





#### 1. Narrative Summary

During this period Helicopter Support Teams were provided for Operations Maneluke Thrust, Allen Brook, Sussex Bay, and Dodge Valley.


Companies A and B completed this and returned to the Battalion area and Company B (Rein) 5th Shore Party B attalion was returned to control of RLT - 27.

1st Shore Party Battalion provided Engineer equipment in support of 1st Marine Division Units. Three projects assigned by the Division Engineer were completed. Continuous Engineer equipment support was provided the Division.

The Med Cap treated a total of 205 medical and 54 dental cases during this reporting period. The Civic Action Program is providing material for the construction of a maternity hospital at Phu Thu'o'ng XA (AT 907754). This project is 90% complete.

The Battalion lifted 2,528,014 pounds in support of Division Operations.

During this period, 1st Shore Party Battalion sustained one (1) Enlisted KIA and one (1) Officer and four (4) Enlisted WIA's.
