NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The 1st Motor Transport Battalion performed routine combat logistical functions within the 1st Marine Division TAOR. The Battalion traveled 90,502 miles transporting 48,435 troops, and 5,659 tons of general cargo. The 1st Motor Transport Battalion remains in support of the 1st Marine, 5th Marine, 7th Marine, and 26th Marine Regiments.
