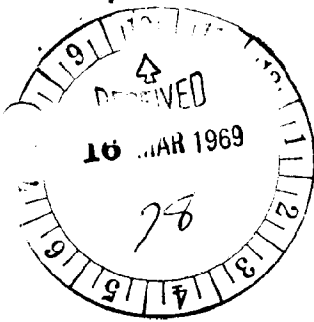





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PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 1st Motor Transport Battalion performed routine combat logistical functions within the 1st Marine Division TACR. The Battalion traveled 65,578 miles, transporting 46,446 troops, and 4,946 tons of general cargo. The 1st Motor Transport Battalion remains in support of the 1st Marine, 5th Marine, 7th Marine, and 26th Marine Regiments.

PART III
SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

10 Feb 1969

1st Marine Division tasked this Battalion to provide a five (5) truck standby detail for contingency operations during the TET Holiday period. This commitment continued through 28 February.

23 Feb 1969

0210 Sapper attack launched against our cantonment. (Camp Perdue). Enemy (NVA) employed satchel charges, RPG's and chicom grenades.

During this attack the following casualties were sustained by this battalion:

KIA-1 Cpl MOSS, Ronald G. 2257263/3371 H&S Company

WIA-4 Sgt KLINE, Charles M. 1916101/3371 H&S Company, multiple cuts on both feet and right leg and torn ligament right knee.

Cpl BRUNER, Henry T. 2230334/3371 H&S Company shrapnel wound left arm and hand.

LCpl ARRIS, William E. Jr. 2257267/3371 H&S Company, multiple wounds of head and back.

PFC TUMMINGS, Byron A. 2467254/3371 H&S Company, shrapnel wound right arm.

0900 Two 140mm rockets impacted in 1st Motor Transport Battalion Industrial Area.

Results 1 WIA and no property damage.

WIA-1 Pvt McDEVITT, Barney 2375081/3531 B Company, shrapnel wound of right elbow.

1100 Two 140mm rockets impacted in 1st Motor Transport Battalion Industrial area. No personnel casualties. CFM15 Lubrication Unit, was damaged by shrapnel.

23 Feb 1969

Pvt BEMLEY, Jerry L. 2423029/3531 A Company, while at Phu Loc (6) RVN suffered shrapnel wound of scalp during hostile action.

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
