1. Narrative Summary

During this period Helicopter Support Teams (HST's) were provided for Operations Mameluke Thrust, Allen Brook, Houston and Scotland II.

Company A remained OPCON to the 1st Marine Regiment.

lst Shore Farty Battalion provided engineer equipment in support of lst Marine Division units. Seven construction projects assigned by the Division Engineer were completed. Continuous engineer equipment support was provided to the Division.

The Med-Cap treated a total of 163 Vietnamese civilians during this reporting period. The Civic Action program is providing materials for the construction of a maternity hospital at Phu Thu'o'ng xa (AT 907754). This project is 90% complete at the present time.

The Battalion heli-lifted 2,056,542 pounds in support of operating Battalions and received 2,731,253 pounds for a total of 4,787,795 pounds handled in the month.

During this period 1st Shore Party Battalion sustained one (1) enlisted KIA and twenty one (21) enlisted WIA.
