NARRATIVE SUMMARY1. GENERAL OVERVIEW OF ALL ACTIVITIES

The majority of the fire missions fired by this battery were against bunker complexes in the southern half of the DMZ. As shown in enclosure (3), all firing platoons rotated firing positions to equalize amount and types of firing, evaluate readiness of platoons to displace, exercise the guns and temporarily mislead the enemy as to the location of the guns.

Construction continued in platoon positions and the battery rear.

During the month of May, the howitzers of this battery fired 134 observed missions and 138 unobserved missions, expending 3403 rounds of M106 (HE) and 32 rounds of M404 (HE).



- a. The Mess Hall at Con Thien was completed significantly enhancing sanitation.
- b. The Special Services Building at Dong Ha was completed and placed in operation.
- c. Lack of gun pads at Gio Linh is a minor problem at this time. Work is scheduled for June to preclude major problems during the monsoon.
- d. Lack of electrical power at Elliot Combat Base presents a minor problem.

10. COMMUNICATIONS - ELECTRONICS

The Battery continues to have difficulty acquiring parts for the M-110 Howitzer. One gun has been dead-lined since 12 May, 1969 awaiting an engine.

12. CIVIC ACTION

The Battery Corpseman conducted 4 MEDCAPS, treating 298 Vietnamese National's.

13. PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATION

The Battery joined 4 Officers and 23 Enlisted and dropped 0 Officers and 21 Enlisted. The Operating Percentage (of manning level) of Officers is 100% and, of Enlisted, 98%.

14. TRAINING

Unit/Section Training, COATIP, Personal Response and CMS Training, continued throughout the month.



Subj: Rotation of Platoon Firing Positions (Operation Janet)

1. Rotation of platoons ("A" to ECB, "B" to Con Thien, "C" to Gio Linh) will be executed on J-Day (tentatively 7 May 1969) in order to:

- a. Equalize amount and types of firing.
- b. Evaluate readiness of platoons to displace.
- c. Exercise guns.
- d. Furnish a "change-of-pace/scenery for platoons previously locked in concrete.
- e. Temporarily mislead the enemy as to the location of the deadliest guns in Vietnam.

2. To provide continuous fire support from all three positions simultaneously during multiple displacement, the following schedule applies:

- a. "A" gun and Advance Party depart Gio Linh when road clear (about 0930) and proceed to ECB.
- b. "C" gun and Advance Party depart Con Thien when road clear (about 0930) and proceed to Gio Linh.
- c. "B" gun and Advance Party depart ECB after "A" gun is in position ready to fire (about 1130) and proceed to Con Thien.
- d. "A" gun and Main Body depart Gio Linh after "C" gun is in position ready to fire (about 1130 and proceed to ECB.
- e. "C" gun and Main Body depart Con Thien after "B" gun is in position ready to fire (about 1330) and proceed to Gio Linh.

f. "B" Main Body depart ECB after arrival of "A" Main Body (about 1400) and proceed to Con Thien.

3. Advance Parties will assume technical control of Fire Direction ASAP at new positions. Registration will be conducted as soon as clearance available whether or not met available. Lay, bore sight, and safety in accordance with SOP.

4. Direct liaison authorized between platoons. Use cipher or courier to preclude premature disclosure of displacement. Minimize discussion of displacement outside 1st 8".

5. Retriever and Wrecker on-call.

6. Report ASAP CSMO, departures, arrivals, delays and crossing all check points. For call signs, use suffix "2" for advance parties, suffix "4" for main body, suffix last two digits of gun number for gun (example "A2 and A51 passing check point 6 at 0935H). Check points as follows:

CP1 - Con Thien Gate
 CP2 - ECB Gate
 CP3 - Gio Linh Gate
 CP4 - C-2
 CP5 - Cam Lo Bridge
 CP6 - Cam Lo Intersection
 CP7 - Khe Gio Bridge (026561)
 CP8 - C-1 Town
 CP9 - Dong Ha Bridge
 CP10 - Vinh Dai Rock Crusher (166585)
 CP11 - Hill 37 (089578)

7. Ammunition levels will be built to approximately 480 rounds HE/Plt on J minus one to preclude necessity for ammunition resupply on J-Day. No ammunition will be shifted on J-Day except 2 rds/gun.

8. Messhalls, all mess equipment (including reefers and ME-10's) and cooks will remain at present positions.

9. Bulldozers will remain at present positions as will operators.

10. Other guidelines on equipment:

- a. If you're signed for it, take it.
- b. If it's T/E, take it.
- c. If required for tactical operations, take it.

d. If it's "Base Property", leave it behind.

e. Examples and exceptions:

- (1) Showers stay.
- (2) Rations stay.
- (3) Excess POL stays.
- (4) Directional Antennas stay.
- (5) Special Services gear goes.
- (6) Cots at "B" stay.
- (7) FDC charts and Sit maps stay.
- (8) All other FDC gear goes.
- (9) Engineer stakes and barbed wire stay.
- (10) Lyster bags stay.
- (11) Trash barrels stay.

11. "C" FDC will be reactivated on J-Day for movement to Gio Linh. "B" FDC will deactivate upon arrival Con Thien and integrate into Btry FDC. Lt. FUIMER transfer to "C" for duty as FDO. Secondary checks from positions as before.

12. Noon meal on J-Day C-Rations.

13. Platoons prepare a continuity folder including information of value to the incoming unit containing, as a minimum, the following information:

- a. Position Area Diagram showing bunkers, gun positions, comm wire, barbed wire, OS's, EOL's, Platoon Center, adjacent units, CSW position and sectors of fire.
- b. Survey information
- c. Electrical power status.
- d. Water source.
- e. Ammo count by Lot #.
- f. Previous agreements and arrangements with adjacent tenant activities and base coordinator.

- g. Circuit diagram for wire lines.
- h. "Lessons Learned" for position area, (drainage during monsoon, problems with adjacent units, scrounge sources, etc.).
- i. Minimum QE's.

14. Each platoon will have available a total of (3) 6 X 6 trucks and (2) trailers, for the displacement. Trucks and trailers for "B" and "C" will be pre-positioned on J minus one. Trailers for "A" will follow sweep team on J-Day.

15. Police and sanitation: Golden rule applies. Each platoon will report on condition of new position.

16. Battery Gunnery Sgt will contact 12th Marines S-4 to arrange ferry at Dong Ha Bridge.

17. Secure gear on vehicles to preclude loss in transit.


18. In event of slippage, no movements will be initiated after 1630.

20. Thrust Point 0860. Base Number 3800.

21. Convoy Commanders plan and brief ambush immediate action.
