generator was connected to the main power switch on 152200 September 1968. Normal electric power was restored on 161500 September 1968.

### 2. Motor Transport

- a. The battalion received six (6) trucks utility M-151 as replacement for the trucks utility M-38A1.
- b. The battalion received eleven (11) trucks cargo M-35A2C as replacement for truck cargo M-35.

### S-5 CIVIL AFFAIRS

### 1. General

a. One-hundred and seventy (170) plasters were paid to a boy from My Thi hamlet (BT052794) for finding and turning in two (2) M-79 rounds. Also one-hundred and seventy (170) plasters were paid to another young boy from the same hamlet for finding and turning in two-hundred and fifty (250) rounds of M-16 ammunition.

- b. One-hundred (100) bags of coment, five (5) truck loads of lumber, and one (1) load of dirt was delivered to the Sicovina Textilia Factory (BT011728) during this reporting period for the construction of n meeting hall that is now nearing completion.
- c. During this reporting period, three (3) truck loads of lumber, and eight (8) bags of cament were delivered to the Hoa Tho Village (BT010723) Headquarters Chief for the construction of homes that were destroyed during the last enemy offensive.
- d. During this period, a reported twenty-four (24) hours was spent on census taking.

### 2. MUCATION

- a. Twenty-eight (28) hours of English instruction were given to students at the Sicovina Textile Factory (ETO11728).
- b. Twelve (12) hours of English instruction were given to seven (7) adults at Xaum Hoa High School (AT992778).
  - c. Hoa Vang High School began their school year during this period.
- d. Minestional and Psychological Operations films were presented to an attendance of approximately eight-hundred (800) people at the Sicovina Textile Factory (BT011728), and at Khue Trung (4) village (BT035737) where three-hundred (300) people were in attendance.

#### 3. PUBLIC HEALTH

- a. MEDCAP's treated 1,009 patients within the 1st Marine Air Wing's Civic Action TACR this month.
- b. MEDCAP's treated 635 patients within the Naval Support Activity's Civic Action TAOR this month.
  - c. Soap was distributed during all MEDCAP's.
- d. Dental MEDCAP's distributed 200 bars of scap, 155 toothbrushes, and 110 tubes of toothpasts during the month.
- e. Transportation is continuing to be provided to and from the Force Logistic Command Children's Hospital for parents of patients referred there by this office.

### 5. CIVIC ACTION TRAINING

- a. The Civil Affairs Officer gave Personal Response instruction in the Battalian Orientation Classes which are held for all newly arrived personnel.
- b. A total of four hours of Personal Response instruction was given to 187 members of the battalion.
- 6. <u>PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS</u>. During the month the battalion oivio action program effected the following distribution within the TAOR:
  - a. 3,000 Free South Newspapers.
  - b. 5,000 information leaflets.
  - c. 1,000 Safe Conduct Passes.
  - d. 850 Chieu Hoi Leaflets.

### 1. Bettalion Aid Station Chronological Data

- a. Significant Events: The Commanding Officer held a personnel inspection on 23 September 1968 and a material inspection on 24 September 1968. BAS section rated satisfactory in all respects. A total of 1,472 Vietnamese were treated through the Battalian MEDCAP program, exclusive of operations in Dalta Companies AOR. A large number of Flu shots were given this month. PMM from FLC held sanitation inspections during the month.
  - b. New Developments: None
- c. Problems Encetatored: Lack of ventilation and lighting fixtures in the BAS bunker.

### SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

# 1 September 1968

Company "B", 1st MP Battalion apprehended (4) VCS in the hamlet of Da Me (2) (BT064715) during a daylight probing operation. The VCS were

turned over to the 106th RF Company for interrogation.

At 011130H Company "C", 3rd MP Battalion Attached with elements of the 789th RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in An Thuong hamlet (BTO47760) resulting in the apprehension of (1) VCS. Custody of the VCS was turned over to the 106th RF Company for interrogation.

