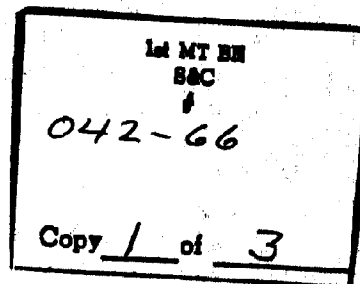
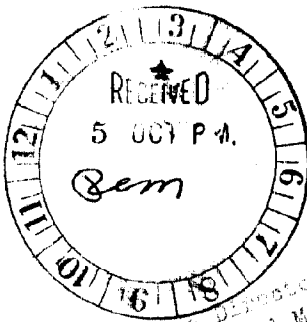

- a. On 26 and 27 September 1966 personnel of this Battalion participated in it's first "Rough Rider" convoy. The task was performed in accordance with Appendix G to Division Administrative Order 301-66 and was completed without incident.
- b. During the month of September this Battalion experienced a change of command and replacement of every Staff Officer. It is recommended that an attempt be made to avoid this in the future, since it deters continuity and is conducive to an oversight of requirements.

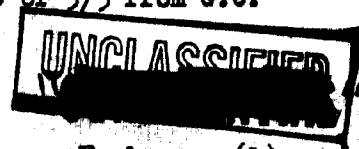

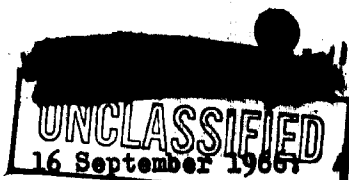


September 1966:

- 01 September 1966: 11 trucks transported 31,500 pounds of supplies and 16 troops of the 2ndROKBrig from the Chu Lai sand ramp to Tuy Hoa.
- 02 September 1966: 10 trucks transported 17,000 pounds of supplies and 29 troops of the 2ndROKBrig from the Chu Lai sand ramp to Tuy Hoa.
- 02 September 1966: FMFPac inspection of the 1st Motor Transport Battalion.
- 04 September 1966: 4 trucks transported 45 troops and 7,000 pounds of supplies for the 5thMarRegt from hill #35 to the Tam Ky ISA.
- 04 September 1966: 4 trucks from 1stMTBn and 20 trucks from LAAM Bn transported 336 troops of 1/5 and 3/5 from Chu Lai to Tam Ky. Convoy remained in Tam Ky, until the following morning.
- 04 September 1966: LtGen KRULAK visited 1st Motor Transport Battalion.
- 04 September 1966: 6 trucks transported 180 troops of 3/5 from the 3/5 C.P. to Tam Ky.
- 04 September 1966: 8 trucks transported 160 troops of 2/5 from the 2/5 C.P. to the Tam Ky ISA.
- 05 September 1966: 2 trucks transported 42 troops and 1,000 pounds of supplies from 1stReconBn to the Tam-Ky ISA.
- 05 September 1966: Convoy which staged overnight at Tam Ky returned. (See 04Sep66)
- 06 September 1966: 3 trucks transported 40 troops of the 1stEngBn from the 1stEngBn C.P. to Quang Ngai. 1 truck remained behind for support.
- 08 September 1966: 19 trucks transported 358 troops and 9,100 pounds of radio equipment from the 7thMarRegt and 1/7 C.P. to Quang Ngai.
- 09 September 1966: 2 trucks were used for security of a Communications Convoy to Quang Ngai.
- 14 September 1966: 13 trucks transported 264 troops and 15,510 pounds of supplies of 2/5 from the Tam Ky ISA to G.C. 269192.
- 15 September 1966: 11 trucks transported 225 troops of 3/5 from G.C. 269192 to the 3/5 C.P.

- 16 September 1966: 4 trucks transported 84 troops and 1,500 pounds of supplies, of 1/7 from G.C. 729539 to the 1/7 C.P.
- 17 September 1966: 2 trucks returned from Quang Ngai. (See 06Sep66)
- 17 September 1966: 4 trucks transported 99 troops, of 1/7, from G.C. 729539 to the 1/7 C.P.
- 18 September 1966: 4 trucks transported 77 troops and 1,300 pounds of supplies, of 1/7, from G.C. 729539 to the 1/7 C.P.
- 22 September 1966: 2 trucks transported 35 troops from the 1/7 C.P. to G.C. 729539.
- 23 September 1966: 1 truck: TAD to G-5 Binh Son.
- 26 September 1966: 23 trucks transported 29,975 pounds of sand bags from Chu Lai to Da Nang. Rough Rider remained in Da Nang overnight.
- 26 September 1966: 10 trucks to Mo Duc staged overnight to return the following day with troops.
- 27 September 1966: Rough Rider returning to Chu Lai complex from Da Nang transported 51,650 pounds of lime and water purification equipment.
- 27 September 1966: 10 trucks returned from Mo Duc with 430 troops and 2,000 pounds of supplies. 1 truck from Company "B" 1stMTBn TAD to operation FRESNO returned to the C.P.
- 29 September 1966: 8 trucks transported 167 troops and 600 pounds of supplies for 3/5 to Phu-Loc.
