

PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. Force Logistic Command continued effective combat service support to all III MAF units in RVN and in addition furnished logistic support to other Service's units and the 2nd ROK Marine Brigade within I Corps. Enclosures (1) and (2) herein describe in detail the magnitude of such support.

PART III

SEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

1. Summary of Events

a. Personnel.

(1) Transient Center: Improvements are being accomplished on a continuing basis. Occupancy for the month of January was as follows: High 1058, Low 291, Monthly Average 674.

(2) Savings Bond and Savings Deposit program: Of the 6788 personnel on board, 5403 or 79.6% are actively participating in the Savings Bond Program. 17 Officers and 142 enlisted personnel are participating in the Savings Deposit Program.

(3) Reenlistment and Extensions of Enlistments: The monthly reenlistment percentages are as follows: First term - 13%, Career - 93%, for an overall average of 63% for the Command. There were 15 extensions of enlistments for the month of January 1967. Further, 103 personnel extended their overseas tour for the "special" 30 days leave.

(4) The 3d Quarter Manning Level of the Force Logistic Command published by CG FMFPac spdltr 1/rbg over 5320/9 of 30 January 1967 has increased the strength from 303 officers and 6282 enlisted to 306 officers and 6682 enlisted broken down as follows:

b. Legal. No significant events.

c. Training.

(1) Explosive Ordnance Orientation initiated at Saigon, RVN. Intention is to brief newly arrived EOD on latest techniques encountered in RVN. Orientation duration three days on a monthly scheduled.

(2) Training Officer attended the FMFPac training conference on Okinawa. Highlights of training conference are enclosed as Tab K to Enclosure (2).

(3) Major SANFORD, OIC Training Section, was reassigned as CO, FLSU#1 on 16 Jan 1967. His relief is due in February.

(4) GySgt L. C. HOLMES reported into the Training Section on 16 Jan 1967 to replace GySgt MAIERHOFFER as NCOIC.

(5) FLC Provisional Rifle Platoon was instructed in Basic Weapons training and fired the rifle range for familiarization.

(6) A new communication school was established on Okinawa with 4 courses monthly.

(7) Force Logistic Command ordered 45 enlisted and 4 officers to attend formal schools during the month of January.

(8) Force Logistic Command had a total of 2000 personnel enrolled in individual and group study correspondence courses during January. The group study courses and several of the individual courses are MOS orientated.

(9) Force Logistic Command had approximately 155 personnel contacted at their job sites by out of country contact teams.

d. Communications and Electronics.

(1) During the month of January, the Data Communication Facility was completed with exception of the Bill of Materials required from the Naval Shore Electronics Engineering Activity, Pacific (NAVSEEPAC) for final installation, in order to insure TEMPEST control. All equipment, with exception of one air conditioner and one ancillary electrical accounting machine equipment, was delivered. Fencing to provide the necessary physical security was delivered and was awaiting installation at the close of the month. Cryptographic equipments TSEC/KG-13 were modified for low level keying, and Top Secret Keying Material was delivered.

(2) Plans were made for training of message center and communication maintenance personnel in data communications, to support the requirement for a point to point data communication circuit between the Force Logistic Command Headquarters, and Force Logistic Support Unit 2, at Phu Bai. The circuit will not be secured initially.

(3) The Command's first directive on the use of operational communications, FLCO 2000.1, was prepared for signature.

(4) The determination of total communication requirements, to include personnel equipment, and systems requirements, was delayed pending a review of the organizational structure of components of the command.

e. Logistics.

(1) 9 January; A conference at NSA on direct issue of rations from NSA to Marine and CB messhalls in East Danang.

(2) 9 January; The first official ForLogComd RUC listing was published.

(3) 11 January; A conference at ForLogComd on problems connected with Operation of Class V (A) ASP.

(4) 14-19 January 1967; 3d FSR LTI team in-country to LTI BLT 1/3. 2 Officers and 16 enlisted.

(5) 18 January; ForLogSupUnit Two inventory commenced. Inventory will correct balances and improve services of FLSU #2.

(6) 20 January; Major J. MASTERS from Naval Audit Section, San Diego visited to discuss Navy peculiar ammo problems.