### 2 September 1968

At 020130H the city of Danang and surrounding areas received 15-20 122mm rockets. Target areas were NSA Covered Storage area, China Boach PX, Danang Olympic Stadium, railroad station, NE perimeter of Danang Air Base and several locations in Danang City. Casualties were (14) K14 (13 civilians and 1 ARVN) 56 WIA (55 civilians, 1 USMC). Damage included (1) 6% truck 25% destroyed; (1) reefer destroyed, (2) houses destroyed, and (2) houses damaged.

At 021515H Company "D", 1st MP Battalion reported finding (2) AK-47

Assault Rifles southwest of the Cam Le Bridge (BT016714).

### ▲ September 1968

At 040530H (2) 122mm rockets impacted on Danang Air Base in Orld Squares (BT0074 and 0075). No casualties were reported. Damage reported was (1) USAF building destroyed and (3) buildings with light damage.

# 5 September 1968

At 050015H a Company "B", 1st MP Battalion embush apprehended (5) VCS, one (1) admitting to having been a former VC. Suspects were turned over to Danang Special Sector for interrogation.

### 7 September 1968

At 070945H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with elements on the 100000 RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in the hornorion of My Thi (BT054744) resulting in the apprehension of (2) VCS. The suspects were turned over to Danang Special Sector for interrogation.

#### 10 September 1968

At 101008H Company "D", 1st MP Battalion with elements of the 111th RF Company and National Police from Hoa Vang District conducted a combined search/sweep operation in Bong Vai Viei Nam Village (BT005725). One (1) VCS was apprehended and turned over to the National Police for interrogation.

### **12 September 1968**

At 120807H Company "C", 1st MP Battalion with elements of the 106th RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in Dogpatch (BT993748). Six (6) VCS were apprehended and turned over to Hoa Vang Subsector for interrogation.

At 121915H a Company "B", 1st MP Battalion patrol apprehended (3) VCS in the hamlet of Khue Bac (BT057733). Fifth (5th) CIT identified one (1) VC who was turned over to Danang Special Sector for further interrogation. The remaining two (2) were released.

# 13 September 1968

At 130945H Company "D", 1st MP Battalion reported that while conducting a sweep operation on the island west of the Cam Le Bridge (BT008707), one (1) cave was located and destroyed.

### 14 Sentember 1968

At 140400H Company "B", 1st MP Battalian with one (1) plateon Company "C", 1st MP Battalian, one (1) plateon H&S Company, 1st MP Battalian, one (1) plateon III MAF Security Forces and a Combined force of PF, PFF, and Police provided by Danang Special Sector and 3rd District Headquarters conducted a combined search/sweep operation in Grid Square (BT0578). Fourteen (14) VCS were apprehended, of which four (4) were on the Black List. All were turned over to Danang Special Sector for interrogation.

#### 15 Sentember 1968

At 152100H, three (3) 122mm rockets impacted near NBA covered storage area and I Corps Headquarters. No property damage was reported, but two (2) civilian WIA's near I Corps Beadquarters were reported as rocket casualties.

### 16 September 1968

At 160330H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with one (1) platoon Company "A", one (1) platoon H&S Company, 1st MP Battalion, one (1) platoon III MAF Security Forces, 5th CIT personnel and a combined force of PF, PFF and Police furnished by Danang Special Sector and 3rd District Headquarters conducted a combined search/sweep operation in Grid Square (BT0577). Nineteen (19) VCS were apprehended and turned over to Danang Special Sector for interrogation.

At 160835H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with elements of the 106th RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in the hamlet of My Thi (BT053743). Three (3) VCS were apprehended (One (1) was found to be on the Black List) and turned over to Denang Special Sorter for

interrogation.

At 160950H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with elements of the 106th RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in the hardet of Khue Bac (BT056735). Five (5) VCS were apprehended and tunned ever to Danang Special Sector.

#### **17** September 1968

At 171610H a Company "B", 1st MP Battalion patrol apprehended one (1) female VCS in the hamlet of My Thi (BT053743). Subject was an the Shack List and taken to Danang Special Sector for immediate interrograms.

# 18 September 1968

At 180405H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with one (1) platoon (page my "A", 1st MP Battalion, one (1) platoon Maintenance Battalion, one (1) platoon III MAF Security Forces and a Combined force of FF, FFF and Police provided by Danang Special Sector and 3rd District Headquarters conducted a combined search/sweep operation in Grid Square (BT0579). One (1) VCS was apprehended and taken to Danang Special Sector for interrogation.

