PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During November 1968, FLSG-Bravo continued to provide logistic support for the Third Marine Division and supporting elements, and Task Force Hotel, in direct support of operations Kentucky V, Scotland II, Napoleon/Saline and Dawson River.

On 1 November 1968 the Electronic Maintenance Platoon shop was totally destroyed as a result of direct hit by one round of enemy 130mm artillery fire. The estimated damage to organic test equipment and tools was approximately \$195,000.00.

On 2 November 1968 arrangements were made for interim electronic maintenance support from the 63rd Maintenance Battalion U.S. Army at Quang Tri.

On 3 November 1968 Electronic Maintenance Platoon personnel and surviving equipment moved to Quang Tri. Assigned shop space was a complete Butler building. On this date FLSG-Bravo joined the calibration team "TSM", equipped with on AN/TSM-60 calibration complex from FLSG-Alpha, Phu Bai.

On 16 November 1968 construction work of benches, partitions electrical wiring and power installation were completed. Received 107 items of test and tool equipment, also a technical library from FLSG-Alpha, Phu Bai.

On 19 November 1968, resumed 100% effective operation of Electronic Maintenance Platoon, The 3rd Echelon Electronic maintenance support is limited only by lack of FADAC parts and repair support is provided by the 63rd Maintenance Battalion. U.S. Army, Quang Tri.

On 23 November 1968, Electronic Maintenance Platoon received two "parts" vans, and two supply clerks from Shop Stores to provide supply support.

General Supply Maintenance lost 75% of files and paper work due enemy action on 1 November 1968. Float typewriters lost due to enemy action: two 22 inch, not authorized on float, but held above allowance, eight 21 inch typewriters, and twenty-four 13 inch typewriters.

Engineer Maintenance Platoon has processed 93 intershop work orders during this period. Twenty generators of the 600 series have been modified during this report period.

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Ordnance Maintenance Platoon has shipped three M-109 How (SP) 155mm and one M48a3 Tank to the Replacment and Evacuation Program. Also shipped was one M-114, 155mm towed, and one M10A1, 155mmHOW to be FMFPac Rebuild Program. Two M110 guns mounts were obtained from the U.S. Army.

Motor Transport Maintenance Platoon has shipped 73 vehicles this period. They have exchanged 197 items from the DX program.
