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

b. Command and Control:

(1) The proposed concept as contained in CG, III MAF ltr 4/GCA/krw over 4000 of 2 February 1966 was approved by CG, FMFPac message 190403Z February 1966.

(2) The Charter of the Force Logistic Command was promulgated by CG, FMFPac ltr 4D/JHM/gea over 5400 of 13 March 1966.

(3) This Headquarters was given operational control of the Force Logistic Command on 15 March 1966 by CG, FMFPac message 132219Z March 1966.

ENCLOSURE (1)

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(4) This Headquarters was given administrative control of the Force Logistic Command on 25 March 1966 by CG, FMFPac message 140423Z March 1966.

(5) The nucleus staff which represented key billets for initial activation and planning consisted of 15 officers and 17 enlisted. These billets are contained in CG, III MAF message 110848Z February 1966.

(6) The period 15 March 1966 to 31 March 1966 was utilized to join personnel, organize office procedures, effect liaison, familiarize sections with the functions of FLSG Alpha and Bravo to ensure an orderly assumption of command.
