- (5) On 8 November 1966 the third platoon, consisting of One (1) M55 8" Howitzer and one (1) M53 155mm Gun displaced from Hill 55 and occupied a firing position at An Hoa. The platoon is presently assigned a mission of general support, reinforcing Foxtrot Battery, 2d Battalion, 12th Marines. On 19 November 1966, the M53 155mm Gun, located at Hill65 was brought into FLSG to have a new tube installed. On 21 November 1966 the m55 8" Howitzer on Hill 65 was displaced to Hill 55 enroute to An Hoa. On 22 November 1966 the M53 155mm Gun had been retubed, and was sent to Hill55. A Tank escort was arranged for, and both the M 55 and M53 of the First Platoon were deployed to An Hoa to join the Third Platoon in their general support reinforcing mission of Foxtrot Battery 2d Battalion, 12th Marines. The M53 Gun at the Battery CP along with two (2) 155mm Howitzers are assigned a mission of general support reinforcing Bravo Battery of the 173 Airborne Brigade. One (1) M55 8" Howitzer remains at FLSG for repairs.
