

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Enclosures (1) and (2) provide detailed background information concerning the effective combat service support which the Force Logistic Command continues to provide all III Marine Amphibious Forces in the Republic of Vietnam during February 1967.
2. On 16 Feb 67 the Flag of the 1st Force Service Regiment was transferred from Camp Pendleton to the Force Logistic Command, FMFPac at Danang, Vietnam. The Commanding General, Force Logistic Command, FMFPac assumed command of the 1st Force Service Regiment and the new organization was redesignated FLC/1st FSR. General and special FLC staffs now function as the command element for both headquarters. Tabs (G), (H) and (I) with supporting documents provide details of the reorganization.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Summary of Events

a. Personnel

(1) Reenlistment and Extensions of Enlistments: The Monthly reenlistment percentages are as follows: First Term - 15%, Career - 83%, for an overall command average of 32%. There were 13 extensions of enlistment for the month of February 1967. Eighty-seven personnel extended their overseas tour and are eligible for the "Special" 30 day leave.

(2) Savings Bond and Savings Deposit Program: Of the 6913 Marine and Navy personnel on board 5620 or 81.2% actively participate in the Savings Bond Program. Forty officers and 194 enlisted men participate in the Savings Deposit Program.

(3) Transient Center: Improvement and expansion of existing facilities and new construction continues. Occupancy figures for February were: High 976, Low 462, Average 663.

b. Legal

(1) The Force Logistic Command Legal Section tried 3 General Courts-Martial and 12 Special and Summary Courts-Martial.

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(2) Captain Charles J. KALL reported to the Legal Section on 12 February 1967 as a Defense Counsel/Legal Assistance Officer replacing Major James R. ZIEMANN who departed on 8 February 1967.

c. Intelligence

(1) On 22 Feb 1967 the 5th Counter-Intelligence Sub-Team assigned to the Red Beach Security Section completed a Security Survey of the Red Beach Defenses and submitted it's report to Commanding General, Force Logistic Command.

(2) During February 1967 - 3500\$VN of Rewards Funds were paid to local Vietnamese civilians for return of weapons and voluntary disclosure of information concerning the Viet Cong.

d. Training

(1) On 1 Feb 1967 Captain T. J. SCOTES was assigned FLC, NBC/Trng Officer.

(2) On 17 Feb 1967 Captain SCOTES moved TAD to H&SBn, 1st FSR as S-3 for approximately 3 weeks.

(3) On 12 Feb 1967 the FMFPac Generator Contact Team completed it s instructions at FLSG-B. Tab (L) to enclosure (2) is the Commander's letter of evaluation on this Team's instructions.

(4) On 20 Feb 1967 four FLC Marines attended the 3 week Mess Management Course at China Beach.

(5) On 23 Feb 1967 the III MAF Rough Terrain Contact Team completed it s instruction at FLSG-A. Tab (M) to enclosure (2) is Commanding-General's letter of evaluation.

(6) On 23 Feb 1967 the FMFPac Communications-Electronics Contact Team completed it s instruction at the 5th Communication Battalion. Tab (N) to enclosure (2) is Commander, 5th Communication Battalion's evaluation.

(7) During Feb 67, four officers and 58 enlisted Marines attended formal schools. Approximately 200 FLC Marines received contact team instruction at their job sites. A total of 2,500 FLC Marines are enrolled in individual and group study correspondence courses. Many of the individual courses are MOS oriented.

e. Communications and Electronics

(1) During the month of February, the Data Communication Facility installation neared final completion. Mr. J. HAMAMOTO, Chief Project Eng-

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ineer for the Force Logistic Command DATACOMM Project arrived from Hawaii, with four other Naval Shore Electronics Engineering Pacific (NAVSEEPAC) Representatives, and began installation engineering on a priority overtime basis. Several boxes of equipment required were lost on the Shipping and Receiving Lot, but were later located. Contact was made with Defense Communication Agency (DCA) Representatives to request a guarantee that channel conditioning would be provided to satisfy requirements of the IBM 1013 - Lenkurt 26C Modem - TSEC/KG-13 Top Secret Installation.

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Lack of an air conditioner, ordered several months ago, appeared to be the most formidable obstacle to operation, but plans were made for check-out about 12 March 1967, during night hours. Power requirements were reviewed, and temporary electrical generator installations made to support the check-out of the system.

(2) Reorganization of the command structure resulted in establishment of a full-time Staff Communication-Electronics Office on 16 February 1967. The reorganization resulted in the following operational communication organizations within the Force Logistic Command, with command relationships as shown below:

(3) Communication Personnel of FLSG ALPHA, PHU BAI, were selected for orientation with the Communication Company H&S Battalion, 1st Force Service Regiment at RED BEACH, and with the US Army Strategic Communication Command Facility, PHU LAM, Non-Automatic Relay Center for the Defense Communication System AUTODIN. Orientation will consist of technical and operational training, in preparation for the establishment of a DATACOMM Facility at the FLSG "A" Communication Center. Although initially unsecure, plans were made for the eventual upgrading of the circuits of 100 card per minute PONTUS Operation, and NAVSEEAPAC Representatives made adjustments to the RED BEACH DATACOMM facility accordingly.

