NARRATIVE SUMMARY

First Motor Transport Battalion primarily performed routine logistic tasks within the DaNang TAOR, and continued convoys from the DaNang TAOR to An Hoa in support of the Vietnamese Industrial Complex located there.

Utilizing 97% of the available trucks, a total of 115,840 miles were driven by the Battalion carrying 29,870 troops and 4,784 tons of cargo.

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

- 5 May 1967 - A Rough Rider convoy of 96 vehicles controlled by Company "A" transported 430 tons of Class I & II from the 1st Motor Transport Battalion Command Post to FLC in the City Of Hue.
- 9 May 1967 - A Rough Rider convoy of 130 trucks controlled by Company "B" transported 480 tons of Class I, II, III, IV, & V from 1st Motor Transport Battalion Command Post to Phu Bai for First Battalion, Twenty-sixth Marines.
- 19 May 1967 - Convoy comprised of 13 M35A2C's from Company "C" transported 250 troops from First Battalion, Seventh Marines Command Post to Hill 190 in support of Operation DUVAL.
- 23 May 1967 - Convoy comprised of 12 trucks from Company "B" transported 31.5 tons of cement and 13.5 tons of rice from the 1st Motor Transport Battalion Command Post to An Hoa.
