NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1. FLSG-Alpha continued to provide supply and maintenance support for the 3d Marine Division and other Marine units in the Northern ICTZ. Logistic Support Units from FLSG-Alpha provided direct supply and maintenance support to Division units participating in Operations Kentucky, Osceola, Napoleon, and Neosho.
2. Intermittent unfavorable weather conditions at Phu Bai coupled with aircraft availability difficulties during December led III MAF Headquarters to assign FLC the responsibility to provide the LSU Khe Sanh with Class III (POL) replenishment support.

1. a. Mission - To provide sustained combat services support to all III MAF units in the 3d Marine Division area of operations from south of Phu Bai, north to the DMZ.