At 180515H two (2) 122mm rockets impacted at Danang Air Base resulting

in one (1) USMC KIA and one (1) USMC WIA.


At 180943H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with elements of the 105th RF Company conducted a combined search/sweep operation in the hamlet of My Thi (BT051745). One (1) VCS was apprehended and turned over to Danang Special Sector.

#### 19 September 1968

At 191000H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with 3rd AmTrae Battalion and personnel from Denang Special Sector conducted a search/sweep operation in Hoa Long hamlet (BT083705). Six (6) VCS were apprehended and turned over to Daneng Special Sector for interrogation.

#### 22 September 1968

At 220201H, twenty-three (23) 122mm rockets and fifthern (65) 82mm morter rounds impacted in the Danang Vital Area. MAG-46 received fifteen (15) 122mm rockets and fifteen (15) 82mm morrow rounds reduling in two (2) WIA and the following aircraft domage: Nino (9) CR-53, thirteen (13) CH-46, Nine (9) JH-34, and seven (7) EUTER's, and one (1) hanger received minor damage. NSA Hospital received three (3) 122mm rockets causing minor damage to one (1) ambulance. I Compute dead overters received five (5) 122mm rockets resulting in seven (7) will and slight demage to one (1) building.

At 222345H a combined ambush from Company "C". 1st MP Battalion and District 2 Headquarters, became involved in a fixe fight at (A1999786) with an unknown size enemy force. There were two (2) Vietnamese WIA's.

No report of enemy casual lies.

# 23 September 1968

At 230330H Company "C", 1st MP Battalion and a PF platson from Danang City District 2 Headquarters conducted a combined awaep operation in Grid Square (AT9978). Six (6) VCS were apprehended and turned over to Daneng Special Sector for interrogation.

### **24 September 1968**

At 240830H Company "B", 1st MP Battalion with one (1) plateon General "A", 1st MP Battalion, one (1) plateon Maintenance Battalion, one (1) platoon III MAF Security Forces and a Combined force of PF, PFP and Polices provided by Danang Special Sector and 3rd District Headquarton: pecture a search/sweep operation in the vicinity of Grid Square (BT0480) a disc (6) VCS were picked up by the National Police and turned over to busing Special Sector.


#### 25 September 1968

At 251130H Company "C" and a reaction Platoen from H&S Company, 1st MP Battalion, the 1st MAW Reserve Company, a detachment from 5th 62T. 300 (2) platoons of District 2 PF's and a detachment of District 2 National Police concluded a combined "County Fair" operation in the village of Thanh Ke Ba and An Khe Mot (AT9977). The U.S. Army 7th PsyOps Bn and 1st MAW Civil Affairs Office provided Psychological and Civic Action support.

At 252117H and 252120H 1st MP Battalion set Tactical Alert Condition 1 due to rocket alert. One (1) 122mm rocket was reported to impact in

the vicinity of Phuoc Thong (AT989749).

# 28 Sontember 1968

At 282150H a Company "B", 1st MP Battalion "Killer Team" composed of one (1) Marine and one (1) 106th RF Company Soldier apprehended one (1) 17 year old female VCS in the hamlet of My Thi (BT054743). The RF soldier pointed her out as being in the wrong house and upon investigation, it was found that she did not have a valid I.D. card. Suspect was questioned by Battalion S-2 personnel and taken to Danang Special Sector for further interrogation.

### 29 September 1968

At 290450H Danang Air Base received approximately four (4) unidentified caliber rocket rounds. Impact reports were received from the following organizations: VQ-1 reported one (1) rocket landed east of their contenemnt area adjacent to the runway and one (1) landed inside their area. They reported three (3) WIA's and damage to one (1) A-3 aircraft. MACG-18 reported receiving one (1) round in their motor pool area. Negative casualties and minor damage to vehicles were reported. 1st MAW Security reported one (1) round landing in the hamlet immediately west of their perimeter fence. No casualty or damage reports received.