(7) 23 January; The inception of the ASP #1 Inventory Control Point under control of Chief of Staff, G-3 ForLogComd. The ICP is manned by 1 Officer, 1 GySgt and 2 SSgt's and located in ForLogComd Headquarters building.

(8) Major MOODY from 9th MAB G-4 Section visited to discuss T/E's and ISSA's for rotating BLT's.

(9) The new program of support by NSA was kicked off 25Jan with the forwarding of a deck of Class II and Medical Items to 3d FSR will cut off support of these items and NSA will be the only source.

(10) 26 January; Seismic Intrusion Device Demonstration. FLC representative together with one man from 1st Marine Division went to Saigon along with 4 AN/PSR01's TAD to Saigon to demonstrate AN/PSR-1 to U. S. Army's 9th Infantry Division, for a period of 5 days.

(11) 28 January ; ForLogSupGroup Bravo commenced operation of LSA "DESOTO"

(12) 30 January; FLSU #2 have completed their inventory started on 18 January.

(13) 31 January; Operations Officer held meeting with 9th MAB representatives and discussed new proposal for support of the rotation BLT by placing LSU maintenance support at Subic Bay. This is a 9th MAB proposal.

(14) 20 January; ForLogComd assumed responsibility for the reception storage and issue of Class V, reference FMFPac AdminO msg 312349Z Dec 66. ...

(15) The purchasing and contracting office, Force Logistic Command, FMF: purchased various items in RVN on the open market during January 1967. \$173,000.00 was obligated during this month.

(16) A contract for potable ice was let at Quang Tri, Vietnam, for use by military forces at Dong Ha, Vietnam.

(17) A contract was let for rock for use by Korean military forces.

f. Transportation/Embarkation.

(1) Transportation/Embarkation Terminal Liaison Units established last month are effectively controlling receipts, processing and shipment of cargo through terminals. Information/data provided by terminal liaison allows for maximum utilization of available transportation on a timely basis.

(2) Cargo which would have been double handled is now being transhipped at the terminal sites.

(3) A comprehensive SOP is being drafted to provide instructions and procedures for all phases of receiving, processing and shipment of cargo to/from and within CG III MAF area of responsibility.

g. Civic Action.

(1) Request was made to CG III MAF to extend Civic Action area of responsibility to include Hoa Vinh and Hoa Thanh Villages.

(2) It is proposed that the Hamlets of Huong Phuoc and Ngai Tay should be the responsibilities of the 7th Engineer Battalion while the Hamlets of Van Duong, Trung Son, Tranh Vin and An Ngai Dong should be the responsibility of the 1st 8" Howitzer Battery. These assignments of hamlets are per unit requests. Both units will be coordinated by the coordinator of Civic Action Area #5.

(3) It was further recommended that Nghi Tay Hamlet of Hoa Phat Village be assigned to Force Logistic Command. The responsibility for civic action in this hamlet will be assigned to Maintenance Company of FLSG-Alpha, and will be coordinated through the 1st Marine Division.

h. Chaplain Support.

- (1) The following chaplains are assigned to FLC:
Lt. F. P. GROSE, Episcopal, (acting staff chaplain), FLSG"A"
Lt. (jg) Preston KEARSLEY, Mormon, FLSU#2, chaplain

Complete Roman Catholic, Jewish, Lutheran, Episcopal coverage was given to all commands by chaplains from the 3rd Marine Division, 1st Marine Division, 1st Marine Air Wing, and MCB-9.

- (2) The Force Logistic chaplains conducted 53 Sunday services with 1270 men attending, and 72 weekday services with 639 men attending.
- (3) The chaplain at FLSG"B" gave one lecture on the "Religions of Vietnam" with 100 men attending.
- (4) There were 10 persons receiving professional counselling during this period. (No records were left in regards to this by the three chaplains who detached.)

All chaplains participated in the civic action activities of their commands with reference to the institutional work within their areas.

22 men accompanied by Chaplain BROWN attended a Bible conference in the Philippines.

Friday evening Bible classes continue at FLSG"A"; in addition a Wednesday evening Episcopal Communion Service open to all personnel was initiated.
