NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the course of the past month, FLSG-Bravo has had a change in mission from support of the Marines in Northern I Corps to support of the 1st Marine Division in the Danang/Chu Lai areas. On 7 November 1969, FLSG-Bravo assumed the old FLSG-Alpha mission and initiated stand-down procedures in the Quang Tri and Dong Ha Combat Bases prior to occupation of the old FLSG-Alpha area at Red Beach. At the same time, the FLSG-Alpha organizational colors were removed to Okinawa. FLSG-Bravo assumed FLSG-Alpha's mission of providing supply/maintenance support to the 1st Marine Division and portions of the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing. This support is provided through the operation of three Logistic Support Units (LSU's), located at Hill 55, Hill 63 (LZ Baldy), and An Hoa Combat Base, and one Sub-Unit located at Chu Lai and known as FLSG-Bravo Sub-Unit #1. The final phases of the FLSG-Bravo stand down in Northern I Corps continues as FLSG-Bravo provides support in the Danang/Chu Lai areas.

The FLSG-Bravo area of operation extends from Red Beach, just north of Danang, south to Chu Lai and west to An Hoa Combat Base. Strategically located within this area are three LSU's and one Sub-Unit. The Sub-Unit located at Chu Lai and operated with 11 Officers and 200 Enlisted men, provides Class V supply support to MAG's 12 and 13, the 1st Combined Action Group, and the 9th Engineer Battalion. In addition, FLSG-Bravo provides 2nd and 3rd echelon maintenance support for the 1st CAG, 3rd echelon support for Marine Corps peculiar equipment belonging to the two Marine Air Groups, and 3rd echelon support for the 9th Engineers. Logistic Support Unit One (LSU-1), located at An Hoa Combat Base, provides Classes I, III and V supply and 3rd echelon maintenance support to the 5th Marine Regiment and attached units. LSU-1 has a personnel compliment of 2 Officers and 75 Enlisted men. LSU-2, located at Hill 55 just west of Danang, provides Classes I and V supply support to the 1st Marine Regiment. No maintenance support at Hill 55 due to the close proximity of Force Logistic Command. One Officer and 14 Enlisted men manage the operation at LSU-2. LSU-3 located at Landing Zone Baldy (Hill 63) is in direct support of the 7th Marine Regiment. Personnel include 2 Officers and 82 Enlisted men. Supply Classes I, III and V and 3rd echelon maintenance support are provided at LSU-3. Facilities occupied at LSU-3 formerly belonged to the U.S. Army. These buildings and other structures were in need of much repair, and a project was started to renovate the area. This renovation project is still underway. In conjunction with the supply/maintenance efforts in support of the 1st Marine Division, FLSG-Bravo continues its retrograde mission from the old 3rd Marine Division TAOR. The final phases of redeployment should be finished before 25 December, but the availability of surface craft will dictate the exact date. All FLSG-Bravo operations are directed and supervised from the Command Post located at Red Beach (Camp Books).

19 November	Close out of Shop Stores.
20 November	Turn-over to Army of Class III support.
21 November	Close out of Medical Supply Support.
22 November	Headquarters of FLSG-Bravo relocated to Camp Books, Red Beach, Danang RVN.  Completion of Class II retrograde and Retail Clothing Retrograde.
