NARRATIVE SUMMARY

SUPPLY SUPPORT

During the reporting period, Sub Unit One, Chu Lai provided Class V, Shipping and Receiving, Laundry and 3rd Echelon Maintenance Support to 9th Engineer Battalion, 1st Combined Action Group and Marine Air Groups 12 and 13.

During the month, Logistic Support Units at An Hoa and LZ Baldy continued to support the 5th and 7th Marine Regiments respectively. The Logistic Support Unit at Hill 55 supported the 1st Marine Regiment until its withdrawal on March 6 1970. The LSU was subsequently disbanded.

During the month of March 1970, Supply Company's Redistribution Point Sub Unit Account 15 remained in full operation, handling all redistribution and excess vehicles for Force Logistic Support Group Bravo. This special project was tasked with receiving all excesses, and to see that all excesses had been LTI'd and that needed maintenance was completed before redistribution. During the month of March 1970, 463 pieces of equipment were received by "Sub Unit 15" and the special project is still in full operation. There have been 1,392 pieces of equipment received and 944 pieces of equipment shipped to date by Supply Company's "Sub Unit Account 15". No major problems are anticipated in the operation of the Redistribution Point.

MAINTENANCE SUPPORT

During the month of March 1970, Electronics Maintenance Platoon continued to LTI and repair for condition code C the equipment from Redistribution Unit #15.

Sub Unit One continued Third Echelon Maintenance support for the 9th Engineer Battalion and Marine Air Groups 12 and 13 and both 2nd and 3rd echelon support for 1st Combined Action Group.

Engineer Maintenance Platoon maintained a satisfactory level of completions. They have also instituted a "crash program" in the repair of the 6,000 lb class of forklifts.

Motor Transport Maintenance Platoon has also maintained a good level of completions while assisting in the LTI of "Green Tag" equipment. They also continue to LTI and repair to condition code C the equipment being sent to Redistribution Unit #15.

Ordnance Maintenance Platoon continued to perform its normal duties in the maintenance of organic gear while finishing up the last of the "Green Tag" equipment.

MOTOR TRANSPORT SUPPORT

During the month of March 1970, Truck Company continued the internal support of motor transport for FLSG-Bravo and continued limited support to Force Logistic Command.

In the accomplishment of its mission, Truck Company provided one 10 truck convoy to Dong Ha and daily runs to An Hoa, Baldy, and Hill 65. Truck Company vehicles traveled 53,641 miles, transported 2,615 tons of cargo, 23,100 gallons of water, 8,500 gallons of fuel and 28,790 personnel.

The turn in of excess property and T/E equipment continued.

CIVIL AFFAIRS

During this reporting period the S-5 Section of FLSG-Bravo has made eighteen (18) contacts with Chanh Huong and nineteen (19) contacts with Chanh Phuoc.

The Group B.A.S. held a total of five (5) MEDCAPS in Chanh Phuoc and four (4) MEDCAPS in Chanh Huong in which four hundred and six (406) civilians were treated.

During the month of March 1970, a two year old baby from Chanh Huong suffering from Angioma and malnutrition was taken to the U. S. Overseas Mission Hospital in Danang for examination. The baby was subsequently admitted for two days for further observation and tests. As a result, the baby may be evacuated to Saigon for further medical care.

Project "Rice for the Poor" was initiated in both hamlets. The object is to provide rice for the extremely poor and jobless. The purchase of the rice was made by funds acquired from the sales of scrap wood by the hamlet chief. The initial fund acquired for rice purchase through this S-5 project was 45,500\$VN for each hamlet.

Also, eight (8) General Walt Scholarships of 500\$VN each were distributed to eight children so they could continue their education.
