PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

First Motor Transport Battalion performed routine logistical tasks within the PHU BAI THON and conducted tactical support operations in conjunction with OPERATION HUE.

During the period twenty five (25) vehicles in support of the displacement of the First Marine Regiment were prevented from returning from QUANG TRI and Camp Evans due to Operation Hue City. From 4 February until 15 February eleven (11) vehicles were caught in Hue City when the bridges were blown. They continued to support the Hue City Operation from within the City. From the 11th February to the end of reporting period seven (7) vehicles were in direct support of Operation Hue. Of the remaining vehicles, 100% were utilized, daily travelling a total of 15,720 miles and carrying 6,659 troops and 729 tons of cargo.