(4) Initial T/O and T/E Requirements were reviewed, and changes were under study at the close of the month in an attempt to keep pace with the expected continuous rapid expansion of Force Logistic Command operational communication requirements.

(5) The Communication Company Commander and Staff Communication-Electronics representatives consulted with the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-3 and the Transportation and Embarkation Officer, and agreed upon plans to provide increased communications in support of the Logistics Operations Center and Traffic Management Operations, to include Air and Surface Port Stations as well as mobile stations.

f. Logistics

(1) Fleet Stock Account activity report for the period 11-18 Feb 67 showed an increase in the fill-rate percentage over the previous reporting period of 4-11 Feb 67. Increased from 29% to 37% in fill rate.

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(2) Brake shoe lining for 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 5 ton trucks ^{have} ~~has~~ been a problem. The shoes with lining attached have been on pri 02 and 05 reqns for a period of two to three months. The lining brake was procured in the amount of 580 feet. This helped, but some units don't have fourth echelon repair capabilities in order to cut and shape the lining to the shoes. Assistance requested from Force Service Regiment of dues of subject item.

(3) 6TN batteries have been a constant problem, they have been procured from the Army at 1st Logistic Command, Naval Support Activity, and we have tried to procure them on the open market Japan. Outstanding reqns are in the system. This battery is used on all types of vehicles, and starter motors.

(4) Butane gas and CO₂ remains a problem. Major source of supply on Butane gas is NSA at the present time. NSA has a monthly demand of 500 cylinders of butane gas in 100 lb. cylinders. NSA's present source of supply is from commercial open-market. NSA indicates relief in sight on butane gas sometime in March or April 67. Assistance has been requested from 3rd FSR on outstanding requisitions for CO₂. Item in short supply at 3rd FSR. Anticipated receipt of CO₂ from MCSC Barstow due in March 67.

(5) Eight (8) foot metal stakes continues to be a problem. The stock accounts at present hold obligations for a quantity of 145,326 each with dues of 178,803 each. Some relief was given by the purchase of 46,000 each and 18,000 each from NSA during the month of February 67. Assistance was requested to CG, FMFPac on subject item.

(6) During the month of February 1967, the summer requirements of major commands within III MAF were completed. Twenty-seven line items were requested. Stock accounts were instructed to requisition RO plus 50% of subject items in order to meet demands of using units.

(7) Furnish the AMRD on 493 Cog "I" blank forms to NSA. NSA will screen these items and AMRD and indicate to us those blank forms they can support us on and the month of start of support.

(8) During February, the G-3 Operations Section coordinated with 1st Marine Division and FLSG Bravo to load initial and follow-on supply aboard four LST's in support of SLF operations in southern ICTZ.

(9) Personnel from the G-3 Operations Section participated in numerous discussions on the handling of retrograde cargo. There were some specific uncertainties concerned with retrograde brass and the reporting requirements. As of this date III MAF is still preparing a directive which will incorporate III MAF and COMUSMACV requirements. 1stFSR and the Groups have been given interim procedures.

(10) G-3 Operations coordinated with G-4 and personnel to prepare the LSU to accompany BLT 2/3. Some personnel and equipment were lifted to Dong Ha via Rough Rider convoy on 25 Feb. (See para 13 below). Opcon of the LSU was passed to the BLT on 24 Feb 1967.

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(11) Agenda items and fact sheets were prepared to accompany Col COWPER and Maj EDEBOHLS to the 7th Periodic Logistic Conference held at Headquarters, FMFPac.

(12) The G-3 Operations Section prepared proposed revisions to the Table of Organization for the Ration Co, Ammo Co, and Truck Co, 1stFSR.

(13) The G-3 Operations Section coordinated with 3d Marine Division, 1st Marine Division, H&S Bn and Supply Bn to load a rough rider convoy for Phu Bai and Dong Ha. The 74 vehicle convoy departed Red Beach at 0930 on 25 Feb 67 with approximately 39 S/T of cargo for FLSG Alpha dumps/customers. Also included in the convoy were 3 vehicles and 3 S/T of cargo for LSU 2/3.

(14) February saw the commencement of airlifts of fresh produce from Danang to Chu Lai. During the first week, 14,000 lbs of fresh produce were delivered.

(15) 3rd FSR LTI team consisting of 22 officers and enlisted personnel arrived in RVN to conduct LTI's on BLT 2/3 on 6 Feb 67. Team departed RVN on 11 Feb 67.

(16) 15-17 Feb 1967 FMFPac held a ground Ordnance Conference at FMFPac (Fwd) Okinawa. Attendees from FLC were Col STEPHENSON, Captain INGLISA, Lt MEYERS and CWO RUST.

