NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Supply Support:

During the month, Logistic Support Units at Hill 55, An Hoa and LZ Baldy continued to support the 1st, 5th and 7th Marine Regiments, respectively. Sub-Unit #1 Chu Lai, continued support of the 9th Engineers, 1st CAG and MAG's 12 and 13.

Class IV supplies at Quang Tri were issued to specified Army units and the remainder retrograded to Force Logistic Command at Danang on 31 December 1969.

Responsibility of the POL transfer capability at Cua Viet was turned over to the U. S. Army during December 1969. The equipment required to maintain the transfer capability was made available to the U. S. Navy on a temporary basis through 31 January 1970.

Maintenance Support:

Motor Transport Platoon inspected, repaired and assigned condition codes to fifty-four items of rolling stock which were shipped to Third Service Battalion as part of the excess equipment reduction program.

Engineer Maintenance Platoon was also engaged in the redistribution of excess assets and continued operation and maintenance of thirty-seven 6000 lbs Rough Terrain forklifts, four 3000 lbs forklift trucks and fifteen 4000 lbs forklifts. The refrigeration section inspected and assigned condition codes to all organic refrigeration equipment.

Ordnance Platoon furnished contact teams to the First Marine Division to inspect M16A1 rifles for exfoliation and urethane corrosion.

Electronics Platoon inspected and assigned condition codes to excess organic equipment and forwarded one hundred thirty-eight pieces of equipment for calibration.

Motor Transport Support:

During the month of December 1969, Truck Company operated convoys between Quang Tri and Danang and provided daily support to the LSU's at An Hoa, LZ Baldy and Hill 55. On 17 December 1969 Truck Company (Forward) moved from Quang Tri to Camp Books and proceeded to redistribute excess motor transport equipment.

Rough Rider convoys between Force Logistic Support Group Bravo and Sub-Unit #1, Chu Lai operated an average of once a week during this reporting period.

Civil Affairs:

During this reporting period S-5 Section of FLSG-Bravo made twenty-three contacts with Chanh Huong Hamlet and twenty contacts with Chanh Phuoc Hamlet.

Six truck loads of scrap wood and ninety-one sheets of tin were distributed to the two hamlets for pagoda repairs. Six General WALT Scholarships of five dollars each were awarded during the month.

The Group BAS conducted four MED-CAPS during which three hundred and forty-three civilians were treated.
