2. Commander's Narrative Statement:

During this reporting period, this organization furnished helicopter support teams (HST) on three (3) occasions and a detachment in support of Logistical support areas (LSAs) these were in support of 5th Marines for Operations Colorado and Jefferson and in support of 7th Marines for Operation Jackson. The battalion furnished a one hundred (100) men detachment to Chu Lai defense command to install 18 miles of defensive wire. Company "B" was committed to the Chu Lai perimeter defense and furnished a fifty (50) men reinforced platoon. Construction was continued on the civic action road between the villages of Long Binh and An Tan. The Battalion MedCap dispensary on KyXuan Island administered treatment to two thousand one hundred and seventy four (2,174) Vietnamese men, women and children. Four hundred (400) bars of soap, four (4) sewing kits and one (1) athletic kit were delivered to the Village Chief.
