

4. Narrative Summary. The vigilance of the 1st Searchlight Battery proceeds while fulfilling its mission of defense to the major perimeters of the I Corps Tactical Zone. No noteworthy enemy contact was made by the Battery during the reporting period nor have any other events of a significant nature occurred. The infra-red capability of individual searchlights have intermittently been rendered inoperable due to the frequent need for replenishment of the power source and the long periods required for repair by third and fourth echelons of maintenance. For the second time, a searchlight at Con Thien Combat Base has been put out of action by enemy fire. Although the infra-red capability is frequently lost, the searchlights maintain the vigil should an immediate need for "white light" become necessary.


