PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. FLSG-A moved from Phu Bai, RVN to DaNang, RVN on 5 January 1969 remaining in a cadre status.
2. Supply Company (Reinforced) FLSG-A remained in Phu Bai and continued to provide limited Supply and Maintenance Support to Marine Elements in the Phu Bai area with a longer range objective to transfer supplies from the stock account to FLSG-BRAVO and FLC. Planning for a new Support Mission commenced.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF EVENTS

1. FLC Organizations Committed to Combat and the SLF.

a. Combat Missions Assigned.

(1) The movement and re-establishment of the main body of FLSG-ALPHA on 5 January 1969 from Phu Bai to DaNang was the primary concern of the Command during the early part of January. The Supply Company (Alpha Rear) remained at Phu Bai for Stock Account MR200 Draw Down.

(2) During January, conferences and briefings were held which led to an agreement with Force Logistics Command that FLSG-ALPHA could provide Combat Supply Support in the form of LSU's for 1st Marine Division Units located at An Hoa (LSU-1) and Hill 55 (LSU-2).

(3) An operation and administrative plan was completed for contingency planning for a future mission.

b. Command Relations. Supply Company, FLSG-ALPHA (Rear) continued to have favorable command relationships with U.S. Army Forces at Phu Bai.

c. Equipment. Approximately 60% of Table of Equipment Allowances are on hand for FLSG-ALPHA.

d. Logistics.

(1) Supply Company FLSG-ALPHA continued to draw down all classes of supplies held my stock account MR200 with considerable shipments to FLSG-BRAVO and to Force Logistic Command for purposes of account de-activation.

(2) In the area of Maintenance, the following events took place:

(a) 9 January 1969 - Project M-16 Rebuild commenced calling for the rebuild of approximately 8,000 rifles.

(b) 9 January 1969 - Project M-60 Bullet Ramp Modification commenced with message sent requesting units to turn in 380 M-60 Machine Guns to be checked for modifications.

- (c) 24 January - Project M-16 Rebuild terminated with the depletion of chrome barrels. A total of 8,152 rifles were rebuilt.
- (d) 26 January - Project 10 completed. A total of 87 trucks were rebuilt and turned over to the 2nd Brigade, Republic of Korea Marine Corps.
- (e) 27 January - Project 11 commenced with plans for rehabilitation of sixty (60) M-38A1 trucks to be issued to MFAAG-3.

e. Civic Action. The S-5 Section at FLSG-ALPHA (Rear) was terminated on 31 January 1969.

f. Personnel. FLSG-ALPHA continued operations in a cadre status.

g. Redesignation. Supply Company, FLSG-ALPHA was redesignated Supply Company, FLSG-ALPHA (Rear).