(17) 17 Feb 1967 CG, FMFPac approved scheduled plan for Force Logistic Command to assume responsibility for 4th Echelon Maintenance of common items of section "M" Equipment commencing 1 Apr 1967 for 1st MAW.

(18) 27-28 Feb 1967 a total of 72 M35A2 multi-fuel trucks and 69 EIMCO tractors arrived RVN LTI's were conducted and distribution orders issued for assignment to specific units within the III MAF TAOR.

(19) The CG, FMFPac authorized this Command requisitioning authority for M-Series T/E items of two Service Battalions, one full strength Force Service Regiment and previously approved special allowances. In order to determine quantities of T/E items authorized to be placed on requisition and to insure that excess items are not generated, an inventory of equipment on hand, programmed assets, and quantities on requisition, has been initiated.

(20) During the month of February 1967 the money value of Garrison Property was tabulated. The account is presently valued at \$1,288,395.92.

(21) Information was received that a total of 40 forklifts 6000 #RTF, have been earmarked for shipment in-country. Delivery is expected during the later part of March. Receipt of the above equipment will

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greatly alleviate present material handling equipment problems in RVN.

(22) The DPP facility building was completed and turned over for installation of equipment during Feb 1967.

(23) The Purchasing and Contracting Office, purchased various items in Vietnam on the open market for support of military forces in Vietnam. \$429,000.00 was obligated.

g. Transportation/Embarkation.

(1) The Transportation/Embarkation Terminal Liaisons established in January are effectively controlling receipts, processing and shipment of cargo through terminals. Information/data provided by terminal liaison allow for maximum utilization of available transportation on a timely basis.

(2) Cargo which would have been double handled is being Transshipped at the terminal sites.

Chu Lai and Phu Bai Terminal Liaison personnel will be increased as personnel become available.

h. Civic Action.

(1) Approval was received from III Marine Amphibious Force to extend Civic Action Area #5. Civic Action Area #5 now includes the villages of HOA VINH, HOA THANH and the hamlets of HOA HIEP, HOA MINH and HOA KHANH as previously assigned.

(2) The units of FLSG Alpha were redesignated as Battalions of the 1st Force Service Regiment and consequently have been assigned areas of responsibility.

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(3) Rebuilding of PHUOC QUANG Hamlet that burned in mid-February is progressing. Pads and frameworks have been completed on some 50 homes. Completion of homes are being accomplished by the hamlet people themselves. Many loads of scrap lumber from dunnage have been made available to the village.

i. Chaplain Support.

(1) The following chaplains are presently assigned to FLC/1stFSR:

(2) The following chaplains are due to report in March:

(3) Complete Roman Catholic, Jewish, Lutheran, Episcopal and Mormon coverage was given to all commands by supporting chaplains from near-by commands.

(4) There were 14 Sunday services conducted by FLC chaplains with 505 men attending. There were 17 weekday services with 58 men attending.

(5) The chaplain at Red Beach counselled on 23 different occasions during the month.

(6) The chaplains participated in the civic action activities with reference to the institutional work within their respective areas. \$500.00 from the Protestant Chapel Fund at Red Beach was contributed to Vietnamese Educational Scholarship Board.

(7) Bible classes were held each Friday evening at Red Beach.

(8) Two indoctrination lectures were given for the command on the "Religions of Vietnam" with 72 men attending.

(9) Six Red Cross emergency messages were handled by the chaplain at Red Beach. (No report as to such from FLSC"A")

(10) Weekly visitations were made to the Transient Center, the III MAF Brig, ASP#1 and the 1st Medical Battalion.



1. Reference (a) contains administrative instructions concerning the transfer and assumption of command of the 1st Force Service Regiment, FMFP. The Battalion structure of the 1st FSR will be the basis for establishing the logistic organizations in the Danang area.

2. In order to more adequately support reference (a), a reallocation of administrative buildings/spaces and messing facilities is required. Accordingly, Battalion Commanders are requested to relocate as indicated in enclosure (1) effective upon receipt of this letter. It is desired that this move be accomplished as expeditiously as possible with minimum interruption to the working schedule.

3. The following additional guidance is provided.

a. Regimental Messhall #1 will be operated by the Commanding Officer, H&S Battalion, 1st FSR. Regimental Messhall #2 will be operated by the Commanding Officer, Supply Battalion, 1st FSR. Personnel will continue to subsist in the messhall in which they are presently subsisting. Essentially, this means that:

(1) All personnel billeted in area A of enclosure (1), except the Supply Battalion officers, will eat in Regimental Messhall #1. Supply Battalion officers will continue to eat in Regimental Messhall #2.

(2) All personnel billeted in area B of enclosure (1), except the Guard, will eat in Regimental Messhall #2. The Guard will continue to eat in Regimental Messhall #1.

b. All personnel will continue to be billeted in their presently assigned quarters until a reassessment of strength and billets is completed. At that time billeting will be reallocated as required.


