



#### FART II

## Narrative Summary

During the period 1-31 January 1969 this Battalion continued to provide support to the 5th Marines (An Hoa), the 7th Marines (Hill 55), the 26th Marines and 1st Marines. On 28 January 1969, Operation "Linn River" was Initiated.

Company A continued to supply LZ support to LZ 467 (26th Marines), LZ 460 (1st Bn, 26th Marines), LZ 410 (3rd Bn, 1st Marines) and LZ 412 (1st Bn, 1st Marines). In addition HSS was sent to LZ 401 (1st Recon Bn) on an "as required" basis. Classes on HST and LSA operations were given to 2nd and 3rd Battalions of the 1st Marines. HSS was furnished to 2nd CAG to rig four (4) 40 foot towers for helilifts, and to 30th Naval Construction Battalion for rigging of two (2) bulldozers for helilift to Hoi An.

Company B continued to support the 5th Marines from An Hoa in addition giving not support to the 11th Marines, two (2) firing batteries of 12th Marines, two (2) firing batteries of 13th Marines in support of Operation "Taylor Common." In addition support was given to AdVN forces at Nong Song, the ATVN District Headquarters and the Special Forces at Duc Duc on several occasions.


Company C continued operations of the LSA at Hill 55 (7th Marines).

Hoff support was provided to 1/7 and 2/26 on Operation "Linn River." Also
Hoff support was provided to FIC, ASF1 and 1st Engineers on an as required
basis.

A total of 7,522,406 pounds of all classes of supplies were helilifted in support of the 1st Marine Division.

The Med-Cap treated 96 Vietnamese patients and Dent-Cap treated 22 patients during this period. \$12,980 VN and 700 pounds of food was contributed to the orphanage at Phu Thoong Than. The initial paperwork for 2 Civic Action projects in Hoa Loc Village, Office/Meeting House and a well pump, was initiated.

The Battalion sustained three (3) WIA's during the reporting period. There was one (1) death during the period due to malaria.
