PART II Narrative Summary

1. General KRULAK toured the FLSG area observing operations and inspecting various facilities.
2. General WAIT inspected the area.
3. The month of June saw a gradual increase in supply and maintenance support furnished.
4. Construction of a new ammunition storage point commenced. The Class V ammunition will be moved from its present close proximity of the airfield and living areas to the vicinity of AT985732. The new area will include four concrete bunkers, seven earth bunkers and approximately 540,000 sqd of staging and open storage area.
5. Representatives from FMFPac Supply and Data Processing offices visited during this month as well as Commanding Officer, 3d FSR and members of his staff.
6. A three mile hoseline was installed from Tourane River to fuel farms and used to unload JP-4 and AVGAS. Four tanker ships with 787,000 gallons of JP-4 and 87,000 gallons of AVGAS were unloaded through the line. A 3.7 mile hoseline and 5000 feet of 4 inch steel pipeline was installed from Red Beach One to the fuel storage area. 725,000 gallons of JP-4 and 143,000 gallons of AVGAS were pumped from this line.
7. Normal functions of each company are listed below:
 - a. Supply Company
 - (1) 15 June, 11,126 pounds of "A" rations flown to FLSU #2.
 - (2) 25 June a local commercial trucker has successfully delivered rations to FLSU #2.
 - (3) 12 June at approximately 12100CH, a rocket fired from a helicopter exploded near the JP-4 tank farm #2. Two 10,000 gallon tanks were punctured by shrapnel. Emergency patches were installed and only approximately 50 gallons were lost. A small fire was extinguished. No casualties were sustained.
 - (4) 19 June ration platoon has one ice block machine in operation. Shipped bread and "B" rations to FLSU #1.
 - b. Medical Branch - During this period the Medical Branch received 44 personnel wounded in action. 41 personnel were killed, the remains were processed and shipped to the Tan Son Nhut Mortuary at Saigon by the Graves Registration Team of the FLSG S-3 office. The 3d Med Bn has been chopped from FLSG to Div OpCon but statistics are included with FLSG report.

c. Transportation Branch/Truck Co - During the month of June 7,042 tons of supplies and equipment and 40,971 personnel were moved a total of 97,519 miles. 3d and 9th Motor Transport Bn were chopped from the FLSG to the Division during the month but their statistics are included for cargo vehicles as well as the FLSG organic vehicles.
